

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Beeshterah with her <u>06\_JOS\_21\_27</u># And unto the children of Gershon, of the families of the Levites, out of the [other] half tribe of Manasseh [they gave] Golan in Bashan with her suburbs, [to be] a city of refuge for the slayer; and Beeshterah with her suburbs; two cities.

Terah an hundred <u>01\_GEN\_11\_25</u># And Nahor lived after he begat Terah an hundred and nineteen years, and begat sons and daughters.

Terah begat Abram <u>01\_GEN\_11\_27</u># Now these [are] the generations of Terah: Terah begat Abram, Nahor, and Haran; and Haran begat Lot.

Terah died in <u>01\_GEN\_11\_32</u># And the days of Terah were two hundred and five years: and Terah died in Haran.

Terah in the <u>01\_GEN\_11\_28</u># And Haran died before his father Terah in the land of his nativity, in Ur of the Chaldees.

Terah lived seventy 01\_GEN\_11\_26 # And Terah lived seventy years, and begat Abram, Nahor, and Haran.
