

# KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Ahasuerus after that <u>17\_EST\_02\_12</u> # Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of the women, [for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, [to wit], six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with [other] things for the purifying of the women;]

Ahasuerus and great <u>17\_EST\_10\_03</u># For Mordecai the Jew [was] next unto king Ahasuerus, and great among the Jews, and accepted of the multitude of his brethren, seeking the wealth of his people, and speaking peace to all his seed.

Ahasuerus and let <u>17\_EST\_01\_19</u> # If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

Ahasuerus answered and <u>17\_EST\_07\_05</u> # Then the king Ahasuerus answered and said unto Esther the queen, Who is he, and where is he, that durst presume in his heart to do so?

Ahasuerus both nigh <u>17\_EST\_09\_20</u># And Mordecai wrote these things, and sent letters unto all the Jews that [were] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, [both] nigh and far,

Ahasuerus by the <u>17\_EST\_01\_15</u> # What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law, because she hath not performed the commandment of the king Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?

Ahasuerus commanded Vashti <u>17\_EST\_01\_17</u> # For [this] deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.

Ahasuerus even the <u>17\_EST\_03\_06</u># And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had showed him the people of Mordecai: wherefore Haman sought to destroy all the Jews that [were] throughout the whole kingdom of Ahasuerus, [even] the people of Mordecai.

Ahasuerus give the <u>17\_EST\_08\_01</u> # On that day did the king Ahasuerus give the house of Haman the Jews' enemy unto Esther the queen. And Mordecai came before the king; for Esther had told what he [was] unto her.

Ahasuerus in the <u>15\_EZR\_04\_06</u> # And in the reign of Ahasuerus, in the beginning of his reign, wrote they [unto him] an accusation against the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem.

Ahasuerus into his <u>17\_EST\_02\_16</u># So Esther was taken unto king Ahasuerus into his house royal in the tenth month, which [is] the month Tebeth, in the seventh year of his reign.

Ahasuerus laid a <u>17\_EST\_10\_01</u># And the king Ahasuerus laid a tribute upon the land, and [upon] the isles of the sea.

Ahasuerus name and <u>17\_EST\_08\_10</u> # And he wrote in the king Ahasuerus' name, and sealed [it] with the king's ring, and sent letters by posts on horseback, [and] riders on mules, camels, [and] young dromedaries:

Ahasuerus namely upon <u>17\_EST\_08\_12</u> # Upon one day in all the provinces of king Ahasuerus, [namely], upon the thirteenth [day] of the twelfth month, which [is] the month Adar.

Ahasuerus of the <u>27\_DAN\_09\_01</u># In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the seed of the Medes, which was made king over the realm of the Chaldeans;

Ahasuerus promote Haman <u>17\_EST\_03\_01</u> # After these things did king Ahasuerus promote Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, and advanced him, and set his seat above all the princes that [were] with him.

Ahasuerus said unto <u>17\_EST\_08\_07</u> # Then the king Ahasuerus said unto Esther the queen and to Mordecai the Jew, Behold, I have given Esther the house of Haman, and him they have hanged upon the gallows, because he laid his hand upon the Jews.

Ahasuerus sat on <u>17\_EST\_01\_02</u># [That] in those days, when the king Ahasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom, which [was] in Shushan the palace,

Ahasuerus the king <u>17\_EST\_01\_10</u> # On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king,

Ahasuerus There is <u>17\_EST\_03\_08</u> # And Haman said unto king Ahasuerus, There is a certain people scattered abroad and dispersed among the people in all the provinces of thy kingdom; and their laws [are] diverse from all people; neither keep they the king's laws: therefore it [is] not for the king's profit to suffer them.

Ahasuerus they cast <u>17\_EST\_03\_07</u> # In the first month, that [is], the month Nisan, in the twelfth year of king Ahasuerus, they cast Pur, that [is], the lot, before Haman from day to day, and from month to month, [to] the twelfth [month], that [is], the month Adar.

Ahasuerus this is <u>17\_EST\_01\_01</u># Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, [this [is] Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, [over] an hundred and seven and twenty provinces:]

Ahasuerus to lay <u>17\_EST\_09\_02</u> # The Jews gathered themselves together in their cities throughout all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, to lay hand on such as sought their hurt: and no man could withstand them; for the fear of them fell upon all people.

Ahasuerus was appeased <u>17\_EST\_02\_01</u> # After these things, when the wrath of king Ahasuerus was appeased, he remembered Vashti, and what she had done, and what was decreed against her.

Ahasuerus was it <u>17\_EST\_03\_12</u> # Then were the king's scribes called on the thirteenth day of the first month, and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors that [were] over every province, and to the rulers of every people of every province according to the writing thereof, and [to] every people after their language; in the name of king Ahasuerus was it written, and sealed with the king's ring.

Ahasuerus which reigned <u>17\_EST\_01\_01</u><sup>#</sup> Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, [this [is] Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, [over] an hundred and seven and twenty provinces:]

Ahasuerus with words <u>17\_EST\_09\_30</u> # And he sent the letters unto all the Jews, to the hundred twenty and seven provinces of the kingdom of Ahasuerus, [with] words of peace and truth,

Ahasuerus <u>17\_EST\_01\_09</u> # Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women [in] the royal house which [belonged] to king Ahasuerus.

Ahasuerus <u>17\_EST\_01\_16</u># And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen

hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that [are] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

Ahasuerus <u>17\_EST\_02\_21</u># In those days, while Mordecai sat in the king's gate, two of the king's chamberlains, Bigthan and Teresh, of those which kept the door, were wroth, and sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

Ahasuerus <u>17\_EST\_06\_02</u> # And it was found written, that Mordecai had told of Bigthana and Teresh, two of the king's chamberlains, the keepers of the door, who sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

ensue it <u>60\_1PE\_03\_11</u># Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it.

issue all vessels <u>23\_ISA\_22\_24</u> # And they shall hang upon him all the glory of his father's house, the offspring and the issue, all vessels of small quantity, from the vessels of cups, even to all the vessels of flagons.

issue and hath <u>03\_LEV\_15\_11</u># And whomsoever he toucheth that hath the issue, and hath not rinsed his hands in water, he shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

issue and her <u>03\_LEV\_15\_19</u> # And if a woman have an issue, [and] her issue in her flesh be blood, she shall be put apart seven days: and whosoever toucheth her shall be unclean until the even.

issue and of <u>03\_LEV\_15\_32</u># This [is] the law of him that hath an issue, and [of him] whose seed goeth from him, and is defiled therewith;

issue and whosoever <u>04\_NUM\_05\_02</u> # Command the children of Israel, that they put out of the camp every leper, and every one that hath an issue, and whosoever is defiled by the dead:

issue from thee <u>12\_2KI\_20\_18</u># And of thy sons that shall issue from thee, which thou shalt beget, shall they take away; and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon.

issue from thee <u>23\_ISA\_39\_07</u># And of thy sons that shall issue from thee, which thou shalt beget, shall they take away; and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon.

issue he is <u>03\_LEV\_15\_02</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When any man hath a running issue out of his flesh, [because of] his issue he [is] unclean.

issue he shall <u>03\_LEV\_22\_04</u> # What man soever of the seed of Aaron [is] a leper, or hath a running issue; he shall not eat of the holy things, until he be clean. And whoso toucheth any thing [that is] unclean [by] the dead, or a man whose seed goeth from him;

issue in her <u>03\_LEV\_15\_19</u># And if a woman have an issue, [and] her issue in her flesh be blood, she shall be put apart seven days: and whosoever toucheth her shall be unclean until the even.

issue is cleansed <u>03\_LEV\_15\_13</u> # And when he that hath an issue is cleansed of his issue; then he shall number to himself seven days for his cleansing, and wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in running water, and shall be clean.

issue is like <u>26\_EZE\_23\_20</u> # For she doted upon their paramours, whose flesh [is as] the flesh of asses, and whose issue [is like] the issue of horses.

issue is unclean <u>03\_LEV\_15\_04</u> # Every bed, whereon he lieth that hath the issue, is unclean: and every thing, whereon he sitteth, shall be unclean.

issue it is <u>03\_LEV\_15\_03</u># And this shall be his uncleanness in his issue: whether his flesh run with his

issue, or his flesh be stopped from his issue, it [is] his uncleanness.

issue left his <u>40\_MAT\_22\_25</u> # Now there were with us seven brethren: and the first, when he had married a wife, deceased, and, having no issue, left his wife unto his brother:

issue of blood <u>42\_LUK\_08\_43</u># And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,

issue of blood <u>42\_LUK\_08\_44</u> # Came behind [him], and touched the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanched.

issue of blood <u>41\_MAR\_05\_25</u> # And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,

issue of blood <u>40\_MAT\_09\_20</u># And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind [him], and touched the hem of his garment:

issue of her <u>03\_LEV\_12\_07</u> # Who shall offer it before the LORD, and make an atonement for her; and she shall be cleansed from the issue of her blood. This [is] the law for her that hath born a male or a female.

issue of her <u>03\_LEV\_15\_25</u> # And if a woman have an issue of her blood many days out of the time of her separation, or if it run beyond the time of her separation; all the days of the issue of her uncleanness shall be as the days of her separation: she [shall be] unclean.

issue of her <u>03\_LEV\_15\_25</u> # And if a woman have an issue of her blood many days out of the time of her separation, or if it run beyond the time of her separation; all the days of the issue of her uncleanness shall be as the days of her separation: she [shall be] unclean.

issue of horses <u>26\_EZE\_23\_20</u># For she doted upon their paramours, whose flesh [is as] the flesh of asses, and whose issue [is like] the issue of horses.

issue of the <u>03\_LEV\_15\_33</u># And of her that is sick of her flowers, and of him that hath an issue, of the man, and of the woman, and of him that lieth with her that is unclean.

issue or his <u>03\_LEV\_15\_03</u> # And this shall be his uncleanness in his issue: whether his flesh run with his issue, or his flesh be stopped from his issue, it [is] his uncleanness.

issue or that <u>10\_2SA\_03\_29</u> # Let it rest on the head of Joab, and on all his father's house; and let there not fail from the house of Joab one that hath an issue, or that is a leper, or that leaneth on a staff, or that falleth on the sword, or that lacketh bread.

issue out of <u>03\_LEV\_15\_02</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When any man hath a running issue out of his flesh, [because of] his issue he [is] unclean.

issue out toward <u>26\_EZE\_47\_08</u># Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: [which being] brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed.

issue shall be <u>03\_LEV\_15\_09</u> # And what saddle soever he rideth upon that hath the issue shall be unclean.

issue shall be <u>03\_LEV\_15\_12</u># And the vessel of earth, that he toucheth which hath the issue, shall be broken: and every vessel of wood shall be rinsed in water.

issue shall be <u>03 LEV 15 26</u># Every bed whereon she lieth all the days of her issue shall be unto her as the bed of her separation: and whatsoever she sitteth upon shall be unclean, as the uncleanness of her separation.

issue shall wash <u>03\_LEV\_15\_06</u># And he that sitteth on [any] thing whereon he sat that hath the issue shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

issue shall wash <u>03\_LEV\_15\_07</u># And he that toucheth the flesh of him that hath the issue shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

issue spit upon <u>03\_LEV\_15\_08</u># And if he that hath the issue spit upon him that is clean; then he shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

issue then he <u>03\_LEV\_15\_13</u># And when he that hath an issue is cleansed of his issue; then he shall number to himself seven days for his cleansing, and wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in running water, and shall be clean.

issue then she <u>03\_LEV\_15\_28</u># But if she be cleansed of her issue, then she shall number to herself seven days, and after that she shall be clean.

issue whether his <u>03\_LEV\_15\_03</u># And this shall be his uncleanness in his issue: whether his flesh run with his issue, or his flesh be stopped from his issue, it [is] his uncleanness.

issue which thou <u>01\_GEN\_48\_06</u># And thy issue, which thou begettest after them, shall be thine, [and] shall be called after the name of their brethren in their inheritance.

issue <u>03\_LEV\_15\_15</u># And the priest shall offer them, the one [for] a sin offering, and the other [for] a burnt offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for him before the LORD for his issue.

issued and came <u>27\_DAN\_07\_10</u> # A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.

issued fire and <u>66\_REV\_09\_17</u> # And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses [were] as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

issued out from <u>26\_EZE\_47\_01</u> # Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house eastward: for the forefront of the house [stood toward] the east, and the waters came down from under from the right side of the house, at the south [side] of the altar.

issued out of <u>18\_JOB\_38\_08</u> # Or [who] shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, [as if] it had issued out of the womb?

issued out of <u>06\_JOS\_08\_22</u># And the other issued out of the city against them; so they were in the midst of Israel, some on this side, and some on that side: and they smote them, so that they let none of them remain or escape.

issued out of <u>66\_REV\_09\_18</u># By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths.

issues from death <u>19\_PSA\_68\_20</u> # [He that is] our God [is] the God of salvation; and unto GOD the Lord [belong] the issues from death.

issues of life 20\_PRO\_04\_23 # Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it [are] the issues of life.

pursue after a <u>09\_1SA\_24\_14</u> # After whom is the king of Israel come out? after whom dost thou pursue? after a dead dog, after a flea.

pursue after David <u>10\_28A\_17\_01</u># Moreover Ahithophel said unto Absalom, Let me now choose out twelve thousand men, and I will arise and pursue after David this night:

pursue after him <u>10\_2SA\_20\_06</u># And David said to Abishai, Now shall Sheba the son of Bichri do us more harm than [did] Absalom: take thou thy lord's servants, and pursue after him, lest he get him fenced cities, and escape us.

pursue after him <u>06\_JOS\_20\_05</u> # And if the avenger of blood pursue after him, then they shall not deliver the slayer up into his hand; because he smote his neighbour unwittingly, and hated him not beforetime.

pursue after his <u>09\_1SA\_26\_18</u># And he said, Wherefore doth my lord thus pursue after his servant? for what have I done? or what evil [is] in mine hand?

pursue after Sheba <u>10\_2SA\_20\_07</u> # And there went out after him Joab's men, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, and all the mighty men: and they went out of Jerusalem, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.

pursue after Sheba <u>10\_2SA\_20\_13</u> # When he was removed out of the highway, all the people went on after Joab, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.

pursue after the <u>01\_GEN\_35\_05</u># And they journeyed: and the terror of God was upon the cities that [were] round about them, and they did not pursue after the sons of Jacob.

pursue after them <u>06\_JOS\_02\_05</u> # And it came to pass [about the time] of shutting of the gate, when it was dark, that the men went out: whither the men went I wot not: pursue after them quickly; for ye shall overtake them.

pursue after them <u>06\_JOS\_08\_16</u> # And all the people that [were] in Ai were called together to pursue after them: and they pursued after Joshua, and were drawn away from the city.

pursue after this <u>09\_1SA\_30\_08</u># And David inquired at the LORD, saying, Shall I pursue after this troop? shall I overtake them? And he answered him, Pursue: for thou shalt surely overtake [them], and without fail recover [all].

pursue after your <u>06\_JOS\_10\_19</u> # And stay ye not, [but] pursue after your enemies, and smite the hindmost of them; suffer them not to enter into their cities: for the LORD your God hath delivered them into your hand.

pursue it <u>19\_PSA\_34\_14</u># Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it.

pursue my soul <u>18\_JOB\_30\_15</u># Terrors are turned upon me: they pursue my soul as the wind: and my welfare passeth away as a cloud.

pursue the dry <u>18\_JOB\_13\_25</u># Wilt thou break a leaf driven to and fro? and wilt thou pursue the dry stubble?

pursue the slayer <u>05\_DEU\_19\_06</u># Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he [was] not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.

pursue thee and <u>09\_1SA\_25\_29</u> # Yet a man is risen to pursue thee, and to seek thy soul: but the soul of my lord shall be bound in the bundle of life with the LORD thy God; and the souls of thine enemies, them shall he sling out, [as out] of the middle of a sling.

pursue you be 23\_ISA\_30\_16 # But ye said, No; for we will flee upon horses; therefore shall ye flee: and, We will ride upon the swift; therefore shall they that pursue you be swift.

pursued after Abner <u>10\_2SA\_02\_19</u> # And Asahel pursued after Abner; and in going he turned not to the right hand nor to the left from following Abner.

pursued after Abner 10\_2SA\_02\_24 # Joab also and Abishai pursued after Abner: and the sun went down

when they were come to the hill of Ammah, that [lieth] before Giah by the way of the wilderness of Gibeon.

pursued after David <u>09\_1SA\_23\_25</u> # Saul also and his men went to seek [him]. And they told David: wherefore he came down into a rock, and abode in the wilderness of Maon. And when Saul heard [that], he pursued after David in the wilderness of Maon.

pursued after him <u>01\_GEN\_31\_23</u> # And he took his brethren with him, and pursued after him seven days' journey; and they overtook him in the mount Gilead.

pursued after him <u>07\_JUD\_01\_06</u># But Adonibezek fled; and they pursued after him, and caught him, and cut off his thumbs and his great toes.

pursued after Israel <u>10\_2SA\_02\_28</u># So Joab blew a trumpet, and all the people stood still, and pursued after Israel no more, neither fought they any more.

pursued after Israel <u>06\_JOS\_08\_17</u># And there was not a man left in Ai or Bethel, that went not out after Israel: and they left the city open, and pursued after Israel.

pursued after Jeroboam <u>14\_2CH\_13\_19</u> # And Abijah pursued after Jeroboam, and took cities from him, Bethel with the towns thereof, and Jeshanah with the towns thereof, and Ephrain with the towns thereof.

pursued after Joshua <u>06\_JOS\_08\_16</u># And all the people that [were] in Ai were called together to pursue after them: and they pursued after Joshua, and were drawn away from the city.

pursued after me <u>01\_GEN\_31\_36</u># And Jacob was wroth, and chided with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What [is] my trespass? what [is] my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me?

pursued after Sheba <u>10\_2SA\_20\_10</u> # But Amasa took no heed to the sword that [was] in Joab's hand: so he smote him therewith in the fifth [rib], and shed out his bowels to the ground, and struck him not again; and he died. So Joab and Abishai his brother pursued after Sheba the son of Bichri.

pursued after the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_05</u># And the army of the Chaldees pursued after the king, and overtook him in the plains of Jericho: and all his army were scattered from him.

pursued after the <u>02\_EXO\_14\_08</u> # And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued after the children of Israel: and the children of Israel went out with an high hand.
