overturneth the mountains <u>18\_JOB\_28\_09</u># He putteth forth his hand upon the rock; he overturneth the mountains by the roots.

overturneth them in <u>18\_JOB\_09\_05</u># Which removeth the mountains, and they know not: which overturneth them in his anger.

overturneth them in <u>18\_JOB\_34\_25</u> # Therefore he knoweth their works, and he overturneth [them] in the night, so that they are destroyed.

returneth again according <u>21\_ECC\_01\_06</u># The wind goeth toward the south, and turneth about unto the north; it whirleth about continually, and the wind returneth again according to his circuits.

turneth away from <u>26\_EZE\_18\_26</u> # When a righteous [man] turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and dieth in them; for his iniquity that he hath done shall he die.

turneth away from <u>26\_EZE\_18\_27</u># Again, when the wicked [man] turneth away from his wickedness that he hath committed, and doeth that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive.

turneth away from <u>26\_EZE\_18\_28</u># Because he considereth, and turneth away from all his transgressions that he hath committed, he shall surely live, he shall not die.

turneth away his <u>20\_PRO\_28\_09</u># He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer [shall be] abomination.

turneth backward <u>25\_LAM\_01\_08</u># Jerusalem hath grievously sinned; therefore she is removed: all that honoured her despise her, because they have seen her nakedness: yea, she sigheth, and turneth backward.

turneth from his <u>26\_EZE\_33\_12</u># Therefore, thou son of man, say unto the children of thy people, The righteousness of the righteous shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he turneth from his wickedness; neither shall the righteous be able to live for his [righteousness] in the day that he sinneth.

turneth from his <u>26\_EZE\_33\_18</u># When the righteous turneth from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, he shall even die thereby.

turneth he back <u>18\_JOB\_39\_22</u># He mocketh at fear, and is not affrighted; neither turneth he back from the sword.

turneth herself to <u>24\_JER\_49\_24</u> # Damascus is waxed feeble, [and] turneth herself to flee, and fear hath seized on [her]: anguish and sorrows have taken her, as a woman in travail.

turneth it prospereth <u>20\_PRO\_17\_08</u> # A gift [is as] a precious stone in the eyes of him that hath it: whithersoever it turneth, it prospereth.

turneth it upside <u>23\_ISA\_24\_01</u># Behold, the LORD maketh the earth empty, and maketh it waste, and turneth it upside down, and scattereth abroad the inhabitants thereof.

turneth it whithersoever 20\_PRO\_21\_01 # The king's heart [is] in the hand of the LORD, [as] the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.

turneth not away 20\_PRO\_30\_30 # A lion [which is] strongest among beasts, and turneth not away for any;

turneth not unto <a>23\_ISA\_09\_13</a> # For the people turneth not unto him that smiteth them, neither do they seek the LORD of hosts.

turneth rivers into 19\_PSA\_107\_33 # He turneth rivers into a wilderness, and the watersprings into dry ground;

turneth the shadow <u>30\_AMO\_05\_08</u> # [Seek him] that maketh the seven stars and Orion, and turneth the shadow of death into the morning, and maketh the day dark with night: that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the earth: The LORD [is] his name:
