stroke and stroke <u>05_DEU_17_08</u># If there arise a matter too hard for thee in judgment, between blood and blood, between plea and plea, and between stroke and stroke, [being] matters of controversy within thy gates: then shalt thou arise, and get thee up into the place which the LORD thy God shall choose;

stroke away from 19_PSA_39_10 # Remove thy stroke away from me: I am consumed by the blow of thine hand.

stroke be tried <u>05_DEU_21_05</u># And the priests the sons of Levi shall come near; for them the LORD thy God hath chosen to minister unto him, and to bless in the name of the LORD; and by their word shall every controversy and every stroke be [tried]:

stroke being matters <u>05_DEU_17_08</u># If there arise a matter too hard for thee in judgment, between blood and blood, between plea and plea, and between stroke and stroke, [being] matters of controversy within thy gates: then shalt thou arise, and get thee up into the place which the LORD thy God shall choose;

stroke he that <u>23_ISA_14_06</u> # He who smote the people in wrath with a continual stroke, he that ruled the nations in anger, is persecuted, [and] none hindereth.

stroke is heavier <u>18_JOB_23_02</u> # Even to day [is] my complaint bitter: my stroke is heavier than my groaning.

stroke of the <u>17_EST_09_05</u> # Thus the Jews smote all their enemies with the stroke of the sword, and slaughter, and destruction, and did what they would unto those that hated them.

stroke of their <u>23_ISA_30_26</u> # Moreover the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day that the LORD bindeth up the breach of his people, and healeth the stroke of their wound.

stroke then a <u>18_JOB_36_18</u> # Because [there is] wrath, [beware] lest he take thee away with [his] stroke: then a great ransom cannot deliver thee.

stroke with the <u>05_DEU_19_05</u># As when a man goeth into the wood with his neighbour to hew wood, and his hand fetcheth a stroke with the ax to cut down the tree, and the head slippeth from the helve, and lighteth upon his neighbour, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live:

stroke yet neither <u>26_EZE_24_16</u> # Son of man, behold, I take away from thee the desire of thine eyes with a stroke: yet neither shalt thou mourn nor weep, neither shall thy tears run down.

strokes 20_PRO_18_06 # A fool's lips enter into contention, and his mouth calleth for strokes.
