stumble among them 23 ISA 05 27 # None shall be weary nor stumble among them; none shall slumber nor sleep; neither shall the girdle of their loins be loosed, nor the latchet of their shoes be broken:

stumble and fall 27 DAN 11 19# Then he shall turn his face toward the fort of his own land: but he shall stumble and fall, and not be found.

stumble and fall 23 ISA 08 15 # And many among them shall stumble, and fall, and be broken, and be snared, and be taken.

stumble and fall 24 JER 46 06 # Let not the swift flee away, nor the mighty man escape; they shall stumble, and fall toward the north by the river Euphrates.
