Jonathan My father <u>09\_1SA\_14\_29</u> # Then said Jonathan, My father hath troubled the land: see, I pray you, how mine eyes have been enlightened, because I tasted a little of this honey.

Jonathan out of 10\_2SA\_04\_04 # And Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son [that was] lame of [his] feet. He was five years old when the tidings came of Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and his nurse took him up, and fled: and it came to pass, as she made haste to flee, that he fell, and became lame. And his name [was] Mephibosheth.

Jonathan Peleth and 13\_1CH\_02\_33 # And the sons of Jonathan; Peleth, and Zaza. These were the sons of Jerahmeel.

Jonathan said Far <u>09\_1SA\_20\_09</u> # And Jonathan said, Far be it from thee: for if I knew certainly that evil were determined by my father to come upon thee, then would not I tell it thee?

Jonathan said to <u>09\_1SA\_14\_06</u># And Jonathan said to the young man that bare his armour, Come, and let us go over unto the garrison of these uncircumcised: it may be that the LORD will work for us: for [there is] no restraint to the LORD to save by many or by few.
