sustain thee he [19 PSA 55 22](#) # Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

sustain thee [11 IKL 17 09](#) # Arise, get thee to Zarephath, which [belongeth] to Zidon, and dwell there: behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee.
