filthiness and from <u>26\_EZE\_36\_25</u> # Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you.

filthiness and superfluity <u>59\_JAM\_01\_21</u># Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

filthiness any more <u>26\_EZE\_24\_13</u># In thy filthiness [is] lewdness: because I have purged thee, and thou wast not purged, thou shalt not be purged from thy filthiness any more, till I have caused my fury to rest upon thee.

filthiness is in <u>25\_LAM\_01\_09</u># Her filthiness [is] in her skirts; she remembereth not her last end; therefore she came down wonderfully: she had no comforter. O LORD, behold my affliction: for the enemy hath magnified [himself].

filthiness is lewdness <u>26\_EZE\_24\_13</u> # In thy filthiness [is] lewdness: because I have purged thee, and thou wast not purged, thou shalt not be purged from thy filthiness any more, till I have caused my fury to rest upon thee.

filthiness nor foolish 49\_EPH\_05\_04 # Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

filthiness of her <u>66\_REV\_17\_04</u> # And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

filthiness of it <u>26\_EZE\_24\_11</u># Then set it empty upon the coals thereof, that the brass of it may be hot, and may burn, and [that] the filthiness of it may be molten in it, [that] the scum of it may be consumed.

filthiness of the <u>47\_2CO\_07\_01</u> # Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

filthiness <u>20\_PRO\_30\_12</u> # [There is] a generation [that are] pure in their own eyes, and [yet] is not washed from their filthiness.

thine abominations out <u>24\_JER\_04\_01</u># If thou wilt return, O Israel, saith the LORD, return unto me: and if thou wilt put away thine abominations out of my sight, then shalt thou not remove.

thine abominations saith <u>26\_EZE\_16\_58</u># Thou hast borne thy lewdness and thine abominations, saith the LORD.

thine abominations shall  $\underline{26\_EZE\_07\_04}$  # And mine eye shall not spare thee, neither will I have pity: but I will recompense thy ways upon thee, and thine abominations shall be in the midst of thee: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

thine adulteries and <u>24 JER\_13\_27</u> # I have seen thine adulteries, and thy neighings, the lewdness of thy whoredom, [and] thine abominations on the hills in the fields. Woe unto thee, O Jerusalem! wilt thou not be made clean? when [shall it] once [be]?

thine adversaries and <u>33\_MIC\_05\_09</u> # Thine hand shall be lifted up upon thine adversaries, and all thine enemies shall be cut off.

thine adversaries every 24\_JER\_30\_16 # Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured; and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey.

thine adversaries that <u>23\_ISA\_64\_02</u># As [when] the melting fire burneth, the fire causeth the waters to boil, to make thy name known to thine adversaries, [that] the nations may tremble at thy presence!

thine adversaries <u>02\_EXO\_23\_22</u> # But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries.

thine adversaries <u>25 LAM\_02\_17</u># The LORD hath done [that] which he had devised; he hath fulfilled his word that he had commanded in the days of old: he hath thrown down, and hath not pitied: and he hath caused [thine] enemy to rejoice over thee, he hath set up the horn of thine adversaries.

thine adversary quickly <u>40\_MAT\_05\_25</u># Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison.

thine adversary to <u>42\_LUK\_12\_58</u># When thou goest with thine adversary to the magistrate, [as thou art] in the way, give diligence that thou mayest be delivered from him; lest he hale thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and the officer cast thee into prison.

thine affliction thy <u>24\_JER\_30\_15</u> # Why criest thou for thine affliction? thy sorrow [is] incurable for the multitude of thine iniquity: [because] thy sins were increased, I have done these things unto thee.

thine age shall <u>18\_JOB\_11\_17</u># And [thine] age shall be clearer than the noonday; thou shalt shine forth, thou shalt be as the morning.

thine alms are <u>44\_ACT\_10\_04</u># And when he looked on him, he was afraid, and said, What is it, Lord? And he said unto him, Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial before God.

thine alms are <u>44\_ACT\_10\_31</u> # And said, Cornelius, thy prayer is heard, and thine alms are had in remembrance in the sight of God.

thine alms do <u>40\_MAT\_06\_02</u># Therefore when thou doest [thine] alms, do not sound a trumpet before thee, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

thine alms may 40\_MAT\_06\_04# That thine alms may be in secret: and thy Father which seeth in secret himself shall reward thee openly.

thine altar in 11 1KI 08 31 # If any man trespass against his neighbour, and an oath be laid upon him to cause him to swear, and the oath come before thine altar in this house:

thine altar in 14\_2CH\_06\_22 # If a man sin against his neighbour, and an oath be laid upon him to make him swear, and the oath come before thine altar in this house;

thine altar O 19 PSA 26 06 # I will wash mine hands in innocency: so will I compass thine altar, O LORD:

thine altar <u>05\_DEU\_33\_10</u># They shall teach Jacob thy judgments, and Israel thy law: they shall put incense before thee, and whole burnt sacrifice upon thine altar.

thine altar 19\_PSA\_51\_19 # Then shalt thou be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering: then shall they offer bullocks upon thine altar.

thine and all <u>11\_1KI\_20\_04</u># And the king of Israel answered and said, My lord, O king, according to thy saying, I [am] thine, and all that I have.

thine and shall <u>01\_GEN\_48\_06</u># And thy issue, which thou begettest after them, shall be thine, [and] shall be called after the name of their brethren in their inheritance.

thine anger even <u>19\_PSA\_90\_11</u># Who knoweth the power of thine anger? even according to thy fear, [so is] thy wrath.

thine anger is 23\_ISA\_12\_01 # And in that day thou shalt say, O LORD, I will praise thee: though thou wast angry with me, thine anger is turned away, and thou comfortedst me.

thine anger lest 24\_JER\_10\_24 # O LORD, correct me, but with judgment; not in thine anger, lest thou bring me to nothing.

thine anger lift 19\_PSA\_07\_06 # Arise, O LORD, in thine anger, lift up thyself because of the rage of mine enemies: and awake for me [to] the judgment [that] thou hast commanded.

thine anger smoke 19\_PSA\_74\_01 # Maschil of Asaph. O God, why hast thou cast [us] off for ever? [why] doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture?

thine anger the <u>19\_PSA\_21\_09</u># Thou shalt make them as a fiery oven in the time of thine anger: the LORD shall swallow them up in his wrath, and the fire shall devour them.

thine anger thou <u>25\_LAM\_02\_21</u># The young and the old lie on the ground in the streets: my virgins and my young men are fallen by the sword; thou hast slain [them] in the day of thine anger; thou hast killed, [and] not pitied.

thine anger to <u>19\_PSA\_85\_05</u> # Wilt thou be angry with us for ever? wilt thou draw out thine anger to all generations?

thine anger toward 19\_PSA\_85\_04 # Turn us, O God of our salvation, and cause thine anger toward us to cease.

thine anger 24\_JER\_18\_23 # Yet, LORD, thou knowest all their counsel against me to slay [me]: forgive not their iniquity, neither blot out their sin from thy sight, but let them be overthrown before thee; deal [thus] with them in the time of thine anger.

thine anger 19\_PSA\_85\_03 # Thou hast taken away all thy wrath: thou hast turned [thyself] from the

fierceness of thine anger.

thine anointed remember 14\_2CH\_06\_42 # O LORD God, turn not away the face of thine anointed: remember the mercies of David thy servant.

thine anointed thou <u>35\_HAB\_03\_13</u># Thou wentest forth for the salvation of thy people, [even] for salvation with thine anointed; thou woundedst the head out of the house of the wicked, by discovering the foundation unto the neck. Selah.

thine anointed 19\_PSA\_132\_10 # For thy servant David's sake turn not away the face of thine anointed.

thine anointed 19\_PSA\_84\_09 # Behold, O God our shield, and look upon the face of thine anointed.

thine anointed 19\_PSA\_89\_38 # But thou hast cast off and abhorred, thou hast been wroth with thine anointed.

thine anointed 19\_PSA\_89\_51 # Wherewith thine enemies have reproached, O LORD; wherewith they have reproached the footsteps of thine anointed.

thine apparel and <u>23\_ISA\_63\_02</u># Wherefore [art thou] red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

thine are all 10\_2SA\_16\_04 # Then said the king to Ziba, Behold, thine [are] all that [pertained] unto Mephibosheth. And Ziba said, I humbly beseech thee [that] I may find grace in thy sight, my lord, O king.

thine are mine 43\_JOH\_17\_10 # And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them.

Thine are we 13 1CH 12 18 # Then the spirit came upon Amasai, [who was] chief of the captains, [and he said], Thine [are we], David, and on thy side, thou son of Jesse: peace, peace [be] unto thee, and peace [be] to thine helpers; for thy God helpeth thee. Then David received them, and made them captains of the band.

thine arm and <u>09\_1SA\_02\_31</u> # Behold, the days come, that I will cut off thine arm, and the arm of thy father's house, that there shall not be an old man in thine house.

thine arm and 19 PSA 44 03 # For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them.

thine arm for <u>22\_SON\_08\_06</u> # Set me as a seal upon thine heart, as a seal upon thine arm: for love [is] strong as death; jealousy [is] cruel as the grave: the coals thereof [are] coals of fire, [which hath a] most vehement flame.

thine arm redeemed 19\_PSA\_77\_15 # Thou hast with [thine] arm redeemed thy people, the sons of Jacob and Joseph. Selah.

thine be driven <u>05\_DEU\_30\_04</u> # If [any] of thine be driven out unto the outmost [parts] of heaven, from thence will the LORD thy God gather thee, and from thence will he fetch thee:
