Thomas and James [41 MAR 03 18](#) # And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,

Thomas and Matthew [40 MAT 10 03](#) # Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;

Thomas answered and [43 JOH 20 28](#) # And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.

Thomas Bartholomew and [44 ACT 01 13](#) # And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas [the brother] of James.

Thomas because thou [43 JOH 20 29](#) # Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed [are] they that have not seen, and [yet] have believed.

Thomas called Didymus [43 JOH 21 02](#) # There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the [sons] of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples.

Thomas James the [42 LUK 06 15](#) # Matthew and Thomas, James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Simon called Zelotes,

Thomas one of [43 JOH 20 24](#) # But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.

Thomas Reach hither [43 JOH 20 27](#) # Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust [it] into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

Thomas saith unto [43 JOH 14 05](#) # Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?
