attire upon their <u>26_EZE_23_15</u> # Girded with girdles upon their loins, exceeding in dyed attire upon their heads, all of them princes to look to, after the manner of the Babylonians of Chaldea, the land of their nativity:

attire yet my <u>24_JER_02_32</u># Can a maid forget her ornaments, [or] a bride her attire? yet my people have forgotten me days without number.

attired these are <u>03_LEV_16_04</u># He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches upon his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen mitre shall he be attired: these [are] holy garments; therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and [so] put them on.

entire wanting nothing <u>59_JAM_01_04</u># But let patience have [her] perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

retire stay not <u>24_JER_04_06</u># Set up the standard toward Zion: retire, stay not: for I will bring evil from the north, and a great destruction.

retire ye from <u>10_28A_11_15</u># And he wrote in the letter, saying, Set ye Uriah in the forefront of the hottest battle, and retire ye from him, that he may be smitten, and die.

tired her head <u>12_2KI_09_30</u># And when Jehu was come to Jezreel, Jezebel heard [of it]; and she painted her face, and tired her head, and looked out at a window.
