sweet and a <u>21\_ECC\_11\_07</u># Truly the light [is] sweet, and a pleasant [thing it is] for the eyes to behold the sun:

sweet and bread 20\_PRO\_09\_17 # Stolen waters are sweet, and bread [eaten] in secret is pleasant.

sweet and send <u>16\_NEH\_08\_10</u># Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for [this] day [is] holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

sweet and sweet <u>23\_ISA\_05\_20</u> # Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!

sweet are thy <u>19\_PSA\_119\_103</u> # How sweet are thy words unto my taste! [yea, sweeter] than honey to my mouth!

sweet as honey <u>66\_REV\_10\_09</u> # And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take [it], and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

sweet calamus two <u>02\_EXO\_30\_23</u> # Take thou also unto thee principal spices, of pure myrrh five hundred [shekels], and of sweet cinnamon half so much, [even] two hundred and fifty [shekels], and of sweet calamus two hundred and fifty [shekels],

sweet cane from <u>24\_JER\_06\_20</u> # To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and the sweet cane from a far country? your burnt offerings [are] not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.

sweet cane with <u>23\_ISA\_43\_24</u> # Thou hast bought me no sweet cane with money, neither hast thou filled me with the fat of thy sacrifices: but thou hast made me to serve with thy sins, thou hast wearied me with thine iniquities.

sweet cinnamon half <u>02\_EXO\_30\_23</u> # Take thou also unto thee principal spices, of pure myrrh five hundred [shekels], and of sweet cinnamon half so much, [even] two hundred and fifty [shekels], and of sweet calamus two hundred and fifty [shekels],

sweet counsel together <u>19\_PSA\_55\_14</u> # We took sweet counsel together, [and] walked unto the house of God in company.

sweet flowers his <u>22\_SON\_05\_13</u> # His cheeks [are] as a bed of spices, [as] sweet flowers: his lips [like] lilies, dropping sweet smelling myrrh.

sweet for bitter <u>23\_ISA\_05\_20</u> # Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!

sweet I will <u>19\_PSA\_104\_34</u># My meditation of him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the LORD.

sweet in his <u>18\_JOB\_20\_12</u># Though wickedness be sweet in his mouth, [though] he hide it under his tongue;

sweet incense and <u>14\_2CH\_02\_04</u> # Behold, I build an house to the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate [it] to him, [and] to burn before him sweet incense, and for the continual showbread, and for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts of the LORD our God. This [is an ordinance] for ever to Israel.

sweet incense and <u>02\_EXO\_35\_15</u> # And the incense altar, and his staves, and the anointing oil, and the sweet incense, and the hanging for the door at the entering in of the tabernacle,

sweet incense and <u>02\_EXO\_39\_38</u># And the golden altar, and the anointing oil, and the sweet incense, and the hanging for the tabernacle door,

sweet incense and <u>04\_NUM\_04\_16</u> # And to the office of Eleazar the son of Aaron the priest [pertaineth] the oil for the light, and the sweet incense, and the daily meat offering, and the anointing oil, [and] the oversight of all the tabernacle, and of all that therein [is], in the sanctuary, and in the vessels thereof.

sweet incense beaten <u>03\_LEV\_16\_12</u> # And he shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire from off the altar before the LORD, and his hands full of sweet incense beaten small, and bring [it] within the veil:

sweet incense before <u>03\_LEV\_04\_07</u> # And the priest shall put [some] of the blood upon the horns of the altar of sweet incense before the LORD, which [is] in the tabernacle of the congregation; and shall pour all the blood of the bullock at the bottom of the altar of the burnt offering, which [is at] the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

sweet incense every <u>02\_EXO\_30\_07</u> # And Aaron shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning: when he dresseth the lamps, he shall burn incense upon it.

sweet incense the <u>14\_2CH\_13\_11</u># And they burn unto the LORD every morning and every evening burnt sacrifices and sweet incense: the showbread also [set they in order] upon the pure table; and the candlestick of gold with the lamps thereof, to burn every evening: for we keep the charge of the LORD our God; but ye have forsaken him.

sweet incense thereon <u>02\_EXO\_40\_27</u># And he burnt sweet incense thereon; as the LORD commanded Moses.

sweet incense <u>02\_EXO\_25\_06</u> # Oil for the light, spices for anointing oil, and for sweet incense,

sweet incense <u>02\_EXO\_35\_08</u># And oil for the light, and spices for anointing oil, and for the sweet incense,

sweet incense <u>02\_EXO\_35\_28</u># And spice, and oil for the light, and for the anointing oil, and for the sweet incense.

sweet influences of <u>18\_JOB\_38\_31</u> # Canst thou bind the sweet influences of Pleiades, or loose the bands of Orion?

sweet is thy <u>22\_SON\_02\_14</u> # O my dove, [that art] in the clefts of the rock, in the secret [places] of the stairs, let me see thy countenance, let me hear thy voice; for sweet [is] thy voice, and thy countenance [is] comely.

sweet melody sing <u>23\_ISA\_23\_16</u> # Take an harp, go about the city, thou harlot that hast been forgotten;

make sweet melody, sing many songs, that thou mayest be remembered.

sweet odours and <u>14\_2CH\_16\_14</u># And they buried him in his own sepulchres, which he had made for himself in the city of David, and laid him in the bed which was filled with sweet odours and divers kinds [of spices] prepared by the apothecaries' art: and they made a very great burning for him.

sweet odours and <u>17\_EST\_02\_12</u> # Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of the women, [for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, [to wit], six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with [other] things for the purifying of the women;]

sweet odours unto <u>27\_DAN\_02\_46</u> # Then the king Nebuchadnezzar fell upon his face, and worshipped Daniel, and commanded that they should offer an oblation and sweet odours unto him.

sweet odours <u>03\_LEV\_26\_31</u> # And I will make your cities waste, and bring your sanctuaries unto desolation, and I will not smell the savour of your sweet odours.

sweet psalmist of <u>10\_2SA\_23\_01</u> # Now these [be] the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man [who was] raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,

sweet savour a <u>04\_NUM\_28\_06</u> # [It is] a continual burnt offering, which was ordained in mount Sinai for a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.

sweet savour a <u>04\_NUM\_28\_13</u> # And a several tenth deal of flour mingled with oil [for] a meat offering unto one lamb; [for] a burnt offering of a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.

sweet savour a <u>04\_NUM\_29\_06</u> # Beside the burnt offering of the month, and his meat offering, and the daily burnt offering, and his meat offering, and their drink offerings, according unto their manner, for a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.

sweet savour all <u>03\_LEV\_03\_16</u># And the priest shall burn them upon the altar: [it is] the food of the offering made by fire for a sweet savour: all the fat [is] the LORD'S.

sweet savour an <u>02\_EXO\_29\_18</u># And thou shalt burn the whole ram upon the altar: it [is] a burnt offering unto the LORD: it [is] a sweet savour, an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

sweet savour an <u>02\_EXO\_29\_41</u> # And the other lamb thou shalt offer at even, and shalt do thereto according to the meat offering of the morning, and according to the drink offering thereof, for a sweet savour, an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

sweet savour and <u>26\_EZE\_16\_19</u># My meat also which I gave thee, fine flour, and oil, and honey, [wherewith] I fed thee, thou hast even set it before them for a sweet savour: and [thus] it was, saith the Lord GOD.

sweet savour and <u>26\_EZE\_20\_28</u> # [For] when I had brought them into the land, [for] the which I lifted up mine hand to give it to them, then they saw every high hill, and all the thick trees, and they offered there their sacrifices, and there they presented the provocation of their offering: there also they made their sweet savour, and poured out there their drink offerings.

sweet savour and <u>01\_GEN\_08\_21</u># And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart [is] evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.

sweet savour and <u>03\_LEV\_08\_21</u> # And he washed the inwards and the legs in water; and Moses burnt the

whole ram upon the altar: it [was] a burnt sacrifice for a sweet savour, [and] an offering made by fire unto the LORD; as the LORD commanded Moses.

sweet savour and <u>03\_LEV\_23\_13</u># And the meat offering thereof [shall be] two tenth deals of fine flour mingled with oil, an offering made by fire unto the LORD [for] a sweet savour: and the drink offering thereof [shall be] of wine, the fourth [part] of an hin.

sweet savour before <u>02\_EXO\_29\_25</u># And thou shalt receive them of their hands, and burn [them] upon the altar for a burnt offering, for a sweet savour before the LORD: it [is] an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

sweet savour even <u>03\_LEV\_06\_15</u># And he shall take of it his handful, of the flour of the meat offering, and of the oil thereof, and all the frankincense which [is] upon the meat offering, and shall burn [it] upon the altar [for] a sweet savour, [even] the memorial of it, unto the LORD.

sweet savour it <u>03\_LEV\_08\_28</u># And Moses took them from off their hands, and burnt [them] on the altar upon the burnt offering: they [were] consecrations for a sweet savour: it [is] an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

sweet savour of <u>47\_2CO\_02\_15</u># For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish:

sweet savour one <u>04\_NUM\_29\_08</u> # But ye shall offer a burnt offering unto the LORD [for] a sweet savour; one young bullock, one ram, [and] seven lambs of the first year; they shall be unto you without blemish:

sweet savour to <u>26\_EZE\_06\_13</u> # Then shall ye know that I [am] the LORD, when their slain [men] shall be among their idols round about their altars, upon every high hill, in all the tops of the mountains, and under every green tree, and under every thick oak, the place where they did offer sweet savour to all their idols.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_01\_09</u> # But his inwards and his legs shall he wash in water: and the priest shall burn all on the altar, [to be] a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_01\_13</u># But he shall wash the inwards and the legs with water: and the priest shall bring [it] all, and burn [it] upon the altar: it [is] a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_01\_17</u> # And he shall cleave it with the wings thereof, [but] shall not divide [it] asunder: and the priest shall burn it upon the altar, upon the wood that [is] upon the fire: it [is] a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_02\_02</u> # And he shall bring it to Aaron's sons the priests: and he shall take thereout his handful of the flour thereof, and of the oil thereof, with all the frankincense thereof; and the priest shall burn the memorial of it upon the altar, [to be] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD:

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_02\_09</u># And the priest shall take from the meat offering a memorial thereof, and shall burn [it] upon the altar: [it is] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_03\_05</u> # And Aaron's sons shall burn it on the altar upon the burnt sacrifice, which [is] upon the wood that [is] on the fire: [it is] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_04\_31</u> # And he shall take away all the fat thereof, as the fat is taken away from off the sacrifice of peace offerings; and the priest shall burn [it] upon the altar for a sweet savour unto the LORD; and the priest shall make an atonement for him, and it shall be forgiven him.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_06\_21</u># In a pan it shall be made with oil; [and when it is] baken, thou shalt bring it in: [and] the baken pieces of the meat offering shalt thou offer [for] a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_17\_06</u># And the priest shall sprinkle the blood upon the altar of the LORD [at] the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and burn the fat for a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>03\_LEV\_23\_18</u># And ye shall offer with the bread seven lambs without blemish of the first year, and one young bullock, and two rams: they shall be [for] a burnt offering unto the LORD, with their meat offering, and their drink offerings, [even] an offering made by fire, of sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_15\_03</u> # And will make an offering by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, or a sacrifice in performing a vow, or in a freewill offering, or in your solemn feasts, to make a sweet savour unto the LORD, of the herd, or of the flock:

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_15\_07</u> # And for a drink offering thou shalt offer the third [part] of an hin of wine, [for] a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_15\_10</u># And thou shalt bring for a drink offering half an hin of wine, [for] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_15\_13</u># All that are born of the country shall do these things after this manner, in offering an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_15\_14</u># And if a stranger sojourn with you, or whosoever [be] among you in your generations, and will offer an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD; as ye do, so he shall do.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_15\_24</u> # Then it shall be, if [ought] be committed by ignorance without the knowledge of the congregation, that all the congregation shall offer one young bullock for a burnt offering, for a sweet savour unto the LORD, with his meat offering, and his drink offering, according to the manner, and one kid of the goats for a sin offering.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_18\_17</u> # But the firstling of a cow, or the firstling of a sheep, or the firstling of a goat, thou shalt not redeem; they [are] holy: thou shalt sprinkle their blood upon the altar, and shalt burn their fat [for] an offering made by fire, for a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_28\_02</u> # Command the children of Israel, and say unto them, My offering, [and] my bread for my sacrifices made by fire, [for] a sweet savour unto me, shall ye observe to offer unto me in their due season.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_28\_08</u># And the other lamb shalt thou offer at even: as the meat offering of the morning, and as the drink offering thereof, thou shalt offer [it], a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_28\_24</u> # After this manner ye shall offer daily, throughout the seven days, the meat of the sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD: it shall be offered beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering.

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_28\_27</u> # But ye shall offer the burnt offering for a sweet savour unto the LORD; two young bullocks, one ram, seven lambs of the first year;

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_29\_02</u> # And ye shall offer a burnt offering for a sweet savour unto the LORD; one young bullock, one ram, [and] seven lambs of the first year without blemish:

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_29\_13</u># And ye shall offer a burnt offering, a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD; thirteen young bullocks, two rams, [and] fourteen lambs of the first year; they shall be without blemish:

sweet savour unto <u>04\_NUM\_29\_36</u> # But ye shall offer a burnt offering, a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD: one bullock, one ram, seven lambs of the first year without blemish:

sweet savour when <u>26\_EZE\_20\_41</u> # I will accept you with your sweet savour, when I bring you out from the people, and gather you out of the countries wherein ye have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you before the heathen.

sweet savour <u>03\_LEV\_02\_12</u># As for the oblation of the firstfruits, ye shall offer them unto the LORD: but they shall not be burnt on the altar for a sweet savour.

sweet savours unto <u>15\_EZR\_06\_10</u> # That they may offer sacrifices of sweet savours unto the God of heaven, and pray for the life of the king, and of his sons.

sweet smell a <u>50\_PHP\_04\_18</u> # But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things [which were sent] from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.

sweet smell there <u>23\_ISA\_03\_24</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] instead of sweet smell there shall be stink; and instead of a girdle a rent; and instead of well set hair baldness; and instead of a stomacher a girding of sackcloth; [and] burning instead of beauty.

sweet smelling myrrh <u>22\_SON\_05\_05</u> # I rose up to open to my beloved; and my hands dropped [with] myrrh, and my fingers [with] sweet smelling myrrh, upon the handles of the lock.

sweet smelling myrrh <u>22\_SON\_05\_13</u># His cheeks [are] as a bed of spices, [as] sweet flowers: his lips [like] lilies, dropping sweet smelling myrrh.

sweet spices according <u>02\_EXO\_37\_29</u> # And he made the holy anointing oil, and the pure incense of sweet spices, according to the work of the apothecary.

sweet spices stacte <u>02\_EXO\_30\_34</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Take unto thee sweet spices, stacte, and onycha, and galbanum; [these] sweet spices with pure frankincense: of each shall there be a like [weight]:

sweet spices that <u>41\_MAR\_16\_01</u> # And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the [mother] of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.

sweet spices with <u>02\_EXO\_30\_34</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Take unto thee sweet spices, stacte, and onycha, and galbanum; [these] sweet spices with pure frankincense: of each shall there be a like [weight]:

sweet there he <u>02\_EXO\_15\_25</u> # And he cried unto the LORD; and the LORD showed him a tree, [which] when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: there he made for them a statute and an ordinance, and there he proved them,

sweet to a <u>20\_PRO\_20\_17</u># Bread of deceit [is] sweet to a man; but afterwards his mouth shall be filled with gravel.

sweet to my <u>22\_SON\_02\_03</u># As the apple tree among the trees of the wood, so [is] my beloved among the sons. I sat down under his shadow with great delight, and his fruit [was] sweet to my taste.

sweet to the <u>20\_PRO\_13\_19</u># The desire accomplished is sweet to the soul: but [it is] abomination to fools to depart from evil.

sweet to the <u>20\_PRO\_16\_24</u> # Pleasant words [are as] an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

sweet to thy <u>20\_PRO\_24\_13</u> # My son, eat thou honey, because [it is] good; and the honeycomb, [which is] sweet to thy taste:

sweet unto him <u>18\_JOB\_21\_33</u># The clods of the valley shall be sweet unto him, and every man shall draw after him, as [there are] innumerable before him.

sweet unto me <u>24\_JER\_06\_20</u> # To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and the sweet cane from a far country? your burnt offerings [are] not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.

sweet unto me <u>24\_JER\_31\_26</u> # Upon this I awaked, and beheld; and my sleep was sweet unto me.

sweet water and <u>59\_JAM\_03\_11</u># Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet [water] and bitter?

sweet whether he <u>21\_ECC\_05\_12</u> # The sleep of a labouring man [is] sweet, whether he eat little or much: but the abundance of the rich will not suffer him to sleep.

sweet wine and <u>30\_AMO\_09\_13</u># Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

sweet wine and <u>23\_ISA\_49\_26</u> # And I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD [am] thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.

sweet wine but <u>33\_MIC\_06\_15</u># Thou shalt sow, but thou shalt not reap; thou shalt tread the olives, but thou shalt not anoint thee with oil; and sweet wine, but shalt not drink wine.

sweet words <u>20\_PRO\_23\_08</u># The morsel [which] thou hast eaten shalt thou vomit up, and lose thy sweet words.

sweet yea he <u>22\_SON\_05\_16</u> # His mouth [is] most sweet: yea, he [is] altogether lovely. This [is] my beloved, and this [is] my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem.

sweet <u>20\_PRO\_03\_24</u> # When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.

sweeter than honey <u>19\_PSA\_119\_103</u> # How sweet are thy words unto my taste! [yea, sweeter] than honey to my mouth!

sweetly causing the <u>22\_SON\_07\_09</u> # And the roof of thy mouth like the best wine for my beloved, that goeth [down] sweetly, causing the lips of those that are asleep to speak.

sweetly on him <u>18\_JOB\_24\_20</u> # The womb shall forget him; the worm shall feed sweetly on him; he shall be no more remembered; and wickedness shall be broken as a tree.

sweetness and my <u>07\_JUD\_09\_11</u># But the fig tree said unto them, Should I forsake my sweetness, and my good fruit, and go to be promoted over the trees?
