trodden down all 19 PSA 119 118 # Thou hast trodden down all them that err from thy statutes: for their deceit [is] falsehood.

trodden down and 42 LUK 08 05 # A sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it.

trodden down as <u>33 MIC 07 10</u> # Then [she that is] mine enemy shall see [it], and shame shall cover her which said unto me, Where is the LORD thy God? mine eyes shall behold her: now shall she be trodden down as the mire of the streets.

trodden down by 23 ISA 28 18 # And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it. trodden down for 23 ISA 25 10 # For in this mountain shall the hand of the LORD rest, and Moab shall be trodden down under him, even as straw is trodden down for the dunphill.

trodden down of <u>42 LUK 21 24</u> # And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. trodden down strength <u>07 JUD 05 21</u> # The river of Kishon swept them away, that ancient river, the river Kishon. O my soul, thou hast trodden down strength.

trodden down thy 23 ISA 63 18 # The people of thy holiness have possessed [it] but a little while: our adversaries have trodden down thy sanctuary.

trodden down under 23 ISA 25 10 # For in this mountain shall the hand of the LORD rest, and Moab shall be trodden down under him, even as straw is trodden down for the dunghill.

trodden down whose 23 ISA 18 02 # That sendeth ambassadors by the sea, even in vessels of bulrushes upon the waters, [saying], Go, ye swift messengers, to a nation scattered and peeled, to a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden down, whose land the rivers have spoiled!

trodden down 23 ISA 05 05 # And now go to; I will tell you what I will do to my vineyard: I will take away the hedge thereof, and it shall be eaten up; [and] break down the wall thereof, and it shall be trodden down:

trodden it nor <u>18 JOB 28 08</u># The lion's whelps have not trodden it, nor the fierce lion passed by it.

trodden my portion 24 JER 12 10 # Many pastors have destroyed my vineyard, they have trodden my portion under foot, they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilderness.

trodden shall be 06 JOS 14 09 # And Moses sware on that day, saying, Surely the land whereon thy feet have trodden shall be thine inheritance, and thy children's for ever, because thou hast wholly followed the LORD my God.

trodden the virgin 25 LAM 01 15 # The Lord hath trodden under foot all my mighty [men] in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: the Lord hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, [as] in a winepress.

trodden the winepress 23 ISA 63 03 # I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people [there was] none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

trodden under feet 23 ISA 14 19 # But thou art cast out of thy grave like an abominable branch, [and as] the raiment of those that are slain, thrust through with a sword, that go down to the stones of the pit; as a carcase trodden under feet.

trodden under feet 23 ISA 28 03 # The crown of pride, the drunkards of Ephraim, shall be trodden under feet:

trodden under foot 27 DAN 08 13 # Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain [saint] which spake, How long [shall be] the vision [concerning] the daily [sacrifice], and the transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot?

trodden under foot 58 HEB 10 29 # Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

trodden under foot 23 ISA 18 07 # In that time shall the present be brought unto the LORD of hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, the mount Zion.

trodden under foot 25 LAM 01 15 # The Lord hath trodden under foot all my mighty [men] in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: the Lord hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, [as] in a winepress.

trodden under foot 40 MAT 05 13# Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.

trodden upon and 05 DEU 01 36 # Save Caleb the son of Jephunneh; he shall see it, and to him will I give the land that he hath trodden upon, and to his children, because he hath wholly followed the LORD.

trodden with your 26 EZE 34 19 # And [as for] my flock, they eat that which ye have trodden with your feet; and they drink that which ye have fouled with your feet.

trodden without the 66 REV 14 20 # And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand [and] six hundred furlongs.
