attent unto the <u>14\_2CH\_06\_40</u> # Now, my God, let, I beseech thee, thine eyes be open, and [let] thine ears [be] attent unto the prayer [that is made] in this place.

attent unto the <u>14\_2CH\_07\_15</u> # Now mine eyes shall be open, and mine ears attent unto the prayer [that is made] in this place.

attentive and thine <u>16\_NEH\_01\_06</u> # Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned.

attentive to hear <u>42\_LUK\_19\_48</u> # And could not find what they might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear him.

attentive to the <u>16\_NEH\_01\_11</u># O Lord, I beseech thee, let now thine ear be attentive to the prayer of thy servant, and to the prayer of thy servants, who desire to fear thy name: and prosper, I pray thee, thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer.

attentive to the <u>19\_PSA\_130\_02</u> # Lord, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications.

attentive unto the <u>16\_NEH\_08\_03</u># And he read therein before the street that [was] before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could understand; and the ears of all the people [were attentive] unto the book of the law.

attentively the noise <u>18\_JOB\_37\_02</u> # Hear attentively the noise of his voice, and the sound [that] goeth out of his mouth.

content and dwelt <u>06\_JOS\_07\_07</u> # And Joshua said, Alas, O Lord GOD, wherefore hast thou at all brought this people over Jordan, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us? would to God we had been content, and dwelt on the other side Jordan!

content I pray <u>12\_2KI\_06\_03</u> # And one said, Be content, I pray thee, and go with thy servants. And he answered, I will go.

content I pray <u>07\_JUD\_19\_06</u># And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine heart be merry.

content look upon <u>18\_JOB\_06\_28</u> # Now therefore be content, look upon me; for [it is] evident unto you if I lie.

content take two <u>12\_2KI\_05\_23</u> # And Naaman said, Be content, take two talents. And he urged him, and bound two talents of silver in two bags, with two changes of garments, and laid [them] upon two of his servants; and they bare [them] before him.

content the people <u>41\_MAR\_15\_15</u> # And [so] Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged [him], to be crucified.

content therewith neither <u>64\_3JO\_01\_10</u> # Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth [them] out of the church.

content though thou <u>20\_PRO\_06\_35</u># He will not regard any ransom; neither will he rest content, though thou givest many gifts.

content to dwell <u>02\_EXO\_02\_21</u># And Moses was content to dwell with the man: and he gave Moses Zipporah his daughter.

content to dwell <u>07\_JUD\_17\_11</u># And the Levite was content to dwell with the man; and the young man was unto him as one of his sons.

content with such <u>58\_HEB\_13\_05</u> # [Let your] conversation [be] without covetousness; [and be] content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

content with your <u>42\_LUK\_03\_14</u># And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse [any] falsely; and be content with your wages.

content <u>54\_1TI\_06\_08</u> # And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.

content <u>01\_GEN\_37\_27</u># Come, and let us sell him to the Ishmeelites, and let not our hand be upon him; for he [is] our brother [and] our flesh. And his brethren were content.

content <u>03\_LEV\_10\_20</u> # And when Moses heard [that], he was content.

content <u>50\_PHP\_04\_11</u># Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, [therewith] to be content.

contention and his <u>20\_PRO\_18\_06</u> # A fool's lips enter into contention, and his mouth calleth for strokes.

contention before it <u>20\_PRO\_17\_14</u> # The beginning of strife [is as] when one letteth out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with.

contention but with <u>20\_PRO\_13\_10</u> # Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised [is] wisdom.

contention not sincerely <u>50\_PHP\_01\_16</u># The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds:

contention shall go <u>20\_PRO\_22\_10</u># Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yea, strife and reproach shall cease.

contention to the <u>24\_JER\_15\_10</u> # Woe is me, my mother, that thou hast borne me a man of strife and a man of contention to the whole earth! I have neither lent on usury, nor men have lent to me on usury; [yet] every one of them doth curse me.

contention was so <u>44\_ACT\_15\_39</u> # And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;

contention <u>52\_1TH\_02\_02</u> # But even after that we had suffered before, and were shamefully entreated, as ye know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much contention.

contention <u>35\_HAB\_01\_03</u> # Why dost thou show me iniquity, and cause [me] to behold grievance? for spoiling and violence [are] before me: and there are [that] raise up strife and contention.

contentions among you <u>46\_1CO\_01\_11</u># For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them [which are of the house] of Chloe, that there are contentions among you.

contentions and strivings <u>56\_TIT\_03\_09</u> # But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

contentions are like <u>20\_PRO\_18\_19</u># A brother offended [is harder to be won] than a strong city: and [their] contentions [are] like the bars of a castle.

contentions of a <u>20\_PRO\_19\_13</u># A foolish son [is] the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife [are] a continual dropping.

contentions to cease <u>20\_PRO\_18\_18</u># The lot causeth contentions to cease, and parteth between the mighty.

contentions who hath <u>20\_PRO\_23\_29</u> # Who hath woe? who hath sorrow? who hath contentions? who hath babbling? who hath wounds without cause? who hath redness of eyes?

contentious and an <u>20\_PRO\_21\_19</u># [It is] better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman.

contentious and do <u>45\_ROM\_02\_08</u># But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,

contentious man to <u>20\_PRO\_26\_21</u> # [As] coals [are] to burning coals, and wood to fire; so [is] a contentious man to kindle strife.

contentious we have <u>46\_1CO\_11\_16</u># But if any man seem to be contentious, we have no such custom, neither the churches of God.

contentious woman are <u>20\_PRO\_27\_15</u># A continual dropping in a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike.

contentment is great <u>54\_1TI\_06\_06</u> # But godliness with contentment is great gain.

discontented gathered themselves <u>09\_1SA\_22\_02</u># And every one [that was] in distress, and every one that [was] in debt, and every one [that was] discontented, gathered themselves unto him; and he became a captain over them: and there were with him about four hundred men.

impenitent heart treasurest <u>45\_ROM\_02\_05</u># But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;

impotent folk of <u>43\_JOH\_05\_03</u># In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.

impotent in his <u>44\_ACT\_14\_08</u># And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:

impotent man answered <u>43\_JOH\_05\_07</u># The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me.

impotent man by <u>44\_ACT\_04\_09</u> # If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole;

intent he spake <u>43\_JOH\_13\_28</u> # Now no man at the table knew for what intent he spake this unto him.

intent that he <u>14\_2CH\_16\_01</u># In the six and thirtieth year of the reign of Asa Baasha king of Israel came up against Judah, and built Ramah, to the intent that he might let none go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.

intent that he <u>12\_2KI\_10\_19</u># Now therefore call unto me all the prophets of Baal, all his servants, and all his priests; let none be wanting: for I have a great sacrifice [to do] to Baal; whosoever shall be wanting, he shall not live. But Jehu did [it] in subtlety, to the intent that he might destroy the worshippers of Baal.

intent that he <u>44\_ACT\_09\_21</u># But all that heard [him] were amazed, and said; Is not this he that destroyed them which called on this name in Jerusalem, and came hither for that intent, that he might bring them bound unto the chief priests?

intent that I <u>26 EZE 40 04</u> # And the man said unto me, Son of man, behold with thine eyes, and hear with thine ears, and set thine heart upon all that I shall show thee; for to the intent that I might show [them] unto thee [art] thou brought hither: declare all that thou seest to the house of Israel.

intent that now <u>49\_EPH\_03\_10</u> # To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly [places] might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,

intent that the <u>10\_2SA\_17\_14</u># And Absalom and all the men of Israel said, The counsel of Hushai the Archite [is] better than the counsel of Ahithophel. For the LORD had appointed to defeat the good counsel of Ahithophel, to the intent that the LORD might bring evil upon Absalom.

intent that the <u>27\_DAN\_04\_17</u> # This matter [is] by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.

intent we should <u>46\_1CO\_10\_06</u> # Now these things were our examples, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted.

intent ye have <u>44\_ACT\_10\_29</u># Therefore came I [unto you] without gainsaying, as soon as I was sent for: I ask therefore for what intent ye have sent for me?

intent ye may <u>43\_JOH\_11\_15</u># And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him.

intents of his <u>24\_JER\_30\_24</u> # The fierce anger of the LORD shall not return, until he have done [it], and until he have performed the intents of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it.

intents of the <u>58\_HEB\_04\_12</u># For the word of God [is] quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and [is] a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

oftentimes also thine <u>21\_ECC\_07\_22</u> # For oftentimes also thine own heart knoweth that thou thyself likewise hast cursed others.

oftentimes the same <u>58\_HEB\_10\_11</u># And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

oftentimes with man <u>18\_JOB\_33\_29</u> # Lo, all these [things] worketh God oftentimes with man,

omnipotent reigneth <u>66\_REV\_19\_06</u># And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth.

Potentate the King <u>54\_1TI\_06\_15</u> # Which in his times he shall show, [who is] the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;

tent above upon <u>02\_EXO\_40\_19</u> # And he spread abroad the tent over the tabernacle, and put the covering of the tent above upon it; as the LORD commanded Moses.

tent all that <u>04\_NUM\_19\_14</u> # This [is] the law, when a man dieth in a tent: all that come into the tent, and all that [is] in the tent, shall be unclean seven days.

tent and brought <u>06\_JOS\_07\_23</u> # And they took them out of the midst of the tent, and brought them unto Joshua, and unto all the children of Israel, and laid them out before the LORD.

tent and burn 24\_JER\_37\_10 # For though ye had smitten the whole army of the Chaldeans that fight against you, and there remained [but] wounded men among them, [yet] should they rise up every man in his tent, and burn this city with fire.

tent and let <u>23\_ISA\_54\_02</u> # Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes;

tent and retained <u>07\_JUD\_07\_08</u># So the people took victuals in their hand, and their trumpets: and he sent all [the rest of] Israel every man unto his tent, and retained those three hundred men: and the host of Midian was beneath him in the valley.

tent and smote <u>07\_JUD\_07\_13</u> # And when Gideon was come, behold, [there was] a man that told a dream unto his fellow, and said, Behold, I dreamed a dream, and, lo, a cake of barley bread tumbled into the host of Midian, and came unto a tent, and smote it that it fell, and overturned it, that the tent lay along.

tent and the <u>06\_JOS\_07\_21</u> # When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they [are] hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.

tent and the <u>06\_JOS\_07\_22</u> # So Joshua sent messengers, and they ran unto the tent; and, behold, [it was] hid in his tent, and the silver under it.

tent and the <u>04\_NUM\_11\_10</u># Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased.

tent and there <u>09\_1SA\_04\_10</u> # And the Philistines fought, and Israel was smitten, and they fled every man into his tent: and there was a very great slaughter; for there fell of Israel thirty thousand footmen.

tent and thrust <u>04\_NUM\_25\_08</u> # And he went after the man of Israel into the tent, and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. So the plague was stayed from the children of Israel.

tent and upon <u>04\_NUM\_19\_18</u> # And a clean person shall take hyssop, and dip [it] in the water, and sprinkle [it] upon the tent, and upon all the vessels, and upon the persons that were there, and upon him that touched a bone, or one slain, or one dead, or a grave:

tent any more <u>24\_JER\_10\_20</u> # My tabernacle is spoiled, and all my cords are broken: my children are gone forth of me, and they [are] not: [there is] none to stretch forth my tent any more, and to set up my curtains.

tent at the <u>01\_GEN\_33\_19</u># And he bought a parcel of a field, where he had spread his tent, at the hand of the children of Hamor, Shechem's father, for an hundred pieces of money.

tent before the <u>01\_GEN\_33\_18</u># And Jacob came to Shalem, a city of Shechem, which [is] in the land of Canaan, when he came from Padanaram; and pitched his tent before the city.

tent behold Sisera <u>07\_JUD\_04\_22</u># And, behold, as Barak pursued Sisera, Jael came out to meet him, and said unto him, Come, and I will show thee the man whom thou seekest. And when he came into her [tent], behold, Sisera lay dead, and the nail [was] in his temples.

tent beyond the <u>01\_GEN\_35\_21</u># And Israel journeyed, and spread his tent beyond the tower of Edar.

tent but found <u>01\_GEN\_31\_34</u> # Now Rachel had taken the images, and put them in the camel's furniture, and sat upon them. And Laban searched all the tent, but found [them] not.

tent door and <u>02\_EXO\_33\_08</u># And it came to pass, when Moses went out unto the tabernacle, [that] all the people rose up, and stood every man [at] his tent door, and looked after Moses, until he was gone into the tabernacle.

tent door and <u>01\_GEN\_18\_02</u># And he lift up his eyes and looked, and, lo, three men stood by him: and when he saw [them], he ran to meet them from the tent door, and bowed himself toward the ground,

tent door in <u>01\_GEN\_18\_01</u># And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day;

tent had been <u>01\_GEN\_13\_03</u># And he went on his journeys from the south even to Bethel, unto the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Hai;

tent having Bethel <u>01\_GEN\_12\_08</u># And he removed from thence unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, [having] Bethel on the west, and Hai on the east: and there he builded an altar unto

the LORD, and called upon the name of the LORD.

tent I have <u>23\_ISA\_38\_12</u> # Mine age is departed, and is removed from me as a shepherd's tent: I have cut off like a weaver my life: he will cut me off with pining sickness: from day [even] to night wilt thou make an end of me.

tent in the <u>01\_GEN\_26\_17</u> # And Isaac departed thence, and pitched his tent in the valley of Gerar, and dwelt there.

tent in the <u>01\_GEN\_31\_25</u> # Then Laban overtook Jacob. Now Jacob had pitched his tent in the mount: and Laban with his brethren pitched in the mount of Gilead.

tent it shall <u>02\_EXO\_26\_13</u># And a cubit on the one side, and a cubit on the other side of that which remaineth in the length of the curtains of the tent, it shall hang over the sides of the tabernacle on this side and on that side, to cover it.

tent lay along <u>07\_JUD\_07\_13</u> # And when Gideon was come, behold, [there was] a man that told a dream unto his fellow, and said, Behold, I dreamed a dream, and, lo, a cake of barley bread tumbled into the host of Midian, and came unto a tent, and smote it that it fell, and overturned it, that the tent lay along.

tent neither will <u>07\_JUD\_20\_08</u> # And all the people arose as one man, saying, We will not any [of us] go to his tent, neither will we any [of us] turn into his house.

tent of blue <u>02\_EXO\_26\_36</u> # And thou shalt make an hanging for the door of the tent, [of] blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, wrought with needlework.

tent of Jael <u>07\_JUD\_04\_17</u> # Howbeit Sisera fled away on his feet to the tent of Jael the wife of Heber the Kenite: for [there was] peace between Jabin the king of Hazor and the house of Heber the Kenite.

tent of rams'skins <u>02\_EXO\_26\_14</u> # And thou shalt make a covering for the tent [of] rams' skins dyed red, and a covering above [of] badgers' skins.

tent of rams'skins <u>02\_EXO\_36\_19</u># And he made a covering for the tent [of] rams' skins dyed red, and a covering [of] badgers' skins above [that].

tent of the <u>02\_EXO\_39\_32</u> # Thus was all the work of the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation finished: and the children of Israel did according to all that the LORD commanded Moses, so did they.

tent of the <u>02\_EXO\_39\_40</u># The hangings of the court, his pillars, and his sockets, and the hanging for the court gate, his cords, and his pins, and all the vessels of the service of the tabernacle, for the tent of the congregation,

tent of the <u>02\_EXO\_40\_02</u> # On the first day of the first month shalt thou set up the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.

tent of the <u>02\_EXO\_40\_06</u> # And thou shalt set the altar of the burnt offering before the door of the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.

tent of the  $02_{EXO_{40_{07}}}$ # And thou shalt set the laver between the tent of the congregation and the altar, and shalt put water therein.

tent of the <u>02\_EXO\_40\_22</u> # And he put the table in the tent of the congregation, upon the side of the tabernacle northward, without the veil.

tent of the <u>02\_EXO\_40\_24</u> # And he put the candlestick in the tent of the congregation, over against the

table, on the side of the tabernacle southward.

tents and my <u>10\_2SA\_11\_11</u># And Uriah said unto David, The ark, and Israel, and Judah, abide in tents; and my lord Joab, and the servants of my lord, are encamped in the open fields; shall I then go into mine house, to eat and to drink, and to lie with my wife? [as] thou livest, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not do this thing.

tents and of <u>01\_GEN\_04\_20</u># And Adah bare Jabal: he was the father of such as dwell in tents, and [of such as have] cattle.

tents and said <u>05\_DEU\_01\_27</u># And ye murmured in your tents, and said, Because the LORD hated us, he hath brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.
