cistern and running <u>20_PRO_05_15</u># Drink waters out of thine own cistern, and running waters out of thine own well.

cistern <u>12_2KI_18_31</u># Hearken not to Hezekiah: for thus saith the king of Assyria, Make [an agreement] with me by a present, and come out to me, and [then] eat ye every man of his own vine, and every one of his fig tree, and drink ye every one the waters of his cistern:
