treadeth clay [23 ISA 41 25](#) # I have raised up [one] from the north, and he shall come: from the rising of the sun shall he call upon my name: and he shall come upon princes as [upon] mortar, and as the potter treadeth clay.

treadeth down and [33 MIC 05 08](#) # And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles in the midst of many people as a lion among the beasts of the forest, as a young lion among the flocks of sheep: who, if he go through, both treadeth down, and teareth in pieces, and none can deliver.

treadeth in the [23 ISA 63 02](#) # Wherefore [art thou] red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

treadeth out the [46 1CO 09 09](#) # For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth God take care for oxen?
