overtaketh thee or <u>13\_1CH\_21\_12</u> # Either three years' famine; or three months to be destroyed before thy foes, while that the sword of thine enemies overtaketh [thee]; or else three days the sword of the LORD, even the pestilence, in the land, and the angel of the LORD destroying throughout all the coasts of Israel. Now therefore advise thyself what word I shall bring again to him that sent me.

taketh a city <u>20\_PRO\_16\_32</u> # [He that is] slow to anger [is] better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city.

taketh a dog <u>20\_PRO\_26\_17</u> # He that passeth by, [and] meddleth with strife [belonging] not to him, [is like] one that taketh a dog by the ears.

taketh a gift <u>20\_PRO\_17\_23</u># A wicked [man] taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.

taketh a man's <u>05\_DEU\_24\_06</u># No man shall take the nether or the upper millstone to pledge: for he taketh [a man's] life to pledge.

taketh and dasheth <u>19\_PSA\_137\_09</u># Happy [shall he be], that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones.

taketh away a <u>20\_PRO\_25\_20</u># [As] he that taketh away a garment in cold weather, [and as] vinegar upon nitre, so [is] he that singeth songs to an heavy heart.

taketh away and <u>43\_JOH\_15\_02</u># Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every [branch] that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.
