Tyrus and all 24 JER 25 22 # And all the kings of Tyrus, and all the kings of Zidon, and the kings of the isles which [are] beyond the sea,

Tyrus and break 26 EZE 26 04 # And they shall destroy the walls of Tyrus, and break down her towers: I will also scrape her dust from her, and make her like the top of a rock
