overtook him in [12 2KI 25 05](#) # And the army of the Chaldees pursued after the king, and overtook him in the plains of Jericho: and all his army were scattered from him.

overtook him in [01 GEN 31 23](#) # And he took his brethren with him, and pursued after him seven days' journey; and they overtook him in the mount Gilead.

took an handful [03 LEV 09 17](#) # And he brought the meat offering, and took an handful thereof, and burnt [it] upon the altar, beside the burnt sacrifice of the morning.

took an harp [09 ISA 16 23](#) # And it came to pass, when the [evil] spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

took an horn [11 1KI 01 39](#) # And Zadok the priest took an horn of oil out of the tabernacle, and anointed Solomon. And they blew the trumpet; and all the people said, God save king Solomon.

took and laid [12\\_2KI\\_20\\_07](#) # And Isaiah said, Take a lump of figs. And they took and laid [it] on the boil, and he recovered.

took and put [02\\_EXO\\_40\\_20](#) # And he took and put the testimony into the ark, and set the staves on the ark, and put the mercy seat above upon the ark:

took away the [14 2CH 30 14](#) # And they arose and took away the altars that [were] in Jerusalem, and all the altars for incense took they away, and cast [them] into the brook Kidron.

took away the [14 2CH 33 15](#) # And he took away the strange gods, and the idol out of the house of the LORD, and all the altars that he had built in the mount of the house of the LORD, and in Jerusalem, and cast [them] out of the city.

took away the [12 2KI 23 11](#) # And he took away the horses that the kings of Judah had given to the sun, at the entering in of the house of the LORD, by the chamber of Nathanmelech the chamberlain, which [was] in the suburbs, and burned the chariots of the sun with fire.

took away the [27 DAN 01 16](#) # Thus Melzar took away the portion of their meat, and the wine that they should drink; and gave them pulse.

took away the [02 EXO 10 19](#) # And the LORD turned a mighty strong west wind, which took away the locusts, and cast them into the Red sea; there remained not one locust in all the coasts of Egypt.

took away the [43 JOH 11 41](#) # Then they took away the stone [from the place] where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up [his] eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.

took away the [07 JUD 08 21](#) # Then Zebah and Zalmunna said, Rise thou, and fall upon us: for as the man [is, so is] his strength. And Gideon arose, and slew Zebah and Zalmunna, and took away the ornaments that [were] on their camels' necks.

took away their [13 1CH 05 21](#) # And they took away their cattle; of their camels fifty thousand, and of sheep two hundred and fifty thousand, and of asses two thousand, and of men an hundred thousand.

took away [12 2KI 25 15](#) # And the firepans, and the bowls, [and] such things as [were] of gold, [in] gold, and of silver, [in] silver, the captain of the guard took away.

took Azariah which [12 2KI 14 21](#) # And all the people of Judah took Azariah, which [was] sixteen years old, and made him king instead of his father Amaziah.

took Balaam and [04 NUM 22 41](#) # And it came to pass on the morrow, that Balak took Balaam, and brought him up into the high places of Baal, that thence he might see the utmost [part] of the people.

took Basmath the [11 1KI 04 15](#) # Ahimaaz [was] in Naphtali; he also took Basmath the daughter of Solomon to wife:

took both one [26 EZE 23 13](#) # Then I saw that she was defiled, [that] they [took] both one way,

Took branches of [43 JOH 12 13](#) # Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed [is] the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.

took bread and [44 ACT 27 35](#) # And when he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken [it], he began to eat.

took bread and [01 GEN 21 14](#) # And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave [it] unto Hagar, putting [it] on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

took bread and [42 LUK 22 19](#) # And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake [it], and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

took bread and [42 LUK 24 30](#) # And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and

blessed [it], and brake, and gave to them.

took bread and [41 MAR 14 22](#) # And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake [it], and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body.

took bread and [40 MAT 26 26](#) # And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed [it], and brake [it], and gave [it] to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

took bread [46 1CO 11 23](#) # For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the [same] night in which he was betrayed took bread:

took bribes and [09 ISA 08 03](#) # And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment.

took butter and [01 GEN 18 08](#) # And he took butter, and milk, and the calf which he had dressed, and set [it] before them; and he stood by them under the tree, and they did eat.

took care of [42 LUK 10 34](#) # And went to [him], and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

took cities from [14 2CH 13 19](#) # And Abijah pursued after Jeroboam, and took cities from him, Bethel with the towns thereof, and Jeshanah with the towns thereof, and Ephraim with the towns thereof.

took counsel against [40 MAT 27 01](#) # When the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death:

took counsel and [11 1KI 12 28](#) # Whereupon the king took counsel, and made two calves [of] gold, and said unto them, It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem: behold thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

took counsel and [40 MAT 27 07](#) # And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

took counsel how [40 MAT 22 15](#) # Then went the Pharisees, and took counsel how they might entangle him in [his] talk.

took counsel to [14 2CH 30 23](#) # And the whole assembly took counsel to keep other seven days: and they kept [other] seven days with gladness.

took counsel to [44 ACT 05 33](#) # When they heard [that], they were cut [to the heart], and took counsel to slay them.

took counsel to [44 ACT 09 23](#) # And after that many days were fulfilled, the Jews took counsel to kill him:

took counsel together [43 JOH 11 53](#) # Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put him to death.

took counsel together [19 PSA 31 13](#) # For I have heard the slander of many: fear [was] on every side: while they took counsel together against me, they devised to take away my life.

took counsel with [14 2CH 10 06](#) # And king Rehoboam took counsel with the old men that had stood before Solomon his father while he yet lived, saying, What counsel give ye [me] to return answer to this people?

took counsel with [14 2CH 10 08](#) # But he forsook the counsel which the old men gave him, and took

counsel with the young men that were brought up with him, that stood before him.

took counsel with [14 2CH 32 03](#) # He took counsel with his princes and his mighty men to stop the waters of the fountains which [were] without the city: and they did help him.

took counsel with [12 2KI 06 08](#) # Then the king of Syria warred against Israel, and took counsel with his servants, saying, In such and such a place [shall be] my camp.

took counsel with [41 MAR 03 06](#) # And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.

took courage and [14 2CH 15 08](#) # And when Asa heard these words, and the prophecy of Oded the prophet, he took courage, and put away the abominable idols out of all the land of Judah and Benjamin, and out of the cities which he had taken from mount Ephraim, and renewed the altar of the LORD, that [was] before the porch of the LORD.

took courage [44 ACT 28 15](#) # And from thence, when the brethren heard of us, they came to meet us as far as Appii forum, and The three taverns: whom when Paul saw, he thanked God, and took courage.

took Dagon and [09 ISA 05 03](#) # And when they of Ashdod arose early on the morrow, behold, Dagon [was] fallen upon his face to the earth before the ark of the LORD. And they took Dagon, and set him in his place again.

took David's servants [13 1CH 19 04](#) # Wherefore Hanun took David's servants, and shaved them, and cut off their garments in the midst hard by their buttocks, and sent them away.

took David's servants [10 2SA 10 04](#) # Wherefore Hanun took David's servants, and shaved off the one half of their beards, and cut off their garments in the middle, [even] to their buttocks, and sent them away.

took Dinah out [01 GEN 34 26](#) # And they slew Hamor and Shechem his son with the edge of the sword, and took Dinah out of Shechem's house, and went out.

took double money [01 GEN 43 15](#) # And the men took that present, and they took double money in their hand, and Benjamin; and rose up, and went down to Egypt, and stood before Joseph.

took down every [01 GEN 44 11](#) # Then they speedily took down every man his sack to the ground, and opened every man his sack.

took down the [09 ISA 06 15](#) # And the Levites took down the ark of the LORD, and the coffer that [was] with it, wherein the jewels of gold [were], and put [them] on the great stone: and the men of Bethshemesh offered burnt offerings and sacrificed sacrifices the same day unto the LORD.

took down the [12 2KI 16 17](#) # And king Ahaz cut off the borders of the bases, and removed the laver from off them; and took down the sea from off the brazen oxen that [were] under it, and put it upon a pavement of stones.

took each man [01 GEN 34 25](#) # And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

took eighteen wives [14 2CH 11 21](#) # And Rehoboam loved Maachah the daughter of Absalom above all his wives and his concubines: [for he took eighteen wives, and threescore concubines; and begat twenty and eight sons, and threescore daughters.]

took either of [03 LEV 10 01](#) # And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer,

and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not.

took every man [14\\_2CH\\_23\\_08](#) # So the Levites and all Judah did according to all things that Jehoiada the priest had commanded, and took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, with them that were to go [out] on the sabbath: for Jehoiada the priest dismissed not the courses.

took every man [12\\_2KI\\_09\\_13](#) # Then they hasted, and took every man his garment, and put [it] under him on the top of the stairs, and blew with trumpets, saying, Jehu is king.

took every man [12\\_2KI\\_11\\_09](#) # And the captains over the hundreds did according to all [things] that Jehoiada the priest commanded: and they took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, with them that should go out on the sabbath, and came to Jehoiada the priest.

took every man [04\\_NUM\\_16\\_18](#) # And they took every man his censer, and put fire in them, and laid incense thereon, and stood in the door of the tabernacle of the congregation with Moses and Aaron.

took every man [04\\_NUM\\_17\\_09](#) # And Moses brought out all the rods from before the LORD unto all the children of Israel: and they looked, and took every man his rod.

took exceeding much [10\\_2SA\\_08\\_08](#) # And from Betah, and from Berothai, cities of Hadadezer, king David took exceeding much brass.

took firebrands and [07\\_JUD\\_15\\_04](#) # And Samson went and caught three hundred foxes, and took firebrands, and turned tail to tail, and put a firebrand in the midst between two tails.

took flour and [09\\_1SA\\_28\\_24](#) # And the woman had a fat calf in the house; and she hasted, and killed it, and took flour, and kneaded [it], and did bake unleavened bread thereof:

took flour and [10\\_2SA\\_13\\_08](#) # So Tamar went to her brother Amnon's house; and he was laid down. And she took flour, and kneaded [it], and made cakes in his sight, and did bake the cakes.

took for a [05\\_DEU\\_02\\_35](#) # Only the cattle we took for a prey unto ourselves, and the spoil of the cities which we took.

took for a [05\\_DEU\\_03\\_07](#) # But all the cattle, and the spoil of the cities, we took for a prey to ourselves.

took for a [06\\_JOS\\_08\\_27](#) # Only the cattle and the spoil of that city Israel took for a prey unto themselves, according unto the word of the LORD which he commanded Joshua.

took for a [06\\_JOS\\_11\\_14](#) # And all the spoil of these cities, and the cattle, the children of Israel took for a prey unto themselves; but every man they smote with the edge of the sword, until they had destroyed them, neither left they any to breathe.

took for him [14\\_2CH\\_24\\_03](#) # And Jehoiada took for him two wives; and he begat sons and daughters.

took for him [02\\_EXO\\_02\\_03](#) # And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid [it] in the flags by the river's brink.

took for himself [09\\_1SA\\_02\\_14](#) # And he struck [it] into the pan, or kettle, or caldron, or pot; all that the fleshhook brought up the priest took for himself. So they did in Shiloh, unto all the Israelites that came thither.

took for his [17\\_EST\\_02\\_07](#) # And he brought up Hadassah, that [is], Esther, his uncle's daughter: for she

had neither father nor mother, and the maid [was] fair and beautiful; whom Mordecai, when her father and mother were dead, took for his own daughter.

took forth out [15 EZR 06 05](#) # And also let the golden and silver vessels of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took forth out of the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, and brought unto Babylon, be restored, and brought again unto the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, [every one] to his place, and place [them] in the house of God.

took from him [13 1CH 18 04](#) # And David took from him a thousand chariots, and seven thousand horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: David also hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them an hundred chariots.

took from him [10 2SA 08 04](#) # And David took from him a thousand [chariots], and seven hundred horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: and David hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them [for] an hundred chariots.

took from them [01 GEN 42 24](#) # And he turned himself about from them, and wept; and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them Simeon, and bound him before their eyes.

took from thy [11 1KI 20 34](#) # And [Benhadad] said unto him, The cities, which my father took from thy father, I will restore; and thou shalt make streets for thee in Damascus, as my father made in Samaria. Then [said Ahab], I will send thee away with this covenant. So he made a covenant with him, and sent him away.

took Gath and [13 1CH 18 01](#) # Now after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them, and took Gath and her towns out of the hand of the Philistines.

took Gaza with [07 JUD 01 18](#) # Also Judah took Gaza with the coast thereof, and Askelon with the coast thereof, and Ekron with the coast thereof.

took Geshur and [13 1CH 02 23](#) # And he took Geshur, and Aram, with the towns of Jair, from them, with Kenath, and the towns thereof, [even] threescore cities. All these [belonged to] the sons of Machir, the father of Gilead.

took Gomer the [28 HOS 01 03](#) # So he went and took Gomer the daughter of Diblaim; which conceived, and bare him a son.

took goodly raiment [01 GEN 27 15](#) # And Rebekah took goodly raiment of her eldest son Esau, which [were] with her in the house, and put them upon Jacob her younger son:

took great indignation [16 NEH 04 01](#) # But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

took Hagar her [01 GEN 16 03](#) # And Sarai Abram's wife took Hagar her maid the Egyptian, after Abram had dwelt ten years in the land of Canaan, and gave her to her husband Abram to be his wife.

took half of [02 EXO 24 06](#) # And Moses took half of the blood, and put [it] in basins; and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar.

took Haman the [17 EST 06 11](#) # Then took Haman the apparel and the horse, and arrayed Mordecai, and brought him on horseback through the street of the city, and proclaimed before him, Thus shall it be done unto the man whom the king delighteth to honour.

took Hazor and [06 JOS 11 10](#) # And Joshua at that time turned back, and took Hazor, and smote the king thereof with the sword: for Hazor beforetime was the head of all those kingdoms.

took he counsel [23 ISA 40 14](#) # With whom took he counsel, and [who] instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and showed to him the way of understanding?

took he him [42 LUK 02 28](#) # Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said,

took he the [04 NUM 03 50](#) # Of the firstborn of the children of Israel took he the money; a thousand three hundred and threescore and five [shekels], after the shekel of the sanctuary:

took her and [10 2SA 11 04](#) # And David sent messengers, and took her; and she came in unto him, and he lay with her; for she was purified from her uncleanness: and she returned unto her house.

took her and [01 GEN 08 09](#) # But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters [were] on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

took her and [01 GEN 34 02](#) # And when Shechem the son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the country, saw her, he took her, and lay with her, and defiled her.

took her and [01 GEN 38 02](#) # And Judah saw there a daughter of a certain Canaanite, whose name [was] Shuah; and he took her, and went in unto her.

took her and [42 LUK 20 31](#) # And the third took her; and in like manner the seven also: and they left no children, and died.

took her and [41 MAR 12 21](#) # And the second took her, and died, neither left he any seed: and the third likewise.

took her by [42 LUK 08 54](#) # And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.

took her by [41 MAR 01 31](#) # And he came and took her by the hand, and lifted her up; and immediately the fever left her, and she ministered unto them.

took her by [40 MAT 09 25](#) # But when the people were put forth, he went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose.

took her from [10 2SA 03 15](#) # And Ishbosheth sent, and took her from [her] husband, [even] from Phaltiel the son of Laish.

took her sons [26 EZE 23 10](#) # These discovered her nakedness: they took her sons and her daughters, and slew her with the sword: and she became famous among women; for they had executed judgment upon her.

took her to [05 DEU 24 03](#) # And [if] the latter husband hate her, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth [it] in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her [to be] his wife;

took her to [42 LUK 20 30](#) # And the second took her to wife, and he died childless.

took her unto [43 JOH 19 27](#) # Then saith he to the disciple, Behold thy mother! And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own [home].

took her up [07 JUD 19 28](#) # And he said unto her, Up, and let us be going. But none answered. Then the man took her [up] upon an ass, and the man rose up, and gat him unto his place.



took him a [01\\_GEN\\_21\\_21](#) # And he dwelt in the wilderness of Paran: and his mother took him a wife out of the land of Egypt.

took him a [18\\_JOB\\_02\\_08](#) # And he took him a potsherd to scrape himself withal; and he sat down among the ashes.

took him and [09\\_ISA\\_17\\_57](#) # And as David returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, Abner took him, and brought him before Saul with the head of the Philistine in his hand.

took him and [10\\_2SA\\_15\\_05](#) # And it was [so], that when any man came night [to him] to do him obeisance, he put forth his hand, and took him, and kissed him.

took him and [44\\_ACT\\_09\\_27](#) # But Barnabas took him, and brought [him] to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.

took him and [44\\_ACT\\_17\\_19](#) # And they took him, and brought him unto Areopagus, saying, May we know what this new doctrine, whereof thou speakest, [is]?

took him and [44\\_ACT\\_21\\_33](#) # Then the chief captain came near, and took him, and commanded [him] to be bound with two chains; and demanded who he was, and what he had done.

took him and [44\\_ACT\\_23\\_18](#) # So he took him, and brought [him] to the chief captain, and said, Paul the prisoner called me unto [him], and prayed me to bring this young man unto thee, who hath something to say unto thee.

took him and [01\\_GEN\\_37\\_24](#) # And they took him, and cast him into a pit: and the pit [was] empty, [there was] no water in it.

took him and [01\\_GEN\\_39\\_20](#) # And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners [were] bound: and he was there in the prison.

took him and [07\\_JUD\\_12\\_06](#) # Then said they unto him, Say now Shibboleth: and he said Sibboleth: for he could not frame to pronounce [it] right. Then they took him, and slew him at the passages of Jordan: and there fell at that time of the Ephraimites forty and two thousand.

took him and [07\\_JUD\\_16\\_21](#) # But the Philistines took him, and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza, and bound him with fetters of brass; and he did grind in the prison house.

took him and [07\\_JUD\\_16\\_31](#) # Then his brethren and all the house of his father came down, and took him, and brought [him] up, and buried him between Zorah and Eshtaol in the buryingplace of Manoah his father. And he judged Israel twenty years.

took him and [42\\_LUK\\_14\\_04](#) # And they held their peace. And he took [him], and healed him, and let him go;

took him and [41\\_MAR\\_08\\_32](#) # And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke him.

took him and [41\\_MAR\\_12\\_08](#) # And they took him, and killed [him], and cast [him] out of the vineyard.

took him and [40\\_MAT\\_16\\_22](#) # Then Peter took him, and began to rebuke him, saying, Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee.

took him aside [10\\_2SA\\_03\\_27](#) # And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate

to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth [rib], that he died, for the blood of Asahel his brother.

took him aside [41 MAR 07 33](#) # And he took him aside from the multitude, and put his fingers into his ears, and he spit, and touched his tongue;

took him away [44 ACT 24 07](#) # But the chief captain Lysias came [upon us], and with great violence took [him] away out of our hands,

took him away [28 HOS 13 11](#) # I gave thee a king in mine anger, and took [him] away in my wrath.

took him by [44 ACT 03 07](#) # And he took him by the right hand, and lifted [him] up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

took him by [44 ACT 09 25](#) # Then the disciples took him by night, and let [him] down by the wall in a basket.

took him by [44 ACT 23 19](#) # Then the chief captain took him by the hand, and went [with him] aside privately, and asked [him], What is that thou hast to tell me?

took him by [41 MAR 09 27](#) # But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose.

took him by [40 MAT 18 28](#) # But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellowservants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took [him] by the throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest.

took him down [44 ACT 13 29](#) # And when they had fulfilled all that was written of him, they took [him] down from the tree, and laid [him] in a sepulchre.

took him down [41 MAR 15 46](#) # And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre.

took him Elisheba [02 EXO 06 23](#) # And Aaron took him Elisheba, daughter of Amminadab, sister of Naashon, to wife; and she bare him Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.

took him even [41 MAR 04 36](#) # And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships.

took him for [40 MAT 21 46](#) # But when they sought to lay hands on him, they feared the multitude, because they took him for a prophet.

took him from [19 PSA 78 70](#) # He chose David also his servant, and took him from the sheepfolds:

took him in [12 2KI 24 12](#) # And Jehoiachin the king of Judah went out to the king of Babylon, he, and his mother, and his servants, and his princes, and his officers: and the king of Babylon took him in the eighth year of his reign.

took him in [44 ACT 20 14](#) # And when he met with us at Assos, we took him in, and came to Mitylene.

took him in [19 PSA 56 01](#) # To the chief Musician upon Jonathelemrechokim, Michtam of David, when the Philistines took him in Gath. Be merciful unto me, O God: for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily oppresseth me.

took him Jochebed [02 EXO 06 20](#) # And Amram took him Jochebed his father's sister to wife; and she

bare him Aaron and Moses: and the years of the life of Amram [were] an hundred and thirty and seven years.

took him Mahalath [14 2CH 11 18](#) # And Rehoboam took him Mahalath the daughter of Jerimoth the son of David to wife, [and] Abihail the daughter of Eliab the son of Jesse;

took him more [10 2SA 05 13](#) # And David took [him] more concubines and wives out of Jerusalem, after he was come from Hebron: and there were yet sons and daughters born to David.

took him one [02 EXO 06 25](#) # And Eleazar Aaron's son took him [one] of the daughters of Putiel to wife; and she bare him Phinehas: these [are] the heads of the fathers of the Levites according to their families.

took him out [11 1KI 17 19](#) # And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her bosom, and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, and laid him upon his own bed.

took him out [14 2CH 35 24](#) # His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.

took him out [24 JER 37 17](#) # Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took him out: and the king asked him secretly in his house, and said, Is there [any] word from the LORD? And Jeremiah said, There is: for, said he, thou shalt be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon.

took him saying [24 JER 26 08](#) # Now it came to pass, when Jeremiah had made an end of speaking all that the LORD had commanded [him] to speak unto all the people, that the priests and the prophets and all the people took him, saying, Thou shalt surely die.

took him that [09 ISA 18 02](#) # And Saul took him that day, and would let him go no more home to his father's house.

took him unto [09 ISA 14 52](#) # And there was sore war against the Philistines all the days of Saul: and when Saul saw any strong man, or any valiant man, he took him unto him.

took him unto [44 ACT 18 26](#) # And he began to speak boldly in the synagogue: whom when Aquila and Priscilla had heard, they took him unto [them], and expounded unto him the way of God more perfectly.

took him up [09 ISA 01 24](#) # And when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, with three bullocks, and one ephah of flour, and a bottle of wine, and brought him unto the house of the LORD in Shiloh: and the child [was] young.

took him up [12 2KI 10 15](#) # And when he was departed thence, he lighted on Jehonadab the son of Rechab [coming] to meet him: and he saluted him, and said to him, Is thine heart right, as my heart [is] with thy heart? And Jehonadab answered, It is. If it be, give [me] thine hand. And he gave [him] his hand; and he took him up to him into the chariot.

took him up [10 2SA 04 04](#) # And Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son [that was] lame of [his] feet. He was five years old when the tidings came of Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and his nurse took him up, and fled: and it came to pass, as she made haste to flee, that he fell, and became lame. And his name [was] Mephibosheth.

took him up [44 ACT 07 21](#) # And when he was cast out, Pharaoh's daughter took him up, and nourished him for her own son.

took him up [44 ACT 10 26](#) # But Peter took him up, saying, Stand up; I myself also am a man.

took him up [24 JER 38 13](#) # So they drew up Jeremiah with cords, and took him up out of the dungeon: and Jeremiah remained in the court of the prison.

took him [01 GEN 05 24](#) # And Enoch walked with God: and he [was] not; for God took him.

took him [41 MAR 14 46](#) # And they laid their hands on him, and took him.

took him [40 MAT 26 50](#) # And Jesus said unto him, Friend, wherefore art thou come? Then came they, and laid hands on Jesus, and took him.

took his brethren [01 GEN 31 23](#) # And he took his brethren with him, and pursued after him seven days' journey; and they overtook him in the mount Gilead.

took his brother [28 HOS 12 03](#) # He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and by his strength he had power with God:

took his concubine [07 JUD 19 25](#) # But the men would not hearken to him: so the man took his concubine, and brought her forth unto them; and they knew her, and abused her all the night until the morning: and when the day began to spring, they let her go.

took his eldest [12 2KI 03 27](#) # Then he took his eldest son that should have reigned in his stead, and offered him [for] a burnt offering upon the wall. And there was great indignation against Israel: and they departed from him, and returned to [their own] land.

took his garments [43 JOH 19 23](#) # Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also [his] coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout.

took his glory [27 DAN 05 20](#) # But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him:

took his head [13 1CH 10 09](#) # And when they had stripped him, they took his head, and his armour, and sent into the land of the Philistines round about, to carry tidings unto their idols, and to the people.

took his head [10 2SA 04 07](#) # For when they came into the house, he lay on his bed in his bedchamber, and they smote him, and slew him, and beheaded him, and took his head, and gat them away through the plain all night.

took his journey [01 GEN 46 01](#) # And Israel took his journey with all that he had, and came to Beersheba, and offered sacrifices unto the God of his father Isaac.

took his journey [42 LUK 15 13](#) # And not many days after the younger son gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country, and there wasted his substance with riotous living.

took his journey [40 MAT 25 15](#) # And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

took his leave [44 ACT 18 18](#) # And Paul [after this] tarried [there] yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn [his] head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow.

took his mantle [12 2KI 02 08](#) # And Elijah took his mantle, and wrapped [it] together, and smote the

waters, and they were divided hither and thither, so that they two went over on dry ground.

took his people [02\\_EXO\\_14\\_06](#) # And he made ready his chariot, and took his people with him:

took his ring [17\\_EST\\_03\\_10](#) # And the king took his ring from his hand, and gave it unto Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, the Jews' enemy.

took his servants [40\\_MAT\\_21\\_35](#) # And the husbandmen took his servants, and beat one, and killed another, and stoned another.

took his servants [40\\_MAT\\_22\\_06](#) # And the remnant took his servants, and entreated [them] spitefully, and slew [them].

took his staff [09\\_ISA\\_17\\_40](#) # And he took his staff in his hand, and chose him five smooth stones out of the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag which he had, even in a scrip; and his sling [was] in his hand: and he drew near to the Philistine.

took his sword [09\\_ISA\\_17\\_51](#) # Therefore David ran, and stood upon the Philistine, and took his sword, and drew it out of the sheath thereof, and slew him, and cut off his head therewith. And when the Philistines saw their champion was dead, they fled.

took his two [01\\_GEN\\_32\\_22](#) # And he rose up that night, and took his two wives, and his two womenservants, and his eleven sons, and passed over the ford Jabbok.

took his wife [02\\_EXO\\_04\\_20](#) # And Moses took his wife and his sons, and set them upon an ass, and he returned to the land of Egypt: and Moses took the rod of God in his hand.

took his wives [01\\_GEN\\_36\\_02](#) # Esau took his wives of the daughters of Canaan; Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah the daughter of Zibeon the Hivite;

took his wives [01\\_GEN\\_36\\_06](#) # And Esau took his wives, and his sons, and his daughters, and all the persons of his house, and his cattle, and all his beasts, and all his substance, which he had got in the land of Canaan; and went into the country from the face of his brother Jacob.

took hold of [12\\_2KI\\_02\\_12](#) # And Elisha saw [it], and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces.

took hold of [10\\_2SA\\_04\\_10](#) # When one told me, saying, Behold, Saul is dead, thinking to have brought good tidings, I took hold of him, and slew him in Ziklag, who [thought] that I would have given him a reward for his tidings:

took hold of [10\\_2SA\\_06\\_06](#) # And when they came to Nachon's threshingfloor, Uzzah put forth [his hand] to the ark of God, and took hold of it; for the oxen shook [it].

took hold of [10\\_2SA\\_13\\_11](#) # And when she had brought [them] unto him to eat, he took hold of her, and said unto her, Come lie with me, my sister.

took hold of [26\\_EZE\\_29\\_07](#) # When they took hold of thee by thy hand, thou didst break, and rend all their shoulder: and when they leaned upon thee, thou brakest, and madest all their loins to be at a stand.

took hold of [24\\_JER\\_50\\_43](#) # The king of Babylon hath heard the report of them, and his hands waxed feeble: anguish took hold of him, [and] pangs as of a woman in travail.

took hold of [07\\_JUD\\_16\\_29](#) # And Samson took hold of the two middle pillars upon which the house stood,

and on which it was borne up, of the one with his right hand, and of the other with his left.

took hold on [10 2SA 01 11](#) # Then David took hold on his clothes, and rent them; and likewise all the men that [were] with him:

took hold on [01 GEN 25 26](#) # And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac [was] threescore years old when she bare them.

took hold upon [19 PSA 48 06](#) # Fear took hold upon them there, [and] pain, as of a woman in travail.

took hot for [06 JOS 09 12](#) # This our bread we took hot [for] our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; but now, behold, it is dry, and it is mouldy:

took I the [24 JER 25 17](#) # Then took I the cup at the LORD'S hand, and made all the nations to drink, unto whom the LORD had sent me:

took Ijon and [12 2KI 15 29](#) # In the days of Pekah king of Israel came Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and took Ijon, and Abelbethmaachah, and Janoah, and Kedesh, and Hazor, and Gilead, and Galilee, all the land of Naphtali, and carried them captive to Assyria.

took in battle [06 JOS 11 19](#) # There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, save the Hivites the inhabitants of Gibeon: all [other] they took in battle.

took in his [02 EXO 34 04](#) # And he hewed two tables of stone like unto the first; and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up unto mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand the two tables of stone.

took in hunting [20 PRO 12 27](#) # The slothful [man] roasteth not that which he took in hunting: but the substance of a diligent man [is] precious.

took in thirty [07 JUD 12 09](#) # And he had thirty sons, and thirty daughters, [whom] he sent abroad, and took in thirty daughters from abroad for his sons. And he judged Israel seven years.

took Ishbosheth the [10 2SA 02 08](#) # But Abner the son of Ner, captain of Saul's host, took Ishbosheth the son of Saul, and brought him over to Mahanaim;

took Ishmael his [01 GEN 17 23](#) # And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him.

took it and [13 1CH 11 18](#) # And the three brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: but David would not drink [of] it, but poured it out to the LORD,

took it and [14 2CH 24 11](#) # Now it came to pass, that at what time the chest was brought unto the king's office by the hand of the Levites, and when they saw that [there was] much money, the king's scribe and the high priest's officer came and emptied the chest, and took it, and carried it to his place again. Thus they did day by day, and gathered money in abundance.

took it and [12 2KI 12 17](#) # Then Hazael king of Syria went up, and fought against Gath, and took it: and Hazael set his face to go up to Jerusalem.

took it and [12 2KI 16 09](#) # And the king of Assyria hearkened unto him: for the king of Assyria went up against Damascus, and took it, and carried [the people of] it captive to Kir, and slew Rezin.



took it and [10 2SA 23 16](#) # And the three mighty men brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: nevertheless he would not drink thereof, but poured it out unto the LORD.

took it and [26 EZE 10 07](#) # And [one] cherub stretched forth his hand from between the cherubims unto the fire that [was] between the cherubims, and took [thereof], and put [it] into the hands of [him that was] clothed with linen: who took [it], and went out.

took it and [06 JOS 08 19](#) # And the ambush arose quickly out of their place, and they ran as soon as he had stretched out his hand: and they entered into the city, and took it, and hasted and set the city on fire.

took it and [06 JOS 10 37](#) # And they took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof, and all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining, according to all that he had done to Eglon; but destroyed it utterly, and all the souls that [were] therein.

took it and [06 JOS 10 39](#) # And he took it, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof; and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and utterly destroyed all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining: as he had done to Hebron, so he did to Debir, and to the king thereof; as he had done also to Libnah, and to her king.

took it and [06 JOS 15 17](#) # And Othniel the son of Kenaz, the brother of Caleb, took it: and he gave him Achsah his daughter to wife.

took it and [06 JOS 19 47](#) # And the coast of the children of Dan went out [too little] for them: therefore the children of Dan went up to fight against Leshem, and took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and possessed it, and dwelt therein, and called Leshem, Dan, after the name of Dan their father.

took it and [07 JUD 01 13](#) # And Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger brother, took it: and he gave him Achsah his daughter to wife.

took it and [07 JUD 09 48](#) # And Abimelech gat him up to mount Zalmon, he and all the people that [were] with him; and Abimelech took an ax in his hand, and cut down a bough from the trees, and took it, and laid [it] on his shoulder, and said unto the people that [were] with him, What ye have seen me do, make haste, [and] do as I [have done].

took it and [07 JUD 15 15](#) # And he found a new jawbone of an ass, and put forth his hand, and took it, and slew a thousand men therewith.

took it And [07 JUD 17 02](#) # And he said unto his mother, The eleven hundred [shekels] of silver that were taken from thee, about which thou cursedst, and spakest of also in mine ears, behold, the silver [is] with me; I took it. And his mother said, Blessed [be thou] of the LORD, my son.

took it and [42 LUK 24 43](#) # And he took [it], and did eat before them.

took it and [04 NUM 32 39](#) # And the children of Machir the son of Manasseh went to Gilead, and took it, and dispossessed the Amorite which [was] in it.

took it down [42 LUK 23 53](#) # And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.

took it even [12 2KI 18 10](#) # And at the end of three years they took it: [even] in the sixth year of Hezekiah, that [is] the ninth year of Hoshea king of Israel, Samaria was taken.

took it from [13 1CH 17 13](#) # I will be his father, and he shall be my son: and I will not take my mercy away from him, as I took [it] from [him] that was before thee:

took it from [10 2SA 07 15](#) # But my mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took [it] from Saul, whom I put away before thee.

took it on [06 JOS 10 32](#) # And the LORD delivered Lachish into the hand of Israel, which took it on the second day, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and all the souls that [were] therein, according to all that he had done to Libnah.

took it on [06 JOS 10 35](#) # And they took it on that day, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and all the souls that [were] therein he utterly destroyed that day, according to all that he had done to Lachish.

took it out [51 COL 02 14](#) # Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

took it out [02 EXO 04 06](#) # And the LORD said furthermore unto him, Put now thine hand into thy bosom. And he put his hand into his bosom: and when he took it out, behold, his hand [was] leprous as snow.

took it out [24 JER 36 21](#) # So the king sent Jehudi to fetch the roll: and he took it out of Elishama the scribe's chamber. And Jehudi read it in the ears of the king, and in the ears of all the princes which stood beside the king.

took it to [14 2CH 29 16](#) # And the priests went into the inner part of the house of the LORD, to cleanse [it], and brought out all the uncleanness that they found in the temple of the LORD into the court of the house of the LORD. And the Levites took [it], to carry [it] out abroad into the brook Kidron.

took it up [08 RUT 02 18](#) # And she took [it] up, and went into the city: and her mother in law saw what she had gleaned: and she brought forth, and gave to her that she had reserved after she was sufficed.

took it [12 2KI 06 07](#) # Therefore said he, Take [it] up to thee. And he put out his hand, and took it.

took it [10 2SA 12 29](#) # And David gathered all the people together, and went to Rabbah, and fought against it, and took it.

took it [01 GEN 33 11](#) # Take, I pray thee, my blessing that is brought to thee; because God hath dealt graciously with me, and because I have enough. And he urged him, and he took [it].

took it [23 ISA 20 01](#) # In the year that Tartan came unto Ashdod [when Sargon the king of Assyria sent him,] and fought against Ashdod, and took it;

took it [07 JUD 09 50](#) # Then went Abimelech to Thebez, and encamped against Thebez, and took it.

took Jaazaniah the [24 JER 35 03](#) # Then I took Jaazaniah the son of Jeremiah, the son of Habaziah, and his brethren, and all his sons, and the whole house of the Rechabites;

took Jehoahaz away [12 2KI 23 34](#) # And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt, and died there.

took Jehoahaz his [14 2CH 36 04](#) # And the king of Egypt made Eliakim his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem, and turned his name to Jehoiakim. And Necho took Jehoahaz his brother, and carried him to Egypt.

took Jehoahaz the [14 2CH 36 01](#) # Then the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and made him king in his father's stead in Jerusalem.

took Jehoahaz the [12\\_2KI\\_23\\_30](#) # And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

took Jeremiah and [24\\_JER\\_37\\_14](#) # Then said Jeremiah, [It is] false; I fall not away to the Chaldeans. But he hearkened not to him: so Irijah took Jeremiah, and brought him to the princes.

took Jeremiah and [24\\_JER\\_40\\_02](#) # And the captain of the guard took Jeremiah, and said unto him, The LORD thy God hath pronounced this evil upon this place.

took Jeremiah another [24\\_JER\\_36\\_32](#) # Then took Jeremiah another roll, and gave it to Baruch the scribe, the son of Neriah; who wrote therein from the mouth of Jeremiah all the words of the book which Jehoiakim king of Judah had burned in the fire: and there were added besides unto them many like words.

took Jeremiah out [24\\_JER\\_39\\_14](#) # Even they sent, and took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: so he dwelt among the people.

took Jeremiah the [24\\_JER\\_37\\_13](#) # And when he was in the gate of Benjamin, a captain of the ward [was] there, whose name [was] Irijah, the son of Shelemiah, the son of Hananiah; and he took Jeremiah the prophet, saying, Thou fallest away to the Chaldeans.

took Jeremiah the [24\\_JER\\_38\\_14](#) # Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took Jeremiah the prophet unto him into the third entry that [is] in the house of the LORD: and the king said unto Jeremiah, I will ask thee a thing; hide nothing from me.

took Jesus and [43\\_JOH\\_18\\_12](#) # Then the band and the captain and officers of the Jews took Jesus, and bound him,

took Jesus and [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_01](#) # Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged [him].

took Jesus and [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_16](#) # Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be crucified. And they took Jesus, and led [him] away.

took Jesus into [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_27](#) # Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the common hall, and gathered unto him the whole band [of soldiers].

took Jesus [44\\_ACT\\_01\\_16](#) # Men [and] brethren, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus.

took Joash the [14\\_2CH\\_22\\_11](#) # But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

took Joash the [12\\_2KI\\_11\\_02](#) # But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

took Johanan the [24\\_JER\\_41\\_16](#) # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war, and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

took Joseph's coat [01 GEN 37 31](#) # And they took Joseph's coat, and killed a kid of the goats, and dipped the coat in the blood;

took Joshua and [04 NUM 27 22](#) # And Moses did as the LORD commanded him: and he took Joshua, and set him before Eleazar the priest, and before all the congregation:

took joyfully the [58 HEB 10 34](#) # For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.

took Kenath and [04 NUM 32 42](#) # And Nobah went and took Kenath, and the villages thereof, and called it Nobah, after his own name.

took knowledge of [44 ACT 04 13](#) # Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

took Leah his [01 GEN 29 23](#) # And it came to pass in the evening, that he took Leah his daughter, and brought her to him; and he went in unto her.

took Lot Abram's [01 GEN 14 12](#) # And they took Lot, Abram's brother's son, who dwelt in Sodom, and his goods, and departed.

took Maachah the [14 2CH 11 20](#) # And after her he took Maachah the daughter of Absalom; which bare him Abijah, and Attai, and Ziza, and Shelomith.

took Makkedah and [06 JOS 10 28](#) # And that day Joshua took Makkedah, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof he utterly destroyed, them, and all the souls that [were] therein; he let none remain: and he did to the king of Makkedah as he did unto the king of Jericho.

took Manasseh among [14 2CH 33 11](#) # Wherefore the LORD brought upon them the captains of the host of the king of Assyria, which took Manasseh among the thorns, and bound him with fetters, and carried him to Babylon.

took Mark and [44 ACT 15 39](#) # And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;

took Mary a [43 JOH 12 03](#) # Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

took me as [30 AMO 07 15](#) # And the LORD took me as I followed the flock, and the LORD said unto me, Go, prophesy unto my people Israel.

took me away [26 EZE 03 14](#) # So the spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me.

took me by [26 EZE 08 03](#) # And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where [was] the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy.

took me not [41 MAR 14 49](#) # I was daily with you in the temple teaching, and ye took me not: but the scriptures must be fulfilled.

took me not [40 MAT 25 43](#) # I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not.

took me out [19 PSA 22 09](#) # But thou [art] he that took me out of the womb: thou didst make me hope [when I was] upon my mother's breasts.

took me out [19 PSA 71 06](#) # By thee have I been holden up from the womb: thou art he that took me out of my mother's bowels: my praise [shall be] continually of thee.

took me up [26 EZE 03 12](#) # Then the spirit took me up, and I heard behind me a voice of a great rushing, [saying], Blessed [be] the glory of the LORD from his place.

took me up [26 EZE 43 05](#) # So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.

took me up [26 EZE 43 05](#) # So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.

took men with [11 1KI 11 18](#) # And they arose out of Midian, and came to Paran: and they took men with them out of Paran, and they came to Egypt, unto Pharaoh king of Egypt; which gave him an house, and appointed him victuals, and gave him land.

took men [04 NUM 16 01](#) # Now Korah, the son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi, and Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, and On, the son of Peleth, sons of Reuben, took [men]:

took Methegammah out [10 2SA 08 01](#) # And after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them: and David took Methegammah out of the hand of the Philistines.

took more wives [13 1CH 14 03](#) # And David took more wives at Jerusalem: and David begat more sons and daughters.

took much spoil [14 2CH 25 13](#) # But the soldiers of the army which Amaziah sent back, that they should not go with him to battle, fell upon the cities of Judah, from Samaria even unto Bethhoron, and smote three thousand of them, and took much spoil.

took my concubine [07 JUD 20 06](#) # And I took my concubine, and cut her in pieces, and sent her throughout all the country of the inheritance of Israel: for they have committed lewdness and folly in Israel.

took my son [11 1KI 03 20](#) # And she arose at midnight, and took my son from beside me, while thine

handmaid slept, and laid it in her bosom, and laid her dead child in my bosom.

took my staff [38 ZEC 11 10](#) # And I took my staff, [even] Beauty, and cut it asunder, that I might break my covenant which I had made with all the people.

took new ropes [07 JUD 16 12](#) # Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And [there were] liers in wait abiding in the chamber. And he brake them from off his arms like a thread.

took no gain [07 JUD 05 19](#) # The kings came [and] fought, then fought the kings of Canaan in Taanach by the waters of Megiddo; they took no gain of money.

took no heed [12 2KI 10 31](#) # But Jehu took no heed to walk in the law of the LORD God of Israel with all his heart: for he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam, which made Israel to sin.

took no heed [10 2SA 20 10](#) # But Amasa took no heed to the sword that [was] in Joab's hand: so he smote him therewith in the fifth [rib], and shed out his bowels to the ground, and struck him not again; and he died. So Joab and Abishai his brother pursued after Sheba the son of Bichri.

took no oil [40 MAT 25 03](#) # They that [were] foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

took not away [02 EXO 13 22](#) # He took not away the pillar of the cloud by day, nor the pillar of fire by night, [from] before the people.

took not away [07 JUD 11 15](#) # And said unto him, Thus saith Jephthah, Israel took not away the land of Moab, nor the land of the children of Ammon:

took not away [19 PSA 69 04](#) # They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, [being] mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored [that] which I took not away.

took not from [05 DEU 03 04](#) # And we took all his cities at that time, there was not a city which we took not from them, threescore cities, all the region of Argob, the kingdom of Og in Bashan.

took not on [58 HEB 02 16](#) # For verily he took not on [him the nature of] angels; but he took on [him] the seed of Abraham.

took not the [13 1CH 27 23](#) # But David took not the number of them from twenty years old and under: because the LORD had said he would increase Israel like to the stars of the heavens.

took not warning [26 EZE 33 05](#) # He heard the sound of the trumpet, and took not warning; his blood shall be upon him. But he that taketh warning shall deliver his soul.

took not when [24 JER 27 20](#) # Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem;

took notice of [10 2SA 03 36](#) # And all the people took notice [of it], and it pleased them: as whatsoever the king did pleased all the people.

took of every [01 GEN 08 20](#) # And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

took of that [01 GEN 32 13](#) # And he lodged there that same night; and took of that which came to his hand a present for Esau his brother;



took of the [09 ISA 15 21](#) # But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God in Gilgal.

took of the [05 DEU 01 25](#) # And they took of the fruit of the land in their hands, and brought [it] down unto us, and brought us word again, and said, [It is] a good land which the LORD our God doth give us.

took of their [06 JOS 09 14](#) # And the men took of their victuals, and asked not [counsel] at the mouth of the LORD.

took off his [17 EST 08 02](#) # And the king took off his ring, which he had taken from Haman, and gave it unto Mordecai. And Esther set Mordecai over the house of Haman.

took off his [01 GEN 41 42](#) # And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck;

took off the [41 MAR 15 20](#) # And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to crucify him.

took off their [02 EXO 14 25](#) # And took off their chariot wheels, that they drave them heavily: so that the Egyptians said, Let us flee from the face of Israel; for the LORD fighteth for them against the Egyptians.

took oil in [40 MAT 25 04](#) # But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.

took old sacks [06 JOS 09 04](#) # They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up;

took on him [58 HEB 02 16](#) # For verily he took not on [him the nature of] angels; but he took on [him] the seed of Abraham.

took one of [01 GEN 02 21](#) # And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and

he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

took one of [16 NEH 07 63](#) # And of the priests: the children of Habaiah, the children of Koz, the children of Barzillai, which took [one] of the daughters of Barzillai the Gileadite to wife, and was called after their name.

took one portion [04 NUM 31 47](#) # Even of the children of Israel's half, Moses took one portion of fifty, [both] of man and of beast, and gave them unto the Levites, which kept the charge of the tabernacle of the LORD; as the LORD commanded Moses.

took one unleavened [03 LEV 08 26](#) # And out of the basket of unleavened bread, that [was] before the LORD, he took one unleavened cake, and a cake of oiled bread, and one wafer, and put [them] on the fat, and upon the right shoulder:

took out of [06 JOS 04 20](#) # And those twelve stones, which they took out of Jordan, did Joshua pitch in Gilgal.

took out two [42 LUK 10 35](#) # And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave [them] to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.

took Peter and [42 LUK 09 28](#) # And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray.

took Pharaoh's daughter [11 1KI 03 01](#) # And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

took Rebekah and [01 GEN 24 61](#) # And Rebekah arose, and her damsels, and they rode upon the camels, and followed the man: and the servant took Rebekah, and went his way.

took Rebekah and [01 GEN 24 67](#) # And Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he loved her: and Isaac was comforted after his mother's [death].

took Rebekah to [01 GEN 25 20](#) # And Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah to wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padanaram, the sister to Laban the Syrian.

took Ruth and [08 RUT 04 13](#) # So Boaz took Ruth, and she was his wife: and when he went in unto her, the LORD gave her conception, and she bare a son.

took sackcloth and [10 2SA 21 10](#) # And Rizpah the daughter of Aiah took sackcloth, and spread it for her upon the rock, from the beginning of harvest until water dropped upon them out of heaven, and suffered neither the birds of the air to rest on them by day, nor the beasts of the field by night.

took Samaria and [12 2KI 17 06](#) # In the ninth year of Hoshea the king of Assyria took Samaria, and carried Israel away into Assyria, and placed them in Halah and in Habor [by] the river of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes.

took Sarah [01 GEN 20 02](#) # And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She [is] my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

took Sarai his [01 GEN 12 05](#) # And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran; and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came.

took Saul and [09 1SA 09 22](#) # And Samuel took Saul and his servant, and brought them into the parlour, and made them sit in the chiefest place among them that were bidden, which [were] about thirty persons.

took Selah by [12 2KI 14 07](#) # He slew of Edom in the valley of salt ten thousand, and took Selah by war, and called the name of it Joktheel unto this day.

took Seraiah the [12 2KI 25 18](#) # And the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest, and Zephaniah the second priest, and the three keepers of the door:

took Seraiah the [24 JER 52 24](#) # And the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest, and Zephaniah the second priest, and the three keepers of the door:

took sheep and [09 1SA 14 32](#) # And the people flew upon the spoil, and took sheep, and oxen, and calves, and slew [them] on the ground: and the people did eat [them] with the blood.

took sheep and [01 GEN 20 14](#) # And Abimelech took sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and womenservants, and gave [them] unto Abraham, and restored him Sarah his wife.

took sheep and [01 GEN 21 27](#) # And Abraham took sheep and oxen, and gave them unto Abimelech; and both of them made a covenant.

took ship and [44 ACT 21 06](#) # And when we had taken our leave one of another, we took ship; and they returned home again.

took ship and [40\\_MAT\\_15\\_39](#) # And he sent away the multitude, and took ship, and came into the coasts of Magdala.

took shipping and [43\\_JOH\\_06\\_24](#) # When the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, neither his disciples, they also took shipping, and came to Capernaum, seeking for Jesus.

took six hundred [02\\_EXO\\_14\\_07](#) # And he took six hundred chosen chariots, and all the chariots of Egypt, and captains over every one of them.

took soldiers and [44\\_ACT\\_21\\_32](#) # Who immediately took soldiers and centurions, and ran down unto them: and when they saw the chief captain and the soldiers, they left beating of Paul.

took some meat [44\\_ACT\\_27\\_36](#) # Then were they all of good cheer, and they also took [some] meat.

took some of [01\\_GEN\\_47\\_02](#) # And he took some of his brethren, [even] five men, and presented them unto Pharaoh.

took some of [04\\_NUM\\_21\\_01](#) # And [when] king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south, heard tell that Israel came by the way of the spies; then he fought against Israel, and took [some] of them prisoners.

took Sosthenes the [44\\_ACT\\_18\\_17](#) # Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and beat [him] before the judgment seat. And Gallio cared for none of those things.

took stones and [01\\_GEN\\_31\\_46](#) # And Jacob said unto his brethren, Gather stones; and they took stones, and made an heap: and they did eat there upon the heap.

took strong cities [16\\_NEH\\_09\\_25](#) # And they took strong cities, and a fat land, and possessed houses full of all goods, wells digged, vineyards, and oliveyards, and fruit trees in abundance: so they did eat, and were filled, and became fat, and delighted themselves in thy great goodness.

took sweet counsel [19\\_PSA\\_55\\_14](#) # We took sweet counsel together, [and] walked unto the house of God in company.

took ten camels [01\\_GEN\\_24\\_10](#) # And the servant took ten camels of the camels of his master, and departed; for all the goods of his master [were] in his hand: and he arose, and went to Mesopotamia, unto the city of Nahor.

took ten men [07\\_JUD\\_06\\_27](#) # Then Gideon took ten men of his servants, and did as the LORD had said unto him: and [so] it was, because he feared his father's household, and the men of the city, that he could not do [it] by day, that he did [it] by night.

took ten men [08\\_RUT\\_04\\_02](#) # And he took ten men of the elders of the city, and said, Sit ye down here. And they sat down.

took that present [01\\_GEN\\_43\\_15](#) # And the men took that present, and they took double money in their hand, and Benjamin; and rose up, and went down to Egypt, and stood before Joseph.

took the anointing [03\\_LEV\\_08\\_10](#) # And Moses took the anointing oil, and anointed the tabernacle and all that [was] therein, and sanctified them.

took the ark [09\\_1SA\\_05\\_01](#) # And the Philistines took the ark of God, and brought it from Ebenezer unto Ashdod.

took the ark [09\\_1SA\\_05\\_02](#) # When the Philistines took the ark of God, they brought it into the house of Dagon, and set it by Dagon.

took the ashes [11\\_1KI\\_20\\_41](#) # And he hasted, and took the ashes away from his face; and the king of Israel discerned him that he [was] of the prophets.

took the blind [41\\_MAR\\_08\\_23](#) # And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.

took the blood [02\\_EXO\\_24\\_08](#) # And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled [it] on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.

took the blood [58\\_HEB\\_09\\_19](#) # For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,

took the breast [03\\_LEV\\_08\\_29](#) # And Moses took the breast, and waved it [for] a wave offering before the LORD: [for] of the ram of consecration it was Moses' part; as the LORD commanded Moses.

took the bullock [11\\_1KI\\_18\\_26](#) # And they took the bullock which was given them, and they dressed [it], and called on the name of Baal from morning even until noon, saying, O Baal, hear us. But [there was] no voice, nor any that answered. And they leaped upon the altar which was made.

took the cakes [10\\_2SA\\_13\\_10](#) # And Amnon said unto Tamar, Bring the meat into the chamber, that I may

eat of thine hand. And Tamar took the cakes which she had made, and brought [them] into the chamber to Amnon her brother.

took the calf [02\\_EXO\\_32\\_20](#) # And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt [it] in the fire, and ground [it] to powder, and strowed [it] upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink [of it].

took the captain [24\\_JER\\_52\\_19](#) # And the basins, and the firepans, and the bowls, and the caldrons, and the candlesticks, and the spoons, and the cups; [that] which [was] of gold [in] gold, and [that] which [was] of silver [in] silver, took the captain of the guard away.

took the captains [14\\_2CH\\_23\\_01](#) # And in the seventh year Jehoiada strengthened himself, and took the captains of hundreds, Azariah the son of Jeroham, and Ishmael the son of Jehohanan, and Azariah the son of Obed, and Maaseiah the son of Adaiah, and Elishaphat the son of Zichri, into covenant with him.

took the captains [14\\_2CH\\_23\\_20](#) # And he took the captains of hundreds, and the nobles, and the governors of the people, and all the people of the land, and brought down the king from the house of the LORD: and they came through the high gate into the king's house, and set the king upon the throne of the kingdom.

took the captives [14\\_2CH\\_28\\_15](#) # And the men which were expressed by name rose up, and took the captives, and with the spoil clothed all that were naked among them, and arrayed them, and shod them, and gave them to eat and to drink, and anointed them, and carried all the feeble of them upon asses, and brought them to Jericho, the city of palm trees, to their brethren: then they returned to Samaria.

took the child [11\\_1KI\\_17\\_23](#) # And Elijah took the child, and brought him down out of the chamber into the house, and delivered him unto his mother: and Elijah said, See, thy son liveth.

took the child [02\\_EXO\\_02\\_09](#) # And Pharaoh's daughter said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give [thee] thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it.

took the child [08\\_RUT\\_04\\_16](#) # And Naomi took the child, and laid it in her bosom, and became nurse unto it.

took the city [06\\_JOS\\_06\\_20](#) # So the people shouted when [the priests] blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

took the city [07\\_JUD\\_09\\_45](#) # And Abimelech fought against the city all that day; and he took the city, and slew the people that [was] therein, and beat down the city, and sowed it with salt.

took the crown [13\\_1CH\\_20\\_02](#) # And David took the crown of their king from off his head, and found it to weigh a talent of gold, and [there were] precious stones in it; and it was set upon David's head: and he brought also exceeding much spoil out of the city.

took the crown [10\\_2SA\\_01\\_10](#) # So I stood upon him, and slew him, because I was sure that he could not



live after that he was fallen: and I took the crown that [was] upon his head, and the bracelet that [was] on his arm, and have brought them hither unto my lord.

took the cup [46 ICO 11 25](#) # After the same manner also [he took] the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink [it], in remembrance of me.

took the cup [42 LUK 22 17](#) # And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide [it] among yourselves:

took the cup [41 MAR 14 23](#) # And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave [it] to them: and they all drank of it.

took the evidence [24 JER 32 11](#) # So I took the evidence of the purchase, [both] that which was sealed [according] to the law and custom, and that which was open:

took the family [06 JOS 07 17](#) # And he brought the family of Judah; and he took the family of the Zarhites: and he brought the family of the Zarhites man by man; and Zabdi was taken:

took the fat [03 LEV 08 25](#) # And he took the fat, and the rump, and all the fat that [was] upon the inwards, and the caul [above] the liver, and the two kidneys, and their fat, and the right shoulder:

took the fenced [14 2CH 12 04](#) # And he took the fenced cities which [pertained] to Judah, and came to Jerusalem.

took the fire [01 GEN 22 06](#) # And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid [it] upon Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together.

took the five [42 LUK 09 16](#) # Then he took the five loaves and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed them, and brake, and gave to the disciples to set before the multitude.

took the five [40 MAT 14 19](#) # And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to [his] disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

took the fords [07 JUD 03 28](#) # And he said unto them, Follow after me: for the LORD hath delivered your enemies the Moabites into your hand. And they went down after him, and took the fords of Jordan toward

Moab, and suffered not a man to pass over.

took the girdle [24 JER 13 07](#) # Then I went to Euphrates, and digged, and took the girdle from the place where I had hid it: and, behold, the girdle was marred, it was profitable for nothing.

took the goat [03 LEV 09 15](#) # And he brought the people's offering, and took the goat, which [was] the sin offering for the people, and slew it, and offered it for sin, as the first.

took the gold [04 NUM 31 51](#) # And Moses and Eleazar the priest took the gold of them, [even] all wrought jewels.

took the gold [04 NUM 31 54](#) # And Moses and Eleazar the priest took the gold of the captains of thousands and of hundreds, and brought it into the tabernacle of the congregation, [for] a memorial for the children of Israel before the LORD.

took the grapes [01 GEN 40 11](#) # And Pharaoh's cup [was] in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

took the graven [07 JUD 18 17](#) # And the five men that went to spy out the land went up, [and] came in thither, [and] took the graven image, and the ephod, and the teraphim, and the molten image: and the priest stood in the entering of the gate with the six hundred men [that were] appointed with weapons of war.

took the head [09 ISA 17 54](#) # And David took the head of the Philistine, and brought it to Jerusalem; but he put his armour in his tent.

took the head [10 2SA 04 12](#) # And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

took the highest [26 EZE 17 03](#) # And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; A great eagle with great wings, longwinged, full of feathers, which had divers colours, came unto Lebanon, and took the highest branch of the cedar:

took the horn [09 ISA 16 13](#) # Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

took the king [12 2KI 25 06](#) # So they took the king, and brought him up to the king of Babylon to Riblah; and they gave judgment upon him.

took the king [24 JER 52 09](#) # Then they took the king, and carried him up unto the king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath; where he gave judgment upon him.

took the king's [12 2KI 10 07](#) # And it came to pass, when the letter came to them, that they took the king's sons, and slew seventy persons, and put their heads in baskets, and sent him [them] to Jezreel.

took the kingdom [09 ISA 14 47](#) # So Saul took the kingdom over Israel, and fought against all his enemies on every side, against Moab, and against the children of Ammon, and against Edom, and against the kings of Zobah, and against the Philistines: and whithersoever he turned himself, he vexed [them].

took the kingdom [27 DAN 05 31](#) # And Darius the Median took the kingdom, [being] about threescore and two years old.

took the knife [01 GEN 22 10](#) # And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

took the little [66\\_REV\\_10\\_10](#) # And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

took the loaves [43\\_JOH\\_06\\_11](#) # And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

took the man [01\\_GEN\\_02\\_15](#) # And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.

took the mantle [12\\_2KI\\_02\\_14](#) # And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where [is] the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

took the men [44\\_ACT\\_21\\_26](#) # Then Paul took the men, and the next day purifying himself with them entered into the temple, to signify the accomplishment of the days of purification, until that an offering should be offered for every one of them.

took the men [24\\_JER\\_38\\_11](#) # So Ebedmelech took the men with him, and went into the house of the king under the treasury, and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags, and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah.

took the money [40\\_MAT\\_28\\_15](#) # So they took the money, and did as they were taught: and this saying is commonly reported among the Jews until this day.

took the passages [07\\_JUD\\_12\\_05](#) # And the Gileadites took the passages of Jordan before the Ephraimites: and it was [so] that when those Ephraimites which were escaped said, Let me go over; that the men of Gilead said unto him, [Art] thou an Ephraimite? If he said, Nay;

took the people [07\\_JUD\\_09\\_43](#) # And he took the people, and divided them into three companies, and laid wait in the field, and looked, and, behold, the people [were] come forth out of the city; and he rose up against them, and smote them.

took the poor [10\\_2SA\\_12\\_04](#) # And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.

took the priests [15\\_EZR\\_08\\_30](#) # So took the priests and the Levites the weight of the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, to bring [them] to Jerusalem unto the house of our God.

took the ram [01\\_GEN\\_22\\_13](#) # And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind [him] a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

took the reed [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_30](#) # And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head.

took the robe [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_31](#) # And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify [him].

took the rod [02\\_EXO\\_04\\_20](#) # And Moses took his wife and his sons, and set them upon an ass, and he returned to the land of Egypt: and Moses took the rod of God in his hand.

took the rod [04\\_NUM\\_20\\_09](#) # And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him.

took the roll [24\\_JER\\_36\\_14](#) # Therefore all the princes sent Jehudi the son of Nethaniah, the son of Shelemiah, the son of Cushi, unto Baruch, saying, Take in thine hand the roll wherein thou hast read in the ears of the people, and come. So Baruch the son of Neriah took the roll in his hand, and came unto them.

took the royal [10\\_2SA\\_12\\_26](#) # And Joab fought against Rabbah of the children of Ammon, and took the royal city.

took the rulers [12\\_2KI\\_11\\_19](#) # And he took the rulers over hundreds, and the captains, and the guard, and all the people of the land; and they brought down the king from the house of the LORD, and came by the way of the gate of the guard to the king's house. And he sat on the throne of the kings.

took the seven [41\\_MAR\\_08\\_06](#) # And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before [them]; and they did set [them] before the people.

took the seven [40\\_MAT\\_15\\_36](#) # And he took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake [them], and gave to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

took the shields [13\\_1CH\\_18\\_07](#) # And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadarezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

took the shields [10\\_2SA\\_08\\_07](#) # And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadadezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

took the silver [12\\_2KI\\_16\\_08](#) # And Ahaz took the silver and gold that was found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and sent [it for] a present to the king of Assyria.

took the silver [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_06](#) # And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood.

took the small [04\\_NUM\\_32\\_41](#) # And Jair the son of Manasseh went and took the small towns thereof, and called them Havothjair.

took the spear [09\\_1SA\\_26\\_12](#) # So David took the spear and the cruse of water from Saul's bolster; and they gat them away, and no man saw [it], nor knew [it], neither awaked: for they [were] all asleep; because a deep sleep from the LORD was fallen upon them.

which sought the LORD went out unto the tabernacle of the congregation, which [was] without the camp.

took the ten [10 2SA 20 03](#) # And David came to his house at Jerusalem; and the king took the ten women [his] concubines, whom he had left to keep the house, and put them in ward, and fed them, but went not in unto them. So they were shut up unto the day of their death, living in widowhood.

took the things [07 JUD 18 27](#) # And they took [the things] which Micah had made, and the priest which he had, and came unto Laish, unto a people [that were] at quiet and secure: and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and burnt the city with fire.

took the thirty [40 MAT 27 09](#) # Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;

took the thirty [38 ZEC 11 13](#) # And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prised at of them. And I took the thirty [pieces] of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

took the twelve [40 MAT 20 17](#) # And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them,

took the two [10 2SA 21 08](#) # But the king took the two sons of Rizpah the daughter of Aiah, whom she bare unto Saul, Armoni and Mephibosheth; and the five sons of Michal the daughter of Saul, whom she brought up for Adriel the son of Barzillai the Meholathite:

took the two [05 DEU 09 17](#) # And I took the two tables, and cast them out of my two hands, and brake them before your eyes.

took the two [06 JOS 02 04](#) # And the woman took the two men, and hid them, and said thus, There came men unto me, but I wist not whence they [were]:

took the two [07 JUD 08 12](#) # And when Zebah and Zalmunna fled, he pursued after them, and took the two kings of Midian, Zebah and Zalmunna, and discomfited all the host.

took the veil [02 EXO 34 34](#) # But when Moses went in before the LORD to speak with him, he took the veil off, until he came out. And he came out, and spake unto the children of Israel [that] which he was commanded.

took the villages [04 NUM 21 32](#) # And Moses sent to spy out Jaazer, and they took the villages thereof, and drove out the Amorites that [were] there.

took the wagons [04 NUM 07 06](#) # And Moses took the wagons and the oxen, and gave them unto the Levites.

took the war [04 NUM 31 27](#) # And divide the prey into two parts; between them that took the war upon them, who went out to battle, and between all the congregation:

took the young [25\\_LAM\\_05\\_13](#) # They took the young men to grind, and the children fell under the wood.

took the young [40\\_MAT\\_02\\_14](#) # When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt:

took the young [40\\_MAT\\_02\\_21](#) # And he arose, and took the young child and his mother, and came into the land of Israel.

took thee from [13\\_1CH\\_17\\_07](#) # Now therefore thus shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, [even] from following the sheep, that thou shouldest be ruler over my people Israel:

took thee from [10\\_2SA\\_07\\_08](#) # Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over my people, over Israel:

took thee in [40\\_MAT\\_25\\_38](#) # When saw we thee a stranger, and took [thee] in? or naked, and clothed [thee]?

took thee to [04\\_NUM\\_23\\_11](#) # And Balak said unto Balaam, What hast thou done unto me? I took thee to curse mine enemies, and, behold, thou hast blessed [them] altogether.

took their bones [09\\_1SA\\_31\\_13](#) # And they took their bones, and buried [them] under a tree at Jabesh, and fasted seven days.

took their cattle [01\\_GEN\\_46\\_06](#) # And they took their cattle, and their goods, which they had gotten in the land of Canaan, and came into Egypt, Jacob, and all his seed with him:

took their daughters [07\\_JUD\\_03\\_06](#) # And they took their daughters to be their wives, and gave their daughters to their sons, and served their gods.

took their dough [02\\_EXO\\_12\\_34](#) # And the people took their dough before it was leavened, their kneadingtroughs being bound up in their clothes upon their shoulders.

took their inheritance [06\\_JOS\\_16\\_04](#) # So the children of Joseph, Manasseh and Ephraim, took their inheritance.

took their journey [05\\_DEU\\_10\\_06](#) # And the children of Israel took their journey from Beeroth of the children of Jaakan to Mosera: there Aaron died, and there he was buried; and Eleazar his son ministered in the priest's office in his stead.

took their journey [02\\_EXO\\_13\\_20](#) # And they took their journey from Succoth, and encamped in Etham, in the edge of the wilderness.

took their journey [02\\_EXO\\_16\\_01](#) # And they took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which [is] between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departing out of the land of Egypt.

took their journey [04\\_NUM\\_10\\_13](#) # And they first took their journey according to the commandment of



the LORD by the hand of Moses.

took their journey [04\\_NUM\\_33\\_12](#) # And they took their journey out of the wilderness of Sin, and encamped in Dophkah.

took their journeys [04\\_NUM\\_10\\_12](#) # And the children of Israel took their journeys out of the wilderness of Sinai; and the cloud rested in the wilderness of Paran.

took their king's [10\\_2SA\\_12\\_30](#) # And he took their king's crown from off his head, the weight whereof [was] a talent of gold with the precious stones: and it was [set] on David's head. And he brought forth the spoil of the city in great abundance.

took their lamps [40\\_MAT\\_25\\_01](#) # Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.

took their lamps [40\\_MAT\\_25\\_03](#) # They that [were] foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

took their land [05\\_DEU\\_29\\_08](#) # And we took their land, and gave it for an inheritance unto the Reubenites, and to the Gadites, and to the half tribe of Manasseh.

took their sheep [01\\_GEN\\_34\\_28](#) # They took their sheep, and their oxen, and their asses, and that which [was] in the city, and that which [was] in the field,

took their spoil [07\\_JUD\\_14\\_19](#) # And the spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled, and he went up to his father's house.

took them alive [12\\_2KI\\_10\\_14](#) # And he said, Take them alive. And they took them alive, and slew them at the pit of the shearing house, [even] two and forty men; neither left he any of them.

took them all [40\\_MAT\\_24\\_39](#) # And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

took them and [11\\_1KI\\_18\\_40](#) # And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.

took them and [01\\_GEN\\_32\\_23](#) # And he took them, and sent them over the brook, and sent over that he had.

took them and [24\\_JER\\_52\\_26](#) # So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard took them, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah.

took them and [06\\_JOS\\_07\\_21](#) # When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they [are] hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.

took them captives [24 JER 50 33](#) # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah [were] oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

took them down [06 JOS 10 27](#) # And it came to pass at the time of the going down of the sun, [that] Joshua commanded, and they took them down off the trees, and cast them into the cave wherein they had been hid, and laid great stones in the cave's mouth, [which remain] until this very day.

took them from [12 2KI 05 24](#) # And when he came to the tower, he took [them] from their hand, and bestowed [them] in the house: and he let the men go, and they departed.

took them from [03 LEV 08 28](#) # And Moses took them from off their hands, and burnt [them] on the altar upon the burnt offering: they [were] consecrations for a sweet savour: it [is] an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

took them into [07 JUD 19 15](#) # And they turned aside thither, to go in [and] to lodge in Gibeah: and when he went in, he sat him down in a street of the city: for [there was] no man that took them into his house to lodging.

took them out [06 JOS 07 23](#) # And they took them out of the midst of the tent, and brought them unto Joshua, and unto all the children of Israel, and laid them out before the LORD.

took them the [44 ACT 16 33](#) # And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed [their] stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.

took them up [41 MAR 10 16](#) # And he took them up in his arms, put [his] hands upon them, and blessed them.

took them wives [01 GEN 06 02](#) # That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they [were] fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

took them wives [01 GEN 11 29](#) # And Abram and Nahor took them wives: the name of Abram's wife [was] Sarai; and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran, the father of Milcah, and the father of Iscah.

took them wives [07 JUD 21 23](#) # And the children of Benjamin did so, and took [them] wives, according to their number, of them that danced, whom they caught: and they went and returned unto their inheritance, and repaired the cities, and dwelt in them.

took them wives [08 RUT 01 04](#) # And they took them wives of the women of Moab; the name of the one [was] Orpah, and the name of the other Ruth: and they dwelled there about ten years.

took them [13 1CH 23 22](#) # And Eleazar died, and had no sons, but daughters: and their brethren the sons of Kish took them.

took them [12 2KI 18 13](#) # Now in the fourteenth year of king Hezekiah did Sennacherib king of Assyria come up against all the fenced cities of Judah, and took them.

took them [23 ISA 36 01](#) # Now it came to pass in the fourteenth year of king Hezekiah, [that] Sennacherib king of Assyria came up against all the defenced cities of Judah, and took them.

took thence a [09 ISA 17 49](#) # And David put his hand in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang [it], and smote the Philistine in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead; and he fell upon his face to the earth.

took thence four [14 2CH 08 18](#) # And Hiram sent him by the hands of his servants ships, and servants that had knowledge of the sea; and they went with the servants of Solomon to Ophir, and took thence four hundred and fifty talents of gold, and brought [them] to king Solomon.

took thence old [24 JER 38 11](#) # So Ebedmelech took the men with him, and went into the house of the king under the treasury, and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags, and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah.

took therefore two [12 2KI 07 14](#) # They took therefore two chariot horses; and the king sent after the host of the Syrians, saying, Go and see.

took thereof and [26 EZE 10 07](#) # And [one] cherub stretched forth his hand from between the cherubims unto the fire that [was] between the cherubims, and took [thereof], and put [it] into the hands of [him that was] clothed with linen: who took [it], and went out.

took thereof in [07 JUD 14 09](#) # And he took thereof in his hands, and went on eating, and came to his father and mother, and he gave them, and they did eat: but he told not them that he had taken the honey out of the carcase of the lion.

took these and [12 2KI 25 20](#) # And Nebuzaradan captain of the guard took these, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah:

took these men [04 NUM 01 17](#) # And Moses and Aaron took these men which are expressed by [their] names:

took they away [14 2CH 30 14](#) # And they arose and took away the altars that [were] in Jerusalem, and all the altars for incense took they away, and cast [them] into the brook Kidron.

took they away [12 2KI 25 14](#) # And the pots, and the shovels, and the snuffers, and the spoons, and all the vessels of brass wherewith they ministered, took they away.

took they away [24 JER 52 18](#) # The caldrons also, and the shovels, and the snuffers, and the bowls, and the spoons, and all the vessels of brass wherewith they ministered, took they away.

took they captive [01 GEN 34 29](#) # And all their wealth, and all their little ones, and their wives took they captive, and spoiled even all that [was] in the house.

took they him [42 LUK 22 54](#) # Then took they him, and led [him], and brought him into the high priest's house. And Peter followed afar off.

took they Jeremiah [24 JER 38 06](#) # Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah

the son of Hammelech, that [was] in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon [there was] no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.

took they the [43 JOH 19 40](#) # Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.

took they up [43 JOH 08 59](#) # Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

took this woman [05 DEU 22 14](#) # And give occasions of speech against her, and bring up an evil name upon her, and say, I took this woman, and when I came to her, I found her not a maid:

took three darts [10 2SA 18 14](#) # Then said Joab, I may not tarry thus with thee. And he took three darts in his hand, and thrust them through the heart of Absalom, while he [was] yet alive in the midst of the oak.

took three thousand [09 1SA 24 02](#) # Then Saul took three thousand chosen men out of all Israel, and went to seek David and his men upon the rocks of the wild goats.

took Titus with [48 GAL 02 01](#) # Then fourteen years after I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and took Titus with [me] also.

took to him [07 JUD 19 01](#) # And it came to pass in those days, when [there was] no king in Israel, that there was a certain Levite sojourning on the side of mount Ephraim, who took to him a concubine out of Bethlehemjudah.

took to wife [13 1CH 07 15](#) # And Machir took to wife [the sister] of Huppim and Shuppim, whose sister's name [was] Maachah;] and the name of the second [was] Zelophehad: and Zelophehad had daughters.

took to wife [11 1KI 16 31](#) # And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took to wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Zidonians, and went and served Baal, and worshipped him.

took to wife [02 EXO 02 01](#) # And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took [to wife] a daughter of Levi.

took to wife [01 GEN 26 34](#) # And Esau was forty years old when he took to wife Judith the daughter of Beeri the Hittite, and Bashemath the daughter of Elon the Hittite:

took twelve men [05 DEU 01 23](#) # And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe:

took twelve stones [11 1KI 18 31](#) # And Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, unto whom the word of the LORD came, saying, Israel shall be thy name:

took two hundred [09 1SA 25 18](#) # Then Abigail made haste, and took two hundred loaves, and two bottles of wine, and five sheep ready dressed, and five measures of parched [corn], and an hundred clusters of raisins, and two hundred cakes of figs, and laid [them] on asses.

took two hundred [07 JUD 17 04](#) # Yet he restored the money unto his mother; and his mother took two hundred [shekels] of silver, and gave them to the founder, who made thereof a graven image and a molten image: and they were in the house of Micah.

took two milch [09 1SA 06 10](#) # And the men did so; and took two milch kine, and tied them to the cart, and shut up their calves at home:

took two of [01\\_GEN\\_22\\_03](#) # And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.

took under the [21\\_ECC\\_02\\_20](#) # Therefore I went about to cause my heart to despair of all the labour which I took under the sun.

took unto him [13\\_1CH\\_02\\_19](#) # And when Azubah was dead, Caleb took unto him Ephrath, which bare him Hur.

took unto him [12\\_2KI\\_13\\_15](#) # And Elisha said unto him, Take bow and arrows. And he took unto him bow and arrows.

took unto him [01\\_GEN\\_04\\_19](#) # And Lamech took unto him two wives: the name of the one [was] Adah, and the name of the other Zillah.

took unto him [01\\_GEN\\_15\\_10](#) # And he took unto him all these, and divided them in the midst, and laid each piece one against another: but the birds divided he not.

took unto him [42\\_LUK\\_18\\_31](#) # Then he took [unto him] the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished.

took unto him [40\\_MAT\\_01\\_24](#) # Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:

took unto me [23\\_ISA\\_08\\_02](#) # And I took unto me faithful witnesses to record, Uriah the priest, and Zechariah the son of Jeberechiah.

took unto me [38\\_ZEC\\_11\\_07](#) # And I will feed the flock of slaughter, [even] you, O poor of the flock. And I took unto me two staves; the one I called Beauty, and the other I called Bands; and I fed the flock.

took unto the [01\\_GEN\\_28\\_09](#) # Then went Esau unto Ishmael, and took unto the wives which he had Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael Abraham's son, the sister of Nebajoth, to be his wife.

took unto them [44\\_ACT\\_17\\_05](#) # But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people.

took up a [66\\_REV\\_18\\_21](#) # And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast [it] into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.

took up also [12\\_2KI\\_02\\_13](#) # He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan;

took up Asahel [10\\_2SA\\_02\\_32](#) # And they took up Asahel, and buried him in the sepulchre of his father, which [was in] Bethlehem. And Joab and his men went all night, and they came to Hebron at break of day.

took up her [12\\_2KI\\_04\\_37](#) # Then she went in, and fell at his feet, and bowed herself to the ground, and took up her son, and went out.

took up his [43 JOH 05 09](#) # And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath.

took up his [41 MAR 06 29](#) # And when his disciples heard [of it], they came and took up his corpse, and laid it in a tomb.

took up his [04 NUM 23 07](#) # And he took up his parable, and said, Balak the king of Moab hath brought me from Aram, out of the mountains of the east, [saying], Come, curse me Jacob, and come, defy Israel.

took up his [04 NUM 23 18](#) # And he took up his parable, and said, Rise up, Balak, and hear; hearken unto me, thou son of Zippor:

took up his [04 NUM 24 03](#) # And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said:

took up his [04 NUM 24 15](#) # And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said:

took up his [04 NUM 24 20](#) # And when he looked on Amalek, he took up his parable, and said, Amalek [was] the first of the nations; but his latter end [shall be] that he perish for ever.

took up of [41 MAR 08 08](#) # So they did eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken [meat] that was left seven baskets.

took up of [40 MAT 14 20](#) # And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full.

took up of [40 MAT 15 37](#) # And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken [meat] that was left seven baskets full.

took up our [44 ACT 21 15](#) # And after those days we took up our carriages, and went up to Jerusalem.

took up Shadrach [27 DAN 03 22](#) # Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flame of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

took up stones [43 JOH 10 31](#) # Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.

took up that [42 LUK 05 25](#) # And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.

took upon them [44 ACT 19 13](#) # Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.

took upon them [17 EST 09 27](#) # The Jews ordained, and took upon them, and upon their seed, and upon all such as joined themselves unto them, so as it should not fail, that they would keep these two days according to their writing, and according to their [appointed] time every year;

took us for [01 GEN 42 30](#) # The man, [who is] the lord of the land, spake roughly to us, and took us for spies of the country.

took Uzziah who [14 2CH 26 01](#) # Then all the people of Judah took Uzziah, who [was] sixteen years old, and made him king in the room of his father Amaziah.

took violently away [03 LEV 06 04](#) # Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

took water and [40 MAT 27 24](#) # When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but [that] rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed [his] hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye [to it].

took witnesses and [24 JER 32 10](#) # And I subscribed the evidence, and sealed [it], and took witnesses, and weighed [him] the money in the balances.

took ye up [41 MAR 08 19](#) # When I brake the five loaves among five thousand, how many baskets full of fragments took ye up? They say unto him, Twelve.

took ye up [41 MAR 08 20](#) # And when the seven among four thousand, how many baskets full of fragments took ye up? And they said, Seven.

took your father [06 JOS 24 03](#) # And I took your father Abraham from the other side of the flood, and led him throughout all the land of Canaan, and multiplied his seed, and gave him Isaac.

took your sin [05 DEU 09 21](#) # And I took your sin, the calf which ye had made, and burnt it with fire, and stamped it, [and] ground [it] very small, [even] until it was as small as dust: and I cast the dust thereof into the brook that descended out of the mount.

took Zilpah her [01 GEN 30 09](#) # When Leah saw that she had left bearing, she took Zilpah her maid, and gave her Jacob to wife.

took Zipporah Moses' [02 EXO 18 02](#) # Then Jethro, Moses' father in law, took Zipporah, Moses' wife, after he had sent her back,

took [13 1CH 04 18](#) # And his wife Jehudijah bare Jered the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Jekuthiel the father of Zanoah. And these [are] the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

took [05 DEU 02 35](#) # Only the cattle we took for a prey unto ourselves, and the spoil of the cities which we

took.

tookest thy broidered [26 EZE 16 18](#) # And tookest thy broidered garments, and coveredst them: and thou hast set mine oil and mine incense before them.

tookest vengeance of [19 PSA 99 08](#) # Thou answeredst them, O LORD our God: thou wast a God that forgavest them, though thou tookest vengeance of their inventions.

undertook to do [17 EST 09 23](#) # And the Jews undertook to do as they had begun, and as Mordecai had written unto them;
