thought a thing <u>44\_ACT\_26\_08</u># Why should it be thought a thing incredible with you, that God should raise the dead?

thought afar off <u>19 PSA\_139\_02</u> # Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off.

thought and curse 21\_ECC\_10\_20 # Curse not the king, no not in thy thought; and curse not the rich in thy bedchamber: for a bird of the air shall carry the voice, and that which hath wings shall tell the matter.

thought as a <u>46\_1CO\_13\_11</u># When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

thought because Judas <u>43\_JOH\_13\_29</u> # For some [of them] thought, because Judas had the bag, that Jesus had said unto him, Buy [those things] that we have need of against the feast; or, that he should give something to the poor.

thought beforehand what <u>41\_MAR\_13\_11</u># But when they shall lead [you], and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ve: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost.

thought can add 42\_LUK\_12\_25 # And which of you with taking thought can add to his stature one cubit?

thought can add 40\_MAT\_06\_27 # Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?

thought can be <u>18\_JOB\_42\_02</u># I know that thou canst do every [thing], and [that] no thought can be withholden from thee.

thought evil against <u>01\_GEN\_50\_20</u> # But as for you, ye thought evil against me; [but] God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as [it is] this day, to save much people alive.

thought evil lay 20\_PRO\_30\_32 # If thou hast done foolishly in lifting up thyself, or if thou hast thought evil, [lay] thine hand upon thy mouth.

thought for raiment 40 MAT\_06\_28 # And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:

thought for the <u>42\_LUK\_12\_26</u># If ye then be not able to do that thing which is least, why take ye thought for the rest?

thought her to <u>01\_GEN\_38\_15</u># When Judah saw her, he thought her [to be] an harlot; because she had covered her face.

thought how or <u>42\_LUK\_12\_11</u># And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and [unto] magistrates, and powers, take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say:

thought how or <u>40\_MAT\_10\_19</u># But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.

thought I myself <u>42\_LUK\_07\_07</u> # Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.

thought in his <u>17\_EST\_06\_06</u># So Haman came in. And the king said unto him, What shall be done unto the man whom the king delighteth to honour? Now Haman thought in his heart, To whom would the king delight to do honour more than to myself?

thought in these <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_15</u># So again have I thought in these days to do well unto Jerusalem and to the house of Judah: fear ye not.

thought in thy <u>05\_DEU\_15\_09</u> # Beware that there be not a thought in thy wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor brother, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the LORD against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

thought is that 19\_PSA\_49\_11# Their inward thought [is, that] their houses [shall continue] for ever, [and] their dwelling places to all generations; they call [their] lands after their own names.

thought it good <u>52\_1TH\_03\_01</u> # Wherefore when we could no longer forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone;

thought it good <u>27\_DAN\_04\_02</u> # I thought it good to show the signs and wonders that the high God hath wrought toward me.

thought it hard <u>10\_2SA\_13\_02</u> # And Amnon was so vexed, that he fell sick for his sister Tamar; for she [was] a virgin; and Amnon thought it hard for him to do any thing to her.

thought it necessary 47\_2CO\_09\_05 # Therefore I thought it necessary to exhort the brethren, that they

would go before unto you, and make up before hand your bounty, whereof ye had notice before, that the same might be ready, as [a matter of] bounty, and not as [of] covetousness.

thought it not <u>50\_PHP\_02\_06</u># Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

thought not good <u>44\_ACT\_15\_38</u># But Paul thought not good to take him with them, who departed from them from Pamphylia, and went not with them to the work.

thought of every 19\_PSA\_64\_06 # They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward [thought] of every one [of them], and the heart, [is] deep.

thought of foolishness 20\_PRO\_24\_09 # The thought of foolishness [is] sin: and the scorner [is] an abomination to men.

thought of him <u>18\_JOB\_12\_05</u># He that is ready to slip with [his] feet [is as] a lamp despised in the thought of him that is at ease.

thought of their 42\_LUK\_09\_47 # And Jesus, perceiving the thought of their heart, took a child, and set him by him,

thought of thine 44\_ACT\_08\_22 # Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

thought of thy 19\_PSA\_48\_09 # We have thought of thy lovingkindness, O God, in the midst of thy temple.

thought on my 19 PSA 119 59 # I thought on my ways, and turned my feet unto thy testimonies.

thought on the <u>44\_ACT\_10\_19</u> # While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee.

thought on these <u>40\_MAT\_01\_20</u># But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

thought saying What <u>40\_MAT\_06\_31</u># Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

thought scorn to <u>17\_EST\_03\_06</u># And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had showed him the people of Mordecai: wherefore Haman sought to destroy all the Jews that [were] throughout the whole kingdom of Ahasuerus, [even] the people of Mordecai.

thought she had <u>09\_1SA\_01\_13</u># Now Hannah, she spake in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard: therefore Eli thought she had been drunken.

thought so shall <u>23\_ISA\_14\_24</u># The LORD of hosts hath sworn, saying, Surely as I have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as I have purposed, [so] shall it stand:

thought Something hath <u>09\_1SA\_20\_26</u> # Nevertheless Saul spake not any thing that day: for he thought, Something hath befallen him, he [is] not clean; surely he [is] not clean.

thought such a <u>10\_2SA\_14\_13</u># And the woman said, Wherefore then hast thou thought such a thing against the people of God? for the king doth speak this thing as one which is faulty, in that the king doth not fetch home again his banished.

thought Surely the <u>01\_GEN\_20\_11</u># And Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely the fear of God [is] not in this place; and they will slay me for my wife's sake.

thought that he <u>43\_JOH\_11\_13</u># Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep.

thought that I <u>10 2SA 04 10</u> # When one told me, saying, Behold, Saul is dead, thinking to have brought good tidings, I took hold of him, and slew him in Ziklag, who [thought] that I would have given him a reward for his tidings:

thought that maketh <u>30\_AMO\_04\_13</u> # For, lo, he that formeth the mountains, and createth the wind, and declareth unto man what [is] his thought, that maketh the morning darkness, and treadeth upon the high places of the earth, The LORD, The God of hosts, [is] his name.

thought that the <u>44\_ACT\_08\_20</u> # But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money.

thought that the <u>42\_LUK\_19\_11</u># And as they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the kingdom of God should immediately appear.

thought that thou <u>07\_JUD\_15\_02</u> # And her father said, I verily thought that thou hadst utterly hated her; therefore I gave her to thy companion: [is] not her younger sister fairer than she? take her, I pray thee, instead of her.

thought thereon he <u>41\_MAR\_14\_72</u># And the second time the cock crew. And Peter called to mind the word that Jesus said unto him, Before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. And when he thought thereon, he wept.

thought to advertise <u>08\_RUT\_04\_04</u># And I thought to advertise thee, saying, Buy [it] before the inhabitants, and before the elders of my people. If thou wilt redeem [it], redeem [it]: but if thou wilt not redeem [it, then] tell me, that I may know: for [there is] none to redeem [it] beside thee; and I [am] after thee. And he said, I will redeem [it].

thought to do 02\_EXO\_32\_14 # And the LORD repented of the evil which he thought to do unto his people.

thought to do 24\_JER\_18\_08 # If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them.

thought to do <u>16\_NEH\_06\_02</u> # That Sanballat and Geshem sent unto me, saying, Come, let us meet together in [some one of] the villages in the plain of Ono. But they thought to do me mischief.

thought to do <u>04\_NUM\_33\_56</u># Moreover it shall come to pass, [that] I shall do unto you, as I thought to do unto them.

thought to do <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_06</u># But my words and my statutes, which I commanded my servants the prophets, did they not take hold of your fathers? and they returned and said, Like as the LORD of hosts thought to do unto us, according to our ways, and according to our doings, so hath he dealt with us.

thought to have <u>10\_2SA\_21\_16</u># And Ishbibenob, which [was] of the sons of the giant, the weight of whose spear [weighed] three hundred [shekels] of brass in weight, he being girded with a new [sword], thought to have slain David.

thought to have <u>05\_DEU\_19\_19</u># Then shall ye do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shalt thou put the evil away from among you.

thought to have <u>07\_JUD\_20\_05</u># And the men of Gibeah rose against me, and beset the house round about upon me by night, [and] thought to have slain me: and my concubine have they forced, that she is dead.

thought to know 19\_PSA\_73\_16 # When I thought to know this, it [was] too painful for me;

thought to make <u>09\_1SA\_18\_25</u># And Saul said, Thus shall ye say to David, The king desireth not any dowry, but an hundred foreskins of the Philistines, to be avenged of the king's enemies. But Saul thought to make David fall by the hand of the Philistines.

thought to make 14\_2CH\_11\_22 # And Rehoboam made Abijah the son of Maachah the chief, [to be] ruler among his brethren: for [he thought] to make him king.

thought to promote <u>04\_NUM\_24\_11</u># Therefore now flee thou to thy place: I thought to promote thee unto great honour; but, lo, the LORD hath kept thee back from honour.

thought to punish <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_14</u> # For thus saith the LORD of hosts; As I thought to punish you, when your fathers provoked me to wrath, saith the LORD of hosts, and I repented not:

thought to see <u>01\_GEN\_48\_11</u># And Israel said unto Joseph, I had not thought to see thy face: and, lo, God hath showed me also thy seed.

thought to set <u>27\_DAN\_06\_03</u> # Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit [was] in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.

thought to the <u>47\_2CO\_10\_05</u># Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

thought to win <u>14\_2CH\_32\_01</u> # After these things, and the establishment thereof, Sennacherib king of Assyria came, and entered into Judah, and encamped against the fenced cities, and thought to win them for himself.

thought upon his <u>39 MAL\_03\_16</u># Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard [it], and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

thought with myself <u>44\_ACT\_26\_09</u> # I verily thought with myself, that I ought to do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

thought within himself <u>42\_LUK\_12\_17</u> # And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my fruits?

thought worthy who <u>58\_HEB\_10\_29</u> # Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

thought <u>26\_EZE\_38\_10</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; It shall also come to pass, [that] at the same time shall things come into thy mind, and thou shalt think an evil thought:

thoughtest that I <u>19\_PSA\_50\_21</u> # These [things] hast thou done, and I kept silence; thou thoughtest that I was altogether [such an one] as thyself: [but] I will reprove thee, and set [them] in order before thine eyes.

thoughts adulteries fornications <u>41\_MAR\_07\_21</u> # For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders,

thoughts and intents 58\_HEB\_04\_12 # For the word of God [is] quick, and powerful, and sharper than any

twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and [is] a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

thoughts and let <u>23\_ISA\_55\_07</u> # Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

thoughts and said <u>42\_LUK\_06\_08</u> # But he knew their thoughts, and said to the man which had the withered hand, Rise up, and stand forth in the midst. And he arose and stood forth.

thoughts and said <u>40\_MAT\_12\_25</u># And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand:

thoughts and the <u>18\_JOB\_21\_27</u># Behold, I know your thoughts, and the devices [which] ye wrongfully imagine against me.

thoughts are thoughts <u>23\_ISA\_59\_07</u> # Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood: their thoughts [are] thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction [are] in their paths.

thoughts are very 19\_PSA\_92\_05 # O LORD, how great are thy works! [and] thy thoughts are very deep.

thoughts arise in <u>42\_LUK\_24\_38</u># And he said unto them, Why are ye troubled? and why do thoughts arise in your hearts?

thoughts because they <u>24\_JER\_06\_19</u># Hear, O earth: behold, I will bring evil upon this people, [even] the fruit of their thoughts, because they have not hearkened unto my words, nor to my law, but rejected it.

thoughts but thy 19\_PSA\_119\_113# SAMECH. I hate [vain] thoughts: but thy law do I love.

thoughts came into <u>27\_DAN\_02\_29</u> # As for thee, O king, thy thoughts came [into thy mind] upon thy bed, what should come to pass hereafter: and he that revealeth secrets maketh known to thee what shall come to pass.

thoughts cause me <u>18\_JOB\_20\_02</u> # Therefore do my thoughts cause me to answer, and for [this] I make haste.

thoughts from the <u>18\_JOB\_04\_13</u># In thoughts from the visions of the night, when deep sleep falleth on men,

thoughts he answering 42\_LUK\_05\_22 # But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, he answering said unto them, What reason ye in your hearts?

thoughts if thou <u>13\_1CH\_28\_09</u> # And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.

thoughts it shall <u>23\_ISA\_66\_18</u># For I [know] their works and their thoughts: it shall come, that I will gather all nations and tongues; and they shall come, and see my glory.

thoughts lodge within <u>24\_JER\_04\_14</u> # O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, that thou mayest be saved. How long shall thy vain thoughts lodge within thee?

thoughts murders adulteries <u>40\_MAT\_15\_19</u># For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies:

thoughts neither are 23\_ISA\_55\_08 # For my thoughts [are] not your thoughts, neither [are] your ways my ways, saith the LORD.

thoughts of heart <u>07\_JUD\_05\_15</u># And the princes of Issachar [were] with Deborah; even Issachar, and also Barak: he was sent on foot into the valley. For the divisions of Reuben [there were] great thoughts of heart.

thoughts of his <u>01\_GEN\_06\_05</u># And God saw that the wickedness of man [was] great in the earth, and [that] every imagination of the thoughts of his heart [was] only evil continually.

thoughts of his <u>24\_JER\_23\_20</u># The anger of the LORD shall not return, until he have executed, and till he have performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly.

thoughts of his <u>19\_PSA\_33\_11</u># The counsel of the LORD standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations.

thoughts of iniquity <u>23\_ISA\_59\_07</u># Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood: their thoughts [are] thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction [are] in their paths.

thoughts of man 19\_PSA\_94\_11 # The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they [are] vanity.

thoughts of many <u>42\_LUK\_02\_35</u> # [Yea, a sword shall pierce through thy own soul also,] that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed.

thoughts of my <u>18\_JOB\_17\_11</u> # My days are past, my purposes are broken off, [even] the thoughts of my heart.

thoughts of peace 24\_JER\_29\_11 # For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

thoughts of the <u>13\_1CH\_29\_18</u> # O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto thee:

thoughts of the 46\_1CO\_03\_20 # And again, The Lord knoweth the thoughts of the wise, that they are vain.

thoughts trouble thee <u>27\_DAN\_05\_10</u># [Now] the queen by reason of the words of the king and his lords came into the banquet house: [and] the queen spake and said, O king, live for ever: let not thy thoughts trouble thee, nor let thy countenance be changed:

thoughts troubled him <u>27\_DAN\_04\_19</u># Then Daniel, whose name [was] Belteshazzar, was astonied for one hour, and his thoughts troubled him. The king spake, and said, Belteshazzar, let not the dream, or the interpretation thereof, trouble thee. thoughts which are 19 PSA 40 05 # Many, O LORD my God, [are] thy wonderful works [which] thou hast done, and thy thoughts [which are] to us ward: they cannot be reckoned up in order unto thee: [if] I would declare and speak [of them], they are more than can be numbered.

thoughts within me 19\_PSA\_94\_19 # In the multitude of my thoughts within me thy comforts delight my soul.

thoughts <u>23\_ISA\_55\_09</u> # For [as] the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

thoughts <u>23\_ISA\_65\_02</u> # I have spread out my hands all the day unto a rebellious people, which walketh in a way [that was] not good, after their own thoughts;

thoughts 59 JAM 02 04 # Are ye not then partial in yourselves, and are become judges of evil thoughts?

thoughts <u>19 PSA\_10\_04</u> # The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, will not seek [after God]: God [is] not in all his thoughts.

thoughts 19\_PSA\_139\_23 # Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:
