footstool for he 19_PSA_99_05 # Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; [for] he [is] holy.

footstool in the <u>25_LAM_02_01</u># How hath the Lord covered the daughter of Zion with a cloud in his anger, [and] cast down from heaven unto the earth the beauty of Israel, and remembered not his footstool in the day of his anger!

footstool neither by <u>40_MAT_05_35</u># Nor by the earth; for it is his footstool: neither by Jerusalem; for it is the city of the great King.

footstool of gold 14_2CH_09_18 # And [there were] six steps to the throne, with a footstool of gold, [which were] fastened to the throne, and stays on each side of the sitting place, and two lions standing by the stays:

footstool of our 13_1CH_28_02 # Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, my brethren, and my people: [As for me], I [had] in mine heart to build an house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made ready for the building:

footstool what house 44_ACT_07_49 # Heaven [is] my throne, and earth [is] my footstool: what house will ye build me? saith the Lord: or what [is] the place of my rest?

footstool where is <u>23_ISA_66_01</u> # Thus saith the LORD, The heaven [is] my throne, and the earth [is] my footstool: where [is] the house that ye build unto me? and where [is] the place of my rest?

footstool 44_ACT_02_35 # Until I make thy foes thy footstool.

footstool <u>58_HEB_01_13</u># But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool?

footstool 58_HEB_10_13 # From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.

footstool <u>59_JAM_02_03</u># And ye have respect to him that weareth the gay clothing, and say unto him, Sit thou here in a good place; and say to the poor, Stand thou there, or sit here under my footstool:

footstool 42_LUK_20_43 # Till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

footstool <u>41_MAR_12_36</u> # For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

footstool <u>40_MAT_22_44</u># The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool?

footstool 19_PSA_110_01 # A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

footstool 19_PSA_132_07 # We will go into his tabernacles: we will worship at his footstool.

overtook her between <u>25_LAM_01_03</u># Judah is gone into captivity because of affliction, and because of great servitude: she dwelleth among the heathen, she findeth no rest: all her persecutors overtook her

between the straits.

overtook him in 12_2KI_25_05# And the army of the Chaldees pursued after the king, and overtook him in the plains of Jericho: and all his army were scattered from him.

overtook him in <u>01_GEN_31_23</u># And he took his brethren with him, and pursued after him seven days' journey; and they overtook him in the mount Gilead.

overtook Jacob Now <u>01_GEN_31_25</u> # Then Laban overtook Jacob. Now Jacob had pitched his tent in the mount: and Laban with his brethren pitched in the mount of Gilead.

overtook the children <u>07_JUD_18_22</u> # [And] when they were a good way from the house of Micah, the men that [were] in the houses near to Micah's house were gathered together, and overtook the children of Dan.

overtook them and 01_GEN_44_06 # And he overtook them, and he spake unto them these same words.

overtook them and <u>07_JUD_20_42</u># Therefore they turned [their backs] before the men of Israel unto the way of the wilderness; but the battle overtook them; and them which [came] out of the cities they destroyed in the midst of them.

overtook them encamping <u>02_EXO_14_09</u># But the Egyptians pursued after them, all the horses [and] chariots of Pharaoh, and his horsemen, and his army, and overtook them encamping by the sea, beside Pihahiroth, before Baalzephon.

overtook Zedekiah in 24_JER_39_05# But the Chaldeans' army pursued after them, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho: and when they had taken him, they brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath, where he gave judgment upon him.

overtook Zedekiah in <u>24_JER_52_08</u># But the army of the Chaldeans pursued after the king, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho; and all his army was scattered from him.

stood a Lamb <u>66_REV_05_06</u># And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

stood a man <u>44_ACT_16_09</u># And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us.

stood a man <u>06_JOS_05_13</u># And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, [Art] thou for us, or for our adversaries?

stood a watchman <u>12_2KI_09_17</u># And there stood a watchman on the tower in Jezreel, and he spied the company of Jehu as he came, and said, I see a company. And Joram said, Take an horseman, and send to meet them, and let him say, [Is it] peace?

stood about him <u>09_1SA_22_07</u># Then Saul said unto his servants that stood about him, Hear now, ye Benjamites; will the son of Jesse give every one of you fields and vineyards, [and] make you all captains of thousands, and captains of hundreds;

stood about him <u>09_1SA_22_17</u># And the king said unto the footmen that stood about him, Turn, and slay the priests of the LORD; because their hand also [is] with David, and because they knew when he fled, and did not show it to me. But the servants of the king would not put forth their hand to fall upon the priests of the LORD.

stood above it <u>01 GEN 28_13</u> # And, behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I [am] the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;

stood above the <u>14_2CH_24_20</u> # And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you.

stood above the 19_PSA_104_06 # Thou coveredst it with the deep as [with] a garment: the waters stood above the mountains.

stood afar off 02_EXO_02_04 # And his sister stood afar off, to wit what would be done to him.

stood afar off <u>02_EXO_20_18</u># And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw [it], they removed, and stood afar off.

stood afar off <u>02_EXO_20_21</u># And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God [was].

stood afar off <u>42_LUK_17_12</u> # And as he entered into a certain village, there met him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off:

stood afar off <u>42_LUK_23_49</u> # And all his acquaintance, and the women that followed him from Galilee, stood afar off, beholding these things.

stood afar off <u>66_REV_18_17</u> # For in one hour so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,

stood against him <u>07_JUD_06_31</u># And Joash said unto all that stood against him, Will ye plead for Baal? will ye save him? he that will plead for him, let him be put to death whilst [it is yet] morning: if he [be] a god, let him plead for himself, because [one] hath cast down his altar.

stood among the <u>09_1SA_10_23</u> # And they ran and fetched him thence: and when he stood among the people, he was higher than any of the people from his shoulders and upward.

stood among the <u>38_ZEC_01_08</u># I saw by night, and behold a man riding upon a red horse, and he stood among the myrtle trees that [were] in the bottom; and behind him [were there] red horses, speckled, and white.

stood among the <u>38_ZEC_01_10</u># And the man that stood among the myrtle trees answered and said, These [are they] whom the LORD hath sent to walk to and fro through the earth.

stood among the <u>38_ZEC_01_11</u># And they answered the angel of the LORD that stood among the myrtle trees, and said, We have walked to and fro through the earth, and, behold, all the earth sitteth still, and is at rest.

stood and blessed <u>11_1KI_08_55</u># And he stood, and blessed all the congregation of Israel with a loud voice, saying,

stood and called <u>09_1SA_03_10</u># And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.

stood and commanded <u>42_LUK_18_40</u># And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto him: and when he was come near, he asked him,

stood and confessed <u>16_NEH_09_02</u> # And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

stood and cried <u>09_1SA_17_08</u># And he stood and cried unto the armies of Israel, and said unto them, Why are ye come out to set [your] battle in array? [am] not I a Philistine, and ye servants to Saul? choose you a man for you, and let him come down to me.

stood and cried 12_2KI_18_28 # Then Rabshakeh stood and cried with a loud voice in the Jews' language, and spake, saying, Hear the word of the great king, the king of Assyria:

stood and cried <u>23_ISA_36_13</u># Then Rabshakeh stood, and cried with a loud voice in the Jews' language, and said, Hear ye the words of the great king, the king of Assyria.

stood and cried <u>43_JOH_07_37</u> # In the last day, that great [day] of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

stood and had <u>26_EZE_01_25</u> # And there was a voice from the firmament that [was] over their heads, when they stood, [and] had let down their wings.

stood and kneeled 14_2CH_06_13# For Solomon had made a brazen scaffold, of five cubits long, and five cubits broad, and three cubits high, and had set it in the midst of the court: and upon it he stood, and kneeled down upon his knees before all the congregation of Israel, and spread forth his hands toward heaven,

stood and measured <u>35_HAB_03_06</u># He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove asunder the nations; and the everlasting mountains were scattered, the perpetual hills did bow: his ways [are] everlasting.

stood and on <u>07_JUD_16_29</u> # And Samson took hold of the two middle pillars upon which the house stood, and on which it was borne up, of the one with his right hand, and of the other with his left.

stood and prayed <u>42_LUK_18_11</u># The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men [are], extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

stood and rose <u>06_JOS_03_16</u># That the waters which came down from above stood [and] rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that [is] beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea, failed, [and] were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho.

stood and said 14_2CH_20_20 # And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.

stood and said <u>12_2KI_10_09</u> # And it came to pass in the morning, that he went out, and stood, and said to all the people, Ye [be] righteous: behold, I conspired against my master, and slew him: but who slew all these?

stood and said <u>44_ACT_11_13</u># And he showed us how he had seen an angel in his house, which stood and said unto him, Send men to Joppa, and call for Simon, whose surname is Peter;

stood and said <u>44_ACT_22_13</u># Came unto me, and stood, and said unto me, Brother Saul, receive thy sight. And the same hour I looked up upon him.

stood and said 42_LUK_19_08 # And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of

my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore [him] fourfold.

stood and they <u>06_JOS_04_09</u> # And Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests which bare the ark of the covenant stood: and they are there unto this day.

stood and two 43_JOH_01_35 # Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;

stood and vehemently <u>42_LUK_23_10</u># And the chief priests and scribes stood and vehemently accused him.

stood and walked <u>44_ACT_03_08</u># And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.

stood and warmed <u>43_JOH_18_25</u> # And Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also [one] of his disciples? He denied [it], and said, I am not.

stood and when <u>27_DAN_08_17</u> # So he came near where I stood: and when he came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face: but he said unto me, Understand, O son of man: for at the time of the end [shall be] the vision.

stood and when <u>26_EZE_01_21</u># When those went, [these] went; and when those stood, [these] stood; and when those were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the spirit of the living creature [was] in the wheels.

stood and when <u>26_EZE_10_17</u># When they stood, [these] stood; and when they were lifted up, [these] lifted up themselves [also]: for the spirit of the living creature [was] in them.

stood at his <u>14_2CH_23_13</u># And she looked, and, behold, the king stood at his pillar at the entering in, and the princes and the trumpets by the king: and all the people of the land rejoiced, and sounded with trumpets, also the singers with instruments of music, and such as taught to sing praise. Then Athaliah rent her clothes, and said, Treason, Treason.

stood at his <u>42_LUK_07_38</u># And stood at his feet behind [him] weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe [them] with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed [them] with the ointment.

stood at the 14_2CH_05_12 # Also the Levites [which were] the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, [being] arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:]

stood at the 12_2KI_05_09 # So Naaman came with his horses and with his chariot, and stood at the door of the house of Elisha.

stood at the <u>02_EXO_19_17</u># And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with God; and they stood at the nether part of the mount.

stood at the <u>02_EXO_33_09</u> # And it came to pass, as Moses entered into the tabernacle, the cloudy pillar descended, and stood [at] the door of the tabernacle, and [the LORD] talked with Moses.

stood at the <u>26_EZE_10_19</u># And the cherubims lifted up their wings, and mounted up from the earth in my sight: when they went out, the wheels also [were] beside them, and [every one] stood at the door of the east gate of the LORD'S house; and the glory of the God of Israel [was] over them above.

stood at the <u>26_EZE_21_21</u># For the king of Babylon stood at the parting of the way, at the head of the two ways, to use divination: he made [his] arrows bright, he consulted with images, he looked in the liver.

stood at the <u>43_JOH_18_16</u> # But Peter stood at the door without. Then went out that other disciple, which was known unto the high priest, and spake unto her that kept the door, and brought in Peter.

stood at the <u>66_REV_08_03</u># And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer [it] with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne.

stood before God <u>66_REV_08_02</u> # And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets.

stood before him <u>11_1KI_03_16</u># Then came there two women, [that were] harlots, unto the king, and stood before him.

stood before him 11_1KI_12_08 # But he forsook the counsel of the old men, which they had given him, and consulted with the young men that were grown up with him, [and] which stood before him:

stood before him <u>09_1SA_16_21</u># And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he loved him greatly; and he became his armourbearer.

stood before him 14_2CH_10_08 # But he forsook the counsel which the old men gave him, and took counsel with the young men that were brought up with him, that stood before him.

stood before him 12 2KI 04 12 # And he said to Gehazi his servant, Call this Shunammite. And when he had called her, she stood before him.

stood before him 12 2KI 05 15 # And he returned to the man of God, he and all his company, and came, and stood before him: and he said, Behold, now I know that [there is] no God in all the earth, but in Israel: now therefore, I pray thee, take a blessing of thy servant.

stood before him <u>12_2KI_08_09</u> # So Hazael went to meet him, and took a present with him, even of every good thing of Damascus, forty camels' burden, and came and stood before him, and said, Thy son Benhadad king of Syria hath sent me to thee, saying, Shall I recover of this disease?

stood before him <u>27_DAN_07_10</u> # A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.

stood before him 19_PSA_106_23 # Therefore he said that he would destroy them, had not Moses his chosen stood before him in the breach, to turn away his wrath, lest he should destroy [them].

stood before him <u>38_ZEC_03_04</u># And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.

stood before his 12_2KI_05_25 # But he went in, and stood before his master. And Elisha said unto him, Whence [comest thou], Gehazi? And he said, Thy servant went no whither.

stood before it <u>07_JUD_20_28</u> # And Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron, stood before it in those days,] saying, Shall I yet again go out to battle against the children of Benjamin my brother, or shall I cease? And the LORD said, Go up; for to morrow I will deliver them into thine hand.

stood before Joseph 01_GEN_43_15 # And the men took that present, and they took double money in their

hand, and Benjamin; and rose up, and went down to Egypt, and stood before Joseph.

stood before me <u>44_ACT_10_30</u># And Cornelius said, Four days ago I was fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I prayed in my house, and, behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing,

stood before me <u>27_DAN_08_15</u> # And it came to pass, when I, [even] I Daniel, had seen the vision, and sought for the meaning, then, behold, there stood before me as the appearance of a man.

stood before me <u>27 DAN 10 16 # And</u>, behold, [one] like the similitude of the sons of men touched my lips: then I opened my mouth, and spake, and said unto him that stood before me, O my lord, by the vision my sorrows are turned upon me, and I have retained no strength.

stood before me <u>24_JER_15_01</u> # Then said the LORD unto me, Though Moses and Samuel stood before me, [yet] my mind [could] not [be] toward this people: cast [them] out of my sight, and let them go forth.

stood before Moses <u>04_NUM_27_02</u> # And they stood before Moses, and before Eleazar the priest, and before the princes and all the congregation, [by] the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, saying,

stood before Pharaoh <u>02_EXO_09_10</u> # And they took ashes of the furnace, and stood before Pharaoh; and Moses sprinkled it up toward heaven; and it became a boil breaking forth [with] blains upon man, and upon beast.

stood before Pharaoh <u>01_GEN_41_46</u># And Joseph [was] thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh, and went throughout all the land of Egypt.

stood before Solomon 11_1KI_12_06# And king Rehoboam consulted with the old men, that stood before Solomon his father while he yet lived, and said, How do ye advise that I may answer this people?

stood before Solomon <u>14_2CH_10_06</u> # And king Rehoboam took counsel with the old men that had stood before Solomon his father while he yet lived, saying, What counsel give ye [me] to return answer to this people?

stood before the <u>11_1KI_01_28</u># Then king David answered and said, Call me Bathsheba. And she came into the king's presence, and stood before the king.

stood before the <u>11_1KI_03_15</u># And Solomon awoke; and, behold, [it was] a dream. And he came to Jerusalem, and stood before the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and offered up burnt offerings, and offered peace offerings, and made a feast to all his servants.

stood before the <u>11_1KI_08_22</u># And Solomon stood before the altar of the LORD in the presence of all the congregation of Israel, and spread forth his hands toward heaven:

stood before the <u>11_1KI_22_21</u># And there came forth a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will persuade him.

stood before the <u>14_2CH_06_12</u> # And he stood before the altar of the LORD in the presence of all the congregation of Israel, and spread forth his hands:

stood before the 14_2CH_18_20 # Then there came out a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will entice him. And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith?

stood before the <u>14_2CH_20_13</u> # And all Judah stood before the LORD, with their little ones, their wives, and their children.

stood before the <u>44_ACT_10_17</u> # Now while Peter doubted in himself what this vision which he had seen should mean, behold, the men which were sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate,

stood before the <u>44_ACT_12_14</u> # And when she knew Peter's voice, she opened not the gate for gladness, but ran in, and told how Peter stood before the gate.

stood before the <u>44_ACT_24_20</u> # Or else let these same [here] say, if they have found any evil doing in me, while I stood before the council,

stood before the <u>27_DAN_02_02</u># Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to show the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king.

stood before the <u>27_DAN_03_03</u># Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.

stood before the <u>27_DAN_08_03</u># Then I lifted up mine eyes, and saw, and, behold, there stood before the river a ram which had [two] horns: and the [two] horns [were] high; but one [was] higher than the other, and the higher came up last.

stood before the 17_EST_08_04 # Then the king held out the golden sceptre toward Esther. So Esther arose, and stood before the king,

stood before the <u>01_GEN_19_27</u> # And Abraham gat up early in the morning to the place where he stood before the LORD:

stood before the <u>06_JOS_20_09</u> # These were the cities appointed for all the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them, that whosoever killeth [any] person at unawares might flee thither, and not die by the hand of the avenger of blood, until he stood before the congregation.

stood before the <u>03_LEV_09_05</u># And they brought [that] which Moses commanded before the tabernacle of the congregation: and all the congregation drew near and stood before the LORD.

stood before the <u>40_MAT_27_11</u># And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jesus? And Jesus said unto him, Thou sayest.

stood before the <u>66_REV_07_09</u># After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

stood before the <u>66_REV_12_04</u># And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

stood before the <u>38_ZEC_03_03</u> # Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel.

stood before thee <u>27_DAN_02_31</u># Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness [was] excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof [was] terrible.

stood before thee <u>24_JER_18_20</u> # Shall evil be recompensed for good? for they have digged a pit for my soul. Remember that I stood before thee to speak good for them, [and] to turn away thy wrath from them.

stood before them <u>26_EZE_08_11</u># And there stood before them seventy men of the ancients of the house of Israel, and in the midst of them stood Jaazaniah the son of Shaphan, with every man his censer in his hand; and a thick cloud of incense went up.

stood behind them <u>02_EXO_14_19</u># And the angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them:

stood beholding And <u>42_LUK_23_35</u> # And the people stood beholding. And the rulers also with them derided [him], saying, He saved others; let him save himself, if he be Christ, the chosen of God.

stood beside the <u>11_1KI_10_19</u># The throne had six steps, and the top of the throne [was] round behind: and [there were] stays on either side on the place of the seat, and two lions stood beside the stays.

stood beside the <u>10_2SA_15_02</u># And Absalom rose up early, and stood beside the way of the gate: and it was [so], that when any man that had a controversy came to the king for judgment, then Absalom called unto him, and said, Of what city [art] thou? And he said, Thy servant [is] of one of the tribes of Israel.

stood beside the <u>26_EZE_09_02</u># And, behold, six men came from the way of the higher gate, which lieth toward the north, and every man a slaughter weapon in his hand; and one man among them [was] clothed with linen, with a writer's inkhorn by his side: and they went in, and stood beside the brazen altar.

stood beside the <u>26_EZE_10_06</u># And it came to pass, [that] when he had commanded the man clothed with linen, saying, Take fire from between the wheels, from between the cherubims; then he went in, and stood beside the wheels.

stood beside the 24 JER 36 21 # So the king sent Jehudi to fetch the roll: and he took it out of Elishama the scribe's chamber. And Jehudi read it in the ears of the king, and in the ears of all the princes which stood beside the king.

stood between the <u>05_DEU_05_05</u># [I stood between the LORD and you at that time, to show you the word of the LORD: for ye were afraid by reason of the fire, and went not up into the mount;] saying,

stood between the <u>04_NUM_16_48</u># And he stood between the dead and the living; and the plague was stayed.

stood by a 12_2KI_11_14# And when she looked, behold, the king stood by a pillar, as the manner [was], and the princes and the trumpeters by the king, and all the people of the land rejoiced, and blew with trumpets: and Athaliah rent her clothes, and cried, Treason, Treason.

stood by a 12_2KI_23_03# And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all [their] heart and all [their] soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant.

stood by Jordan 12_2KI_02_07 # And fifty men of the sons of the prophets went, and stood to view afar off: and they two stood by Jordan.

stood by me <u>44_ACT_27_23</u> # For there stood by me this night the angel of God, whose I am, and whom I serve,

stood by me 26_EZE_43_06 # And I heard [him] speaking unto me out of the house; and the man stood by

me.

stood by Moses <u>02_EXO_18_13</u># And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses sat to judge the people: and the people stood by Moses from the morning unto the evening.

stood by Moses <u>02_EXO_18_13</u># And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses sat to judge the people: and the people stood by Moses from the morning unto the evening.

stood by said 44_ACT_23_04 # And they that stood by said, Revilest thou God's high priest?

stood by said 41_MAR_14_70 # And he denied it again. And a little after, they that stood by said again to Peter, Surely thou art [one] of them: for thou art a Galilaean, and thy speech agreeth [thereto].

stood by struck <u>43_JOH_18_22</u> # And when he had thus spoken, one of the officers which stood by struck Jesus with the palm of his hand, saying, Answerest thou the high priest so?

stood by Take 42_LUK_19_24 # And he said unto them that stood by, Take from him the pound, and give [it] to him that hath ten pounds.

stood by Take 42 LUK 19 24 # And he said unto them that stood by, Take from him the pound, and give [it] to him that hath ten pounds.

stood by the <u>13_1CH_21_15</u># And God sent an angel unto Jerusalem to destroy it: and as he was destroying, the LORD beheld, and he repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed, It is enough, stay now thine hand. stood by the 12_2KI_18_17# And the king of Assyria sent Tartan and Rabsaris and Rabshakeh from Lachish to king Hezekiah with a great host against Jerusalem. And they went up and came to Jerusalem. And when they were come up, they came and stood by the conduit of the upper pool, which [is] in the highway of the fuller's field.

stood by the <u>10_2SA_18_04</u># And the king said unto them, What seemeth you best I will do. And the king stood by the gate side, and all the people came out by hundreds and by thousands.

you, and leave them in the lodging place, where ye shall lodge this night.

stood for their <u>17_EST_09_16</u> # But the other Jews that [were] in the king's provinces gathered themselves together, and stood for their lives, and had rest from their enemies, and slew of their foes seventy and five thousand, but they laid not their hands on the prey,

stood in a <u>04_NUM_22_24</u># But the angel of the LORD stood in a path of the vineyards, a wall [being] on this side, and a wall on that side.

stood in a <u>04_NUM_22_26</u># And the angel of the LORD went further, and stood in a narrow place, where [was] no way to turn either to the right hand or to the left.

stood in his <u>14_2CH_34_31</u># And the king stood in his place, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments, and his testimonies, and his statutes, with all his heart, and with all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant which are written in this book.

stood in the <u>10_2SA_20_15</u># And they came and besieged him in Abel of Bethmaachah, and they cast up a bank against the city, and it stood in the trench: and all the people that [were] with Joab battered the wall, to throw it down.

stood in the <u>10_2SA_23_12</u> # But he stood in the midst of the ground, and defended it, and slew the Philistines: and the LORD wrought a great victory.

stood in the <u>44_ACT_17_22</u> # Then Paul stood in the midst of Mars' hill, and said, [Ye] men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too superstitious.

stood in the <u>17_EST_05_01</u># Now it came to pass on the third day, that Esther put on [her] royal [apparel], and stood in the inner court of the king's house, over against the king's house: and the king sat upon his royal throne in the royal house, over against the gate of the house.

stood in the <u>02_EXO_05_20</u># And they met Moses and Aaron, who stood in the way, as they came forth from Pharaoh:

stood in the <u>02_EXO_32_26</u> # Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who [is] on the LORD'S side? [let him come] unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.

stood in the <u>26_EZE_40_03</u># And he brought me thither, and, behold, [there was] a man, whose appearance [was] like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and a measuring reed; and he stood in the gate.

stood in the <u>24_JER_19_14</u> # Then came Jeremiah from Tophet, whither the LORD had sent him to prophesy; and he stood in the court of the LORD'S house; and said to all the people,

stood in the 24_JER_23_18 # For who hath stood in the counsel of the LORD, and hath perceived and heard his word? who hath marked his word, and heard [it]?

stood in the <u>24_JER_28_05</u> # Then the prophet Jeremiah said unto the prophet Hananiah in the presence of the priests, and in the presence of all the people that stood in the house of the LORD,

stood in the <u>43_JOH_11_56</u># Then sought they for Jesus, and spake among themselves, as they stood in the temple, What think ye, that he will not come to the feast?

stood in the <u>43_JOH_20_19</u># Then the same day at evening, being the first [day] of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace [be] unto you.

stood in the <u>43_JOH_20_26</u> # And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: [then] came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace [be] unto you.

stood in the <u>06_JOS_04_10</u># For the priests which bare the ark stood in the midst of Jordan, until every thing was finished that the LORD commanded Joshua to speak unto the people, according to all that Moses commanded Joshua: and the people hasted and passed over.

stood in the <u>42_LUK_24_36</u> # And as they thus spake, Jesus himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, Peace [be] unto you.

stood in the <u>04_NUM_12_05</u> # And the LORD came down in the pillar of the cloud, and stood [in] the door of the tabernacle, and called Aaron and Miriam: and they both came forth.

stood Mattithiah and <u>16_NEH_08_04</u> # And Ezra the scribe stood upon a pulpit of wood, which they had made for the purpose; and beside him stood Mattithiah, and Shema, and Anaiah, and Urijah, and Hilkiah, and Maseiah, on his right hand; and on his left hand, Pedaiah, and Mishael, and Malchiah, and Hashum, and Hashbadana, Zechariah, [and] Meshullam.

stood no man <u>01_GEN_45_01</u># Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him; and he cried, Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren.

stood not a <u>06_JOS_21_44</u># And the LORD gave them rest round about, according to all that he sware unto their fathers: and there stood not a man of all their enemies before them; the LORD delivered all their enemies into their hand.

stood not because 24_JER_46_15 # Why are thy valiant [men] swept away? they stood not, because the LORD did drive them.

stood not before 12_2KI_10_04 # But they were exceedingly afraid, and said, Behold, two kings stood not before him: how then shall we stand?

stood not up <u>17_EST_05_09</u> # Then went Haman forth that day joyful and with a glad heart: but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, that he stood not up, nor moved for him, he was full of indignation against Mordecai.

stood on a <u>09_1SA_17_03</u># And the Philistines stood on a mountain on the one side, and Israel stood on a mountain on the other side: and [there was] a valley between them.

stood on a <u>09_1SA_17_03</u># And the Philistines stood on a mountain on the one side, and Israel stood on a mountain on the other side: and [there was] a valley between them.

stood on his <u>13_1CH_06_39</u> # And his brother Asaph, who stood on his right hand, [even] Asaph the son of Berachiah, the son of Shimea,

stood on the <u>13_1CH_06_44</u> # And their brethren the sons of Merari [stood] on the left hand: Ethan the son of Kishi, the son of Abdi, the son of Malluch,

stood on the <u>09_1SA_26_13</u> # Then David went over to the other side, and stood on the top of an hill afar off; a great space [being] between them:

stood on the <u>10_2SA_02_25</u># And the children of Benjamin gathered themselves together after Abner, and became one troop, and stood on the top of an hill.

stood on the <u>44_ACT_21_40</u># And when he had given him licence, Paul stood on the stairs, and beckoned with the hand unto the people. And when there was made a great silence, he spake unto [them] in the Hebrew tongue, saying,

stood on the <u>26_EZE_10_03</u># Now the cherubims stood on the right side of the house, when the man went in; and the cloud filled the inner court.

stood on the <u>43_JOH_06_22</u> # The day following, when the people which stood on the other side of the sea saw that there was none other boat there, save that one whereinto his disciples were entered, and that Jesus went not with his disciples into the boat, but [that] his disciples were gone away alone;

stood on the <u>43_JOH_21_04</u># But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus.

stood on this <u>06_JOS_08_33</u> # And all Israel, and their elders, and officers, and their judges, stood on this side the ark and on that side before the priests the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, as well the stranger, as he that was born among them; half of them over against mount Gerizim, and half of them over against mount Ebal; as Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded before, that they should bless the people of Israel.

stood other two <u>27_DAN_12_05</u># Then I Daniel looked, and, behold, there stood other two, the one on this side of the bank of the river, and the other on that side of the bank of the river.

stood over against <u>41_MAR_15_39</u> # And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.

stood over her <u>42_LUK_04_39</u># And he stood over her, and rebuked the fever; and it left her: and immediately she arose and ministered unto them.

stood over the <u>05_DEU_31_15</u># And the LORD appeared in the tabernacle in a pillar of a cloud: and the pillar of the cloud stood over the door of the tabernacle.

stood over the <u>26_EZE_10_04</u># Then the glory of the LORD went up from the cherub, [and stood] over the threshold of the house; and the house was filled with the cloud, and the court was full of the brightness of the LORD'S glory.

stood round about <u>66_REV_07_11</u># And all the angels stood round about the throne, and [about] the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God,

stood saying Rise <u>66_REV_11_01</u># And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.

stood speechless hearing <u>44_ACT_09_07</u> # And the men which journeyed with him stood speechless, hearing a voice, but seeing no man.

stood still and <u>10_2SA_02_28</u># So Joab blew a trumpet, and all the people stood still, and pursued after Israel no more, neither fought they any more.

stood there where <u>09_1SA_06_14</u># And the cart came into the field of Joshua, a Bethshemite, and stood there, where [there was] a great stone: and they clave the wood of the cart, and offered the kine a burnt offering unto the LORD.

stood there who <u>43_JOH_18_18</u> # And the servants and officers stood there, who had made a fire of coals; for it was cold: and they warmed themselves: and Peter stood with them, and warmed himself.

stood these stood <u>26_EZE_01_21</u># When those went, [these] went; and when those stood, [these] stood; and when those were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the spirit of the living creature [was] in the wheels.

stood up and <u>44_ACT_04_26</u># The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ.

stood up and <u>44_ACT_13_16</u># Then Paul stood up, and beckoning with [his] hand said, Men of Israel, and ye that fear God, give audience.

stood up and <u>02_EXO_02_17</u> # And the shepherds came and drove them away: but Moses stood up and helped them, and watered their flock.

too heavy for 19_PSA_38_04 # For mine iniquities are gone over mine head: as an heavy burden they are too heavy for me.

too high for 20_PRO_24_07 # Wisdom [is] too high for a fool: he openeth not his mouth in the gate.

too high for 19_PSA_131_01 # A Song of degrees of David. LORD, my heart is not haughty, nor mine eyes lofty: neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me.

too little for <u>02_EXO_12_04</u># And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take [it] according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.

too little for <u>06_JOS_19_47</u># And the coast of the children of Dan went out [too little] for them: therefore the children of Dan went up to fight against Leshem, and took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and possessed it, and dwelt therein, and called Leshem, Dan, after the name of Dan their father.

took away my <u>01_GEN_27_36</u># And he said, Is not he rightly named Jacob? for he hath supplanted me these two times: he took away my birthright; and, behold, now he hath taken away my blessing. And he said, Hast thou not reserved a blessing for me?

took away my <u>07_JUD_11_13</u># And the king of the children of Ammon answered unto the messengers of Jephthah, Because Israel took away my land, when they came up out of Egypt, from Arnon even unto Jabbok, and unto Jordan: now therefore restore those [lands] again peaceably.

took away my <u>22_SON_05_07</u> # The watchmen that went about the city found me, they smote me, they wounded me; the keepers of the walls took away my veil from me.

took away out 14_2CH_14_05# Also he took away out of all the cities of Judah the high places and the images: and the kingdom was quiet before him.

took away the <u>13_1CH_10_12</u># They arose, all the valiant men, and took away the body of Saul, and the bodies of his sons, and brought them to Jabesh, and buried their bones under the oak in Jabesh, and fasted seven days.

took away the <u>11_1KI_14_26</u># And he took away the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house; he even took away all: and he took away all the shields of gold which Solomon had made.

took away the <u>11_1KI_15_12</u># And he took away the sodomites out of the land, and removed all the idols that his fathers had made.

took away the <u>11_1KI_15_22</u># Then king Asa made a proclamation throughout all Judah; none [was] exempted: and they took away the stones of Ramah, and the timber thereof, wherewith Baasha had builded; and king Asa built with them Geba of Benjamin, and Mizpah.

took away the <u>09_1SA_27_09</u># And David smote the land, and left neither man nor woman alive, and took away the sheep, and the oxen, and the asses, and the camels, and the apparel, and returned, and came to Achish.

took away the <u>14_2CH_12_09</u># So Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem, and took away the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house; he took all: he carried away also the shields of gold which Solomon had made.

took away the <u>14_2CH_14_03</u># For he took away the altars of the strange [gods], and the high places, and brake down the images, and cut down the groves:

took away the 14_2CH_17_06# And his heart was lifted up in the ways of the LORD: moreover he took away the high places and groves out of Judah.

took away the 14_2CH_30_14 # And they arose and took away the altars that [were] in Jerusalem, and all the altars for incense took they away, and cast [them] into the brook Kidron.

took away the 14 2CH 33 15 # And he took away the strange gods, and the idol out of the house of the LORD, and all the altars that he had built in the mount of the house of the LORD, and in Jerusalem, and cast [them] out of the city.

took away the 12 2KI 23 11 # And he took away the horses that the kings of Judah had given to the sun, at the entering in of the house of the LORD, by the chamber of Nathanmelech the chamberlain, which [was] in the suburbs, and burned the chariots of the sun with fire.

took away the <u>27_DAN_01_16</u># Thus Melzar took away the portion of their meat, and the wine that they should drink; and gave them pulse.

took away the <u>02_EXO_10_19</u> # And the LORD turned a mighty strong west wind, which took away the locusts, and cast them into the Red sea; there remained not one locust in all the coasts of Egypt.

took away the <u>43_JOH_11_41</u># Then they took away the stone [from the place] where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up [his] eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.

took away the <u>07_JUD_08_21</u># Then Zebah and Zalmunna said, Rise thou, and fall upon us: for as the man [is, so is] his strength. And Gideon arose, and slew Zebah and Zalmunna, and took away the ornaments that [were] on their camels' necks.

took away their <u>13_1CH_05_21</u># And they took away their cattle; of their camels fifty thousand, and of sheep two hundred and fifty thousand, and of asses two thousand, and of men an hundred thousand.

took away 12_2KI_25_15 # And the firepans, and the bowls, [and] such things as [were] of gold, [in] gold, and of silver, [in] silver, the captain of the guard took away.

took Azariah which 12_2KI_14_21 # And all the people of Judah took Azariah, which [was] sixteen years old, and made him king instead of his father Amaziah.

took Balaam and <u>04_NUM_22_41</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, that Balak took Balaam, and brought him up into the high places of Baal, that thence he might see the utmost [part] of the people.

took Basmath the <u>11_1KI_04_15</u># Ahimaaz [was] in Naphtali; he also took Basmath the daughter of Solomon to wife:

took both one 26 EZE 23 13 # Then I saw that she was defiled, [that] they [took] both one way,

Took branches of 43_JOH_12_13 # Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed [is] the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.

took bread and <u>44_ACT_27_35</u># And when he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken [it], he began to eat.

took bread and <u>01_GEN_21_14</u># And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave [it] unto Hagar, putting [it] on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she

departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

took bread and <u>42_LUK_22_19</u># And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake [it], and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

took bread and <u>42_LUK_24_30</u># And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and blessed [it], and brake, and gave to them.

took bread and 41_MAR_14_22 # And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake [it], and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body.

took bread and 40 MAT 26 26 # And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed [it], and brake [it], and gave [it] to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

took bread 46_1CO_11_23 # For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the [same] night in which he was betrayed took bread:

took bribes and <u>09_1SA_08_03</u> # And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment.

took butter and <u>01_GEN_18_08</u> # And he took butter, and milk, and the calf which he had dressed, and set [it] before them; and he stood by them under the tree, and they did eat.

took care of <u>42_LUK_10_34</u> # And went to [him], and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

took cities from 14_2CH_13_19 # And Abijah pursued after Jeroboam, and took cities from him, Bethel with the towns thereof, and Jeshanah with the towns thereof, and Ephrain with the towns thereof.

took counsel against <u>40_MAT_27_01</u># When the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death:

took counsel and 11 1KI 12 28 # Whereupon the king took counsel, and made two calves [of] gold, and said unto them, It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem: behold thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

took counsel and <u>40_MAT_27_07</u># And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

took counsel how 40_MAT_22_15# Then went the Pharisees, and took counsel how they might entangle him in [his] talk.

took counsel to 14_2CH_30_23 # And the whole assembly took counsel to keep other seven days: and they kept [other] seven days with gladness.

took counsel to <u>44_ACT_05_33</u># When they heard [that], they were cut [to the heart], and took counsel to slay them.

took counsel to 44_ACT_09_23 # And after that many days were fulfilled, the Jews took counsel to kill him:

took counsel together $43_JOH_11_53$ # Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put him to death.

took counsel together 19_PSA_31_13 # For I have heard the slander of many: fear [was] on every side: while they took counsel together against me, they devised to take away my life.

took counsel with <u>14_2CH_10_06</u># And king Rehoboam took counsel with the old men that had stood before Solomon his father while he yet lived, saying, What counsel give ye [me] to return answer to this people?

took counsel with <u>14_2CH_10_08</u># But he forsook the counsel which the old men gave him, and took counsel with the young men that were brought up with him, that stood before him.

took counsel with 14_2CH_32_03 # He took counsel with his princes and his mighty men to stop the waters of the fountains which [were] without the city: and they did help him.

took counsel with 12_2KI_06_08 # Then the king of Syria warred against Israel, and took counsel with his servants, saying, In such and such a place [shall be] my camp.

took counsel with <u>41_MAR_03_06</u># And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.

took courage and 14_2CH_15_08 # And when Asa heard these words, and the prophecy of Oded the prophet, he took courage, and put away the abominable idols out of all the land of Judah and Benjamin, and out of the cities which he had taken from mount Ephraim, and renewed the altar of the LORD, that [was] before the porch of the LORD.

took courage <u>44_ACT_28_15</u> # And from thence, when the brethren heard of us, they came to meet us as far as Appii forum, and The three taverns: whom when Paul saw, he thanked God, and took courage.

took Dagon and <u>09_1SA_05_03</u># And when they of Ashdod arose early on the morrow, behold, Dagon [was] fallen upon his face to the earth before the ark of the LORD. And they took Dagon, and set him in his place again.

took David's servants <u>13_1CH_19_04</u># Wherefore Hanun took David's servants, and shaved them, and cut off their garments in the midst hard by their buttocks, and sent them away.

took David's servants <u>10_2SA_10_04</u># Wherefore Hanun took David's servants, and shaved off the one half of their beards, and cut off their garments in the middle, [even] to their buttocks, and sent them away.

took Dinah out <u>01_GEN_34_26</u># And they slew Hamor and Shechem his son with the edge of the sword, and took Dinah out of Shechem's house, and went out.

took double money <u>01_GEN_43_15</u># And the men took that present, and they took double money in their hand, and Benjamin; and rose up, and went down to Egypt, and stood before Joseph.

took down every <u>01_GEN_44_11</u># Then they speedily took down every man his sack to the ground, and opened every man his sack.

took down the <u>09_1SA_06_15</u># And the Levites took down the ark of the LORD, and the coffer that [was] with it, wherein the jewels of gold [were], and put [them] on the great stone: and the men of Bethshemesh offered burnt offerings and sacrificed sacrifices the same day unto the LORD.

took down the <u>12_2KI_16_17</u># And king Ahaz cut off the borders of the bases, and removed the laver from off them; and took down the sea from off the brazen oxen that [were] under it, and put it upon a pavement of stones.

took each man <u>01_GEN_34_25</u># And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

took eighteen wives <u>14_2CH_11_21</u># And Rehoboam loved Maachah the daughter of Absalom above all his wives and his concubines: [for he took eighteen wives, and threescore concubines; and begat twenty and eight sons, and threescore daughters.]

took either of <u>03_LEV_10_01</u># And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not.

took every man <u>14_2CH_23_08</u># So the Levites and all Judah did according to all things that Jehoiada the priest had commanded, and took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, with them that were to go [out] on the sabbath: for Jehoiada the priest dismissed not the courses.

took every man 12_2KI_09_13 # Then they hasted, and took every man his garment, and put [it] under him on the top of the stairs, and blew with trumpets, saying, Jehu is king.

took every man 12_2KI_11_09 # And the captains over the hundreds did according to all [things] that Jehoiada the priest commanded: and they took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, with them that should go out on the sabbath, and came to Jehoiada the priest.

took every man <u>04_NUM_16_18</u># And they took every man his censer, and put fire in them, and laid incense thereon, and stood in the door of the tabernacle of the congregation with Moses and Aaron.

took every man <u>04_NUM_17_09</u> # And Moses brought out all the rods from before the LORD unto all the children of Israel: and they looked, and took every man his rod.

took exceeding much <u>10_2SA_08_08</u># And from Betah, and from Berothai, cities of Hadadezer, king David took exceeding much brass.

took firebrands and <u>07_JUD_15_04</u># And Samson went and caught three hundred foxes, and took firebrands, and turned tail to tail, and put a firebrand in the midst between two tails.

took flour and <u>09_1SA_28_24</u># And the woman had a fat calf in the house; and she hasted, and killed it, and took flour, and kneaded [it], and did bake unleavened bread thereof:

took flour and <u>10_2SA_13_08</u> # So Tamar went to her brother Amnon's house; and he was laid down. And she took flour, and kneaded [it], and made cakes in his sight, and did bake the cakes.

took for a <u>05_DEU_02_35</u># Only the cattle we took for a prey unto ourselves, and the spoil of the cities which we took.

took for a 05_DEU_03_07 # But all the cattle, and the spoil of the cities, we took for a prey to ourselves.

took for a <u>06_JOS_08_27</u> # Only the cattle and the spoil of that city Israel took for a prey unto themselves, according unto the word of the LORD which he commanded Joshua.

took for a <u>06_JOS_11_14</u># And all the spoil of these cities, and the cattle, the children of Israel took for a prey unto themselves; but every man they smote with the edge of the sword, until they had destroyed them, neither left they any to breathe.

took for him 14_2CH_24_03 # And Jehoiada took for him two wives; and he begat sons and daughters.

took for him <u>02_EXO_02_03</u># And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid [it] in the flags by the river's brink.

took for himself <u>09 1SA 02 14 #</u> And he struck [it] into the pan, or kettle, or caldron, or pot; all that the fleshhook brought up the priest took for himself. So they did in Shiloh, unto all the Israelites that came thither.

took for his <u>17_EST_02_07</u># And he brought up Hadassah, that [is], Esther, his uncle's daughter: for she had neither father nor mother, and the maid [was] fair and beautiful; whom Mordecai, when her father and mother were dead, took for his own daughter.

took forth out 15 EZR 06 05 # And also let the golden and silver vessels of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took forth out of the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, and brought unto Babylon, be restored, and brought again unto the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, [every one] to his place, and place [them] in the house of God.

took from him <u>13_1CH_18_04</u># And David took from him a thousand chariots, and seven thousand horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: David also hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them an hundred chariots.

took from him <u>10_2SA_08_04</u> # And David took from him a thousand [chariots], and seven hundred horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: and David hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them [for] an hundred chariots.

took from them <u>01_GEN_42_24</u># And he turned himself about from them, and wept; and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them Simeon, and bound him before their eyes.

took from thy 11_1KI_20_34 # And [Benhadad] said unto him, The cities, which my father took from thy father, I will restore; and thou shalt make streets for thee in Damascus, as my father made in Samaria. Then [said Ahab], I will send thee away with this covenant. So he made a covenant with him, and sent him away.

took Gath and <u>13_1CH_18_01</u> # Now after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them, and took Gath and her towns out of the hand of the Philistines.

took Gaza with <u>07_JUD_01_18</u> # Also Judah took Gaza with the coast thereof, and Askelon with the coast thereof, and Ekron with the coast thereof.

took Geshur and 13 1CH 02 23 # And he took Geshur, and Aram, with the towns of Jair, from them, with Kenath, and the towns thereof, [even] threescore cities. All these [belonged to] the sons of Machir, the father of Gilead.

took Gomer the <u>28_HOS_01_03</u># So he went and took Gomer the daughter of Diblaim; which conceived, and bare him a son.

took goodly raiment $01_GEN_27_15$ # And Rebekah took goodly raiment of her eldest son Esau, which [were] with her in the house, and put them upon Jacob her younger son:

took great indignation <u>16_NEH_04_01</u> # But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

took Hagar her <u>01_GEN_16_03</u># And Sarai Abram's wife took Hagar her maid the Egyptian, after Abram had dwelt ten years in the land of Canaan, and gave her to her husband Abram to be his wife.

took half of <u>02_EXO_24_06</u># And Moses took half of the blood, and put [it] in basins; and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar.

took Haman the <u>17_EST_06_11</u># Then took Haman the apparel and the horse, and arrayed Mordecai, and brought him on horseback through the street of the city, and proclaimed before him, Thus shall it be done unto the man whom the king delighteth to honour.

took Hazor and <u>06_JOS_11_10</u># And Joshua at that time turned back, and took Hazor, and smote the king thereof with the sword: for Hazor beforetime was the head of all those kingdoms.

took he counsel <u>23_ISA_40_14</u> # With whom took he counsel, and [who] instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and showed to him the way of understanding?

took he him 42_LUK_02_28 # Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said,

took he the <u>04_NUM_03_50</u> # Of the firstborn of the children of Israel took he the money; a thousand three hundred and threescore and five [shekels], after the shekel of the sanctuary:

took her and 10_2SA_11_04# And David sent messengers, and took her; and she came in unto him, and he lay with her; for she was purified from her uncleanness: and she returned unto her house.

took her and <u>01_GEN_08_09</u># But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters [were] on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

took her and <u>01_GEN_34_02</u># And when Shechem the son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the country, saw her, he took her, and lay with her, and defiled her.

took her and <u>01_GEN_38_02</u># And Judah saw there a daughter of a certain Canaanite, whose name [was] Shuah; and he took her, and went in unto her.

took her and <u>42_LUK_20_31</u># And the third took her; and in like manner the seven also: and they left no children, and died.

took her and <u>41_MAR_12_21</u># And the second took her, and died, neither left he any seed: and the third likewise.

took her by <u>42_LUK_08_54</u> # And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.

took her by <u>41_MAR_01_31</u># And he came and took her by the hand, and lifted her up; and immediately the fever left her, and she ministered unto them.

took her by 40_MAT_09_25# But when the people were put forth, he went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose.

took her from 10_2SA_03_15 # And Ishbosheth sent, and took her from [her] husband, [even] from Phaltiel the son of Laish.

took her sons <u>26_EZE_23_10</u> # These discovered her nakedness: they took her sons and her daughters, and slew her with the sword: and she became famous among women; for they had executed judgment upon her.

took her to <u>05_DEU_24_03</u># And [if] the latter husband hate her, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth [it] in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her [to be] his wife;

took her to 42_LUK_20_30 # And the second took her to wife, and he died childless.

took her unto <u>43_JOH_19_27</u> # Then saith he to the disciple, Behold thy mother! And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own [home].

took her up <u>07_JUD_19_28</u># And he said unto her, Up, and let us be going. But none answered. Then the man took her [up] upon an ass, and the man rose up, and gat him unto his place.

took him a <u>01_GEN_21_21</u># And he dwelt in the wilderness of Paran: and his mother took him a wife out of the land of Egypt.

took him a <u>18_JOB_02_08</u># And he took him a potsherd to scrape himself withal; and he sat down among the ashes.

took him and <u>09_1SA_17_57</u> # And as David returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, Abner took him, and brought him before Saul with the head of the Philistine in his hand.

took him and 10_2SA_15_05 # And it was [so], that when any man came night [to him] to do him obeisance, he put forth his hand, and took him, and kissed him.

took him and <u>44_ACT_09_27</u># But Barnabas took him, and brought [him] to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.

took him and 44_ACT_17_19 # And they took him, and brought him unto Areopagus, saying, May we know what this new doctrine, whereof thou speakest, [is]?

took him and 44_ACT_21_33 # Then the chief captain came near, and took him, and commanded [him] to be bound with two chains; and demanded who he was, and what he had done.

took him and <u>44_ACT_23_18</u># So he took him, and brought [him] to the chief captain, and said, Paul the prisoner called me unto [him], and prayed me to bring this young man unto thee, who hath something to say unto thee.

took him and <u>01_GEN_37_24</u> # And they took him, and cast him into a pit: and the pit [was] empty, [there was] no water in it.

took him and <u>01_GEN_39_20</u> # And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners [were] bound: and he was there in the prison.

took him and <u>07_JUD_12_06</u> # Then said they unto him, Say now Shibboleth: and he said Sibboleth: for he could not frame to pronounce [it] right. Then they took him, and slew him at the passages of Jordan: and there fell at that time of the Ephraimites forty and two thousand.

took him and <u>07_JUD_16_21</u> # But the Philistines took him, and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza, and bound him with fetters of brass; and he did grind in the prison house.

took him and <u>07_JUD_16_31</u># Then his brethren and all the house of his father came down, and took him, and brought [him] up, and buried him between Zorah and Eshtaol in the buryingplace of Manoah his father. And he judged Israel twenty years.

took him and <u>42_LUK_14_04</u># And they held their peace. And he took [him], and healed him, and let him go;

took him and <u>41_MAR_08_32</u># And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke him.

took him and 41_MAR_12_08 # And they took him, and killed [him], and cast [him] out of the vineyard.

took him and <u>40_MAT_16_22</u># Then Peter took him, and began to rebuke him, saying, Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee.

took him aside <u>10_2SA_03_27</u> # And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth [rib], that he died, for the blood of Asahel his brother.

took him aside 41_MAR_07_33 # And he took him aside from the multitude, and put his fingers into his ears, and he spit, and touched his tongue;

took him away 44_ACT_24_07 # But the chief captain Lysias came [upon us], and with great violence took [him] away out of our hands,

took him away 28_HOS_13_11 # I gave thee a king in mine anger, and took [him] away in my wrath.

took him by <u>44_ACT_03_07</u> # And he took him by the right hand, and lifted [him] up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

took him by 44_ACT_09_25_# Then the disciples took him by night, and let [him] down by the wall in a basket.

took him by 44_ACT_23_19 # Then the chief captain took him by the hand, and went [with him] aside privately, and asked [him], What is that thou hast to tell me?

took him by 41_MAR_09_27 # But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose.

took him by <u>40_MAT_18_28</u># But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellowservants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took [him] by the throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest.

took him down 44_ACT_13_29 # And when they had fulfilled all that was written of him, they took [him] down from the tree, and laid [him] in a sepulchre.

took him down <u>41_MAR_15_46</u># And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre.

took him Elisheba <u>02_EXO_06_23</u> # And Aaron took him Elisheba, daughter of Amminadab, sister of Naashon, to wife; and she bare him Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.

took him even <u>41_MAR_04_36</u> # And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships.

took him for <u>40_MAT_21_46</u># But when they sought to lay hands on him, they feared the multitude, because they took him for a prophet.

took him from 19 PSA 78 70 # He chose David also his servant, and took him from the sheepfolds:

took him in 12_2KI_24_12 # And Jehoiachin the king of Judah went out to the king of Babylon, he, and his mother, and his servants, and his princes, and his officers: and the king of Babylon took him in the eighth year of his reign.

took him in 44_ACT_20_14 # And when he met with us at Assos, we took him in, and came to Mitylene.

took him in 19 PSA 56 01 # To the chief Musician upon Jonathelemrechokim, Michtam of David, when the Philistines took him in Gath. Be merciful unto me, O God: for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily oppresseth me.

took him Jochebed <u>02_EXO_06_20</u># And Amram took him Jochebed his father's sister to wife; and she bare him Aaron and Moses: and the years of the life of Amram [were] an hundred and thirty and seven years.

took him Mahalath 14_2CH_11_18# And Rehoboam took him Mahalath the daughter of Jerimoth the son of David to wife, [and] Abihail the daughter of Eliab the son of Jesse;

took him more 10_2SA_05_13 # And David took [him] more concubines and wives out of Jerusalem, after he was come from Hebron: and there were yet sons and daughters born to David.

took him one <u>02_EXO_06_25</u> # And Eleazar Aaron's son took him [one] of the daughters of Putiel to wife; and she bare him Phinehas: these [are] the heads of the fathers of the Levites according to their families.

took him out 11_1KI_17_19# And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her bosom, and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, and laid him upon his own bed.

took him out 14_2CH_35_24# His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.

took him out <u>24_JER_37_17</u> # Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took him out: and the king asked him secretly in his house, and said, Is there [any] word from the LORD? And Jeremiah said, There is: for, said he, thou shalt be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon.

took him rods <u>01_GEN_30_37</u># And Jacob took him rods of green poplar, and of the hazel and chestnut tree; and pilled white streaks in them, and made the white appear which [was] in the rods.

took him saying 24_JER_26_08 # Now it came to pass, when Jeremiah had made an end of speaking all that the LORD had commanded [him] to speak unto all the people, that the priests and the prophets and all the people took him, saying, Thou shalt surely die.

took him that <u>09_1SA_18_02</u> # And Saul took him that day, and would let him go no more home to his father's house.

took him unto <u>09_1SA_14_52</u> # And there was sore war against the Philistines all the days of Saul: and when Saul saw any strong man, or any valiant man, he took him unto him.

took him unto <u>44_ACT_18_26</u># And he began to speak boldly in the synagogue: whom when Aquila and Priscilla had heard, they took him unto [them], and expounded unto him the way of God more perfectly.

took him up <u>09_1SA_01_24</u># And when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, with three bullocks, and one ephah of flour, and a bottle of wine, and brought him unto the house of the LORD in Shiloh: and the child [was] young.

took him up 12 2KI 10 15 # And when he was departed thence, he lighted on Jehonadab the son of Rechab [coming] to meet him: and he saluted him, and said to him, Is thine heart right, as my heart [is] with thy heart? And Jehonadab answered, It is. If it be, give [me] thine hand. And he gave [him] his hand; and he took him up to him into the chariot.

took him up 10_2SA_04_04 # And Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son [that was] lame of [his] feet. He was five

years old when the tidings came of Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and his nurse took him up, and fled: and it came to pass, as she made haste to flee, that he fell, and became lame. And his name [was] Mephibosheth.

took him up <u>44_ACT_07_21</u> # And when he was cast out, Pharaoh's daughter took him up, and nourished him for her own son.

took him up 44_ACT_10_26 # But Peter took him up, saying, Stand up; I myself also am a man.

took him up <u>24_JER_38_13</u> # So they drew up Jeremiah with cords, and took him up out of the dungeon: and Jeremiah remained in the court of the prison.

took him 01_GEN_05_24 # And Enoch walked with God: and he [was] not; for God took him.

took him 41_MAR_14_46 # And they laid their hands on him, and took him.

took him <u>40_MAT_26_50</u># And Jesus said unto him, Friend, wherefore art thou come? Then came they, and laid hands on Jesus, and took him.

took his brethren <u>01_GEN_31_23</u># And he took his brethren with him, and pursued after him seven days' journey; and they overtook him in the mount Gilead.

took his brother <u>28_HOS_12_03</u># He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and by his strength he had power with God:

took his concubine <u>07_JUD_19_25</u># But the men would not hearken to him: so the man took his concubine, and brought her forth unto them; and they knew her, and abused her all the night until the morning: and when the day began to spring, they let her go.

took his eldest 12_2KI_03_27 # Then he took his eldest son that should have reigned in his stead, and offered him [for] a burnt offering upon the wall. And there was great indignation against Israel: and they departed from him, and returned to [their own] land.

took his garments <u>43 JOH 19 23</u> # Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also [his] coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout.

took his glory <u>27_DAN_05_20</u> # But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him:

took his head <u>13_1CH_10_09</u># And when they had stripped him, they took his head, and his armour, and sent into the land of the Philistines round about, to carry tidings unto their idols, and to the people.

took his head <u>10_2SA_04_07</u> # For when they came into the house, he lay on his bed in his bedchamber, and they smote him, and slew him, and beheaded him, and took his head, and gat them away through the plain all night.

took his journey <u>01_GEN_46_01</u> # And Israel took his journey with all that he had, and came to Beersheba, and offered sacrifices unto the God of his father Isaac.

took his journey <u>42_LUK_15_13</u># And not many days after the younger son gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country, and there wasted his substance with riotous living.

took his journey 40_MAT_25_15# And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

took his leave <u>44_ACT_18_18</u># And Paul [after this] tarried [there] yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn [his] head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow.

took his mantle 12_2KI_02_08 # And Elijah took his mantle, and wrapped [it] together, and smote the waters, and they were divided hither and thither, so that they two went over on dry ground.

took his people 02_EXO_14_06 # And he made ready his chariot, and took his people with him:

took his ring <u>17_EST_03_10</u># And the king took his ring from his hand, and gave it unto Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, the Jews' enemy.

took his servants <u>40_MAT_21_35</u># And the husbandmen took his servants, and beat one, and killed another, and stoned another.

took his servants <u>40_MAT_22_06</u># And the remnant took his servants, and entreated [them] spitefully, and slew [them].

took his staff <u>09_1SA_17_40</u># And he took his staff in his hand, and chose him five smooth stones out of the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag which he had, even in a scrip; and his sling [was] in his hand: and he drew near to the Philistine.

took his sword <u>09_1SA_17_51</u># Therefore David ran, and stood upon the Philistine, and took his sword, and drew it out of the sheath thereof, and slew him, and cut off his head therewith. And when the Philistines saw their champion was dead, they fled.

took his two <u>01_GEN_32_22</u> # And he rose up that night, and took his two wives, and his two womenservants, and his eleven sons, and passed over the ford Jabbok.

took his wife <u>02_EXO_04_20</u> # And Moses took his wife and his sons, and set them upon an ass, and he returned to the land of Egypt: and Moses took the rod of God in his hand.

took his wives <u>01_GEN_36_02</u># Esau took his wives of the daughters of Canaan; Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah the daughter of Zibeon the Hivite;

took his wives <u>01_GEN_36_06</u># And Esau took his wives, and his sons, and his daughters, and all the persons of his house, and his cattle, and all his beasts, and all his substance, which he had got in the land of Canaan; and went into the country from the face of his brother Jacob.

took hold of 12 2KI 02 12 # And Elisha saw [it], and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces.

took hold of <u>10_2SA_04_10</u># When one told me, saying, Behold, Saul is dead, thinking to have brought good tidings, I took hold of him, and slew him in Ziklag, who [thought] that I would have given him a reward for his tidings:

took hold of <u>10_2SA_06_06</u># And when they came to Nachon's threshingfloor, Uzzah put forth [his hand] to the ark of God, and took hold of it; for the oxen shook [it].

took hold of <u>10_2SA_13_11</u># And when she had brought [them] unto him to eat, he took hold of her, and said unto her, Come lie with me, my sister.

took hold of 26_EZE_29_07 # When they took hold of thee by thy hand, thou didst break, and rend all their

shoulder: and when they leaned upon thee, thou brakest, and madest all their loins to be at a stand.

took hold of <u>24_JER_50_43</u># The king of Babylon hath heard the report of them, and his hands waxed feeble: anguish took hold of him, [and] pangs as of a woman in travail.

took hold of <u>07_JUD_16_29</u> # And Samson took hold of the two middle pillars upon which the house stood, and on which it was borne up, of the one with his right hand, and of the other with his left.

took hold on 10_2SA_01_11# Then David took hold on his clothes, and rent them; and likewise all the men that [were] with him:

took hold on <u>01_GEN_25_26</u># And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac [was] threescore years old when she bare them.

took hold upon 19_PSA_48_06 # Fear took hold upon them there, [and] pain, as of a woman in travail.

took hot for <u>06_JOS_09_12</u> # This our bread we took hot [for] our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; but now, behold, it is dry, and it is mouldy:

took I the <u>24_JER_25_17</u> # Then took I the cup at the LORD'S hand, and made all the nations to drink, unto whom the LORD had sent me:

took Ijon and 12_2KI_15_29# In the days of Pekah king of Israel came Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and took Ijon, and Abelbethmaachah, and Janoah, and Kedesh, and Hazor, and Gilead, and Galilee, all the land of Naphtali, and carried them captive to Assyria.

took in battle <u>06_JOS_11_19</u># There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, save the Hivites the inhabitants of Gibeon: all [other] they took in battle.

took in his <u>02_EXO_34_04</u># And he hewed two tables of stone like unto the first; and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up unto mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand the two tables of stone.

took in hunting 20_PRO_12_27 # The slothful [man] roasteth not that which he took in hunting: but the substance of a diligent man [is] precious.

took in thirty <u>07_JUD_12_09</u> # And he had thirty sons, and thirty daughters, [whom] he sent abroad, and took in thirty daughters from abroad for his sons. And he judged Israel seven years.

took Ishbosheth the <u>10_2SA_02_08</u># But Abner the son of Ner, captain of Saul's host, took Ishbosheth the son of Saul, and brought him over to Mahanaim;

took Ishmael his <u>01_GEN_17_23</u> # And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him.

took it and 13_1CH_11_18# And the three brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: but David would not drink [of] it, but poured it out to the LORD,

took it and 14_2CH_24_11 # Now it came to pass, that at what time the chest was brought unto the king's office by the hand of the Levites, and when they saw that [there was] much money, the king's scribe and the high priest's officer came and emptied the chest, and took it, and carried it to his place again. Thus they did day by day, and gathered money in abundance.

took it and 12 2KI 12 17 # Then Hazael king of Syria went up, and fought against Gath, and took it: and Hazael set his face to go up to Jerusalem.

took it and 12 2KI 16 09 # And the king of Assyria hearkened unto him: for the king of Assyria went up against Damascus, and took it, and carried [the people of] it captive to Kir, and slew Rezin.

took it and <u>10_2SA_23_16</u># And the three mighty men brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: nevertheless he would not drink thereof, but poured it out unto the LORD.

took it and <u>26_EZE_10_07</u> # And [one] cherub stretched forth his hand from between the cherubims unto the fire that [was] between the cherubims, and took [thereof], and put [it] into the hands of [him that was] clothed with linen: who took [it], and went out.

took it and <u>06_JOS_08_19</u> # And the ambush arose quickly out of their place, and they ran as soon as he had stretched out his hand: and they entered into the city, and took it, and hasted and set the city on fire.

took it and <u>06_JOS_10_37</u> # And they took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof, and all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining, according to all that he had done to Eglon; but destroyed it utterly, and all the souls that [were] therein.

took it and <u>06_JOS_10_39</u> # And he took it, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof; and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and utterly destroyed all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining: as he had done to Hebron, so he did to Debir, and to the king thereof; as he had done also to Libnah, and to her king.

took it and <u>06_JOS_15_17</u># And Othniel the son of Kenaz, the brother of Caleb, took it: and he gave him Achsah his daughter to wife.

took it and <u>06_JOS_19_47</u># And the coast of the children of Dan went out [too little] for them: therefore the children of Dan went up to fight against Leshem, and took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and possessed it, and dwelt therein, and called Leshem, Dan, after the name of Dan their father.

took it and <u>07_JUD_01_13</u># And Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger brother, took it: and he gave him Achsah his daughter to wife.

took it and <u>07_JUD_09_48</u> # And Abimelech gat him up to mount Zalmon, he and all the people that [were] with him; and Abimelech took an ax in his hand, and cut down a bough from the trees, and took it, and laid [it] on his shoulder, and said unto the people that [were] with him, What ye have seen me do, make haste, [and] do as I [have done].

took it and <u>07_JUD_15_15</u> # And he found a new jawbone of an ass, and put forth his hand, and took it, and slew a thousand men therewith.

took it And <u>07_JUD_17_02</u># And he said unto his mother, The eleven hundred [shekels] of silver that were taken from thee, about which thou cursedst, and spakest of also in mine ears, behold, the silver [is] with me; I took it. And his mother said, Blessed [be thou] of the LORD, my son.

took it and 42_LUK_24_43 # And he took [it], and did eat before them.

took it and <u>04_NUM_32_39</u> # And the children of Machir the son of Manasseh went to Gilead, and took it, and dispossessed the Amorite which [was] in it.

took it down <u>42_LUK_23_53</u> # And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.

took it even 12 2KI 18 10 # And at the end of three years they took it: [even] in the sixth year of Hezekiah, that [is] the ninth year of Hoshea king of Israel, Samaria was taken.

took it from 13_1CH_17_13 # I will be his father, and he shall be my son: and I will not take my mercy away from him, as I took [it] from [him] that was before thee:

took it from <u>10_2SA_07_15</u> # But my mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took [it] from Saul, whom I put away before thee.

took it on <u>06_JOS_10_32</u># And the LORD delivered Lachish into the hand of Israel, which took it on the second day, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and all the souls that [were] therein, according to all that he had done to Libnah.

took it on <u>06_JOS_10_35</u> # And they took it on that day, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and all the souls that [were] therein he utterly destroyed that day, according to all that he had done to Lachish.

took it out <u>51_COL_02_14</u># Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

took it out <u>02_EXO_04_06</u># And the LORD said furthermore unto him, Put now thine hand into thy bosom. And he put his hand into his bosom: and when he took it out, behold, his hand [was] leprous as snow.

took it out <u>24_JER_36_21</u># So the king sent Jehudi to fetch the roll: and he took it out of Elishama the scribe's chamber. And Jehudi read it in the ears of the king, and in the ears of all the princes which stood beside the king.

took it to 14 2CH 29 16 # And the priests went into the inner part of the house of the LORD, to cleanse [it], and brought out all the uncleanness that they found in the temple of the LORD into the court of the house of the LORD. And the Levites took [it], to carry [it] out abroad into the brook Kidron.

took it up <u>08_RUT_02_18</u># And she took [it] up, and went into the city: and her mother in law saw what she had gleaned: and she brought forth, and gave to her that she had reserved after she was sufficed.

took it 12_2KI_06_07 # Therefore said he, Take [it] up to thee. And he put out his hand, and took it.

took it <u>10_2SA_12_29</u> # And David gathered all the people together, and went to Rabbah, and fought against it, and took it.

took it <u>01_GEN_33_11</u># Take, I pray thee, my blessing that is brought to thee; because God hath dealt graciously with me, and because I have enough. And he urged him, and he took [it].

took it <u>23_ISA_20_01</u># In the year that Tartan came unto Ashdod [when Sargon the king of Assyria sent him,] and fought against Ashdod, and took it;

took it 07_JUD_09_50 # Then went Abimelech to Thebez, and encamped against Thebez, and took it.

took Jaazaniah the <u>24_JER_35_03</u> # Then I took Jaazaniah the son of Jeremiah, the son of Habaziniah, and his brethren, and all his sons, and the whole house of the Rechabites;

took Jehoahaz away <u>12 2KI 23 34 # And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt, and died there.</u>

took Jehoahaz his <u>14_2CH_36_04</u># And the king of Egypt made Eliakim his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem, and turned his name to Jehoiakim. And Necho took Jehoahaz his brother, and carried him to Egypt.

took Jehoahaz the 14_2CH_36_01 # Then the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and made him king in his father's stead in Jerusalem.

took Jehoahaz the 12_2KI_23_30 # And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

took Jeremiah and 24 JER 37 14 # Then said Jeremiah, [It is] false; I fall not away to the Chaldeans. But he hearkened not to him: so Irijah took Jeremiah, and brought him to the princes.

took Jeremiah and 24_JER_40_02# And the captain of the guard took Jeremiah, and said unto him, The LORD thy God hath pronounced this evil upon this place.

took Jeremiah another <u>24_JER_36_32</u> # Then took Jeremiah another roll, and gave it to Baruch the scribe, the son of Neriah; who wrote therein from the mouth of Jeremiah all the words of the book which Jehoiakim king of Judah had burned in the fire: and there were added besides unto them many like words.

took Jeremiah out <u>24_JER_39_14</u> # Even they sent, and took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: so he dwelt among the people.

took Jeremiah the <u>24_JER_37_13</u># And when he was in the gate of Benjamin, a captain of the ward [was] there, whose name [was] Irijah, the son of Shelemiah, the son of Hananiah; and he took Jeremiah the prophet, saying, Thou fallest away to the Chaldeans.

took Jeremiah the <u>24_JER_38_14</u> # Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took Jeremiah the prophet unto him into the third entry that [is] in the house of the LORD: and the king said unto Jeremiah, I will ask thee a thing; hide nothing from me.

took Jesus and <u>43_JOH_18_12</u> # Then the band and the captain and officers of the Jews took Jesus, and bound him,

took Jesus and 43_JOH_19_01 # Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged [him].

took Jesus and <u>43_JOH_19_16</u># Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be crucified. And they took Jesus, and led [him] away.

took Jesus into <u>40_MAT_27_27</u># Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the common hall, and gathered unto him the whole band [of soldiers].

took Jesus <u>44_ACT_01_16</u># Men [and] brethren, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus.

took Joash the 14_2CH_22_11# But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

took Joash the <u>12_2KI_11_02</u># But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even]

him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

took Johanan the <u>24_JER_41_16</u> # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war, and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

took Joseph's coat <u>01_GEN_37_31</u># And they took Joseph's coat, and killed a kid of the goats, and dipped the coat in the blood;

took Joshua and <u>04_NUM_27_22</u> # And Moses did as the LORD commanded him: and he took Joshua, and set him before Eleazar the priest, and before all the congregation:

took joyfully the <u>58_HEB_10_34</u># For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.

took Kenath and <u>04_NUM_32_42</u># And Nobah went and took Kenath, and the villages thereof, and called it Nobah, after his own name.

took knowledge of <u>44_ACT_04_13</u># Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

took Leah his <u>01_GEN_29_23</u># And it came to pass in the evening, that he took Leah his daughter, and brought her to him; and he went in unto her.

took Lot Abram's <u>01_GEN_14_12</u># And they took Lot, Abram's brother's son, who dwelt in Sodom, and his goods, and departed.

took Maachah the <u>14_2CH_11_20</u># And after her he took Maachah the daughter of Absalom; which bare him Abijah, and Attai, and Ziza, and Shelomith.

took Makkedah and <u>06_JOS_10_28</u># And that day Joshua took Makkedah, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof he utterly destroyed, them, and all the souls that [were] therein; he let none remain: and he did to the king of Makkedah as he did unto the king of Jericho.

took Manasseh among <u>14_2CH_33_11</u># Wherefore the LORD brought upon them the captains of the host of the king of Assyria, which took Manasseh among the thorns, and bound him with fetters, and carried him to Babylon.

took Mark and <u>44_ACT_15_39</u># And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;

took Mary a <u>43_JOH_12_03</u># Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

took me as <u>30_AMO_07_15</u> # And the LORD took me as I followed the flock, and the LORD said unto me, Go, prophesy unto my people Israel.

took me away <u>26_EZE_03_14</u> # So the spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me.

took me by <u>26_EZE_08_03</u># And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where [was] the seat of the image of

jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy.

took me from <u>01_GEN_24_07</u> # The LORD God of heaven, which took me from my father's house, and from the land of my kindred, and which spake unto me, and that sware unto me, saying, Unto thy seed will I give this land; he shall send his angel before thee, and thou shalt take a wife unto my son from thence.

took me he 10_2SA_22_17 # He sent from above, he took me; he drew me out of many waters;

took me he 19_PSA_18_16 # He sent from above, he took me, he drew me out of many waters.

took more wives <u>13_1CH_14_03</u># And David took more wives at Jerusalem: and David begat more sons and daughters.

took much spoil 14_2CH_25_13 # But the soldiers of the army which Amaziah sent back, that they should not go with him to battle, fell upon the cities of Judah, from Samaria even unto Bethhoron, and smote three

thousand of them, and took much spoil.

took my concubine <u>07_JUD_20_06</u># And I took my concubine, and cut her in pieces, and sent her throughout all the country of the inheritance of Israel: for they have committed lewdness and folly in Israel.

took my son 11_1KI_03_20 # And she arose at midnight, and took my son from beside me, while thine handmaid slept, and laid it in her bosom, and laid her dead child in my bosom.

took my staff 38_ZEC_11_10# And I took my staff, [even] Beauty, and cut it asunder, that I might break my covenant which I had made with all the people.

took new ropes <u>07_JUD_16_12</u> # Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And [there were] liers in wait abiding in the chamber. And he brake them from off his arms like a thread.

took no oil 40_MAT_25_03 # They that [were] foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

took not away <u>02_EXO_13_22</u> # He took not away the pillar of the cloud by day, nor the pillar of fire by night, [from] before the people.

took not away <u>07_JUD_11_15</u># And said unto him, Thus saith Jephthah, Israel took not away the land of Moab, nor the land of the children of Ammon:

took not away 19_PSA_69_04 # They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, [being] mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored [that] which I took not away.

took not from <u>05_DEU_03_04</u> # And we took all his cities at that time, there was not a city which we took not from them, threescore cities, all the region of Argob, the kingdom of Og in Bashan.

took not on <u>58_HEB_02_16</u># For verily he took not on [him the nature of] angels; but he took on [him] the seed of Abraham.

took not the <u>13_1CH_27_23</u> # But David took not the number of them from twenty years old and under: because the LORD had said he would increase Israel like to the stars of the heavens.

took not warning <u>26_EZE_33_05</u># He heard the sound of the trumpet, and took not warning; his blood shall be upon him. But he that taketh warning shall deliver his soul.

took not when <u>24_JER_27_20</u># Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem;

took notice of <u>10_2SA_03_36</u># And all the people took notice [of it], and it pleased them: as whatsoever the king did pleased all the people.

took of every <u>01_GEN_08_20</u> # And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

took of that <u>01_GEN_32_13</u> # And he lodged there that same night; and took of that which came to his hand a present for Esau his brother;

took of the <u>09_1SA_15_21</u># But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God in Gilgal.

took off his <u>17_EST_08_02</u> # And the king took off his ring, which he had taken from Haman, and gave it unto Mordecai. And Esther set Mordecai over the house of Haman.

took off his <u>01_GEN_41_42</u> # And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck;

took off the <u>41_MAR_15_20</u> # And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to crucify him.

took off their <u>02_EXO_14_25</u> # And took off their chariot wheels, that they drave them heavily: so that the Egyptians said, Let us flee from the face of Israel; for the LORD fighteth for them against the Egyptians.

took oil in 40_MAT_25_04 # But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.

took old sacks 06_JOS_09_04 # They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors,

and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up;

took on him <u>58_HEB_02_16</u># For verily he took not on [him the nature of] angels; but he took on [him] the seed of Abraham.

took one of <u>01_GEN_02_21</u># And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

took one of <u>16_NEH_07_63</u># And of the priests: the children of Habaiah, the children of Koz, the children of Barzillai, which took [one] of the daughters of Barzillai the Gileadite to wife, and was called after their name.

took one portion <u>04_NUM_31_47</u># Even of the children of Israel's half, Moses took one portion of fifty, [both] of man and of beast, and gave them unto the Levites, which kept the charge of the tabernacle of the LORD; as the LORD commanded Moses.

took one unleavened <u>03_LEV_08_26</u># And out of the basket of unleavened bread, that [was] before the LORD, he took one unleavened cake, and a cake of oiled bread, and one wafer, and put [them] on the fat, and upon the right shoulder:

took our infirmities <u>40_MAT_08_17</u># That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare [our] sicknesses.

took out of <u>06_JOS_04_20</u> # And those twelve stones, which they took out of Jordan, did Joshua pitch in Gilgal.

took out two <u>42_LUK_10_35</u># And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave [them] to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.

took part of <u>58_HEB_02_14</u># Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

took Paul and 44_ACT_21_30 # And all the city was moved, and the people ran together: and they took Paul, and drew him out of the temple: and forthwith the doors were shut.

took Paul and <u>44_ACT_23_31</u># Then the soldiers, as it was commanded them, took Paul, and brought [him] by night to Antipatris.

took Paul's girdle 44_ACT_21_11 # And when he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his

own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the Holy Ghost, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver [him] into the hands of the Gentiles.

took Peter and <u>42_LUK_09_28</u># And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray.

took Pharaoh's daughter <u>11_1KI_03_01</u># And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

took Rebekah and <u>01_GEN_24_61</u># And Rebekah arose, and her damsels, and they rode upon the camels, and followed the man: and the servant took Rebekah, and went his way.

took Rebekah and <u>01_GEN_24_67</u> # And Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he loved her: and Isaac was comforted after his mother's [death].

took Samaria and 12 2KI 17 06 # In the ninth year of Hoshea the king of Assyria took Samaria, and carried Israel away into Assyria, and placed them in Halah and in Habor [by] the river of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes.

took Sarah <u>01_GEN_20_02</u> # And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She [is] my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

took Sarai his <u>01_GEN_12_05</u># And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran; and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came.

took Saul and <u>09_1SA_09_22</u># And Samuel took Saul and his servant, and brought them into the parlour, and made them sit in the chiefest place among them that were bidden, which [were] about thirty persons.

took Selah by 12_2KI_14_07# He slew of Edom in the valley of salt ten thousand, and took Selah by war, and called the name of it Joktheel unto this day.

took Seraiah the 12_2KI_25_18 # And the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest, and Zephaniah the second priest, and the three keepers of the door:

took Seraiah the <u>24_JER_52_24</u> # And the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest, and Zephaniah the second priest, and the three keepers of the door:

took sheep and <u>09_1SA_14_32</u> # And the people flew upon the spoil, and took sheep, and oxen, and calves, and slew [them] on the ground: and the people did eat [them] with the blood.

took sheep and <u>01_GEN_20_14</u> # And Abimelech took sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and womenservants, and gave [them] unto Abraham, and restored him Sarah his wife.

took sheep and <u>01_GEN_21_27</u> # And Abraham took sheep and oxen, and gave them unto Abimelech; and both of them made a covenant.

took ship and <u>44_ACT_21_06</u># And when we had taken our leave one of another, we took ship; and they returned home again.

took ship and 40_MAT_15_39# And he sent away the multitude, and took ship, and came into the coasts of Magdala.

took shipping and <u>43_JOH_06_24</u> # When the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, neither his disciples, they also took shipping, and came to Capernaum, seeking for Jesus.

took six hundred <u>02_EXO_14_07</u># And he took six hundred chosen chariots, and all the chariots of Egypt, and captains over every one of them.

took soldiers and <u>44_ACT_21_32</u># Who immediately took soldiers and centurions, and ran down unto them: and when they saw the chief captain and the soldiers, they left beating of Paul.

took some meat 44_ACT_27_36 # Then were they all of good cheer, and they also took [some] meat.

took some of <u>01_GEN_47_02</u># And he took some of his brethren, [even] five men, and presented them unto Pharaoh.

took some of <u>04_NUM_21_01</u># And [when] king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south, heard tell that Israel came by the way of the spies; then he fought against Israel, and took [some] of them prisoners.

took Sosthenes the <u>44_ACT_18_17</u> # Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and beat [him] before the judgment seat. And Gallio cared for none of those things.

took stones and <u>01_GEN_31_46</u># And Jacob said unto his brethren, Gather stones; and they took stones, and made an heap: and they did eat there upon the heap.

took strong cities <u>16_NEH_09_25</u> # And they took strong cities, and a fat land, and possessed houses full of all goods, wells digged, vineyards, and oliveyards, and fruit trees in abundance: so they did eat, and were filled, and became fat, and delighted themselves in thy great goodness.

took sweet counsel 19_PSA_55_14 # We took sweet counsel together, [and] walked unto the house of God in company.

took ten camels <u>01_GEN_24_10</u># And the servant took ten camels of the camels of his master, and departed; for all the goods of his master [were] in his hand: and he arose, and went to Mesopotamia, unto the city of Nahor.

took ten men <u>07_JUD_06_27</u># Then Gideon took ten men of his servants, and did as the LORD had said unto him: and [so] it was, because he feared his father's household, and the men of the city, that he could not do [it] by day, that he did [it] by night.

took ten men <u>08_RUT_04_02</u># And he took ten men of the elders of the city, and said, Sit ye down here. And they sat down.

took that present <u>01_GEN_43_15</u> # And the men took that present, and they took double money in their hand, and Benjamin; and rose up, and went down to Egypt, and stood before Joseph.

took the anointing <u>03_LEV_08_10</u># And Moses took the anointing oil, and anointed the tabernacle and all that [was] therein, and sanctified them.

took the ark <u>09_1SA_05_01</u># And the Philistines took the ark of God, and brought it from Ebenezer unto Ashdod.

took the ark <u>09_1SA_05_02</u># When the Philistines took the ark of God, they brought it into the house of Dagon, and set it by Dagon.

took the ashes 11_1KI_20_41 # And he hasted, and took the ashes away from his face; and the king of Israel discerned him that he [was] of the prophets.

took the blind 41_MAR_08_23 # And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.

took the blood <u>02_EXO_24_08</u># And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled [it] on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.

took the blood <u>58_HEB_09_19</u># For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,

took the blood <u>03_LEV_08_15</u># And he slew [it]; and Moses took the blood, and put [it] upon the horns of the altar round about with his finger, and purified the altar, and poured the blood at the bottom of the altar, and sanctified it, to make reconciliation upon it.

took the body <u>09_1SA_31_12</u># All the valiant men arose, and went all night, and took the body of Saul and the bodies of his sons from the wall of Bethshan, and came to Jabesh, and burnt them there.

took the body <u>43_JOH_19_38</u># And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave [him] leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

took the bullock <u>11 1KI 18 26 #</u> And they took the bullock which was given them, and they dressed [it], and called on the name of Baal from morning even until noon, saying, O Baal, hear us. But [there was] no voice, nor any that answered. And they leaped upon the altar which was made.

took the cakes <u>10_2SA_13_10</u># And Amnon said unto Tamar, Bring the meat into the chamber, that I may eat of thine hand. And Tamar took the cakes which she had made, and brought [them] into the chamber to Amnon her brother.

took the calf <u>02_EXO_32_20</u> # And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt [it] in the fire, and ground [it] to powder, and strowed [it] upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink [of it].

took the captain 24 JER_52 19 # And the basins, and the firepans, and the bowls, and the caldrons, and the candlesticks, and the spoons, and the cups; [that] which [was] of gold [in] gold, and [that] which [was] of silver [in] silver, took the captain of the guard away.

took the captains <u>14_2CH_23_01</u># And in the seventh year Jehoiada strengthened himself, and took the captains of hundreds, Azariah the son of Jeroham, and Ishmael the son of Jehohanan, and Azariah the son of Obed, and Maaseiah the son of Adaiah, and Elishaphat the son of Zichri, into covenant with him.

took the captains <u>14_2CH_23_20</u># And he took the captains of hundreds, and the nobles, and the governors of the people, and all the people of the land, and brought down the king from the house of the LORD: and they came through the high gate into the king's house, and set the king upon the throne of the kingdom.

took the captives <u>14_2CH_28_15</u># And the men which were expressed by name rose up, and took the captives, and with the spoil clothed all that were naked among them, and arrayed them, and shod them, and gave them to eat and to drink, and anointed them, and carried all the feeble of them upon asses, and brought them to Jericho, the city of palm trees, to their brethren: then they returned to Samaria.

took the city <u>06_JOS_06_20</u># So the people shouted when [the priests] blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

took the city <u>07_JUD_09_45</u># And Abimelech fought against the city all that day; and he took the city, and slew the people that [was] therein, and beat down the city, and sowed it with salt.

took the crown 13 1CH 20 02 # And David took the crown of their king from off his head, and found it to weigh a talent of gold, and [there were] precious stones in it; and it was set upon David's head: and he brought also exceeding much spoil out of the city.

took the crown 10 2SA 01 10 # So I stood upon him, and slew him, because I was sure that he could not live after that he was fallen: and I took the crown that [was] upon his head, and the bracelet that [was] on his arm, and have brought them hither unto my lord.

took the cup 46_1CO_11_25# After the same manner also [he took] the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink [it], in remembrance of me.

took the cup <u>42_LUK_22_17</u># And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide [it] among yourselves:

took the cup 41_MAR_14_23 # And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave [it] to them: and they all drank of it.

took the cup 40_MAT_26_27# And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave [it] to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;

took the dagger <u>07_JUD_03_21</u> # And Ehud put forth his left hand, and took the dagger from his right thigh, and thrust it into his belly:

took the damsel <u>41_MAR_05_41</u> # And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

took the doors <u>07_JUD_16_03</u> # And Samson lay till midnight, and arose at midnight, and took the doors of the gate of the city, and the two posts, and went away with them, bar and all, and put [them] upon his shoulders, and carried them up to the top of an hill that [is] before Hebron.

took the elders <u>07_JUD_08_16</u> # And he took the elders of the city, and thorns of the wilderness and briers, and with them he taught the men of Succoth.

took the ephod <u>07_JUD_18_20</u> # And the priest's heart was glad, and he took the ephod, and the teraphim, and the graven image, and went in the midst of the people.

took the evidence <u>24_JER_32_11</u># So I took the evidence of the purchase, [both] that which was sealed [according] to the law and custom, and that which was open:

took the family <u>06_JOS_07_17</u># And he brought the family of Judah; and he took the family of the Zarhites: and he brought the family of the Zarhites man by man; and Zabdi was taken:

took the fat <u>03_LEV_08_25</u> # And he took the fat, and the rump, and all the fat that [was] upon the inwards, and the caul [above] the liver, and the two kidneys, and their fat, and the right shoulder:

took the fenced <u>14_2CH_12_04</u># And he took the fenced cities which [pertained] to Judah, and came to Jerusalem.

took the fire <u>01_GEN_22_06</u> # And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid [it] upon Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together.

took the five <u>42_LUK_09_16</u> # Then he took the five loaves and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed them, and brake, and gave to the disciples to set before the multitude.

took the five <u>40_MAT_14_19</u># And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to [his] disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

took the fords <u>07_JUD_03_28</u># And he said unto them, Follow after me: for the LORD hath delivered your enemies the Moabites into your hand. And they went down after him, and took the fords of Jordan toward Moab, and suffered not a man to pass over.

took the girdle <u>24_JER_13_07</u> # Then I went to Euphrates, and digged, and took the girdle from the place where I had hid it: and, behold, the girdle was marred, it was profitable for nothing.

took the goat <u>03_LEV_09_15</u># And he brought the people's offering, and took the goat, which [was] the sin offering for the people, and slew it, and offered it for sin, as the first.

took the gold <u>04_NUM_31_51</u># And Moses and Eleazar the priest took the gold of them, [even] all wrought jewels.

took the gold <u>04_NUM_31_54</u># And Moses and Eleazar the priest took the gold of the captains of thousands and of hundreds, and brought it into the tabernacle of the congregation, [for] a memorial for the children of Israel before the LORD.

took the grapes <u>01_GEN_40_11</u># And Pharaoh's cup [was] in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

took the graven <u>07_JUD_18_17</u># And the five men that went to spy out the land went up, [and] came in thither, [and] took the graven image, and the ephod, and the teraphim, and the molten image: and the priest stood in the entering of the gate with the six hundred men [that were] appointed with weapons of war.

took the head <u>09_1SA_17_54</u># And David took the head of the Philistine, and brought it to Jerusalem; but he put his armour in his tent.

took the head <u>10_2SA_04_12</u> # And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

took the highest <u>26_EZE_17_03</u># And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; A great eagle with great wings, longwinged, full of feathers, which had divers colours, came unto Lebanon, and took the highest branch of the cedar:

took the horn <u>09_1SA_16_13</u> # Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

took the king <u>12_2KI_25_06</u> # So they took the king, and brought him up to the king of Babylon to Riblah; and they gave judgment upon him.

took the king 24_JER_52_09 # Then they took the king, and carried him up unto the king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath; where he gave judgment upon him.

took the king's 12_2KI_10_07 # And it came to pass, when the letter came to them, that they took the king's sons, and slew seventy persons, and put their heads in baskets, and sent him [them] to Jezreel.

took the kingdom <u>09_1SA_14_47</u># So Saul took the kingdom over Israel, and fought against all his enemies on every side, against Moab, and against the children of Ammon, and against Edom, and against the kings

of Zobah, and against the Philistines: and whithersoever he turned himself, he vexed [them].

took the kingdom <u>27_DAN_05_31</u> # And Darius the Median took the kingdom, [being] about threescore and two years old.

took the knife 01_GEN_22_10 # And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

took the little <u>66_REV_10_10</u># And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

took the loaves <u>43_JOH_06_11</u># And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

took the man <u>01_GEN_02_15</u># And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.

took the mantle <u>12_2KI_02_14</u># And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where [is] the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

took the men <u>44_ACT_21_26</u># Then Paul took the men, and the next day purifying himself with them entered into the temple, to signify the accomplishment of the days of purification, until that an offering should be offered for every one of them.

took the men 24 JER_38 11 # So Ebedmelech took the men with him, and went into the house of the king under the treasury, and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags, and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah.

took the money <u>40_MAT_28_15</u># So they took the money, and did as they were taught: and this saying is commonly reported among the Jews until this day.

took the passages <u>07_JUD_12_05</u># And the Gileadites took the passages of Jordan before the Ephraimites: and it was [so] that when those Ephraimites which were escaped said, Let me go over; that the men of Gilead said unto him, [Art] thou an Ephraimite? If he said, Nay;

took the people <u>07_JUD_09_43</u># And he took the people, and divided them into three companies, and laid wait in the field, and looked, and, behold, the people [were] come forth out of the city; and he rose up against them, and smote them.

took the poor 10_2SA_12_04 # And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.

took the priests <u>15_EZR_08_30</u> # So took the priests and the Levites the weight of the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, to bring [them] to Jerusalem unto the house of our God.

took the ram <u>01_GEN_22_13</u># And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind [him] a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

took the redemption <u>04_NUM_03_49</u> # And Moses took the redemption money of them that were over and above them that were redeemed by the Levites:

took the reed 40_MAT_27_30 # And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head.

took the robe 40 MAT 27 31 # And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify [him].

took the rod <u>02_EXO_04_20</u># And Moses took his wife and his sons, and set them upon an ass, and he returned to the land of Egypt: and Moses took the rod of God in his hand.

took the rod 04_NUM_20_09 # And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him.

took the roll <u>24_JER_36_14</u> # Therefore all the princes sent Jehudi the son of Nethaniah, the son of Shelemiah, the son of Cushi, unto Baruch, saying, Take in thine hand the roll wherein thou hast read in the ears of the people, and come. So Baruch the son of Neriah took the roll in his hand, and came unto them.

took the royal 10_2SA_12_26# And Joab fought against Rabbah of the children of Ammon, and took the royal city.

took the rulers <u>12_2KI_11_19</u># And he took the rulers over hundreds, and the captains, and the guard, and all the people of the land; and they brought down the king from the house of the LORD, and came by the way of the gate of the guard to the king's house. And he sat on the throne of the kings.

took the seven <u>41_MAR_08_06</u> # And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before [them]; and they did set [them] before the people.

took the seven <u>40_MAT_15_36</u># And he took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake [them], and gave to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

took the shields <u>13_1CH_18_07</u> # And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadarezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

took the shields <u>10_2SA_08_07</u># And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadadezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

took the silver 12_2KI_16_08 # And Ahaz took the silver and gold that was found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and sent [it for] a present to the king of Assyria.

took the silver 40_MAT_27_06# And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood.

took the small <u>04_NUM_32_41</u> # And Jair the son of Manasseh went and took the small towns thereof, and called them Havothjair.

took the spear <u>09_1SA_26_12</u> # So David took the spear and the cruse of water from Saul's bolster; and they gat them away, and no man saw [it], nor knew [it], neither awaked: for they [were] all asleep; because a deep sleep from the LORD was fallen upon them.

took the spoil <u>04_NUM_31_09</u> # And the children of Israel took [all] the women of Midian captives, and their little ones, and took the spoil of all their cattle, and all their flocks, and all their goods.

took the stone <u>01_GEN_28_18</u> # And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put [for] his pillows, and set it up [for] a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it.

took the straight <u>09_1SA_06_12</u> # And the kine took the straight way to the way of Bethshemesh, [and] went along the highway, lowing as they went, and turned not aside [to] the right hand or [to] the left; and the lords of the Philistines went after them unto the border of Bethshemesh.

took the strong 10_2SA_05_07 # Nevertheless David took the strong hold of Zion: the same [is] the city of David.

took the tabernacle <u>02_EXO_33_07</u># And Moses took the tabernacle, and pitched it without the camp, afar off from the camp, and called it the Tabernacle of the congregation. And it came to pass, [that] every one which sought the LORD went out unto the tabernacle of the congregation, which [was] without the camp.

took the ten <u>10_2SA_20_03</u># And David came to his house at Jerusalem; and the king took the ten women [his] concubines, whom he had left to keep the house, and put them in ward, and fed them, but went not in unto them. So they were shut up unto the day of their death, living in widowhood.

took the things <u>07_JUD_18_27</u> # And they took [the things] which Micah had made, and the priest which he had, and came unto Laish, unto a people [that were] at quiet and secure: and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and burnt the city with fire.

took the thirty 40_MAT_27_09# Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;

took the thirty <u>38_ZEC_11_13</u># And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prised at of them. And I took the thirty [pieces] of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

took the twelve <u>40_MAT_20_17</u># And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them,

took the two <u>10_2SA_21_08</u># But the king took the two sons of Rizpah the daughter of Aiah, whom she bare unto Saul, Armoni and Mephibosheth; and the five sons of Michal the daughter of Saul, whom she brought up for Adriel the son of Barzillai the Meholathite:

took the two <u>05_DEU_09_17</u># And I took the two tables, and cast them out of my two hands, and brake them before your eyes.

took the two <u>06_JOS_02_04</u> # And the woman took the two men, and hid them, and said thus, There came men unto me, but I wist not whence they [were]:

took the two <u>07_JUD_08_12</u># And when Zebah and Zalmunna fled, he pursued after them, and took the two kings of Midian, Zebah and Zalmunna, and discomfited all the host.

took the veil <u>02_EXO_34_34</u> # But when Moses went in before the LORD to speak with him, he took the veil off, until he came out. And he came out, and spake unto the children of Israel [that] which he was commanded.

took the villages <u>04_NUM_21_32</u> # And Moses sent to spy out Jaazer, and they took the villages thereof, and drove out the Amorites that [were] there.

took the wagons <u>04_NUM_07_06</u># And Moses took the wagons and the oxen, and gave them unto the Levites.

took the war <u>04_NUM_31_27</u> # And divide the prey into two parts; between them that took the war upon them, who went out to battle, and between all the congregation:

took the waters <u>07_JUD_07_24</u># And Gideon sent messengers throughout all mount Ephraim, saying, Come down against the Midianites, and take before them the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan. Then all

the men of Ephraim gathered themselves together, and took the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan.

took the whole <u>06_JOS_11_23</u># So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the LORD said unto Moses; and Joshua gave it for an inheritance unto Israel according to their divisions by their tribes. And the land rested from war.

took the wood <u>01_GEN_22_06</u># And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid [it] upon Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together.

took the yoke <u>24_JER_28_10</u> # Then Hananiah the prophet took the yoke from off the prophet Jeremiah's neck, and brake it.

took the young 25_LAM_05_13 # They took the young men to grind, and the children fell under the wood.

took the young 40 MAT 02 14 # When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt:

took the young 40_MAT_02_21# And he arose, and took the young child and his mother, and came into the land of Israel.

took thee from <u>13_1CH_17_07</u># Now therefore thus shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, [even] from following the sheep, that thou shouldest be ruler over my people Israel:

took thee from <u>10_2SA_07_08</u># Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over my people, over Israel:

took thee in <u>40_MAT_25_38</u># When saw we thee a stranger, and took [thee] in? or naked, and clothed [thee]?

took thee to <u>04_NUM_23_11</u># And Balak said unto Balaam, What hast thou done unto me? I took thee to curse mine enemies, and, behold, thou hast blessed [them] altogether.

took their bones <u>09_1SA_31_13</u> # And they took their bones, and buried [them] under a tree at Jabesh, and fasted seven days.

took their cattle <u>01_GEN_46_06</u># And they took their cattle, and their goods, which they had gotten in the land of Canaan, and came into Egypt, Jacob, and all his seed with him:

took their daughters <u>07_JUD_03_06</u># And they took their daughters to be their wives, and gave their daughters to their sons, and served their gods.

took their dough <u>02_EXO_12_34</u> # And the people took their dough before it was leavened, their kneadingtroughs being bound up in their clothes upon their shoulders.

took their inheritance <u>06_JOS_16_04</u># So the children of Joseph, Manasseh and Ephraim, took their inheritance.

took their journey <u>05_DEU_10_06</u># And the children of Israel took their journey from Beeroth of the children of Jaakan to Mosera: there Aaron died, and there he was buried; and Eleazar his son ministered in the priest's office in his stead.

took their journey <u>02_EXO_13_20</u># And they took their journey from Succoth, and encamped in Etham, in the edge of the wilderness.

took their journey <u>02 EXO 16 01 # And they took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which [is] between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departing out of the land of Egypt.</u>

took their journey <u>04_NUM_10_13</u># And they first took their journey according to the commandment of the LORD by the hand of Moses.

took their journey <u>04_NUM_33_12</u># And they took their journey out of the wilderness of Sin, and encamped in Dophkah.

took their journeys <u>04_NUM_10_12</u> # And the children of Israel took their journeys out of the wilderness of Sinai; and the cloud rested in the wilderness of Paran.

took their king's 10_2SA_12_30 # And he took their king's crown from off his head, the weight whereof [was] a talent of gold with the precious stones: and it was [set] on David's head. And he brought forth the spoil of the city in great abundance.

took their lamps <u>40_MAT_25_01</u># Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.

took their lamps 40_MAT_25_03# They that [were] foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

took their land <u>05_DEU_29_08</u># And we took their land, and gave it for an inheritance unto the Reubenites, and to the Gadites, and to the half tribe of Manasseh.

took their sheep <u>01_GEN_34_28</u> # They took their sheep, and their oxen, and their asses, and that which [was] in the city, and that which [was] in the field,

took their spoil <u>07_JUD_14_19</u># And the spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled, and he went up to his father's house.

took them alive 12_2KI_10_14 # And he said, Take them alive. And they took them alive, and slew them at the pit of the shearing house, [even] two and forty men; neither left he any of them.

took them all <u>40_MAT_24_39</u># And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

took them and 11_1KI_18_40 # And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.

took them And 12_2KI_13_18 # And he said, Take the arrows. And he took [them]. And he said unto the king of Israel, Smite upon the ground. And he smote thrice, and stayed.

took them and <u>01_GEN_32_23</u> # And he took them, and sent them over the brook, and sent over that he had.

took them and <u>24_JER_52_26</u> # So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard took them, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah.

took them and <u>06_JOS_07_21</u># When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they [are] hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.

took them and <u>42_LUK_09_10</u> # And the apostles, when they were returned, told him all that they had done. And he took them, and went aside privately into a desert place belonging to the city called Bethsaida.

took them away <u>26_EZE_16_50</u> # And they were haughty, and committed abomination before me: therefore I took them away as I saw [good].

took them away <u>18_JOB_01_15</u> # And the Sabeans fell [upon them], and took them away; yea, they have slain the servants with the edge of the sword; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.

took them by 24 JER 31 32 # Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day [that] I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD:

took them captives <u>24_JER_50_33</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah [were] oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

took them down <u>06_JOS_10_27</u># And it came to pass at the time of the going down of the sun, [that] Joshua commanded, and they took them down off the trees, and cast them into the cave wherein they had been hid, and laid great stones in the cave's mouth, [which remain] until this very day.

took them from 12_2KI_05_24 # And when he came to the tower, he took [them] from their hand, and bestowed [them] in the house: and he let the men go, and they departed.

took them from <u>03_LEV_08_28</u># And Moses took them from off their hands, and burnt [them] on the altar upon the burnt offering: they [were] consecrations for a sweet savour: it [is] an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

took them into <u>07_JUD_19_15</u> # And they turned aside thither, to go in [and] to lodge in Gibeah: and when he went in, he sat him down in a street of the city: for [there was] no man that took them into his house to lodging.

took them out <u>06_JOS_07_23</u> # And they took them out of the midst of the tent, and brought them unto Joshua, and unto all the children of Israel, and laid them out before the LORD.

took them the <u>44_ACT_16_33</u> # And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed [their] stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.

took them up <u>41_MAR_10_16</u># And he took them up in his arms, put [his] hands upon them, and blessed them.

took them wives <u>01_GEN_06_02</u># That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they [were] fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

took them wives <u>01_GEN_11_29</u># And Abram and Nahor took them wives: the name of Abram's wife [was] Sarai; and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran, the father of Milcah, and the father of Iscah.

took them wives <u>07_JUD_21_23</u># And the children of Benjamin did so, and took [them] wives, according to their number, of them that danced, whom they caught: and they went and returned unto their inheritance, and repaired the cities, and dwelt in them.

took them wives <u>08_RUT_01_04</u># And they took them wives of the women of Moab; the name of the one [was] Orpah, and the name of the other Ruth: and they dwelled there about ten years.

took them <u>13_1CH_23_22</u> # And Eleazar died, and had no sons, but daughters: and their brethren the sons of Kish took them.

took them <u>12_2KI_18_13</u># Now in the fourteenth year of king Hezekiah did Sennacherib king of Assyria come up against all the fenced cities of Judah, and took them.

took them <u>23_ISA_36_01</u># Now it came to pass in the fourteenth year of king Hezekiah, [that] Sennacherib king of Assyria came up against all the defenced cities of Judah, and took them.

took thence a <u>09_1SA_17_49</u># And David put his hand in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang [it], and smote the Philistine in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead; and he fell upon his face to the earth.

took thence four 14_2CH_08_18 # And Huram sent him by the hands of his servants ships, and servants that had knowledge of the sea; and they went with the servants of Solomon to Ophir, and took thence four hundred and fifty talents of gold, and brought [them] to king Solomon.

took thence old <u>24_JER_38_11</u># So Ebedmelech took the men with him, and went into the house of the king under the treasury, and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags, and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah.

took therefore two 12_2KI_07_14 # They took therefore two chariot horses; and the king sent after the host of the Syrians, saying, Go and see.

took thereof and <u>26_EZE_10_07</u> # And [one] cherub stretched forth his hand from between the cherubims unto the fire that [was] between the cherubims, and took [thereof], and put [it] into the hands of [him that was] clothed with linen: who took [it], and went out.

took thereof in <u>07_JUD_14_09</u> # And he took thereof in his hands, and went on eating, and came to his father and mother, and he gave them, and they did eat: but he told not them that he had taken the honey out of the carcase of the lion.

took these and 12_2KI_25_20 # And Nebuzaradan captain of the guard took these, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah:

took these men <u>04_NUM_01_17</u># And Moses and Aaron took these men which are expressed by [their] names:

took they away 14_2CH_30_14 # And they arose and took away the altars that [were] in Jerusalem, and all the altars for incense took they away, and cast [them] into the brook Kidron.

took they away 12_2KI_25_14 # And the pots, and the shovels, and the snuffers, and the spoons, and all the vessels of brass wherewith they ministered, took they away.

took they away 24_JER_52_18 # The caldrons also, and the shovels, and the snuffers, and the bowls, and the spoons, and all the vessels of brass wherewith they ministered, took they away.

took they captive 01_GEN_34_29 # And all their wealth, and all their little ones, and their wives took they

captive, and spoiled even all that [was] in the house.

took they him <u>42_LUK_22_54</u> # Then took they him, and led [him], and brought him into the high priest's house. And Peter followed afar off.

took they Jeremiah 24 JER 38 06 # Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that [was] in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon [there was] no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.

took they the <u>43_JOH_19_40</u> # Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.

took they up <u>43_JOH_08_59</u> # Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

took this woman <u>05_DEU_22_14</u># And give occasions of speech against her, and bring up an evil name upon her, and say, I took this woman, and when I came to her, I found her not a maid:

took three darts 10_2SA_18_14 # Then said Joab, I may not tarry thus with thee. And he took three darts in his hand, and thrust them through the heart of Absalom, while he [was] yet alive in the midst of the oak.

took three thousand <u>09_1SA_24_02</u># Then Saul took three thousand chosen men out of all Israel, and went to seek David and his men upon the rocks of the wild goats.

took Titus with <u>48_GAL_02_01</u># Then fourteen years after I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and took Titus with [me] also.

took to him <u>07_JUD_19_01</u># And it came to pass in those days, when [there was] no king in Israel, that there was a certain Levite sojourning on the side of mount Ephraim, who took to him a concubine out of Bethlehemjudah.

took to wife 13_1CH_07_15 # And Machir took to wife [the sister] of Huppim and Shuppim, whose sister's name [was] Maachah;] and the name of the second [was] Zelophehad: and Zelophehad had daughters.

took to wife 11_1KI_16_31 # And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took to wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Zidonians, and went and served Baal, and worshipped him.

took to wife <u>02_EXO_02_01</u># And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took [to wife] a daughter of Levi.

took to wife <u>01_GEN_26_34</u># And Esau was forty years old when he took to wife Judith the daughter of Beeri the Hittite, and Bashemath the daughter of Elon the Hittite:

took twelve men <u>05_DEU_01_23</u># And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe:

took twelve stones <u>11_1KI_18_31</u># And Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, unto whom the word of the LORD came, saying, Israel shall be thy name:

took two hundred <u>09_1SA_25_18</u># Then Abigail made haste, and took two hundred loaves, and two bottles of wine, and five sheep ready dressed, and five measures of parched [corn], and an hundred clusters of raisins, and two hundred cakes of figs, and laid [them] on asses.

took two hundred <u>07_JUD_17_04</u> # Yet he restored the money unto his mother; and his mother took two

hundred [shekels] of silver, and gave them to the founder, who made thereof a graven image and a molten image: and they were in the house of Micah.

took two milch <u>09_1SA_06_10</u># And the men did so; and took two milch kine, and tied them to the cart, and shut up their calves at home:

took two of <u>01_GEN_22_03</u># And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.

took under the <u>21_ECC_02_20</u># Therefore I went about to cause my heart to despair of all the labour which I took under the sun.

took unto him 13_1CH_02_19 # And when Azubah was dead, Caleb took unto him Ephrath, which bare him Hur.

took unto him 12_2KI_13_15 # And Elisha said unto him, Take bow and arrows. And he took unto him bow and arrows.

took unto him <u>01_GEN_04_19</u># And Lamech took unto him two wives: the name of the one [was] Adah, and the name of the other Zillah.

took unto him <u>01_GEN_15_10</u> # And he took unto him all these, and divided them in the midst, and laid each piece one against another: but the birds divided he not.

took unto him <u>42_LUK_18_31</u> # Then he took [unto him] the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished.

took unto him <u>40_MAT_01_24</u># Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:

took unto me <u>23_ISA_08_02</u># And I took unto me faithful witnesses to record, Uriah the priest, and Zechariah the son of Jeberechiah.

took unto me <u>38_ZEC_11_07</u># And I will feed the flock of slaughter, [even] you, O poor of the flock. And I took unto me two staves; the one I called Beauty, and the other I called Bands; and I fed the flock.

took unto the <u>01_GEN_28_09</u> # Then went Esau unto Ishmael, and took unto the wives which he had Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael Abraham's son, the sister of Nebajoth, to be his wife.

took unto them <u>44_ACT_17_05</u> # But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people.

took up of <u>40_MAT_14_20</u># And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full.

took up of <u>40_MAT_15_37</u># And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken [meat] that was left seven baskets full.

took up our 44_ACT_21_15 # And after those days we took up our carriages, and went up to Jerusalem.

took up Shadrach <u>27_DAN_03_22</u> # Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flame of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

took up stones 43_JOH_10_31 # Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.

took up that <u>42_LUK_05_25</u># And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.

took up the 11_1KI_08_03 # And all the elders of Israel came, and the priests took up the ark.

took up the <u>11_1KI_13_29</u># And the prophet took up the carcase of the man of God, and laid it upon the ass, and brought it back: and the old prophet came to the city, to mourn and to bury him.

took upon them <u>17_EST_09_27</u> # The Jews ordained, and took upon them, and upon their seed, and upon all such as joined themselves unto them, so as it should not fail, that they would keep these two days according to their writing, and according to their [appointed] time every year;

took us for <u>01_GEN_42_30</u># The man, [who is] the lord of the land, spake roughly to us, and took us for

spies of the country.

took Uzziah who 14_2CH_26_01 # Then all the people of Judah took Uzziah, who [was] sixteen years old, and made him king in the room of his father Amaziah.

took victuals in <u>07_JUD_07_08</u># So the people took victuals in their hand, and their trumpets: and he sent all [the rest of] Israel every man unto his tent, and retained those three hundred men: and the host of Midian was beneath him in the valley.

took your father <u>06_JOS_24_03</u># And I took your father Abraham from the other side of the flood, and led him throughout all the land of Canaan, and multiplied his seed, and gave him Isaac.

took your sin <u>05_DEU_09_21</u># And I took your sin, the calf which ye had made, and burnt it with fire, and stamped it, [and] ground [it] very small, [even] until it was as small as dust: and I cast the dust thereof into the brook that descended out of the mount.

took Zilpah her <u>01_GEN_30_09</u> # When Leah saw that she had left bearing, she took Zilpah her maid, and gave her Jacob to wife.

took Zipporah Moses' <u>02_EXO_18_02</u># Then Jethro, Moses' father in law, took Zipporah, Moses' wife, after he had sent her back,

took <u>13_1CH_04_18</u># And his wife Jehudijah bare Jered the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Jekuthiel the father of Zanoah. And these [are] the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

took <u>05_DEU_02_35</u># Only the cattle we took for a prey unto ourselves, and the spoil of the cities which we took.

tookest thy broidered <u>26_EZE_16_18</u># And tookest thy broidered garments, and coveredst them: and thou hast set mine oil and mine incense before them.

tookest vengeance of 19_PSA_99_08 # Thou answeredst them, O LORD our God: thou wast a God that forgavest them, though thou tookest vengeance of their inventions.

tool after he <u>02_EXO_32_04</u> # And he received [them] at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These [be] thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.
