

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Ashurites and over <u>10\_2SA\_02\_09</u># And made him king over Gilead, and over the Ashurites, and over Jezreel, and over Ephraim, and over Benjamin, and over all Israel.

Ashurites have made 26 EZE 27 06 # [Of] the oaks of Bashan have they made thine oars; the company of the Ashurites have made thy benches [of] ivory, [brought] out of the isles of Chittim.

Asshurim and Letushim <u>01\_GEN\_25\_03</u># And Jokshan begat Sheba, and Dedan. And the sons of Dedan were Asshurim, and Letushim, and Leummim.

Bahurim behold thence <u>10\_2SA\_16\_05</u># And when king David came to Bahurim, behold, thence came out a man of the family of the house of Saul, whose name [was] Shimei, the son of Gera: he came forth, and cursed still as he came.

Bahurim hasted and 10\_2SA\_19\_16 # And Shimei the son of Gera, a Benjamite, which [was] of Bahurim, hasted and came down with the men of Judah to meet king David.

Bahurim Then said <u>10\_2SA\_03\_16</u># And her husband went with her along weeping behind her to Bahurim. Then said Abner unto him, Go, return. And he returned.

Bahurim which cursed <a href="mailto:11\_IKI\_02\_08">11\_IKI\_02\_08</a> # And, behold, [thou hast] with thee Shimei the son of Gera, a Benjamite of Bahurim, which cursed me with a grievous curse in the day when I went to Mahanaim: but he came down to meet me at Jordan, and I sware to him by the LORD, saying, I will not put thee to death with the sword.

Bahurim which had 10\_2SA\_17\_18 # Nevertheless a lad saw them, and told Absalom: but they went both of them away quickly, and came to a man's house in Bahurim, which had a well in his court; whither they went down.

burial and made <u>44\_ACT\_08\_02</u> # And devout men carried Stephen [to his burial], and made great lamentation over him.

burial because thou <u>23\_ISA\_14\_20</u> # Thou shalt not be joined with them in burial, because thou hast destroyed thy land, [and] slain thy people: the seed of evildoers shall never be renowned.

burial I say <u>21\_ECC\_06\_03</u># If a man beget an hundred [children], and live many years, so that the days of his years be many, and his soul be not filled with good, and also [that] he have no burial; I say, [that] an untimely birth [is] better than he.

burial of an <u>24\_JER\_22\_19</u># He shall be buried with the burial of an ass, drawn and cast forth beyond the gates of Jerusalem.

burial which belonged 14\_2CH\_26\_23 # So Uzziah slept with his fathers, and they buried him with his fathers in the field of the burial which [belonged] to the kings; for they said, He [is] a leper: and Jotham his son reigned in his stead.

burial 40\_MAT\_26\_12 # For in that she hath poured this ointment on my body, she did [it] for my burial.

buried Abner in 10\_2SA\_03\_32 # And they buried Abner in Hebron: and the king lifted up his voice, and

wept at the grave of Abner; and all the people wept.

buried Abraham and <u>01\_GEN\_49\_31</u># There they buried Abraham and Sarah his wife; there they buried Isaac and Rebekah his wife; and there I buried Leah.

buried all their <u>04\_NUM\_33\_04</u># For the Egyptians buried all [their] firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD executed judgments.

buried and Eleazar <u>05\_DEU\_10\_06</u># And the children of Israel took their journey from Beeroth of the children of Jaakan to Mosera: there Aaron died, and there he was buried; and Eleazar his son ministered in the priest's office in his stead.

buried and his 44\_ACT\_02\_29 # Men [and] brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day.

buried and Sarah <u>01\_GEN\_25\_10</u> # The field which Abraham purchased of the sons of Heth: there was Abraham buried, and Sarah his wife.

buried and that <u>46\_1CO\_15\_04</u> # And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

buried at Bethlehem <u>07\_JUD\_12\_10</u> # Then died Ibzan, and was buried at Bethlehem.

buried at Jerusalem 12 2KI 14 20 # And they brought him on horses: and he was buried at Jerusalem with his fathers in the city of David.

buried beneath Bethel <u>01\_GEN\_35\_08</u># But Deborah Rebekah's nurse died, and she was buried beneath Bethel under an oak: and the name of it was called Allonbachuth.

buried but they 24\_JER\_16\_04# They shall die of grievous deaths; they shall not be lamented; neither shall they be buried; [but] they shall be as dung upon the face of the earth: and they shall be consumed by the sword, and by famine; and their carcases shall be meat for the fowls of heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.

buried by the <u>10\_2SA\_19\_37</u> # Let thy servant, I pray thee, turn back again, that I may die in mine own city, [and be buried] by the grave of my father and of my mother. But behold thy servant Chimham; let him go over with my lord the king; and do to him what shall seem good unto thee.

buried her by 44\_ACT\_05\_10 # Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying [her] forth, buried [her] by her husband.

buried her there <u>01\_GEN\_48\_07</u> # And as for me, when I came from Padan, Rachel died by me in the land of Canaan in the way, when yet [there was] but a little way to come unto Ephrath: and I buried her there in the way of Ephrath; the same [is] Bethlehem.

buried him and 11\_1KI\_14\_18# And they buried him; and all Israel mourned for him, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by the hand of his servant Ahijah the prophet.

buried him And 12\_2KI\_13\_20 # And Elisha died, and they buried him. And the bands of the Moabites invaded the land at the coming in of the year.

buried him Because 14\_2CH\_22\_09 # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria,] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

buried him between <u>07\_JUD\_16\_31</u># Then his brethren and all the house of his father came down, and took him, and brought [him] up, and buried him between Zorah and Eshtaol in the buryingplace of Manoah his father. And he judged Israel twenty years.

buried him in 11\_1KI\_15\_08# And Abijam slept with his fathers; and they buried him in the city of David: and Asa his son reigned in his stead.

buried him in <u>09\_1SA\_25\_01</u># And Samuel died; and all the Israelites were gathered together, and lamented him, and buried him in his house at Ramah. And David arose, and went down to the wilderness of Paran.

buried him in <u>09\_1SA\_28\_03</u> # Now Samuel was dead, and all Israel had lamented him, and buried him in Ramah, even in his own city. And Saul had put away those that had familiar spirits, and the wizards, out of the land.

buried him in 14\_2CH\_14\_01 # So Abijah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Asa his son reigned in his stead. In his days the land was quiet ten years.

buried him in 14\_2CH\_16\_14# And they buried him in his own sepulchres, which he had made for himself in the city of David, and laid him in the bed which was filled with sweet odours and divers kinds [of spices] prepared by the apothecaries' art: and they made a very great burning for him.

buried him in 14\_2CH\_21\_20 # Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years, and departed without being desired. Howbeit they buried him in the city of David, but not in the sepulchres of the kings.

buried him in 14\_2CH\_24\_16 # And they buried him in the city of David among the kings, because he had done good in Israel, both toward God, and toward his house.

buried him in 14\_2CH\_24\_25 # And when they were departed from him, [for they left him in great diseases, ] his own servants conspired against him for the blood of the sons of Jehoiada the priest, and slew him on his bed, and he died: and they buried him in the city of David, but they buried him not in the sepulchres of the kings.

buried him in 14\_2CH\_27\_09 # And Jotham slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Ahaz his son reigned in his stead.

buried him in <u>14\_2CH\_28\_27</u> # And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city, [even] in Jerusalem: but they brought him not into the sepulchres of the kings of Israel: and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

buried him in <u>14\_2CH\_32\_33</u> # And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

buried him in 14\_2CH\_33\_20 # So Manasseh slept with his fathers, and they buried him in his own house: and Amon his son reigned in his stead.

buried him in 12 2KI 09 28 # And his servants carried him in a chariot to Jerusalem, and buried him in his sepulchre with his fathers in the city of David.

buried him in 12\_2KI\_10\_35 # And Jehu slept with his fathers: and they buried him in Samaria. And Jehoahaz his son reigned in his stead.

buried him in 12 2KI 13 09 # And Jehoahaz slept with his fathers; and they buried him in Samaria: and Joash his son reigned in his stead.

buried him in 12 2KI 23 30 # And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

buried him in 10 2SA 02 32 # And they took up Asahel, and buried him in the sepulchre of his father, which [was in] Bethlehem. And Joab and his men went all night, and they came to Hebron at break of day.

buried him in <u>05\_DEU\_34\_06</u> # And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: but no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day.

buried him in <u>01\_GEN\_25\_09</u># And his sons Isaac and Ishmael buried him in the cave of Machpelah, in the field of Ephron the son of Zohar the Hittite, which [is] before Mamre;

buried him in <u>01\_GEN\_50\_13</u># For his sons carried him into the land of Canaan, and buried him in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham bought with the field for a possession of a buryingplace of Ephron the Hittite, before Mamre.

buried him in <u>06\_JOS\_24\_30</u> # And they buried him in the border of his inheritance in Timnathserah, which [is] in mount Ephraim, on the north side of the hill of Gaash.

buried him in <u>06\_JOS\_24\_33</u> # And Eleazar the son of Aaron died; and they buried him in a hill [that pertained to] Phinehas his son, which was given him in mount Ephraim.

buried him in <u>07\_JUD\_02\_09</u> # And they buried him in the border of his inheritance in Timnathheres, in the mount of Ephraim, on the north side of the hill Gaash.

buried him not 14\_2CH\_24\_25 # And when they were departed from him, [for they left him in great diseases,] his own servants conspired against him for the blood of the sons of Jehoiada the priest, and slew him on his bed, and he died: and they buried him in the city of David, but they buried him not in the sepulchres of the kings.

buried him that 11\_1KI\_13\_31 # And it came to pass, after he had buried him, that he spake to his sons, saying, When I am dead, then bury me in the sepulchre wherein the man of God [is] buried; lay my bones beside his bones:

buried him with 14\_2CH\_25\_28 # And they brought him upon horses, and buried him with his fathers in the city of Judah.

buried him with 14\_2CH\_26\_23 # So Uzziah slept with his fathers, and they buried him with his fathers in the field of the burial which [belonged] to the kings; for they said, He [is] a leper: and Jotham his son reigned in his stead.

buried him with 12 2KI 12 21 # For Jozachar the son of Shimeath, and Jehozabad the son of Shomer, his servants, smote him, and he died; and they buried him with his fathers in the city of David: and Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.

buried him with 12\_2KI\_15\_07 # So Azariah slept with his fathers; and they buried him with his fathers in the city of David: and Jotham his son reigned in his stead.

buried him <u>10\_2SA\_02\_05</u># And David sent messengers unto the men of Jabeshgilead, and said unto them, Blessed [be] ye of the LORD, that ye have showed this kindness unto your lord, [even] unto Saul, and have buried him.

buried him 44\_ACT\_05\_06 # And the young men arose, wound him up, and carried [him] out, and buried [him].

buried him <u>01\_GEN\_35\_29</u> # And Isaac gave up the ghost, and died, and was gathered unto his people, [being] old and full of days: and his sons Esau and Jacob buried him.

buried his father <u>01\_GEN\_50\_14</u># And Joseph returned into Egypt, he, and his brethren, and all that went up with him to bury his father, after he had buried his father.

buried in a <u>01\_GEN\_15\_15</u># And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace; thou shalt be buried in a good old age.

buried in Aijalon <u>07\_JUD\_12\_12</u> # And Elon the Zebulonite died, and was buried in Aijalon in the country of Zebulun.

buried in Camon 07\_JUD\_10\_05 # And Jair died, and was buried in Camon.

buried in death <u>18\_JOB\_27\_15</u># Those that remain of him shall be buried in death: and his widows shall not weep.

buried in his 11\_1KI\_02\_34 # So Benaiah the son of Jehoiada went up, and fell upon him, and slew him: and he was buried in his own house in the wilderness.

buried in his 12\_2KI\_21\_26# And he was buried in his sepulchre in the garden of Uzza: and Josiah his son reigned in his stead.

buried in one <u>14\_2CH\_35\_24</u># His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.

buried in one <u>07\_JUD\_12\_07</u># And Jephthah judged Israel six years. Then died Jephthah the Gileadite, and was buried in [one of] the cities of Gilead.

buried in Pirathon <u>07\_JUD\_12\_15</u> # And Abdon the son of Hillel the Pirathonite died, and was buried in Pirathon in the land of Ephraim, in the mount of the Amalekites.

buried in Samaria 11\_1KI\_16\_28 # So Omri slept with his fathers, and was buried in Samaria: and Ahab his son reigned in his stead.

buried in Samaria 12 2KI 13 13 # And Joash slept with his fathers; and Jeroboam sat upon his throne: and Joash was buried in Samaria with the kings of Israel.

buried in Samaria 12\_2KI\_14\_16# And Jehoash slept with his fathers, and was buried in Samaria with the kings of Israel; and Jeroboam his son reigned in his stead.

buried in Shamir <u>07\_JUD\_10\_02</u># And he judged Israel twenty and three years, and died, and was buried in Shamir.

buried in the 11\_1KI\_02\_10 # So David slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David.

buried in the 11\_1KI\_11\_43# And Solomon slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David his father: and Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.

buried in the 14\_2CH\_09\_31 # And Solomon slept with his fathers, and he was buried in the city of David

his father: and Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.

buried in the 14\_2CH\_12\_16 # And Rehoboam slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David: and Abijah his son reigned in his stead.

buried in the 12 2KI 21 18 # And Manasseh slept with his fathers, and was buried in the garden of his own house, in the garden of Uzza: and Amon his son reigned in his stead.

buried in the <u>10\_2SA\_17\_23</u># And when Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not followed, he saddled [his] ass, and arose, and gat him home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order, and hanged himself, and died, and was buried in the sepulchre of his father.

buried in the <u>01\_GEN\_35\_19</u># And Rachel died, and was buried in the way to Ephrath, which [is] Bethlehem.

buried in the <u>07\_JUD\_08\_32</u># And Gideon the son of Joash died in a good old age, and was buried in the sepulchre of Joash his father, in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

buried in Tirzah 11\_1KI\_16\_06 # So Baasha slept with his fathers, and was buried in Tirzah: and Elah his son reigned in his stead.

buried Isaac and <u>01\_GEN\_49\_31</u> # There they buried Abraham and Sarah his wife; there they buried Isaac and Rebekah his wife; and there I buried Leah.

buried it and 40\_MAT\_14\_12# And his disciples came, and took up the body, and buried it, and went and told Jesus.

buried it in <u>10\_2SA\_04\_12</u># And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

buried it in <u>26\_EZE\_39\_15</u> # And the passengers [that] pass through the land, when [any] seeth a man's bone, then shall he set up a sign by it, till the buriers have buried it in the valley of Hamongog.

buried lay my 11 1KI 13 31 # And it came to pass, after he had buried him, that he spake to his sons, saying, When I am dead, then bury me in the sepulchre wherein the man of God [is] buried; lay my bones beside his bones:

buried Leah <u>01\_GEN\_49\_31</u> # There they buried Abraham and Sarah his wife; there they buried Isaac and Rebekah his wife; and there I buried Leah.

buried neither shall 24\_JER\_16\_06 # Both the great and the small shall die in this land: they shall not be buried, neither shall [men] lament for them, nor cut themselves, nor make themselves bald for them:

buried Sarah his <u>01\_GEN\_23\_19</u># And after this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre: the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan.

buried Saul 10\_28A\_02\_04 # And the men of Judah came, and there they anointed David king over the house of Judah. And they told David, saying, [That] the men of Jabeshgilead [were they] that buried Saul.

buried the king  $\underline{11\_1KI\_22\_37}$ # So the king died, and was brought to Samaria; and they buried the king in Samaria.

buried the LORD <u>08\_RUT\_01\_17</u> # Where thou diest, will I die, and there will I be buried: the LORD do so to me, and more also, [if ought] but death part thee and me.

buried the people <u>04\_NUM\_11\_34</u># And he called the name of that place Kibrothhattaavah: because there they buried the people that lusted.

buried their bones <u>13\_1CH\_10\_12</u> # They arose, all the valiant men, and took away the body of Saul, and the bodies of his sons, and brought them to Jabesh, and buried their bones under the oak in Jabesh, and fasted seven days.

buried them under <u>09\_1SA\_31\_13</u> # And they took their bones, and buried [them] under a tree at Jabesh, and fasted seven days.

buried there thou <u>24\_JER\_20\_06</u># And thou, Pashur, and all that dwell in thine house shall go into captivity: and thou shalt come to Babylon, and there thou shalt die, and shalt be buried there, thou, and all thy friends, to whom thou hast prophesied lies.

buried there <u>04\_NUM\_20\_01</u># Then came the children of Israel, [even] the whole congregation, into the desert of Zin in the first month: and the people abode in Kadesh; and Miriam died there, and was buried there.

buried they in <u>10\_2SA\_21\_14</u># And the bones of Saul and Jonathan his son buried they in the country of Benjamin in Zelah, in the sepulchre of Kish his father: and they performed all that the king commanded. And after that God was entreated for the land.

buried they in <u>06\_JOS\_24\_32</u> # And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.

buried they shall <u>24\_JER\_08\_02</u> # And they shall spread them before the sun, and the moon, and all the host of heaven, whom they have loved, and whom they have served, and after whom they have walked, and whom they have sought, and whom they have worshipped: they shall not be gathered, nor be buried; they shall be for dung upon the face of the earth.

buried they shall 24 JER 25 33 # And the slain of the LORD shall be at that day from [one] end of the earth even unto the [other] end of the earth: they shall not be lamented, neither gathered, nor buried; they shall be dung upon the ground.

buried thy husband <u>44\_ACT\_05\_09</u># Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband [are] at the door, and shall carry thee out.

buried who had 21\_ECC\_08\_10 # And so I saw the wicked buried, who had come and gone from the place of the holy, and they were forgotten in the city where they had so done: this [is] also vanity.

Buried with him <u>51\_COL\_02\_12</u> # Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

buried with him <u>45\_ROM\_06\_04</u># Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

buried with his <u>11\_1KI\_14\_31</u># And Rehoboam slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David. And his mother's name [was] Naamah an Ammonitess. And Abijam his son reigned in his stead.

buried with his 11\_1KI\_15\_24 # And Asa slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city

buried with his 12\_2KI\_08\_24 # And Joram slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David: and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead.

buried with his 12\_2KI\_15\_38 # And Jotham slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Ahaz his son reigned in his stead.

buried with his 12\_2KI\_16\_20 # And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David: and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

buried with the <u>24\_JER\_22\_19</u># He shall be buried with the burial of an ass, drawn and cast forth beyond the gates of Jerusalem.

buried <u>42\_LUK\_16\_22</u># And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;

buriers have buried <u>26\_EZE\_39\_15</u># And the passengers [that] pass through the land, when [any] seeth a man's bone, then shall he set up a sign by it, till the buriers have buried it in the valley of Hamongog.

centurion a just <u>44\_ACT\_10\_22</u> # And they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee.

centurion and they <u>40\_MAT\_27\_54</u># Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

centurion and to <u>44\_ACT\_27\_31</u> # Paul said to the centurion and to the soldiers, Except these abide in the ship, ye cannot be saved.

centurion answered and <u>40\_MAT\_08\_08</u># The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

centurion believed the <u>44\_ACT\_27\_11</u># Nevertheless the centurion believed the master and the owner of the ship, more than those things which were spoken by Paul.

centurion beseeching him <u>40\_MAT\_08\_05</u># And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,

centurion delivered the <u>44\_ACT\_28\_16</u># And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him.

centurion found a <u>44\_ACT\_27\_06</u># And there the centurion found a ship of Alexandria sailing into Italy; and he put us therein.

centurion Go thy <u>40\_MAT\_08\_13</u># And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, [so] be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

centurion he asked 41\_MAR\_15\_44 # And Pilate marvelled if he were already dead: and calling [unto him] the centurion, he asked him whether he had been any while dead.

centurion he gave 41\_MAR\_15\_45 # And when he knew [it] of the centurion, he gave the body to Joseph.

centurion heard that <u>44\_ACT\_22\_26</u># When the centurion heard [that], he went and told the chief captain, saying, Take heed what thou doest: for this man is a Roman.

centurion of Augustus' 44\_ACT\_27\_01 # And when it was determined that we should sail into Italy, they delivered Paul and certain other prisoners unto [one] named Julius, a centurion of Augustus' band.

centurion of the <u>44\_ACT\_10\_01</u># There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian [band],

centurion saw what <u>42\_LUK\_23\_47</u> # Now when the centurion saw what was done, he glorified God, saying, Certainly this was a righteous man.

centurion willing to <u>44\_ACT\_27\_43</u># But the centurion, willing to save Paul, kept them from [their] purpose; and commanded that they which could swim should cast [themselves] first [into the sea], and get to land:

enduring substance <u>58\_HEB\_10\_34</u># For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.

flourish and abundance 19 PSA 72 07 # In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endureth.

injurious but I <u>54\_1TI\_01\_13</u> # Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did [it] ignorantly in unbelief.

jurisdiction he sent <u>42\_LUK\_23\_07</u> # And as soon as he knew that he belonged unto Herod's jurisdiction, he sent him to Herod, who himself also was at Jerusalem at that time.

labouring fervently for <u>51\_COL\_04\_12</u> # Epaphras, who is [one] of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.
