thrust another they <u>29\_JOE\_02\_08</u> # Neither shall one thrust another; they shall walk every one in his path: and [when] they fall upon the sword, they shall not be wounded.

thrust away because <u>10\_2SA\_23\_06</u> # But [the sons] of Belial [shall be] all of them as thorns thrust away, because they cannot be taken with hands:

thrust both of <u>04\_NUM\_25\_08</u> # And he went after the man of Israel into the tent, and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. So the plague was stayed from the children of Israel.
