overturned it that <u>07\_JUD\_07\_13</u> # And when Gideon was come, behold, [there was] a man that told a dream unto his fellow, and said, Behold, I dreamed a dream, and, lo, a cake of barley bread tumbled into the host of Midian, and came unto a tent, and smote it that it fell, and overturned it, that the tent lay along.

returned after him <u>10\_2SA\_23\_10</u># He arose, and smote the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand clave unto the sword: and the LORD wrought a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to spoil.

returned again to <u>44\_ACT\_14\_21</u> # And when they had preached the gospel to that city, and had taught many, they returned again to Lystra, and [to] Iconium, and Antioch,

returned again unto <u>48\_GAL\_01\_17</u># Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus.

returned again with <u>42\_LUK\_10\_17</u> # And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

returned all of <u>16\_NEH\_04\_15</u> # And it came to pass, when our enemies heard that it was known unto us, and God had brought their counsel to nought, that we returned all of us to the wall, every one unto his work.

returned and afterward <u>06\_JOS\_02\_16</u># And she said unto them, Get you to the mountain, lest the pursuers meet you; and hide yourselves there three days, until the pursuers be returned: and afterward may ye go your way.

returned and all <u>06\_JOS\_10\_15</u># And Joshua returned, and all Israel with him, unto the camp to Gilgal.

returned and all <u>06\_JOS\_10\_38</u># And Joshua returned, and all Israel with him, to Debir; and fought against it:

returned and all <u>06\_JOS\_10\_43</u># And Joshua returned, and all Israel with him, unto the camp to Gilgal.

returned and came <u>09\_1SA\_01\_19</u># And they rose up in the morning early, and worshipped before the LORD, and returned, and came to their house to Ramah: and Elkanah knew Hannah his wife; and the LORD remembered her.

returned and came <u>09\_1SA\_27\_09</u> # And David smote the land, and left neither man nor woman alive, and took away the sheep, and the oxen, and the asses, and the camels, and the apparel, and returned, and came to Achish.

returned and came <u>10\_2SA\_19\_15</u># So the king returned, and came to Jordan. And Judah came to Gilgal, to go to meet the king, to conduct the king over Jordan.

returned and came <u>01\_GEN\_14\_07</u># And they returned, and came to Enmishpat, which [is] Kadesh, and smote all the country of the Amalekites, and also the Amorites, that dwelt in Hazezontamar.

returned and considered 21\_ECC\_04\_01 # So I returned, and considered all the oppressions that are done under the sun: and behold the tears of [such as were] oppressed, and they had no comforter; and on the

returned and inquired <u>19\_PSA\_78\_34</u># When he slew them, then they sought him: and they returned and inquired early after God.

returned and made <u>04\_NUM\_14\_36</u># And the men, which Moses sent to search the land, who returned, and made all the congregation to murmur against him, by bringing up a slander upon the land,

returned and prepared <u>42\_LUK\_23\_56</u> # And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment.

returned and Ruth <u>08\_RUT\_01\_22</u> # So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabitess, her daughter in law, with her, which returned out of the country of Moab: and they came to Bethlehem in the beginning of barley harvest.

returned and said <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_06</u># But my words and my statutes, which I commanded my servants the prophets, did they not take hold of your fathers? and they returned and said, Like as the LORD of hosts thought to do unto us, according to our ways, and according to our doings, so hath he dealt with us.

returned and saw 21\_ECC\_09\_11 # I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race [is] not to the swift, nor

returned answer by <u>15\_EZR\_05\_05</u># But the eye of their God was upon the elders of the Jews, that they could not cause them to cease, till the matter came to Darius: and then they returned answer by letter concerning this [matter].

returned answer to 07\_JUD\_05\_29 # Her wise ladies answered her, yea, she returned answer to herself,

returned as the <u>26\_EZE\_01\_14</u># And the living creatures ran and returned as the appearance of a flash of lightning.

returned back again <u>42\_LUK\_08\_37</u> # Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again.

returned back from <u>11\_1KI\_19\_21</u># And he returned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen, and slew them, and boiled their flesh with the instruments of the oxen, and gave unto the people, and they did eat. Then he arose, and went after Elijah, and ministered unto him.

returned behold at <u>26\_EZE\_47\_07</u> # Now when I had returned, behold, at the bank of the river [were] very many trees on the one side and on the other.

returned every man <u>14\_2CH\_20\_27</u># Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat in the forefront of them, to go again to Jerusalem with joy; for the LORD had made them to rejoice over their enemies.

returned every man <u>14\_2CH\_31\_01</u> # Now when all this was finished, all Israel that were present went out to the cities of Judah, and brake the images in pieces, and cut down the groves, and threw down the high places and the altars out of all Judah and Benjamin, in Ephraim also and Manasseh, until they had utterly

destroyed them all. Then all the children of Israel returned, every man to his possession, into their own cities.

returned for a <u>09\_1SA\_06\_17</u># And these [are] the golden emerods which the Philistines returned [for] a trespass offering unto the LORD; for Ashdod one, for Gaza one, for Askelon one, for Gath one, for Ekron one;

returned for they <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_14</u> # But I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations whom they knew not. Thus the land was desolate after them, that no man passed through nor returned: for they laid the pleasant land desolate.

returned from all <u>24\_JER\_43\_05</u># But Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces, took all the remnant of Judah, that were returned from all nations, whither they had been driven, to dwell in the land of Judah;

returned from battle <u>07\_JUD\_08\_13</u># And Gideon the son of Joash returned from battle before the sun [was up],

returned from chasing <u>09\_1SA\_17\_53</u># And the children of Israel returned from chasing after the Philistines, and they spoiled their tents.

returned from following <u>09\_1SA\_24\_01</u># And it came to pass, when Saul was returned from following the Philistines, that it was told him, saying, Behold, David [is] in the wilderness of Engedi.

returned from following <u>10\_2SA\_02\_30</u># And Joab returned from following Abner: and when he had gathered all the people together, there lacked of David's servants nineteen men and Asahel.

returned from going <u>14\_2CH\_11\_04</u># Thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against your brethren: return every man to his house: for this thing is done of me. And they obeyed the words of the LORD, and returned from going against Jeroboam.

returned from Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_12\_25</u> # And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem, when they had fulfilled [their] ministry, and took with them John, whose surname was Mark.

returned from Jordan <u>42\_LUK\_04\_01</u># And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

returned from off <u>01\_GEN\_08\_03</u> # And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated.

returned from pursuing <u>09\_18A\_23\_28</u> # Wherefore Saul returned from pursuing after David, and went against the Philistines: therefore they called that place Selahammahlekoth.

returned from pursuing <u>10\_2SA\_18\_16</u># And Joab blew the trumpet, and the people returned from pursuing after Israel: for Joab held back the people.

returned from Saul <u>09\_1SA\_17\_15</u># But David went and returned from Saul to feed his father's sheep at Bethlehem.

returned from searching <u>04\_NUM\_13\_25</u> # And they returned from searching of the land after forty days.

returned from smiting <u>10\_2SA\_08\_13</u> # And David gat [him] a name when he returned from smiting of the Syrians in the valley of salt, [being] eighteen thousand [men].

returned from the <u>09\_1SA\_17\_57</u> # And as David returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, Abner took

him, and brought him before Saul with the head of the Philistine in his hand.

returned from the <u>09\_1SA\_18\_06</u> # And it came to pass as they came, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, that the women came out of all cities of Israel, singing and dancing, to meet king Saul, with tabrets, with joy, and with instruments of music.

returned from the <u>10\_2SA\_01\_01</u># Now it came to pass after the death of Saul, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Amalekites, and David had abode two days in Ziklag;

returned from the <u>10\_2SA\_10\_14</u> # And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, then fled they also before Abishai, and entered into the city. So Joab returned from the children of Ammon, and came to Jerusalem.

returned into Galilee <u>42\_LUK\_02\_39</u> # And when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city Nazareth.

returned into mine <u>19\_PSA\_35\_13</u> # But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing [was] sackcloth: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom.

returned into the <u>17\_EST\_02\_14</u> # In the evening she went, and on the morrow she returned into the second house of the women, to the custody of Shaashgaz, the king's chamberlain, which kept the concubines: she

came in unto the king no more, except the king delighted in her, and that she were called by name.

returned into the <u>01\_GEN\_21\_32</u># Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba: then Abimelech rose up, and Phichol the chief captain of his host, and they returned into the land of the Philistines.

returned into the <u>06\_JOS\_06\_14</u> # And the second day they compassed the city once, and returned into the camp: so they did six days.

returned into the <u>07\_JUD\_07\_15</u> # And it was [so], when Gideon heard the telling of the dream, and the interpretation thereof, that he worshipped, and returned into the host of Israel, and said, Arise; for the LORD hath delivered into your hand the host of Midian.

returned into the <u>40\_MAT\_21\_18</u># Now in the morning as he returned into the city, he hungered.

returned not again <u>01\_GEN\_08\_12</u> # And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again unto him any more.

returned not And <u>24\_JER\_03\_07</u># And I said after she had done all these [things], Turn thou unto me. But she returned not. And her treacherous sister Judah saw [it].

returned not by <u>11\_1KI\_13\_10</u># So he went another way, and returned not by the way that he came to Bethel.

returned not empty <u>10\_2SA\_01\_22</u> # From the blood of the slain, from the fat of the mighty, the bow of Jonathan turned not back, and the sword of Saul returned not empty.

returned not from <u>11\_1KI\_13\_33</u># After this thing Jeroboam returned not from his evil way, but made again of the lowest of the people priests of the high places: whosoever would, he consecrated him, and he became [one] of the priests of the high places.

returned of the <u>07\_JUD\_07\_03</u> # Now therefore go to, proclaim in the ears of the people, saying, Whosoever [is] fearful and afraid, let him return and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand.

returned out of <u>14\_2CH\_10\_02</u># And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who [was] in Egypt, whither he had fled from the presence of Solomon the king, heard [it], that Jeroboam returned out of Egypt.

returned out of <u>08\_RUT\_01\_22</u> # So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabitess, her daughter in law, with her, which returned out of the country of Moab: and they came to Bethlehem in the beginning of barley harvest.

returned so all <u>10\_2SA\_17\_03</u># And I will bring back all the people unto thee: the man whom thou seekest [is] as if all returned: [so] all the people shall be in peace.

returned ten degrees <u>23\_ISA\_38\_08</u> # Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, ten degrees backward. So the sun returned ten degrees, by which degrees it was gone down.

returned that day <u>01\_GEN\_33\_16</u># So Esau returned that day on his way unto Seir.

returned the captivity <u>28\_HOS\_06\_11</u># Also, O Judah, he hath set an harvest for thee, when I returned the captivity of my people.

returned the child <u>42\_LUK\_02\_43</u> # And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not [of it].

returned the people <u>42\_LUK\_08\_40</u> # And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people [gladly] received him: for they were all waiting for him.

returned the wickedness <u>09\_1SA\_25\_39</u> # And when David heard that Nabal was dead, he said, Blessed [be] the LORD, that hath pleaded the cause of my reproach from the hand of Nabal, and hath kept his servant from evil: for the LORD hath returned the wickedness of Nabal upon his own head. And David sent and communed with Abigail, to take her to him to wife.

returned the words <u>02\_EXO\_19\_08</u> # And all the people answered together, and said, All that the LORD hath spoken we will do. And Moses returned the words of the people unto the LORD.

returned they unto <u>44\_ACT\_01\_12</u> # Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day's journey.

returned this second <u>01\_GEN\_43\_10</u># For except we had lingered, surely now we had returned this second time.

returned to be <u>14\_2CH\_22\_06</u> # And he returned to be healed in Jezreel because of the wounds which were given him at Ramah, when he fought with Hazael king of Syria. And Azariah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Jehoram the son of Ahab at Jezreel, because he was sick.

returned to be <u>12\_2KI\_09\_15</u> # But king Joram was returned to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him, when he fought with Hazael king of Syria.] And Jehu said, If it be your minds, [then] let none go forth [nor] escape out of the city to go to tell [it] in Jezreel.

returned to bless <u>13\_1CH\_16\_43</u> # And all the people departed every man to his house: and David returned to bless his house.

returned to bless <u>10\_2SA\_06\_20</u> # Then David returned to bless his household. And Michal the daughter of Saul came out to meet David, and said, How glorious was the king of Israel to day, who uncovered himself to day in the eyes of the handmaids of his servants, as one of the vain fellows shamelessly uncovereth himself!

returned to depart <u>11\_1KI\_12\_24</u># Thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against your brethren the children of Israel: return every man to his house; for this thing is from me. They hearkened therefore to the word of the LORD, and returned to depart, according to the word of the LORD.

returned to Ekron <u>09\_1SA\_06\_16</u> # And when the five lords of the Philistines had seen [it], they returned to Ekron the same day.

returned to give <u>42\_LUK\_17\_18</u># There are not found that returned to give glory to God, save this stranger.

returned to Hebron <u>10\_2SA\_03\_27</u> # And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth [rib], that he died, for the blood of Asahel his brother.

returned to her <u>42\_LUK\_01\_56</u># And Mary abode with her about three months, and returned to her own house.

returned to his <u>09\_1SA\_26\_25</u> # Then Saul said to David, Blessed [be] thou, my son David: thou shalt both do great [things], and also shalt still prevail. So David went on his way, and Saul returned to his place.

returned to his <u>14\_2CH\_19\_01</u> # And Jehoshaphat the king of Judah returned to his house in peace to Jerusalem.

returned to his <u>10\_2SA\_14\_24</u> # And the king said, Let him turn to his own house, and let him not see my face. So Absalom returned to his own house, and saw not the king's face.

returned to his <u>02\_EXO\_14\_27</u> # And Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared; and the Egyptians fled against it; and the LORD overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea.

returned to Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_24\_52</u># And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:

returned to Jerusalem <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_16</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD; I am returned to Jerusalem with mercies: my house shall be built in it, saith the LORD of hosts, and a line shall be stretched forth upon Jerusalem.

returned to Jethro <u>02\_EXO\_04\_18</u># And Moses went and returned to Jethro his father in law, and said unto him, Let me go, I pray thee, and return unto my brethren which [are] in Egypt, and see whether they be yet alive. And Jethro said to Moses, Go in peace.

returned to Joshua <u>06\_JOS\_07\_03</u> # And they returned to Joshua, and said unto him, Let not all the people go up; but let about two or three thousand men go up and smite Ai; [and] make not all the people to labour thither; for they [are but] few.

returned to Judah <u>01\_GEN\_38\_22</u># And he returned to Judah, and said, I cannot find her; and also the men of the place said, [that] there was no harlot in this [place].

returned to provoke <u>26\_EZE\_08\_17</u># Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen [this], O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose.

returned to Samaria <u>14\_2CH\_25\_24</u> # And [he took] all the gold and the silver, and all the vessels that were found in the house of God with Obededom, and the treasures of the king's house, the hostages also, and returned to Samaria.

returned to Samaria <u>14\_2CH\_28\_15</u> # And the men which were expressed by name rose up, and took the captives, and with the spoil clothed all that were naked among them, and arrayed them, and shod them, and gave them to eat and to drink, and anointed them, and carried all the feeble of them upon asses, and brought them to Jericho, the city of palm trees, to their brethren: then they returned to Samaria.

returned to Samaria <u>12\_2KI\_02\_25</u># And he went from thence to mount Carmel, and from thence he returned to Samaria.

returned to Samaria <u>12\_2KI\_14\_14</u> # And he took all the gold and silver, and all the vessels that were found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and hostages, and returned to Samaria.

returned to take <u>07\_JUD\_14\_08</u># And after a time he returned to take her, and he turned aside to see the carcase of the lion: and, behold, [there was] a swarm of bees and honey in the carcase of the lion.

returned to the <u>12\_2KI\_05\_15</u># And he returned to the man of God, he and all his company, and came, and stood before him: and he said, Behold, now I know that [there is] no God in all the earth, but in Israel: now

therefore, I pray thee, take a blessing of thy servant.

returned to the <u>44\_ACT\_23\_32</u># On the morrow they left the horsemen to go with him, and returned to the castle:

returned to the <u>02\_EXO\_04\_20</u> # And Moses took his wife and his sons, and set them upon an ass, and he returned to the land of Egypt: and Moses took the rod of God in his hand.

returned to the <u>01\_GEN\_44\_13</u># Then they rent their clothes, and laded every man his ass, and returned to the city.

returned to the <u>06\_JOS\_10\_21</u> # And all the people returned to the camp to Joshua at Makkedah in peace: none moved his tongue against any of the children of Israel.

returned to their <u>12\_2KI\_03\_27</u># Then he took his eldest son that should have reigned in his stead, and offered him [for] a burnt offering upon the wall. And there was great indignation against Israel: and they departed from him, and returned to [their own] land.

returned to them <u>01\_GEN\_42\_24</u> # And he turned himself about from them, and wept; and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them Simeon, and bound him before their eyes.

returned unto her <u>10\_2SA\_11\_04</u># And David sent messengers, and took her; and she came in unto him, and he lay with her; for she was purified from her uncleanness: and she returned unto her house.

returned unto her <u>07\_JUD\_11\_39</u># And it came to pass at the end of two months, that she returned unto her father, who did with her [according] to his vow which he had vowed: and she knew no man. And it was a custom in Israel,

returned unto her <u>03\_LEV\_22\_13</u> # But if the priest's daughter be a widow, or divorced, and have no child, and is returned unto her father's house, as in her youth, she shall eat of her father's meat: but there shall no stranger eat thereof.

returned unto him <u>02\_EXO\_34\_31</u> # And Moses called unto them; and Aaron and all the rulers of the congregation returned unto him: and Moses talked with them.

returned unto him <u>01\_GEN\_08\_09</u># But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters [were] on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

returned unto him <u>04\_NUM\_23\_06</u># And he returned unto him, and, lo, he stood by his burnt sacrifice, he, and all the princes of Moab.

returned unto his <u>10\_2SA\_19\_39</u> # And all the people went over Jordan. And when the king was come over, the king kissed Barzillai, and blessed him; and he returned unto his own place.

returned unto his <u>01\_GEN\_18\_33</u># And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.

returned unto his <u>01\_GEN\_22\_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

returned unto his <u>01\_GEN\_31\_55</u> # And early in the morning Laban rose up, and kissed his sons and his daughters, and blessed them: and Laban departed, and returned unto his place.

returned unto his <u>01\_GEN\_37\_30</u># And he returned unto his brethren, and said, The child [is] not; and I, whither shall I go?

returned unto Jerusalem <u>10\_2SA\_12\_31</u> # And he brought forth the people that [were] therein, and put [them] under saws, and under harrows of iron, and under axes of iron, and made them pass through the brickkiln: and thus did he unto all the cities of the children of Ammon. So David and all the people returned unto Jerusalem.

returned unto me <u>30\_AMO\_04\_06</u># And I also have given you cleanness of teeth in all your cities, and want of bread in all your places: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD.

returned unto me <u>30\_AMO\_04\_11</u># I have overthrown [some] of you, as God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah, and ye were as a firebrand plucked out of the burning: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD.

returned unto me <u>27\_DAN\_04\_34</u> # And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion [is] an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom [is] from generation to generation:

returned unto me <u>27\_DAN\_04\_36</u> # At the same time my reason returned unto me; and for the glory of my kingdom, mine honour and brightness returned unto me; and my counsellors and my lords sought unto me; and I was established in my kingdom, and excellent majesty was added unto me.

returned unto Moses <u>04\_NUM\_16\_50</u> # And Aaron returned unto Moses unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: and the plague was stayed.

returned unto the <u>02\_EXO\_05\_22</u># And Moses returned unto the LORD, and said, Lord, wherefore hast thou [so] evil entreated this people? why [is] it [that] thou hast sent me?

returned unto the <u>02\_EXO\_32\_31</u># And Moses returned unto the LORD, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold.

returned unto the <u>01\_GEN\_37\_29</u># And Reuben returned unto the pit; and, behold, Joseph [was] not in the pit; and he rent his clothes.

returned unto their <u>06\_JOS\_04\_18</u> # And it came to pass, when the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD were come up out of the midst of Jordan, [and] the soles of the priests' feet were lifted up unto the dry land, that the waters of Jordan returned unto their place, and flowed over all his banks, as [they did] before.

returned unto their <u>07\_JUD\_21\_23</u># And the children of Benjamin did so, and took [them] wives, according to their number, of them that danced, whom they caught: and they went and returned unto their inheritance, and repaired the cities, and dwelt in them.

returned unto Zion <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_03</u> # Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain.

returned upon thee <u>10\_2SA\_16\_08</u># The LORD hath returned upon thee all the blood of the house of Saul, in whose stead thou hast reigned; and the LORD hath delivered the kingdom into the hand of Absalom thy son: and, behold, thou [art taken] in thy mischief, because thou [art] a bloody man.

returned <u>42\_LUK\_23\_48</u> # And all the people that came together to that sight, beholding the things which were done, smote their breasts, and returned.

returned <u>16\_NEH\_02\_15</u># Then went I up in the night by the brook, and viewed the wall, and turned back, and entered by the gate of the valley, and [so] returned.

turned a mighty <u>02\_EXO\_10\_19</u> # And the LORD turned a mighty strong west wind, which took away the locusts, and cast them into the Red sea; there remained not one locust in all the coasts of Egypt.

turned about and <u>11\_1KI\_02\_15</u># And he said, Thou knowest that the kingdom was mine, and [that] all Israel set their faces on me, that I should reign: howbeit the kingdom is turned about, and is become my brother's: for it was his from the LORD.

turned about and <u>41\_MAR\_08\_33</u># But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

turned about to <u>09\_1SA\_15\_27</u> # And as Samuel turned about to go away, he laid hold upon the skirt of his mantle, and it rent.

turned about to <u>26\_EZE\_42\_19</u># He turned about to the west side, [and] measured five hundred reeds with the measuring reed.

turned about upon <u>23\_ISA\_28\_27</u># For the fitches are not threshed with a threshing instrument, neither is a cart wheel turned about upon the cummin; but the fitches are beaten out with a staff, and the cummin with a rod.

turned about with <u>59\_JAM\_03\_04</u># Behold also the ships, which though [they be] so great, and [are] driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.

turned after Adonijah <u>11\_1KI\_02\_28</u># Then tidings came to Joab: for Joab had turned after Adonijah, though he turned not after Absalom. And Joab fled unto the tabernacle of the LORD, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.

turned again after <u>09\_1SA\_15\_31</u># So Samuel turned again after Saul; and Saul worshipped the LORD.

turned again and <u>06\_JOS\_08\_21</u># And when Joshua and all Israel saw that the ambush had taken the city, and that the smoke of the city ascended, then they turned again, and slew the men of Ai.

turned again the <u>19\_PSA\_126\_01</u> # A Song of degrees. When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream.

turned again unto <u>04\_NUM\_33\_07</u># And they removed from Etham, and turned again unto Pihahiroth, which [is] before Baalzephon: and they pitched before Migdol.

turned again upon <u>07\_JUD\_20\_48</u># And the men of Israel turned again upon the children of Benjamin, and smote them with the edge of the sword, as well the men of [every] city, as the beast, and all that came to

hand: also they set on fire all the cities that they came to.

turned against me <u>18\_JOB\_19\_19</u> # All my inward friends abhorred me: and they whom I loved are turned against me.

turned against the <u>02\_EXO\_14\_05</u> # And it was told the king of Egypt that the people fled: and the heart of Pharaoh and of his servants was turned against the people, and they said, Why have we done this, that we have let Israel go from serving us?

turned and came <u>05\_DEU\_09\_15</u># So I turned and came down from the mount, and the mount burned with fire: and the two tables of the covenant [were] in my two hands.

turned and caused <u>24\_JER\_34\_11</u># But afterward they turned, and caused the servants and the handmaids, whom they had let go free, to return, and brought them into subjection for servants and for handmaids.

turned and departed <u>07\_JUD\_18\_21</u># So they turned and departed, and put the little ones and the cattle and the carriage before them.

turned and fled <u>07\_JUD\_20\_45</u> # And they turned and fled toward the wilderness unto the rock of Rimmon: and they gleaned of them in the highways five thousand men; and pursued hard after them unto Gidom, and slew two thousand men of them.

turned and fled <u>07\_JUD\_20\_47</u># But six hundred men turned and fled to the wilderness unto the rock Rimmon, and abode in the rock Rimmon four months.

turned and gave <u>44\_ACT\_07\_42</u> # Then God turned, and gave them up to worship the host of heaven; as it is written in the book of the prophets, O ye house of Israel, have ye offered to me slain beasts and sacrifices [by the space of] forty years in the wilderness?

turned and had <u>24\_JER\_34\_15</u> # And ye were now turned, and had done right in my sight, in proclaiming liberty every man to his neighbour; and ye had made a covenant before me in the house which is called by my name:

turned and he <u>09\_1SA\_22\_18</u> # And the king said to Doeg, Turn thou, and fall upon the priests. And Doeg the Edomite turned, and he fell upon the priests, and slew on that day fourscore and five persons that did wear a linen ephod.

turned and lifted <u>38\_ZEC\_05\_01</u># Then I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a flying roll.

turned and lifted <u>38\_ZEC\_06\_01</u># And I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came four chariots out from between two mountains; and the mountains [were] mountains of brass.

turned and looked <u>42\_LUK\_22\_61</u> # And the Lord turned, and looked upon Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice.

turned and passed <u>05\_DEU\_02\_08</u># And when we passed by from our brethren the children of Esau, which dwelt in Seir, through the way of the plain from Elath, and from Eziongaber, we turned and passed by the way of the wilderness of Moab.

turned and polluted <u>24\_JER\_34\_16</u> # But ye turned and polluted my name, and caused every man his servant, and every man his handmaid, whom he had set at liberty at their pleasure, to return, and brought them into subjection, to be unto you for servants and for handmaids.

turned and rebelled <u>12\_2KI\_24\_01</u># In his days Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came up, and Jehoiakim became his servant three years: then he turned and rebelled against him.

turned and rebuked <u>42\_LUK\_09\_55</u># But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of.

turned and said <u>44\_ACT\_16\_18</u># And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.

turned and said <u>42\_LUK\_14\_25</u># And there went great multitudes with him: and he turned, and said unto them,

turned and said <u>40\_MAT\_16\_23</u># But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

turned and saw <u>43\_JOH\_01\_38</u> # Then Jesus turned, and saw them following, and saith unto them, What seek ye? They said unto him, Rabbi, [which is to say, being interpreted, Master,] where dwellest thou?

turned and took <u>05\_DEU\_02\_01</u># Then we turned, and took our journey into the wilderness by the way of the Red sea, as the LORD spake unto me: and we compassed mount Seir many days.

turned and went <u>11\_1KI\_10\_13</u># And king Solomon gave unto the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside [that] which Solomon gave her of his royal bounty. So she turned and went to her own country, she and her servants.

turned and went <u>14\_2CH\_09\_12</u> # And king Solomon gave to the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside [that] which she had brought unto the king. So she turned, and went away to her own land, she and her servants.

turned and went <u>12\_2KI\_05\_12</u> # [Are] not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? may I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in a rage.

turned and went <u>05\_DEU\_01\_24</u> # And they turned and went up into the mountain, and came unto the valley of Eshcol, and searched it out.

turned and went <u>05\_DEU\_03\_01</u> # Then we turned, and went up the way to Bashan: and Og the king of Bashan came out against us, he and all his people, to battle at Edrei.

turned and went <u>02\_EXO\_07\_23</u># And Pharaoh turned and went into his house, neither did he set his heart to this also.

turned and went <u>02\_EXO\_32\_15</u># And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony [were] in his hand: the tables [were] written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other [were] they written.

turned and went <u>07\_JUD\_18\_26</u> # And the children of Dan went their way: and when Micah saw that they [were] too strong for him, he turned and went back unto his house.

turned and went <u>04\_NUM\_21\_33</u># And they turned and went up by the way of Bashan: and Og the king of Bashan went out against them, he, and all his people, to the battle at Edrei.

turned as a <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_10</u># All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and [from] the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

turned as clay <u>18\_JOB\_38\_14</u> # It is turned as clay [to] the seal; and they stand as a garment.

turned aside after <u>09\_1SA\_08\_03</u># And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment.

turned aside after <u>54\_1TI\_05\_15</u># For some are already turned aside after Satan.

turned aside and <u>11\_1KI\_20\_39</u># And as the king passed by, he cried unto the king: and he said, Thy servant went out into the midst of the battle; and, behold, a man turned aside, and brought a man unto me, and said, Keep this man: if by any means he be missing, then shall thy life be for his life, or else thou shalt pay a talent of silver.

turned aside and <u>10\_2SA\_18\_30</u># And the king said [unto him], Turn aside, [and] stand here. And he turned aside, and stood still.

turned aside and <u>08\_RUT\_04\_01</u># Then went Boaz up to the gate, and sat him down there: and, behold, the kinsman of whom Boaz spake came by; unto whom he said, Ho, such a one! turn aside, sit down here. And he turned aside, and sat down.

turned aside into <u>40\_MAT\_02\_22</u># But when he heard that Archelaus did reign in Judaea in the room of his father Herod, he was afraid to go thither: notwithstanding, being warned of God in a dream, he turned aside into the parts of Galilee:

turned aside like <u>19\_PSA\_78\_57</u> # But turned back, and dealt unfaithfully like their fathers: they were turned aside like a deceitful bow.

turned aside my <u>25\_LAM\_03\_11</u># He hath turned aside my ways, and pulled me in pieces: he hath made me desolate.

turned aside out <u>05\_DEU\_09\_12</u># And the LORD said unto me, Arise, get thee down quickly from hence; for thy people which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt have corrupted [themselves]; they are quickly turned aside out of the way which I commanded them; they have made them a molten image.

turned aside out <u>04\_NUM\_22\_23</u># And the ass saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword drawn in his hand: and the ass turned aside out of the way, and went into the field: and Balaam smote the ass, to turn her into the way.

turned aside unto <u>54\_1TI\_01\_06</u># From which some having swerved have turned aside unto vain jangling;

turned away and <u>23\_ISA\_12\_01</u># And in that day thou shalt say, O LORD, I will praise thee: though thou wast angry with me, thine anger is turned away, and thou comfortedst me.

turned quickly out <u>07\_JUD\_02\_17</u> # And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the commandments of the LORD; [but] they did not so.

turned renew our <u>25\_LAM\_05\_21</u># Turn thou us unto thee, O LORD, and we shall be turned; renew our days as of old.

turned round about <u>18\_JOB\_37\_12</u> # And it is turned round about by his counsels: that they may do whatsoever he commandeth them upon the face of the world in the earth.

turned tail to <u>07\_JUD\_15\_04</u> # And Samson went and caught three hundred foxes, and took firebrands, and turned tail to tail, and put a firebrand in the midst between two tails.

turned the back <u>24\_JER\_48\_39</u> # They shall howl, [saying], How is it broken down! how hath Moab turned the back with shame! so shall Moab be a derision and a dismaying to all them about him.

turned the captivity <u>18\_JOB\_42\_10</u> # And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.

turned the curse <u>05\_DEU\_23\_05</u> # Nevertheless the LORD thy God would not hearken unto Balaam; but the LORD thy God turned the curse into a blessing unto thee, because the LORD thy God loved thee.

turned the curse <u>16\_NEH\_13\_02</u> # Because they met not the children of Israel with bread and with water, but hired Balaam against them, that he should curse them: howbeit our God turned the curse into a blessing.

turned the edge <u>19\_PSA\_89\_43</u># Thou hast also turned the edge of his sword, and hast not made him to stand in the battle.

turned the hair <u>03\_LEV\_13\_10</u> # And the priest shall see [him]: and, behold, [if] the rising [be] white in the skin, and it have turned the hair white, and [there be] quick raw flesh in the rising;

turned the heart <u>15\_EZR\_06\_22</u># And kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with joy: for the LORD had made them joyful, and turned the heart of the king of Assyria unto them, to strengthen their hands in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel.

turned the kingdom <u>13\_1CH\_10\_14</u># And inquired not of the LORD: therefore he slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David the son of Jesse.

turned the rock <u>19\_PSA\_114\_08</u># Which turned the rock [into] a standing water, the flint into a fountain of waters.

turned the sea <u>19\_PSA\_66\_06</u># He turned the sea into dry [land]: they went through the flood on foot: there did we rejoice in him.

turned the way <u>09\_1SA\_13\_18</u># And another company turned the way [to] Bethhoron: and another company turned [to] the way of the border that looketh to the valley of Zeboim toward the wilderness.

turned the world <u>44\_ACT\_17\_06</u> # And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

turned their back <u>24\_JER\_02\_27</u> # Saying to a stock, Thou [art] my father; and to a stone, Thou hast brought me forth: for they have turned [their] back unto me, and not [their] face: but in the time of their trouble they will say, Arise, and save us.

turned their backs <u>14\_2CH\_29\_06</u> # For our fathers have trespassed, and done [that which was] evil in the eyes of the LORD our God, and have forsaken him, and have turned away their faces from the habitation of the LORD, and turned [their] backs.

turned their backs <u>06\_JOS\_07\_12</u># Therefore the children of Israel could not stand before their enemies, [but] turned [their] backs before their enemies, because they were accursed: neither will I be with you any more, except ye destroy the accursed from among you.

turned their backs <u>07\_JUD\_20\_42</u> # Therefore they turned [their backs] before the men of Israel unto the way of the wilderness; but the battle overtook them; and them which [came] out of the cities they destroyed in the midst of them.

turned their faces <u>01\_GEN\_18\_22</u># And the men turned their faces from thence, and went toward Sodom: but Abraham stood yet before the LORD.

turned their faces <u>07\_JUD\_18\_23</u> # And they cried unto the children of Dan. And they turned their faces, and said unto Micah, What aileth thee, that thou comest with such a company?

turned their heart <u>11\_1KI\_18\_37</u># Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou [art] the LORD God, and [that] thou hast turned their heart back again.

turned their heart <u>19\_PSA\_105\_25</u># He turned their heart to hate his people, to deal subtly with his servants.

turned their rivers <u>19\_PSA\_78\_44</u> # And had turned their rivers into blood; and their floods, that they could not drink.

turned their waters <u>19\_PSA\_105\_29</u> # He turned their waters into blood, and slew their fish.

turned their way <u>09\_18A\_25\_12</u># So David's young men turned their way, and went again, and came and told him all those sayings.

turned them away 24\_JER\_50\_06 # My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away [on] the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.

turned them from <u>24\_JER\_23\_22</u> # But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

turned they from <u>16\_NEH\_09\_35</u># For they have not served thee in their kingdom, and in thy great goodness that thou gavest them, and in the large and fat land which thou gavest before them, neither turned they from their wicked works.

turned thitherward and <u>07\_JUD\_18\_15</u> # And they turned thitherward, and came to the house of the young man the Levite, [even] unto the house of Micah, and saluted him.

turned thyself from <u>19\_PSA\_85\_03</u># Thou hast taken away all thy wrath: thou hast turned [thyself] from the fierceness of thine anger.

turned to a <u>02\_EXO\_07\_15</u># Get thee unto Pharaoh in the morning; lo, he goeth out unto the water; and thou shalt stand by the river's brink against he come; and the rod which was turned to a serpent shalt thou take in thine hand.

turned to be <u>09\_1SA\_14\_21</u># Moreover the Hebrews [that] were with the Philistines before that time, which went up with them into the camp [from the country] round about, even they also [turned] to be with the Israelites that [were] with Saul and Jonathan.

turned to be <u>23\_ISA\_63\_10</u># But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, [and] he fought against them.

turned to blood <u>02\_EXO\_07\_17</u># Thus saith the LORD, In this thou shalt know that I [am] the LORD: behold, I will smite with the rod that [is] in mine hand upon the waters which [are] in the river, and they shall be turned to blood.

turned to blood <u>02\_EXO\_07\_20</u> # And Moses and Aaron did so, as the LORD commanded; and he lifted up the rod, and smote the waters that [were] in the river, in the sight of Pharaoh, and in the sight of his servants; and all the waters that [were] in the river were turned to blood.

turned to flight <u>58\_HEB\_11\_34</u># Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

turned to God <u>52\_1TH\_01\_09</u># For they themselves show of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God;

turned to God <u>44\_ACT\_15\_19</u> # Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God:

turned to his <u>61\_2PE\_02\_22</u> # But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog [is] turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

turned to his <u>24\_JER\_08\_06</u> # I hearkened and heard, [but] they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle.

turned to mourning <u>59\_JAM\_04\_09</u># Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and [your] joy to heaviness.

turned to mourning <u>18\_JOB\_30\_31</u> # My harp also is [turned] to mourning, and my organ into the voice of them that weep.

turned to see <u>66\_REV\_01\_12</u># And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;

turned to strangers <u>25\_LAM\_05\_02</u> # Our inheritance is turned to strangers, our houses to aliens.

turned to the <u>09\_1SA\_13\_18</u># And another company turned the way [to] Bethhoron: and another company turned [to] the way of the border that looketh to the valley of Zeboim toward the wilderness.

turned to the <u>12\_2KI\_23\_25</u># And like unto him was there no king before him, that turned to the LORD with all his heart, and with all his soul, and with all his might, according to all the law of Moses; neither after him arose there [any] like him.

turned to the <u>44\_ACT\_09\_35</u># And all that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw him, and turned to the Lord.

turned to the <u>17\_EST\_09\_01</u> # Now in the twelfth month, that [is], the month Adar, on the thirteenth day of the same, when the king's commandment and his decree drew near to be put in execution, in the day that the enemies of the Jews hoped to have power over them, [though it was turned to the contrary, that the Jews had rule over them that hated them;]

turned to the <u>42\_LUK\_07\_44</u> # And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped [them] with the hairs of her head.

turned toward him <u>26\_EZE\_17\_06</u># And it grew, and became a spreading vine of low stature, whose branches turned toward him, and the roots thereof were under him: so it became a vine, and brought forth branches, and shot forth sprigs.

turned unto fables <u>55\_2TI\_04\_04</u># And they shall turn away [their] ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

turned unto her <u>01\_GEN\_38\_16</u># And he turned unto her by the way, and said, Go to, I pray thee, let me come in unto thee; [for he knew not that she [was] his daughter in law.] And she said, What wilt thou give me, that thou mayest come in unto me?

turned unto me <u>26\_EZE\_26\_02</u># Son of man, because that Tyrus hath said against Jerusalem, Aha, she is broken [that was] the gates of the people: she is turned unto me: I shall be replenished, [now] she is laid waste:

turned unto me <u>24\_JER\_03\_10</u> # And yet for all this her treacherous sister Judah hath not turned unto me with her whole heart, but feignedly, saith the LORD.

turned unto me <u>24\_JER\_32\_33</u># And they have turned unto me the back, and not the face: though I taught them, rising up early and teaching [them], yet they have not hearkened to receive instruction.

turned unto other <u>05\_DEU\_31\_18</u># And I will surely hide my face in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.

turned unto others 24\_JER\_06\_12 # And their houses shall be turned unto others, [with their] fields and

wives together: for I will stretch out my hand upon the inhabitants of the land, saith the LORD.

turned unto the <u>09\_1SA\_13\_17</u># And the spoilers came out of the camp of the Philistines in three companies: one company turned unto the way [that leadeth to] Ophrah, unto the land of Shual:

turned unto the <u>44\_ACT\_11\_21</u># And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and turned unto the Lord.

turned unto thee <u>35\_HAB\_02\_16</u># Thou art filled with shame for glory: drink thou also, and let thy foreskin be uncovered: the cup of the LORD'S right hand shall be turned unto thee, and shameful spewing [shall be] on thy glory.

turned unto them <u>17\_EST\_09\_22</u> # As the days wherein the Jews rested from their enemies, and the month which was turned unto them from sorrow to joy, and from mourning into a good day: that they should make them days of feasting and joy, and of sending portions one to another, and gifts to the poor.

turned up as <u>18\_JOB\_28\_05</u> # [As for] the earth, out of it cometh bread: and under it is turned up as it were fire.

turned upon me <u>27\_DAN\_10\_16</u> # And, behold, [one] like the similitude of the sons of men touched my lips: then I opened my mouth, and spake, and said unto him that stood before me, O my lord, by the vision my sorrows are turned upon me, and I have retained no strength.

turned upon me <u>18\_JOB\_30\_15</u># Terrors are turned upon me: they pursue my soul as the wind: and my welfare passeth away as a cloud.

turned white and <u>03\_LEV\_13\_03</u># And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

turned white and <u>03\_LEV\_13\_25</u># Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the hair in the bright spot be turned white, and it [be in] sight deeper than the skin; it [is] a leprosy broken out of the burning: wherefore the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

turned white he <u>03\_LEV\_13\_13</u># Then the priest shall consider: and, behold, [if] the leprosy have covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce [him] clean [that hath] the plague: it is all turned white: he [is] clean.

turned white the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_20</u> # And if, when the priest seeth it, behold, it [be] in sight lower than the skin, and the hair thereof be turned white; the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a plague of leprosy broken out of the boil.

turned white then <u>03\_LEV\_13\_04</u># If the bright spot [be] white in the skin of his flesh, and in sight [be] not deeper than the skin, and the hair thereof be not turned white; then the priest shall shut up [him that hath] the plague seven days:

turned with him <u>18\_JOB\_41\_28</u># The arrow cannot make him flee: slingstones are turned with him into stubble.

turned within me <u>28\_HOS\_11\_08</u># How shall I give thee up, Ephraim? [how] shall I deliver thee, Israel? how shall I make thee as Admah? [how] shall I set thee as Zeboim? mine heart is turned within me, my repentings are kindled together.

turned within me <u>25\_LAM\_01\_20</u># Behold, O LORD; for I [am] in distress: my bowels are troubled; mine heart is turned within me; for I have grievously rebelled: abroad the sword bereaveth, at home [there is] as death.

turned **<u>28\_HOS\_07\_08</u>**# Ephraim, he hath mixed himself among the people; Ephraim is a cake not turned.
