strife among them <u>42_LUK_22_24</u># And there was also a strife among them, which of them should be accounted the greatest.

strife and a <u>24_JER_15_10</u> # Woe is me, my mother, that thou hast borne me a man of strife and a man of contention to the whole earth! I have neither lent on usury, nor men have lent to me on usury; [yet] every one of them doth curse me.

strife and a <u>20_PRO_16_28</u># A froward man soweth strife: and a whisperer separateth chief friends.

strife and a <u>20_PRO_29_22</u> # An angry man stirreth up strife, and a furious man aboundeth in transgression.

strife and contention <u>35_HAB_01_03</u># Why dost thou show me iniquity, and cause [me] to behold grievance? for spoiling and violence [are] before me: and there are [that] raise up strife and contention.

strife and debate <u>23_ISA_58_04</u># Behold, ye fast for strife and debate, and to smite with the fist of wickedness: ye shall not fast as [ye do this] day, to make your voice to be heard on high.

strife and divisions <u>46_1CO_03_03</u> # For ye are yet carnal: for whereas [there is] among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

strife and envying <u>45_ROM_13_13</u> # Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.

strife and he <u>20_PRO_17_19</u># He loveth transgression that loveth strife: [and] he that exalteth his gate seeketh destruction.

strife and reproach <u>20_PRO_22_10</u># Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yea, strife and reproach shall cease.

strife and some <u>50_PHP_01_15</u># Some indeed preach Christ even of envy and strife; and some also of good will:

strife belonging not <u>20_PRO_26_17</u> # He that passeth by, [and] meddleth with strife [belonging] not to him, [is like] one that taketh a dog by the ears.

strife between the <u>01_GEN_13_07</u># And there was a strife between the herdmen of Abram's cattle and the herdmen of Lot's cattle: and the Canaanite and the Perizzite dwelled then in the land.

strife but every <u>20_PRO_20_03</u># [It is] an honour for a man to cease from strife: but every fool will be meddling.

strife but he <u>20_PRO_15_18</u># A wrathful man stirreth up strife: but [he that is] slow to anger appeaseth strife.

strife but he <u>20_PRO_28_25</u># He that is of a proud heart stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat.

strife ceaseth <u>20_PRO_26_20</u> # Where no wood is, [there] the fire goeth out: so where [there is] no talebearer, the strife ceaseth.

strife I pray <u>01_GEN_13_08</u># And Abram said unto Lot, Let there be no strife, I pray thee, between me and thee, and between my herdmen and thy herdmen; for we [be] brethren.

strife in Kadesh <u>26 EZE 47 19</u> # And the south side southward, from Tamar [even] to the waters of strife [in] Kadesh, the river to the great sea. And [this is] the south side southward.

strife in Kadesh <u>26 EZE 48 28</u> # And by the border of Gad, at the south side southward, the border shall be even from Tamar [unto] the waters of strife [in] Kadesh, [and] to the river toward the great sea.

strife in the <u>19_PSA_55_09</u># Destroy, O Lord, [and] divide their tongues: for I have seen violence and strife in the city.

strife in your <u>59_JAM_03_14</u> # But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.

strife is as <u>20_PRO_17_14</u> # The beginning of strife [is as] when one letteth out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with.

strife is there <u>59_JAM_03_16</u># For where envying and strife [is], there [is] confusion and every evil work.

strife of the <u>04_NUM_27_14</u># For ye rebelled against my commandment in the desert of Zin, in the strife of the congregation, to sanctify me at the water before their eyes: that [is] the water of Meribah in Kadesh in the wilderness of Zin.

strife of tongues <u>19_PSA_31_20</u> # Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.

strife or vainglory <u>50_PHP_02_03</u> # [Let] nothing [be done] through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.

strife railings evil <u>54_1TI_06_04</u> # He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,

strife seditions heresies <u>48_GAL_05_20</u> # Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,

strife so that <u>19_PSA_106_32</u># They angered [him] also at the waters of strife, so that it went ill with Moses for their sakes:

strife throughout all <u>10_2SA_19_09</u> # And all the people were at strife throughout all the tribes of Israel, saying, The king saved us out of the hand of our enemies, and he delivered us out of the hand of the Philistines; and now he is fled out of the land for Absalom.

strife unto our <u>19_PSA_80_06</u># Thou makest us a strife unto our neighbours: and our enemies laugh among themselves.

strife with the <u>07_JUD_12_02</u> # And Jephthah said unto them, I and my people were at great strife with the children of Ammon; and when I called you, ye delivered me not out of their hands.

strife <u>05_DEU_01_12</u># How can I myself alone bear your cumbrance, and your burden, and your strife?

strife <u>58_HEB_06_16</u> # For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation [is] to them an

strife <u>20_PRO_17_01</u> # Better [is] a dry morsel, and quietness therewith, than an house full of sacrifices [with] strife.

strife <u>20_PRO_26_21</u> # [As] coals [are] to burning coals, and wood to fire; so [is] a contentious man to kindle strife.

strife <u>20_PRO_30_33</u># Surely the churning of milk bringeth forth butter, and the wringing of the nose bringeth forth blood: so the forcing of wrath bringeth forth strife.

strifes backbitings whisperings <u>47_2CO_12_20</u> # For I fear, lest, when I come, I shall not find you such as I would, and [that] I shall be found unto you such as ye would not: lest [there be] debates, envyings, wraths, strifes, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, tumults:

strifes but love 20_PRO_10_12 # Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins.

strifes of words <u>54_1TI_06_04</u> # He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,

strifes <u>55_2TI_02_23</u> # But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.
