attend to know <u>20\_PRO\_04\_01</u> # Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding.

attend to my 20\_PRO\_04\_20 # My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.

attend to the 20\_PRO\_07\_24 # Hearken unto me now therefore, O ye children, and attend to the words of my mouth.

attend to the <u>19\_PSA\_86\_06</u># Give ear, O LORD, unto my prayer; and attend to the voice of my supplications.

Attend unto me <u>19\_PSA\_55\_02</u> # Attend unto me, and hear me: I mourn in my complaint, and make a noise;

attend unto my <u>20\_PRO\_05\_01</u> # My son, attend unto my wisdom, [and] bow thine ear to my understanding:

attend upon her <u>17 EST\_04\_05</u> # Then called Esther for Hatach, [one] of the king's chamberlains, whom he had appointed to attend upon her, and gave him a commandment to Mordecai, to know what it [was], and why it [was].

attend upon the <u>46\_1CO\_07\_35</u># And this I speak for your own profit; not that I may cast a snare upon you, but for that which is comely, and that ye may attend upon the Lord without distraction.

attendance to reading <u>54\_1TI\_04\_13</u> # Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

attended to the <u>19\_PSA\_66\_19</u># [But] verily God hath heard [me]; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer.

attended unto the <u>44\_ACT\_16\_14</u> # And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard [us]: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.

attended unto you <u>18\_JOB\_32\_12</u># Yea, I attended unto you, and, behold, [there was] none of you that convinced Job, [or] that answered his words:

contend by fire <u>30\_AMO\_07\_04</u># Thus hath the Lord GOD showed unto me: and, behold, the Lord GOD called to contend by fire, and it devoured the great deep, and did eat up a part.

contend for ever <u>23\_ISA\_57\_16</u># For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the spirit should fail before me, and the souls [which] I have made.

contend for God <u>18\_JOB\_13\_08</u> # Will ye accept his person? will ye contend for God?

contend for the <u>65\_JDE\_01\_03</u># Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort [you] that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

contend thou before <u>33\_MIC\_06\_01</u># Hear ye now what the LORD saith; Arise, contend thou before the mountains, and let the hills hear thy voice.

contend with him <u>05\_DEU\_02\_24</u> # Rise ye up, take your journey, and pass over the river Arnon: behold, I have given into thine hand Sihon the Amorite, king of Heshbon, and his land: begin to possess [it], and contend with him in battle.

contend with him <u>21\_ECC\_06\_10</u># That which hath been is named already, and it is known that it [is] man: neither may he contend with him that is mightier than he.

contend with him <u>23\_ISA\_49\_25</u> # But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children.

contend with him <u>18\_JOB\_09\_03</u> # If he will contend with him, he cannot answer him one of a thousand.

contend with horses 24\_JER\_12\_05 # If thou hast run with the footmen, and they have wearied thee, then how canst thou contend with horses? and [if] in the land of peace, [wherein] thou trustedst, [they wearied thee], then how wilt thou do in the swelling of Jordan?

contend with me <u>23\_ISA\_50\_08</u> # [He is] near that justifieth me; who will contend with me? let us stand together: who [is] mine adversary? let him come near to me.

contend with me <u>24\_JER\_18\_19</u># Give heed to me, O LORD, and hearken to the voice of them that contend with me.

contend with them <u>05\_DEU\_02\_09</u> # And the LORD said unto me, Distress not the Moabites, neither contend with them in battle: for I will not give thee of their land [for] a possession; because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

contend with them <u>20\_PRO\_28\_04</u> # They that forsake the law praise the wicked: but such as keep the law contend with them.

contended I with <u>16\_NEH\_13\_11</u># Then contended I with the rulers, and said, Why is the house of God forsaken? And I gathered them together, and set them in their place.

contended with him <u>44\_ACT\_11\_02</u># And when Peter was come up to Jerusalem, they that were of the circumcision contended with him,

contended with me <u>18\_JOB\_31\_13</u># If I did despise the cause of my manservant or of my maidservant, when they contended with me;

contended with the <u>16\_NEH\_13\_17</u># Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing [is] this that ye do, and profane the sabbath day?

contended with thee <u>23\_ISA\_41\_12</u># Thou shalt seek them, and shalt not find them, [even] them that contended with thee: they that war against thee shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought.

contended with them <u>16\_NEH\_13\_25</u> # And I contended with them, and cursed them, and smote certain of them, and plucked off their hair, and made them swear by God, [saying], Ye shall not give your daughters unto their sons, nor take their daughters unto your sons, or for yourselves.

contendest with me <u>18\_JOB\_10\_02</u># I will say unto God, Do not condemn me; show me wherefore thou contendest with me.

contendeth with a <u>20\_PRO\_29\_09</u> # [If] a wise man contendeth with a foolish man, whether he rage or laugh, [there is] no rest.

contendeth with the <u>18\_JOB\_40\_02</u># Shall he that contendeth with the Almighty instruct [him]? he that reproveth God, let him answer it.

contendeth with thee <u>23\_ISA\_49\_25</u> # But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children.

contending with the <u>65\_JDE\_01\_09</u> # Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

extend mercy unto <u>19\_PSA\_109\_12</u># Let there be none to extend mercy unto him: neither let there be any to favour his fatherless children.

extend peace to <u>23\_ISA\_66\_12</u> # For thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will extend peace to her like a river, and the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream: then shall ye suck, ye shall be borne upon [her] sides, and be dandled upon [her] knees.

extended mercy unto <u>15\_EZR\_07\_28</u># And hath extended mercy unto me before the king, and his counsellors, and before all the king's mighty princes. And I was strengthened as the hand of the LORD my God [was] upon me, and I gathered together out of Israel chief men to go up with me.

extended mercy unto <u>15\_EZR\_09\_09</u># For we [were] bondmen; yet our God hath not forsaken us in our bondage, but hath extended mercy unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our God, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem.

extendeth not to <u>19\_PSA\_16\_02</u># [O my soul], thou hast said unto the LORD, Thou [art] my Lord: my goodness [extendeth] not to thee;

intend to do <u>44\_ACT\_05\_35</u># And said unto them, Ye men of Israel, take heed to yourselves what ye intend to do as touching these men.

intend to go <u>06\_JOS\_22\_33</u># And the thing pleased the children of Israel; and the children of Israel blessed God, and did not intend to go up against them in battle, to destroy the land wherein the children of Reuben and Gad dwelt.

intended evil against <u>19\_PSA\_21\_11</u># For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a mischievous device, [which] they are not able [to perform].

intendest thou to <u>02\_EXO\_02\_14</u> # And he said, Who made thee a prince and a judge over us? intendest thou to kill me, as thou killedst the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known.

intending after Easter <u>44\_ACT\_12\_04</u> # And when he had apprehended him, he put [him] in prison, and delivered [him] to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people.

intending to build <u>42\_LUK\_14\_28</u># For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have [sufficient] to finish [it]?

intending to take <u>44\_ACT\_20\_13</u> # And we went before to ship, and sailed unto Assos, there intending to take in Paul: for so had he appointed, minding himself to go afoot.

tend only to <u>20\_PRO\_21\_05</u># The thoughts of the diligent [tend] only to plenteousness; but of every one [that is] hasty only to want.

tender among you <u>05\_DEU\_28\_54</u># [So that] the man [that is] tender among you, and very delicate, his eye shall be evil toward his brother, and toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the remnant of his children which he shall leave:

tender and delicate <u>05\_DEU\_28\_56</u> # The tender and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

tender and delicate <u>23\_ISA\_47\_01</u> # Come down, and sit in the dust, O virgin daughter of Babylon, sit on the ground: [there is] no throne, O daughter of the Chaldeans: for thou shalt no more be called tender and delicate.

tender and good <u>01\_GEN\_18\_07</u># And Abraham ran unto the herd, and fetched a calf tender and good, and gave [it] unto a young man; and he hasted to dress it.

tender and only <u>20\_PRO\_04\_03</u># For I was my father's son, tender and only [beloved] in the sight of my mother.

tender and putteth <u>41\_MAR\_13\_28</u> # Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When her branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is near:

tender and putteth <u>40\_MAT\_24\_32</u># Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer [is] nigh:

tender and the <u>13\_1CH\_22\_05</u> # And David said, Solomon my son [is] young and tender, and the house [that is] to be builded for the LORD [must be] exceeding magnifical, of fame and of glory throughout all countries: I will [therefore] now make preparation for it. So David prepared abundantly before his death.

tender and the <u>13\_1CH\_29\_01</u> # Furthermore David the king said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God hath chosen, [is yet] young and tender, and the work [is] great: for the palace [is] not for man, but for the LORD God.

tender eyed but <u>01\_GEN\_29\_17</u># Leah [was] tender eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well favoured.

tender grape appear <u>22\_SON\_07\_12</u> # Let us get up early to the vineyards; let us see if the vine flourish, [whether] the tender grape appear, [and] the pomegranates bud forth: there will I give thee my loves.

tender grape give <u>22\_SON\_02\_13</u> # The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines [with] the tender grape give a [good] smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

tender grapes <u>22\_SON\_02\_15</u> # Take us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vines: for our vines [have] tender grapes.

tender mercies come <u>19\_PSA\_119\_77</u># Let thy tender mercies come unto me, that I may live: for thy law [is] my delight.

tender mercies from <u>19\_PSA\_40\_11</u># Withhold not thou thy tender mercies from me, O LORD: let thy lovingkindness and thy truth continually preserve me.

tender mercies O <u>19\_PSA\_119\_156</u> # Great [are] thy tender mercies, O LORD: quicken me according to thy judgments.

tender mercies of <u>20\_PRO\_12\_10</u># A righteous [man] regardeth the life of his beast: but the tender mercies of the wicked [are] cruel.

tender mercies Selah <u>19\_PSA\_77\_09</u># Hath God forgotten to be gracious? hath he in anger shut up his tender mercies? Selah.

tender mercies speedily <u>19\_PSA\_79\_08</u># O remember not against us former iniquities: let thy tender mercies speedily prevent us: for we are brought very low.

tender mercies <u>19\_PSA\_103\_04</u> # Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies;

tender mercies <u>19\_PSA\_69\_16</u># Hear me, O LORD; for thy lovingkindness [is] good: turn unto me according to the multitude of thy tender mercies.

tender mercy of <u>42\_LUK\_01\_78</u># Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us,

tender mercy <u>59\_JAM\_05\_11</u># Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy.

tender one and <u>26\_EZE\_17\_22</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also take of the highest branch of the high cedar, and will set [it]; I will crop off from the top of his young twigs a tender one, and will plant [it] upon an high mountain and eminent:

tenderness her eye <u>05\_DEU\_28\_56</u># The tender and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

tendeth only to <u>20\_PRO\_14\_23</u># In all labour there is profit: but the talk of the lips [tendeth] only to penury.

tendeth to life <u>20\_PRO\_10\_16</u># The labour of the righteous [tendeth] to life: the fruit of the wicked to sin.

tendeth to life <u>20\_PRO\_11\_19</u># As righteousness [tendeth] to life: so he that pursueth evil [pursueth it] to his own death.

tendeth to life <u>20\_PRO\_19\_23</u># The fear of the LORD [tendeth] to life: and [he that hath it] shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.

tendeth to poverty <u>20\_PRO\_11\_24</u># There is that scattereth, and yet increaseth; and [there is] that withholdeth more than is meet, but [it tendeth] to poverty.
