

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

bethink themselves in <u>11\_1KI\_08\_47</u># [Yet] if they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and repent, and make supplication unto thee in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness;

bethink themselves in <u>14\_2CH\_06\_37</u> # Yet [if] they bethink themselves in the land whither they are carried captive, and turn and pray unto thee in the land of their captivity, saying, We have sinned, we have done amiss, and have dealt wickedly;

think according to <u>49\_EPH\_03\_20</u> # Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

think also that <u>46\_1CO\_07\_40</u> # But she is happier if she so abide, after my judgment: and I think also that I have the Spirit of God.

think an evil <u>26\_EZE\_38\_10</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; It shall also come to pass, [that] at the same time shall things come into thy mind, and thou shalt think an evil thought:

think any thing <u>47\_2CO\_03\_05</u> # Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency [is] of God;

think best only <u>04\_NUM\_36\_06</u> # This [is] the thing which the LORD doth command concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, saying, Let them marry to whom they think best; only to the family of the tribe of their father shall they marry.

think but to <u>45\_ROM\_12\_03</u> # For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think [of himself] more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

think good give <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_12</u># And I said unto them, If ye think good, give [me] my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty [pieces] of silver.

think himself to  $46_{1CO_{14_{37}}}$ # If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.

think himself to <u>48\_GAL\_06\_03</u># For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

think it meet <u>61\_2PE\_01\_13</u># Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting [you] in remembrance;

think it not <u>60\_1PE\_04\_12</u> # Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:

think it strange <u>60\_1PE\_04\_04</u> # Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with [them] to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of [you]:

think me a <u>47\_2CO\_11\_16</u># I say again, Let no man think me a fool; if otherwise, yet as a fool receive me, that I may boast myself a little.

think myself happy <u>44\_ACT\_26\_02</u> # I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before thee touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews:

Think not that <u>40\_MAT\_05\_17</u># Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

Think not that <u>40\_MAT\_10\_34</u># Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.

think not the <u>40\_MAT\_24\_44</u># Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.

think not to <u>40\_MAT\_03\_09</u># And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to [our] father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.

Think not with <u>17\_EST\_04\_13</u># Then Mordecai commanded to answer Esther, Think not with thyself that thou shalt escape in the king's house, more than all the Jews.

think not <u>42\_LUK\_12\_40</u> # Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not.

think of himself <u>45\_ROM\_12\_03</u> # For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think [of himself] more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

think of me <u>47\_2CO\_12\_06</u> # For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but [now] I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me [to be], or [that] he heareth of me.

think of men <u>46\_1CO\_04\_06</u> # And these things, brethren, I have in a figure transferred to myself and [to] Apollos for your sakes; that ye might learn in us not to think [of men] above that which is written, that no one of you be puffed up for one against another.

think of us <u>47\_2CO\_10\_02</u> # But I beseech [you], that I may not be bold when I am present with that confidence, wherewith I think to be bold against some, which think of us as if we walked according to the flesh.

think on me <u>01\_GEN\_40\_14</u> # But think on me when it shall be well with thee, and show kindness, I pray thee, unto me, and make mention of me unto Pharaoh, and bring me out of this house:

think on these <u>50\_PHP\_04\_08</u># Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things [are] honest, whatsoever things [are] just, whatsoever things [are] pure, whatsoever things [are] lovely, whatsoever things [are] of good report; if [there be] any virtue, and if [there be] any praise, think on these things.

think so but <u>23\_ISA\_10\_07</u> # Howbeit he meaneth not so, neither doth his heart think so; but [it is] in his heart to destroy and cut off nations not a few.

think soberly according <u>45\_ROM\_12\_03</u># For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think [of himself] more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

think that all <u>10\_2SA\_13\_33</u> # Now therefore let not my lord the king take the thing to his heart, to think that all the king's sons are dead: for Amnon only is dead.

think that God <u>46\_1CO\_04\_09</u> # For I think that God hath set forth us the apostles last, as it were appointed to death: for we are made a spectacle unto the world, and to angels, and to men.

think that he <u>46\_1CO\_07\_36</u> # But if any man think that he behaveth himself uncomely toward his virgin, if she pass the flower of [her] age, and need so require, let him do what he will, he sinneth not: let them marry.

think that he <u>46\_1CO\_08\_02</u> # And if any man think that he knoweth any thing, he knoweth nothing yet as he ought to know.

think that he <u>59\_JAM\_01\_07</u> # For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

think that he <u>43\_JOH\_16\_02</u># They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service.

think that I <u>43\_JOH\_05\_45</u> # Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is [one] that accuse the you, [even] Moses, in whom ye trust.

think that the <u>44\_ACT\_17\_29</u># Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.

think that the <u>59\_JAM\_04\_05</u># Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy?

think that they <u>40\_MAT\_06\_07</u># But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen [do]: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.

think the deep <u>18\_JOB\_41\_32</u># He maketh a path to shine after him; [one] would think the deep [to be] hoary.

think this again <u>47\_2CO\_10\_07</u> # Do ye look on things after the outward appearance? If any man trust to himself that he is Christ's, let him of himself think this again, that, as he [is] Christ's, even so [are] we Christ's.

think this of <u>50\_PHP\_01\_07</u># Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace.

think this that <u>47\_2CO\_10\_11</u># Let such an one think this, that, such as we are in word by letters when we are absent, such [will we be] also in deed when we are present.

think thou upon <u>16\_NEH\_06\_14</u> # My God, think thou upon Tobiah and Sanballat according to these their works, and on the prophetess Noadiah, and the rest of the prophets, that would have put me in fear.

think to be <u>46\_1CO\_12\_23</u> # And those [members] of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely [parts] have more abundant comeliness.

think to be <u>47\_2CO\_10\_02</u> # But I beseech [you], that I may not be bold when I am present with that confidence, wherewith I think to be bold against some, which think of us as if we walked according to the flesh.

think to cause <u>24\_JER\_23\_27</u> # Which think to cause my people to forget my name by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.

think to change <u>27\_DAN\_07\_25</u># And he shall speak [great] words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

think to know <u>21\_ECC\_08\_17</u># Then I beheld all the work of God, that a man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun: because though a man labour to seek [it] out, yet he shall not find [it]; yea farther; though a wise [man] think to know [it], yet shall he not be able to find [it].

think to rebel <u>16\_NEH\_06\_06</u># Wherein [was] written, It is reported among the heathen, and Gashmu saith [it, that] thou and the Jews think to rebel: for which cause thou buildest the wall, that thou mayest be their king, according to these words.

think to withstand <u>14\_2CH\_13\_08</u> # And now ye think to withstand the kingdom of the LORD in the hand of the sons of David; and ye [be] a great multitude, and [there are] with you golden calves, which Jeroboam made you for gods.

think toward you <u>24\_JER\_29\_11</u># For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

think upon a <a><u>18\_JOB\_31\_01</u></a># I made a covenant with mine eyes; why then should I think upon a maid?

Think upon me <u>16\_NEH\_05\_19</u># Think upon me, my God, for good, [according] to all that I have done for this people.

think upon us <u>32\_JON\_01\_06</u># So the shipmaster came to him, and said unto him, What meanest thou, O sleeper? arise, call upon thy God, if so be that God will think upon us, that we perish not.

think ye A <u>40\_MAT\_21\_28</u># But what think ye? A [certain] man had two sons; and he came to the first, and said, Son, go work to day in my vineyard.

think ye And <u>41\_MAR\_14\_64</u># Ye have heard the blasphemy: what think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.

think ye evil <u>40\_MAT\_09\_04</u># And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, Wherefore think ye evil in your hearts?

think ye have <u>43\_JOH\_05\_39</u> # Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.

think ye if <u>40\_MAT\_18\_12</u># How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray?

think ye of <u>40\_MAT\_22\_42</u># Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, [The son] of David.

think ye that <u>47\_2CO\_12\_19</u> # Again, think ye that we excuse ourselves unto you? we speak before God in Christ: but [we do] all things, dearly beloved, for your edifying.

think ye that <u>44\_ACT\_13\_25</u> # And as John fulfilled his course, he said, Whom think ye that I am? I am not [he]. But, behold, there cometh one after me, whose shoes of [his] feet I am not worthy to loose.

think ye that <u>43\_JOH\_11\_56</u># Then sought they for Jesus, and spake among themselves, as they stood in the temple, What think ye, that he will not come to the feast?

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think ye that <u>42\_LUK\_13\_04</u># Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem?

think ye They <u>40\_MAT\_26\_66</u># What think ye? They answered and said, He is guilty of death.

thinkest for as <u>44\_ACT\_28\_22</u> # But we desire to hear of thee what thou thinkest: for as concerning this sect, we know that every where it is spoken against.

thinkest thou Is <u>40\_MAT\_22\_17</u># Tell us therefore, What thinkest thou? Is it lawful to give tribute unto Caesar, or not?

thinkest thou Simon <u>40 MAT\_17\_25</u># He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?

Thinkest thou that <u>13\_1CH\_19\_03</u># But the princes of the children of Ammon said to Hanun, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? are not his servants come unto thee for to search, and to overthrow, and to spy out the land?

Thinkest thou that <u>10\_2SA\_10\_03</u># And the princes of the children of Ammon said unto Hanun their lord, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? hath not David [rather] sent his servants unto thee, to search the city, and to spy it out, and to overthrow it?

Thinkest thou that <u>40\_MAT\_26\_53</u># Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?

Thinkest thou this <u>18\_JOB\_35\_02</u># Thinkest thou this to be right, [that] thou saidst, My righteousness [is] more than God's?

thinkest thou this <u>45\_ROM\_02\_03</u> # And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?

thinkest thou was <u>42\_LUK\_10\_36</u># Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?

thinketh he standeth <u>46\_1CO\_10\_12</u> # Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall.

thinketh in his <u>20\_PRO\_23\_07</u> # For as he thinketh in his heart, so [is] he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart [is] not with thee.

thinketh no evil <u>46\_1CO\_13\_05</u> # Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

thinketh that he <u>50\_PHP\_03\_04</u># Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more:

thinketh the running <u>10\_2SA\_18\_27</u> # And the watchman said, Me thinketh the running of the foremost is like the running of Ahimaaz the son of Zadok. And the king said, He [is] a good man, and cometh with good tidings.

thinketh upon me <u>19\_PSA\_40\_17</u> # But I [am] poor and needy; [yet] the Lord thinketh upon me: thou [art] my help and my deliverer; make no tarrying, O my God.

thinking David cannot <u>10\_2SA\_05\_06</u> # And the king and his men went to Jerusalem unto the Jebusites, the inhabitants of the land: which spake unto David, saying, Except thou take away the blind and the lame,

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thou shalt not come in hither: thinking, David cannot come in hither.

thinking to have <u>10\_2SA\_04\_10</u> # When one told me, saying, Behold, Saul is dead, thinking to have brought good tidings, I took hold of him, and slew him in Ziklag, who [thought] that I would have given him a reward for his tidings:
