twilight and I <u>26\_EZE\_12\_07</u># And I did so as I was commanded: I brought forth my stuff by day, as stuff for captivity, and in the even I digged through the wall with mine hand; I brought [it] forth in the twilight, [and] I bare [it] upon [my] shoulder in their sight.

twilight and left 12 2KI 07 07 # Wherefore they arose and fled in the twilight, and left their tents, and their horses, and their asses, even the camp as it [was], and fled for their life.

twilight and shall <u>26\_EZE\_12\_12</u> # And the prince that [is] among them shall bear upon [his] shoulder in the twilight, and shall go forth: they shall dig through the wall to carry out thereby: he shall cover his face, that he see not the ground with [his] eyes.

twilight even unto <u>09\_1SA\_30\_17</u># And David smote them from the twilight even unto the evening of the next day: and there escaped not a man of them, save four hundred young men, which rode upon camels, and fled.

twilight in the 20\_PRO\_07\_09 # In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night:

twilight saying No <u>18\_JOB\_24\_15</u># The eye also of the adulterer waiteth for the twilight, saying, No eye shall see me: and disguiseth [his] face.

twilight thereof be <u>18\_JOB\_03\_09</u> # Let the stars of the twilight thereof be dark; let it look for light, but [have] none; neither let it see the dawning of the day:

twilight thou shalt <u>26\_EZE\_12\_06</u># In their sight shalt thou bear [it] upon [thy] shoulders, [and] carry [it] forth in the twilight: thou shalt cover thy face, that thou see not the ground: for I have set thee [for] a sign unto the house of Israel.

twilight to go 12\_2KI\_07\_05 # And they rose up in the twilight, to go unto the camp of the Syrians: and when they were come to the uttermost part of the camp of Syria, behold, [there was] no man there.
