firstripe figs if <u>34\_NAH\_03\_12</u> # All thy strong holds [shall be like] fig trees with the firstripe figs: if they be shaken, they shall even fall into the mouth of the eater.

firstripe fruit 33\_MIC\_07\_01 # Woe is me! for I am as when they have gathered the summer fruits, as the grapegleanings of the vintage: [there is] no cluster to eat: my soul desired the firstripe fruit.

firstripe grapes <u>04\_NUM\_13\_20</u> # And what the land [is], whether it [be] fat or lean, whether there be wood therein, or not. And be ye of good courage, and bring of the fruit of the land. Now the time [was] the time of the firstripe grapes.

firstripe in the <u>28\_HOS\_09\_10</u># I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the firstripe in the fig tree at her first time: [but] they went to Baalpeor, and separated themselves unto [that] shame; and [their] abominations were according as they loved.

strip the slain <u>09\_1SA\_31\_08</u># And it came to pass on the morrow, when the Philistines came to strip the slain, that they found Saul and his three sons fallen in mount Gilboa.

strip thee also <u>26\_EZE\_16\_39</u> # And I will also give thee into their hand, and they shall throw down thine eminent place, and shall break down thy high places: they shall strip thee also of thy clothes, and shall take thy fair jewels, and leave thee naked and bare.

strip thee out <u>26\_EZE\_23\_26</u> # They shall also strip thee out of thy clothes, and take away thy fair jewels.

stripes above measure <u>47\_2CO\_11\_23</u># Are they ministers of Christ? [I speak as a fool] I [am] more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

stripes and was 44\_ACT\_16\_33 # And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed [their] stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.

stripes for the 20\_PRO\_19\_29 # Judgments are prepared for scorners, and stripes for the back of fools.

stripes For unto 42\_LUK\_12\_48 # But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be

beaten with few [stripes]. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

stripes he may <u>05\_DEU\_25\_03</u># Forty stripes he may give him, [and] not exceed: lest, [if] he should exceed, and beat him above these with many stripes, then thy brother should seem vile unto thee.

stripes in imprisonments <u>47\_2CO\_06\_05</u># In stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labours, in watchings, in fastings;

stripes into a **20\_PRO\_17\_10** # A reproof entereth more into a wise man than an hundred stripes into a fool.

stripes of the <u>10\_2SA\_07\_14</u># I will be his father, and he shall be my son. If he commit iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men:

stripes save one 47\_2CO\_11\_24 # Of the Jews five times received I forty [stripes] save one.

stripped Aaron of <u>04\_NUM\_20\_28</u># And Moses stripped Aaron of his garments, and put them upon Eleazar his son; and Aaron died there in the top of the mount: and Moses and Eleazar came down from the mount.

stripped and naked <u>33\_MIC\_01\_08</u># Therefore I will wail and howl, I will go stripped and naked: I will make a wailing like the dragons, and mourning as the owls.

stripped him and 40\_MAT\_27\_28 # And they stripped him, and put on him a scarlet robe.

stripped him of <u>42\_LUK\_10\_30</u># And Jesus answering said, A certain [man] went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded [him], and departed, leaving [him] half dead.

stripped him they 13\_1CH\_10\_09 # And when they had stripped him, they took his head, and his armour, and sent into the land of the Philistines round about, to carry tidings unto their idols, and to the people.

stripped himself of <u>09\_1SA\_18\_04</u> # And Jonathan stripped himself of the robe that [was] upon him, and gave it to David, and his garments, even to his sword, and to his bow, and to his girdle.

stripped Joseph out <u>01\_GEN\_37\_23</u> # And it came to pass, when Joseph was come unto his brethren, that they stripped Joseph out of his coat, [his] coat of [many] colours that [was] on him;

stripped me of 18\_JOB\_19\_09 # He hath stripped me of my glory, and taken the crown [from] my head.

stripped off for 14\_2CH\_20\_25 # And when Jehoshaphat and his people came to take away the spoil of them, they found among them in abundance both riches with the dead bodies, and precious jewels, which they stripped off for themselves, more than they could carry away: and they were three days in gathering of the spoil, it was so much.

stripped off his <u>09\_1SA\_19\_24</u># And he stripped off his clothes also, and prophesied before Samuel in like manner, and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Wherefore they say, [Is] Saul also among the prophets?
