sufficient for a <u>23_ISA_40_16</u># And Lebanon [is] not sufficient to burn, nor the beasts thereof sufficient for a burnt offering.

sufficient for all <u>02_EXO_36_07</u> # For the stuff they had was sufficient for all the work to make it, and too much.

sufficient for him <u>05_DEU_33_07</u># And this [is the blessing] of Judah: and he said, Hear, LORD, the voice of Judah, and bring him unto his people: let his hands be sufficient for him; and be thou an help [to him] from his enemies.

sufficient for his <u>05_DEU_15_08</u># But thou shalt open thine hand wide unto him, and shalt surely lend him sufficient for his need, [in that] which he wanteth.

sufficient for thee <u>47_2CO_12_09</u># And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
