thyself a glorious <u>23\_ISA\_63\_14</u> # As a beast goeth down into the valley, the Spirit of the LORD caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name.

thyself a man  $\underline{11\_1KI\_02\_02}$  # I go the way of all the earth: be thou strong therefore, and show thyself a man;

thyself a pattern <u>56\_TIT\_02\_07</u># In all things showing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine [showing] uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,

thyself abroad thou <u>05\_DEU\_23\_13</u># And thou shalt have a paddle upon thy weapon; and it shall be, when thou wilt ease thyself abroad, thou shalt dig therewith, and shalt turn back and cover that which cometh from thee:

thyself against me <u>10\_2SA\_18\_13</u># Otherwise I should have wrought falsehood against mine own life: for there is no matter hid from the king, and thou thyself wouldest have set thyself against [me].

thyself but in 28\_HOS\_13\_09 # O Israel, thou hast destroyed thyself; but in me [is] thine help.

thyself but shalt <u>40\_MAT\_05\_33</u># Again, ye have heard that it hath been said by them of old time, Thou shalt not forswear thyself, but shalt perform unto the Lord thine oaths:

thyself in mischief 19 PSA 52 01 # To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.
