themselves a good <u>54\_1TI\_03\_13</u># For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.

themselves a good <u>54\_1TI\_06\_19</u># Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

themselves a king <u>14\_2CH\_21\_08</u># In his days the Edomites revolted from under the dominion of Judah, and made themselves a king.

themselves together after <u>10\_2SA\_02\_25</u> # And the children of Benjamin gathered themselves together after Abner, and became one troop, and stood on the top of an hill.

themselves together against <u>01\_GEN\_34\_30</u> # And Jacob said to Simeon and Levi, Ye have troubled me to make me to stink among the inhabitants of the land, among the Canaanites and the Perizzites: and I [being] few in number, they shall gather themselves together against me, and slay me; and I shall be destroyed, I and my house.

themselves together against <u>18\_JOB\_16\_10</u> # They have gaped upon me with their mouth; they have smitten me upon the cheek reproachfully; they have gathered themselves together against me.

themselves together to <u>09\_1SA\_13\_05</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which [is] on the sea shore in multitude: and they came up, and pitched in Michmash, eastward from Bethaven.

themselves Whither will <u>43\_JOH\_07\_35</u> # Then said the Jews among themselves, Whither will he go, that we shall not find him? will he go unto the dispersed among the Gentiles, and teach the Gentiles?

themselves who are <u>48\_GAL\_06\_13</u># For neither they themselves who are circumcised keep the law; but desire to have you circumcised, that they may glory in your flesh.

themselves Who is <u>42\_LUK\_07\_49</u> # And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also?

themselves Who shall <u>41\_MAR\_16\_03</u># And they said among themselves, Who shall roll us away the stone from the door of the sepulchre?

themselves who should <u>41\_MAR\_09\_34</u> # But they held their peace: for by the way they had disputed among themselves, who [should be] the greatest.

themselves Who then <u>41\_MAR\_10\_26</u># And they were astonished out of measure, saying among themselves, Who then can be saved?
