

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Tyre a worker <u>11_1KI_07_14</u> # He [was] a widow's son of the tribe of Naphtali, and his father [was] a man of Tyre, a worker in brass: and he was filled with wisdom, and understanding, and cunning to work all works in brass. And he came to king Solomon, and wrought all his work.

Tyre also therein <u>16_NEH_13_16</u># There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

Tyre and she <u>23_ISA_23_17</u> # And it shall come to pass after the end of seventy years, that the LORD will visit Tyre, and she shall turn to her hire, and shall commit fornication with all the kingdoms of the world upon the face of the earth.

Tyre and Sidon <u>44_ACT_12_20</u> # And Herod was highly displeased with them of Tyre and Sidon: but they came with one accord to him, and, having made Blastus the king's chamberlain their friend, desired peace; because their country was nourished by the king's [country].

Tyre and Sidon <u>42_LUK_06_17</u> # And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases;

Tyre and Sidon <u>42_LUK_10_13</u> # Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

Tyre and Sidon <u>42_LUK_10_14</u> # But it shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment, than for you.

Tyre and Sidon <u>41_MAR_03_08</u># And from Jerusalem, and from Idumaea, and [from] beyond Jordan; and they about Tyre and Sidon, a great multitude, when they had heard what great things he did, came unto him.

Tyre and Sidon <u>41_MAR_07_24</u> # And from thence he arose, and went into the borders of Tyre and Sidon, and entered into an house, and would have no man know [it]: but he could not be hid.

Tyre and Sidon <u>41_MAR_07_31</u># And again, departing from the coasts of Tyre and Sidon, he came unto the sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis.

Tyre and Sidon <u>40_MAT_11_21</u># Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.

Tyre and Sidon <u>40_MAT_11_22</u># But I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the day of judgment, than for you.

Tyre and Sidon <u>40_MAT_15_21</u># Then Jesus went thence, and departed into the coasts of Tyre and Sidon.

Tyre and the <u>06_JOS_19_29</u> # And [then] the coast turneth to Ramah, and to the strong city Tyre; and the coast turneth to Hosah; and the outgoings thereof are at the sea from the coast to Achzib:

Tyre and to <u>10_2SA_24_07</u># And came to the strong hold of Tyre, and to all the cities of the Hivites, and of the Canaanites: and they went out to the south of Judah, [even] to Beersheba.

Tyre and Zidon <u>29_JOE_03_04</u> # Yea, and what have ye to do with me, O Tyre, and Zidon, and all the coasts of Palestine? will ye render me a recompense? and if ye recompense me, swiftly [and] speedily will I return your recompense upon your own head;

Tyre answered in <u>14_2CH_02_11</u># Then Huram the king of Tyre answered in writing, which he sent to Solomon, Because the LORD hath loved his people, he hath made thee king over them.

Tyre brought much <u>13_1CH_22_04</u> # Also cedar trees in abundance: for the Zidonians and they of Tyre brought much cedar wood to David.

Tyre for there <u>44_ACT_21_03</u> # Now when we had discovered Cyprus, we left it on the left hand, and sailed into Syria, and landed at Tyre: for there the ship was to unlade her burden.

Tyre had furnished <u>11_1KI_09_11</u># [[Now] Hiram the king of Tyre had furnished Solomon with cedar trees and fir trees, and with gold, according to all his desire,] that then king Solomon gave Hiram twenty cities in the land of Galilee.

Tyre Howl ye <u>23_ISA_23_01</u> # The burden of Tyre. Howl, ye ships of Tarshish; for it is laid waste, so that there is no house, no entering in: from the land of Chittim it is revealed to them.

Tyre saying As <u>14_2CH_02_03</u> # And Solomon sent to Huram the king of Tyre, saying, As thou didst deal with David my father, and didst send him cedars to build him an house to dwell therein, [even so deal with me].

Tyre sent his <u>11_1KI_05_01</u># And Hiram king of Tyre sent his servants unto Solomon; for he had heard that they had anointed him king in the room of his father: for Hiram was ever a lover of David.

Tyre sent messengers <u>13_1CH_14_01</u> # Now Hiram king of Tyre sent messengers to David, and timber of cedars, with masons and carpenters, to build him an house.

Tyre sent messengers <u>10_28A_05_11</u># And Hiram king of Tyre sent messengers to David, and cedar trees, and carpenters, and masons: and they built David an house.

Tyre shall be <u>23_ISA_23_15</u> # And it shall come to pass in that day, that Tyre shall be forgotten seventy years, according to the days of one king: after the end of seventy years shall Tyre sing as an harlot.

Tyre shall be <u>19_PSA_45_12</u> # And the daughter of Tyre [shall be there] with a gift; [even] the rich among the people shall entreat thy favour.

Tyre sing as <u>23_ISA_23_15</u> # And it shall come to pass in that day, that Tyre shall be forgotten seventy years, according to the days of one king: after the end of seventy years shall Tyre sing as an harlot.

Tyre skilful to <u>14_2CH_02_14</u> # The son of a woman of the daughters of Dan, and his father [was] a man of Tyre, skilful to work in gold, and in silver, in brass, in iron, in stone, and in timber, in purple, in blue, and in fine linen, and in crimson; also to grave any manner of graving, and to find out every device which shall be put to him, with thy cunning men, and with the cunning men of my lord David thy father.

Tyre the crowning <u>23_ISA_23_08</u> # Who hath taken this counsel against Tyre, the crowning [city], whose merchants [are] princes, whose traffickers [are] the honourable of the earth?

Tyre to bring <u>15_EZR_03_07</u> # They gave money also unto the masons, and to the carpenters; and meat, and drink, and oil, unto them of Zidon, and to them of Tyre, to bring cedar trees from Lebanon to the sea of

Joppa, according to the grant that they had of Cyrus king of Persia.

Tyre to see <u>11_1KI_09_12</u># And Hiram came out from Tyre to see the cities which Solomon had given him; and they pleased him not.

Tyre we came <u>44_ACT_21_07</u> # And when we had finished [our] course from Tyre, we came to Ptolemais, and saluted the brethren, and abode with them one day.

Tyre with Ethiopia <u>19_PSA_87_04</u> # I will make mention of Rahab and Babylon to them that know me: behold Philistia, and Tyre, with Ethiopia; this [man] was born there.

Tyre <u>11_1KI_07_13</u># And king Solomon sent and fetched Hiram out of Tyre.

Tyre 23_ISA_23_05 # As at the report concerning Egypt, [so] shall they be sorely pained at the report of Tyre.

Tyre <u>19_PSA_83_07</u> # Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre;
