thank and praise <u>13\_1CH\_16\_04</u># And he appointed [certain] of the Levites to minister before the ark of the LORD, and to record, and to thank and praise the LORD God of Israel:

thank and praise 13\_1CH\_23\_30 # And to stand every morning to thank and praise the LORD, and likewise at even;

thank Christ Jesus <u>54\_1TI\_01\_12</u> # And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry;

thank God always <u>53\_2TH\_01\_03</u># We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth;

thank God that 46\_1CO\_01\_14 # I thank God that I baptized none of you, but Crispus and Gaius;

thank God through <u>45\_ROM\_07\_25</u> # I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

thank God whom <u>55\_2TI\_01\_03</u> # I thank God, whom I serve from [my] forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I have remembrance of thee in my prayers night and day;

thank have ye <u>42\_LUK\_06\_32</u># For if ye love them which love you, what thank have ye? for sinners also love those that love them.

thank have ye <u>42\_LUK\_06\_33</u> # And if ye do good to them which do good to you, what thank have ye? for sinners also do even the same.

thank have ye <u>42\_LUK\_06\_34</u> # And if ye lend [to them] of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again.

thank my God <u>46\_1CO\_01\_04</u># I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ;

thank my God 46\_1CO\_14\_18 # I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all:

thank my God 57\_PHM\_01\_04 # I thank my God, making mention of thee always in my prayers,

thank my God 50\_PHP\_01\_03 # I thank my God upon every remembrance of you,

thank my God <u>45\_ROM\_01\_08</u> # First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world.

thank offerings and 14\_2CH\_29\_31# Then Hezekiah answered and said, Now ye have consecrated yourselves unto the LORD, come near and bring sacrifices and thank offerings into the house of the LORD. And the congregation brought in sacrifices and thank offerings; and as many as were of a free heart burnt offerings.

thank offerings and 14\_2CH\_33\_16 # And he repaired the altar of the LORD, and sacrificed thereon peace

thank thee and 13\_1CH\_29\_13 # Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name.

thank thee and <u>27\_DAN\_02\_23</u># I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast [now] made known unto us the king's matter.

thank thee O <u>42\_LUK\_10\_21</u># In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

thank thee O <u>40 MAT\_11\_25</u># At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.

thank thee that <u>43\_JOH\_11\_41</u># Then they took away the stone [from the place] where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up [his] eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.

thank thee that <u>42\_LUK\_18\_11</u> # The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men [are], extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

thank we God <u>52\_1TH\_02\_13</u># For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received [it] not [as] the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.

thanked God and <u>44\_ACT\_28\_15</u> # And from thence, when the brethren heard of us, they came to meet us as far as Appii forum, and The three taverns: whom when Paul saw, he thanked God, and took courage.

thanked that ye <u>45\_ROM\_06\_17</u># But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

thanked the king 10\_2SA\_14\_22 # And Joab fell to the ground on his face, and bowed himself, and thanked the king: and Joab said, To day thy servant knoweth that I have found grace in thy sight, my lord, O king, in that the king hath fulfilled the request of his servant.

thankful but became <u>45\_ROM\_01\_21</u> # Because that, when they knew God, they glorified [him] not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

thankful unto him 19\_PSA\_100\_04 # Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, [and] into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, [and] bless his name.

thankful <u>51\_COL\_03\_15</u># And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.

thankfulness <u>44\_ACT\_24\_03</u># We accept [it] always, and in all places, most noble Felix, with all thankfulness.

thanking the LORD 14 2CH 05 13 # It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers [were] as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up [their] voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, [saying], For [he is] good; for his mercy [endureth] for ever: that [then] the house was filled with a cloud, [even] the house of the LORD;

thanks according to <u>16\_NEH\_12\_24</u># And the chief of the Levites: Hashabiah, Sherebiah, and Jeshua the son of Kadmiel, with their brethren over against them, to praise [and] to give thanks, according to the commandment of David the man of God, ward over against ward.

thanks alway to <u>53\_2TH\_02\_13</u># But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

thanks always for 49\_EPH\_05\_20 # Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

thanks and brake 42\_LUK\_22\_19 # And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake [it], and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

thanks and brake <u>41\_MAR\_08\_06</u># And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before [them]; and they did set [them] before the people.

thanks and he <u>42\_LUK\_17\_16</u># And fell down on [his] face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan.

thanks and he <u>45\_ROM\_14\_06</u># He that regardeth the day, regardeth [it] unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard [it]. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.

thanks and said <u>42\_LUK\_22\_17</u># And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide [it] among yourselves:

thanks and to 14\_2CH\_31\_02 # And Hezekiah appointed the courses of the priests and the Levites after their courses, every man according to his service, the priests and Levites for burnt offerings and for peace offerings, to minister, and to give thanks, and to praise in the gates of the tents of the LORD.

thanks at the <u>19\_PSA\_30\_04</u># Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness.

thanks at the 19\_PSA\_97\_12 # Rejoice in the LORD, ye righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of

his holiness.

thanks be made <u>54\_1TI\_02\_01</u> # I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, [and] giving of thanks, be made for all men;

thanks be to <u>46\_1CO\_15\_57</u> # But thanks [be] to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

thanks be to <u>47\_2CO\_08\_16</u> # But thanks [be] to God, which put the same earnest care into the heart of Titus for you.

thanks be unto 47\_2CO\_02\_14 # Now thanks [be] unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

Thanks be unto 47\_2CO\_09\_15 # Thanks [be] unto God for his unspeakable gift.

thanks before his <u>27\_DAN\_06\_10</u> # Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

thanks but also <u>45\_ROM\_16\_04</u> # Who have for my life laid down their own necks: unto whom not only I give thanks, but also all the churches of the Gentiles.

thanks for that <u>19\_PSA\_75\_01</u> # To the chief Musician, Altaschith, A Psalm [or] Song of Asaph. Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks, [unto thee] do we give thanks: for [that] thy name is near thy wondrous works declare.

thanks for this <u>52\_1TH\_05\_18</u># In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

thanks for you 49\_EPH\_01\_16 # Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers;

thanks he brake 46\_1CO\_11\_24# And when he had given thanks, he brake [it], and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.

thanks he distributed <u>43\_JOH\_06\_11</u># And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

thanks he gave 41\_MAR\_14\_23 # And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave [it] to them: and they all drank of it.

thanks in the <u>16\_NEH\_12\_40</u># So stood the two [companies of them that gave] thanks in the house of God, and I, and the half of the rulers with me:

thanks in the <u>19\_PSA\_35\_18</u># I will give thee thanks in the great congregation: I will praise thee among much people.

thanks likewise unto 42\_LUK\_02\_38 # And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord,

thanks may be <u>47\_2CO\_01\_11</u># Ye also helping together by prayer for us, that for the gift [bestowed] upon us by the means of many persons thanks may be given by many on our behalf.

thanks O Lord 66 REV\_11\_17 # Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

thanks seeing he <u>46\_1CO\_14\_16</u># Else when thou shalt bless with the spirit, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest?

thanks to God <u>52\_1TH\_01\_02</u> # We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers;

thanks to God <u>44\_ACT\_27\_35</u># And when he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken [it], he began to eat.

thanks to God <u>51\_COL\_01\_03</u># We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,

thanks <u>43\_JOH\_06\_23</u> # [Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:]

thanks <u>19 PSA\_06\_05</u> # For in death [there is] no remembrance of thee: in the grave who shall give thee thanks?

thanks <u>45\_ROM\_14\_06</u># He that regardeth the day, regardeth [it] unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard [it]. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.

thanksgiving and declare 19 PSA 107 22 # And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.

thanksgiving and honour <u>66\_REV\_07\_12</u> # Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, [be] unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

thanksgiving and into 19\_PSA\_100\_04 # Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, [and] into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, [and] bless his name.

thanksgiving and make 19\_PSA\_95\_02 # Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.

thanksgiving and pay 19\_PSA\_50\_14 # Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High:

thanksgiving and tell 19\_PSA\_26\_07 # That I may publish with the voice of thanksgiving, and tell of all thy wondrous works.

thanksgiving and the <u>23\_ISA\_51\_03</u># For the LORD shall comfort Zion: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody.

thanksgiving and the 24 JER\_30\_19 # And out of them shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of them that make merry: and I will multiply them, and they shall not be few; I will also glorify them, and they shall not be small.

thanksgiving and will 19\_PSA\_116\_17 # I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD.

thanksgiving he and <u>16\_NEH\_12\_08</u> # Moreover the Levites: Jeshua, Binnui, Kadmiel, Sherebiah, Judah, [and] Mattaniah, [which was] over the thanksgiving, he and his brethren.

thanksgiving I will <u>32\_JON\_02\_09</u> # But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay [that] that I have vowed. Salvation [is] of the LORD.

thanksgiving in prayer <u>16\_NEH\_11\_17</u># And Mattaniah the son of Micha, the son of Zabdi, the son of Asaph, [was] the principal to begin the thanksgiving in prayer: and Bakbukiah the second among his brethren, and Abda the son of Shammua, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun.

thanksgiving let your <u>50\_PHP\_04\_06</u># Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

thanksgiving of his <u>03\_LEV\_07\_13</u> # Besides the cakes, he shall offer [for] his offering leavened bread with the sacrifice of thanksgiving of his peace offerings.

thanksgiving of many 47\_2CO\_04\_15 # For all things [are] for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God.

thanksgiving of them <u>54\_1TI\_04\_03</u># Forbidding to marry, [and commanding] to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

thanksgiving shall be <u>03\_LEV\_07\_15</u># And the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings for thanksgiving shall be eaten the same day that it is offered; he shall not leave any of it until the morning.

thanksgiving sing praise 19\_PSA\_147\_07 # Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God:

thanksgiving then he <u>03\_LEV\_07\_12</u># If he offer it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened cakes mingled with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mingled with oil, of fine flour, fried.

thanksgiving to God <u>47\_2CO\_09\_11</u># Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God.

thanksgiving unleavened cakes <u>03\_LEV\_07\_12</u># If he offer it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened cakes mingled with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mingled with oil, of fine flour, fried.

thanksgiving unto God <u>16\_NEH\_12\_46</u># For in the days of David and Asaph of old [there were] chief of the singers, and songs of praise and thanksgiving unto God.

thanksgiving unto the <u>03\_LEV\_22\_29</u># And when ye will offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving unto the LORD, offer [it] at your own will.

thanksgiving with leaven <u>30\_AMO\_04\_05</u># And offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving with leaven, and proclaim [and] publish the free offerings: for this liketh you, O ye children of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.

thanksgiving <u>54\_1TI\_04\_04</u> # For every creature of God [is] good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:

thanksgiving <u>51\_COL\_02\_07</u># Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.

thanksgiving 51\_COL\_04\_02 # Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;

thanksgiving 19\_PSA\_69\_30\_# I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving.

thanksgivings and with <u>16\_NEH\_12\_27</u># And at the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought the Levites out of all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem, to keep the dedication with gladness, both with thanksgivings, and with singing, [with] cymbals, psalteries, and with harps.

thanksgivings unto God 47\_2CO\_09\_12 # For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want

of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God;

thankworthy if a 60\_1PE\_02\_19 # For this [is] thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully.

unthankful and to <u>42\_LUK\_06\_35</u># But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and [to] the evil.

unthankful unholy <u>55\_2TI\_03\_02</u> # For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,
