till he send <u>40\_MAT\_12\_20</u># A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment unto victory.

till he shall <u>18\_JOB\_14\_06</u># Turn from him, that he may rest, till he shall accomplish, as an hireling, his day.

till he should <u>40\_MAT\_18\_30</u># And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt.

till he should <u>40\_MAT\_18\_34</u># And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him.

till he was <u>14\_2CH\_26\_15</u># And he made in Jerusalem engines, invented by cunning men, to be on the towers and upon the bulwarks, to shoot arrows and great stones withal. And his name spread far abroad; for he was marvellously helped, till he was strong.

till he was <u>12\_2KI\_02\_17</u># And when they urged him till he was ashamed, he said, Send. They sent therefore fifty men; and they sought three days, but found him not.

Till heaven and <u>40\_MAT\_05\_18</u># For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

till his enemies <u>58\_HEB\_10\_13</u># From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.

till his hairs <u>27\_DAN\_04\_33</u># The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' [feathers], and his nails like birds' [claws].

till I come <u>09\_1SA\_10\_08</u># And thou shalt go down before me to Gilgal; and, behold, I will come down unto thee, to offer burnt offerings, [and] to sacrifice sacrifices of peace offerings: seven days shalt thou tarry, till I come to thee, and show thee what thou shalt do.

Till I come <u>54\_1TI\_04\_13</u> # Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

till I come <u>43\_JOH\_21\_22</u># Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what [is that] to thee? follow thou me.

till I come <u>43\_JOH\_21\_23</u># Then went this saying abroad among the brethren, that that disciple should not die: yet Jesus said not unto him, He shall not die; but, If I will that he tarry till I come, what [is that] to thee?

till I come <u>42\_LUK\_19\_13</u> # And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.

till I come <u>16\_NEH\_02\_07</u> # Moreover I said unto the king, If it please the king, let letters be given me to

the governors beyond the river, that they may convey me over till I come into Judah;

till I come <u>66\_REV\_02\_25</u> # But that which ye have [already] hold fast till I come.

till I die <u>18\_JOB\_27\_05</u># God forbid that I should justify you: till I die I will not remove mine integrity from me.

till I have <u>26\_EZE\_24\_13</u># In thy filthiness [is] lewdness: because I have purged thee, and thou wast not purged, thou shalt not be purged from thy filthiness any more, till I have caused my fury to rest upon thee.

till I have <u>24\_JER\_09\_16</u> # I will scatter them also among the heathen, whom neither they nor their fathers have known: and I will send a sword after them, till I have consumed them.

till I have <u>24\_JER\_49\_37</u># For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: and I will bring evil upon them, [even] my fierce anger, saith the LORD; and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them:

till I have <u>42\_LUK\_17\_08</u> # And will not rather say unto him, Make ready wherewith I may sup, and gird thyself, and serve me, till I have eaten and drunken; and afterward thou shalt eat and drink?

till I know <u>09\_1SA\_22\_03</u># And David went thence to Mizpeh of Moab: and he said unto the king of Moab, Let my father and my mother, I pray thee, come forth, [and be] with you, till I know what God will do for me.

Till I make <u>42\_LUK\_20\_43</u> # Till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

till I make <u>41\_MAR\_12\_36</u># For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

till I make <u>40\_MAT\_22\_44</u># The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool?

till I might <u>44\_ACT\_25\_21</u> # But when Paul had appealed to be reserved unto the hearing of Augustus, I commanded him to be kept till I might send him to Caesar.

till I might <u>21\_ECC\_02\_03</u> # I sought in mine heart to give myself unto wine, yet acquainting mine heart with wisdom; and to lay hold on folly, till I might see what [was] that good for the sons of men, which they should do under the heaven all the days of their life.

till I shall <u>42\_LUK\_13\_08</u># And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung [it]:

till I swallow <u>18\_JOB\_07\_19</u># How long wilt thou not depart from me, nor let me alone till I swallow down my spittle?

till iniquity was <u>26\_EZE\_28\_15</u># Thou [wast] perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

till it and <u>24\_JER\_27\_11</u># But the nations that bring their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, and serve him, those will I let remain still in their own land, saith the LORD; and they shall till it, and dwell therein.

till it be <u>11\_1KI\_14\_10</u># Therefore, behold, I will bring evil upon the house of Jeroboam, and will cut off from Jeroboam him that pisseth against the wall, [and] him that is shut up and left in Israel, and will take away the remnant of the house of Jeroboam, as a man taketh away dung, till it be all gone.

till it be <u>42\_LUK\_12\_50</u># But I have a baptism to be baptized with; and how am I straitened till it be accomplished!

till it came <u>40\_MAT\_02\_09</u># When they had heard the king, they departed; and, lo, the star, which they saw in the east, went before them, till it came and stood over where the young child was.

till it was <u>07\_JUD\_19\_26</u># Then came the woman in the dawning of the day, and fell down at the door of the man's house where her lord [was], till it was light.

till Job had <u>18\_JOB\_32\_04</u> # Now Elihu had waited till Job had spoken, because they [were] elder than he.

till midnight and <u>07\_JUD\_16\_03</u> # And Samson lay till midnight, and arose at midnight, and took the doors of the gate of the city, and the two posts, and went away with them, bar and all, and put [them] upon his shoulders, and carried them up to the top of an hill that [is] before Hebron.

till Miriam was <u>04\_NUM\_12\_15</u># And Miriam was shut out from the camp seven days: and the people journeyed not till Miriam was brought in [again].

till Miriam was <u>04\_NUM\_12\_15</u># And Miriam was shut out from the camp seven days: and the people journeyed not till Miriam was brought in [again].

till morning that <u>23\_ISA\_38\_13</u># I reckoned till morning, [that], as a lion, so will he break all my bones: from day [even] to night wilt thou make an end of me.

till Moses had <u>02\_EXO\_34\_33</u># And [till] Moses had done speaking with them, he put a veil on his face.

till my change <u>18\_JOB\_14\_14</u># If a man die, shall he live [again]? all the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come.

till noon and <u>12\_2KI\_04\_20</u># And when he had taken him, and brought him to his mother, he sat on her knees till noon, and [then] died.

till now have <u>26\_EZE\_04\_14</u> # Then said I, Ah Lord GOD! behold, my soul hath not been polluted: for from my youth up even till now have I not eaten of that which dieth of itself, or is torn in pieces; neither came there abominable flesh into my mouth.

till seven times <u>27\_DAN\_04\_23</u> # And whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying, Hew the tree down, and destroy it; yet leave the stump of the roots thereof in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and [let] his portion [be] with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him;

till seven times <u>40\_MAT\_18\_21</u># Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

till she find <u>42\_LUK\_15\_08</u># Either what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose one piece, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently till she find [it]?

till she had <u>40\_MAT\_01\_25</u># And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS.

till Shelah my <u>01\_GEN\_38\_11</u># Then said Judah to Tamar his daughter in law, Remain a widow at thy father's house, till Shelah my son be grown: for he said, Lest peradventure he die also, as his brethren [did]. And Tamar went and dwelt in her father's house.

till that a <u>27\_DAN\_02\_34</u> # Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet [that were] of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.

till the Assyrian <u>23\_ISA\_23\_13</u># Behold the land of the Chaldeans; this people was not, [till] the Assyrian founded it for them that dwell in the wilderness: they set up the towers thereof, they raised up the palaces thereof; [and] he brought it to ruin.

till the beast <u>27\_DAN\_07\_11</u># I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld [even] till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.

till the blood <u>11\_1KI\_18\_28</u># And they cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the blood gushed out upon them.

till the buriers <u>26\_EZE\_39\_15</u># And the passengers [that] pass through the land, when [any] seeth a man's bone, then shall he set up a sign by it, till the buriers have buried it in the valley of Hamongog.

till the day <u>02\_EXO\_40\_37</u># But if the cloud were not taken up, then they journeyed not till the day that it was taken up.

till the day <u>24\_JER\_52\_11</u># Then he put out the eyes of Zedekiah; and the king of Babylon bound him in chains, and carried him to Babylon, and put him in prison till the day of his death.

till the day <u>42\_LUK\_01\_80</u># And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, and was in the deserts till the day of his showing unto Israel.

till the day <u>50\_PHP\_01\_10</u> # That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;

till the end <u>27\_DAN\_12\_13</u># But go thou thy way till the end [be]: for thou shalt rest, and stand in thy lot at the end of the days.

till the going <u>27\_DAN\_06\_14</u># Then the king, when he heard [these] words, was sore displeased with himself, and set [his] heart on Daniel to deliver him: and he laboured till the going down of the sun to deliver him.

till the ground <u>01\_GEN\_02\_05</u> # And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and [there was] not a man to till the ground.

till the ground <u>01\_GEN\_03\_23</u># Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken.

till the heavens <u>18\_JOB\_14\_12</u> # So man lieth down, and riseth not: till the heavens [be] no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep.

till the indignation <u>27\_DAN\_11\_36</u># And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

till the land <u>10\_2SA\_09\_10</u> # Thou therefore, and thy sons, and thy servants, shall till the land for him, and thou shalt bring in [the fruits], that thy master's son may have food to eat: but Mephibosheth thy master's son shall eat bread alway at my table. Now Ziba had fifteen sons and twenty servants.

till the morning <u>12\_2KI\_07\_09</u> # Then they said one to another, We do not well: this day [is] a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace: if we tarry till the morning light, some mischief will come upon us: now therefore come, that we may go and tell the king's household.

till the morning <u>02\_EXO\_16\_19</u># And Moses said, Let no man leave of it till the morning.

till the morning <u>02\_EXO\_16\_24</u> # And they laid it up till the morning, as Moses bade: and it did not stink, neither was there any worm therein.

till the morrow <u>36\_ZEP\_03\_03</u># Her princes within her [are] roaring lions; her judges [are] evening wolves; they gnaw not the bones till the morrow.

till the people <u>02\_EXO\_15\_16</u># Fear and dread shall fall upon them; by the greatness of thine arm they shall be [as] still as a stone; till thy people pass over, O LORD, till the people pass over, [which] thou hast purchased.

till the seed <u>48\_GAL\_03\_19</u> # Wherefore then [serveth] the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; [and it was] ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator.

till the seven <u>66\_REV\_15\_08</u># And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

till the Son <u>41\_MAR\_09\_09</u> # And as they came down from the mountain, he charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the Son of man were risen from the dead.

till the Son <u>40\_MAT\_10\_23</u># But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come.

till the stars <u>16\_NEH\_04\_21</u># So we laboured in the work: and half of them held the spears from the rising of the morning till the stars appeared.

till the sun <u>10\_2SA\_03\_35</u># And when all the people came to cause David to eat meat while it was yet day, David sware, saying, So do God to me, and more also, if I taste bread, or ought else, till the sun be down.

till the thousand <u>66\_REV\_20\_03</u># And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

till the thrones <u>27\_DAN\_07\_09</u> # I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment [was] white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne [was like] the fiery flame, [and] his wheels [as] burning fire.

till the time <u>27\_DAN\_02\_09</u> # But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, [there is but] one decree for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can show me the interpretation thereof.

till the wings <u>27\_DAN\_07\_04</u># The first [was] like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.

till the work <u>14\_2CH\_29\_34</u># But the priests were too few, so that they could not flay all the burnt offerings: wherefore their brethren the Levites did help them, till the work was ended, and until the [other] priests had sanctified themselves: for the Levites [were] more upright in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests.

till there be <u>23\_ISA\_05\_08</u> # Woe unto them that join house to house, [that] lay field to field, till [there be] no place, that they may be placed alone in the midst of the earth!

till there was <u>14\_2CH\_36\_16</u># But they mocked the messengers of God, and despised his words, and misused his prophets, until the wrath of the LORD arose against his people, till [there was] no remedy.

till they acknowledge <u>28\_HOS\_05\_15</u> # I will go [and] return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

till they be <u>24\_JER\_24\_10</u># And I will send the sword, the famine, and the pestilence, among them, till they be consumed from off the land that I gave unto them and to their fathers.

till they die <u>05\_DEU\_17\_05</u># Then shalt thou bring forth that man or that woman, which have committed that wicked thing, unto thy gates, [even] that man or that woman, and shalt stone them with stones, till they die.

till they had <u>44\_ACT\_23\_12</u> # And when it was day, certain of the Jews banded together, and bound themselves under a curse, saying that they would neither eat nor drink till they had killed Paul.

till they had <u>31\_OBA\_01\_05</u># If thieves came to thee, if robbers by night, [how art thou cut off!] would they not have stolen till they had enough? if the grapegatherers came to thee, would they not leave [some] grapes?

till they have <u>44\_ACT\_23\_21</u> # But do not thou yield unto them: for there lie in wait for him of them more than forty men, which have bound themselves with an oath, that they will neither eat nor drink till they have killed him: and now are they ready, looking for a promise from thee.

till they have <u>24\_JER\_49\_09</u> # If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave [some] gleaning grapes? if thieves by night, they will destroy till they have enough.

till they have <u>41\_MAR\_09\_01</u> # And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come with power.

till they roll <u>01\_GEN\_29\_08</u># And they said, We cannot, until all the flocks be gathered together, and [till] they roll the stone from the well's mouth; then we water the sheep.

till they were <u>19\_PSA\_18\_37</u># I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed.

till they were <u>08\_RUT\_01\_13</u> # Would ye tarry for them till they were grown? would ye stay for them from having husbands? nay, my daughters; for it grieveth me much for your sakes that the hand of the LORD is gone out against me.

till thou be <u>05\_DEU\_28\_45</u> # Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which he commanded thee:

till thou be <u>01\_GEN\_19\_22</u># Haste thee, escape thither; for I cannot do any thing till thou be come thither. Therefore the name of the city was called Zoar.

till thou come <u>07\_JUD\_06\_04</u> # And they encamped against them, and destroyed the increase of the earth, till thou come unto Gaza, and left no sustenance for Israel, neither sheep, nor ox, nor ass.

till thou come <u>07\_JUD\_11\_33</u># And he smote them from Aroer, even till thou come to Minnith, [even] twenty cities, and unto the plain of the vineyards, with a very great slaughter. Thus the children of Ammon were subdued before the children of Israel.

till thou find <u>19\_PSA\_10\_15</u># Break thou the arm of the wicked and the evil [man]: seek out his wickedness [till] thou find none.

till thou hadst <u>12\_2KI\_13\_19</u># And the man of God was wroth with him, and said, Thou shouldest have smitten five or six times; then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed [it]: whereas now thou shalt smite Syria [but] thrice.

till thou hadst <u>15\_EZR\_09\_14</u># Should we again break thy commandments, and join in affinity with the people of these abominations? wouldest not thou be angry with us till thou hadst consumed [us], so that [there should be] no remnant nor escaping?

till thou return <u>01\_GEN\_03\_19</u> # In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou [art], and unto dust shalt thou return.

till thou send <u>01\_GEN\_38\_17</u> # And he said, I will send [thee] a kid from the flock. And she said, Wilt thou give [me] a pledge, till thou send [it]?

till three whole <u>27\_DAN\_10\_03</u># I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

till thy people <u>02\_EXO\_15\_16</u># Fear and dread shall fall upon them; by the greatness of thine arm they shall be [as] still as a stone; till thy people pass over, O LORD, till the people pass over, [which] thou hast purchased.

Till we all <u>49\_EPH\_04\_13</u> # Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

till ye have <u>26\_EZE\_34\_21</u> # Because ye have thrust with side and with shoulder, and pushed all the diseased with your horns, till ye have scattered them abroad;

till ye shall <u>40\_MAT\_23\_39</u># For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed [is] he that cometh in the name of the Lord.

tillage of the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_26</u># And over them that did the work of the field for tillage of the ground [was] Ezri the son of Chelub:

tilled whereas it <u>26\_EZE\_36\_34</u> # And the desolate land shall be tilled, whereas it lay desolate in the sight of all that passed by.

tiller of the <u>01\_GEN\_04\_02</u># And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

tillest the ground <u>01\_GEN\_04\_12</u> # When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth.

tilleth his land <u>20\_PRO\_12\_11</u># He that tilleth his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that followeth vain [persons is] void of understanding.

tilleth his land <u>20\_PRO\_28\_19</u># He that tilleth his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that followeth after vain [persons] shall have poverty enough.
