Ahuzzath one of <u>01_GEN_26_26</u># Then Abimelech went to him from Gerar, and Ahuzzath one of his friends, and Phichol the chief captain of his army.

Buz and all 24_JER_25_23 # Dedan, and Tema, and Buz, and all [that are] in the utmost corners,

Buz his brother 01_GEN_22_21 # Huz his firstborn, and Buz his brother, and Kemuel the father of Aram,

Buz <u>13_1CH_05_14</u> # These [are] the children of Abihail the son of Huri, the son of Jaroah, the son of Gilead, the son of Michael, the son of Jeshishai, the son of Jahdo, the son of Buz;

Buzi in the <u>26_EZE_01_03</u># The word of the LORD came expressly unto Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzi, in the land of the Chaldeans by the river Chebar; and the hand of the LORD was there upon him.

Buzite answered and <u>18_JOB_32_06</u> # And Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite answered and said, I [am] young, and ye [are] very old; wherefore I was afraid, and durst not show you mine opinion.

Haruz of Jotbah <u>12_2KI_21_19</u> # Amon [was] twenty and two years old when he began to reign, and he reigned two years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Meshullemeth, the daughter of Haruz of Jotbah.

Huz his firstborn 01_GEN_22_21 # Huz his firstborn, and Buz his brother, and Kemuel the father of Aram,

Huzzab shall be <u>34_NAH_02_07</u> # And Huzzab shall be led away captive, she shall be brought up, and her maids shall lead [her] as with the voice of doves, tabering upon their breasts.

Jeuz and Shachia <u>13_1CH_08_10</u> # And Jeuz, and Shachia, and Mirma. These [were] his sons, heads of the fathers.

Nebuzaradan captain of <u>12_2KI_25_08</u># And in the fifth month, on the seventh [day] of the month, which [is] the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem:

Nebuzaradan the captain 24_JER_52_15 # Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive [certain] of the poor of the people, and the residue of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to the king of Babylon, and the rest of the multitude.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_52_16</u># But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left [certain] of the poor of the land for vinedressers and for husbandmen.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_52_26</u># So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard took them, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_52_30</u> # In the three and twentieth year of Nebuchadrezzar Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive of the Jews seven hundred forty and five persons: all the persons [were] four thousand and six hundred.

Uz and Hul <u>13_1CH_01_17</u># The sons of Shem; Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram, and Uz, and Hul, and Gether, and Meshech.

Uz and Hul <u>01_GEN_10_23</u> # And the children of Aram; Uz, and Hul, and Gether, and Mash.

Uz the cup <u>25_LAM_04_21</u># Rejoice and be glad, O daughter of Edom, that dwellest in the land of Uz; the cup also shall pass through unto thee: thou shalt be drunken, and shalt make thyself naked.

Uz whose name <a><u>18_JOB_01_01</u> # There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name [was] Job; and that man

Uzai over against <u>16_NEH_03_25</u> # Palal the son of Uzai, over against the turning [of the wall], and the tower which lieth out from the king's high house, that [was] by the court of the prison. After him Pedaiah the son of Parosh.

Uzal and Diklah <u>13_1CH_01_21</u> # Hadoram also, and Uzal, and Diklah,

Uzal and Diklah <u>01_GEN_10_27</u> # And Hadoram, and Uzal, and Diklah,

Uzza and Ahihud <u>13_1CH_08_07</u> # And Naaman, and Ahiah, and Gera, he removed them, and begat Uzza, and Ahihud.

Uzza and Ahio <u>13_1CH_13_07</u># And they carried the ark of God in a new cart out of the house of Abinadab: and Uzza and Ahio drave the cart.

Uzza and Amon <u>12_2KI_21_18</u># And Manasseh slept with his fathers, and was buried in the garden of his own house, in the garden of Uzza: and Amon his son reigned in his stead.

Uzza and he <u>13_1CH_13_10</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God.

Uzza and Josiah <u>12_2KI_21_26</u># And he was buried in his sepulchre in the garden of Uzza: and Josiah his son reigned in his stead.

Uzza his son 13_1CH_06_29 # The sons of Merari; Mahli, Libni his son, Shimei his son, Uzza his son,

Uzza put forth <u>13_1CH_13_09</u> # And when they came unto the threshingfloor of Chidon, Uzza put forth his hand to hold the ark; for the oxen stumbled.

Uzza the children 15_EZR_02_49 # The children of Uzza, the children of Paseah, the children of Besai,

Uzza the children <u>16_NEH_07_51</u># The children of Gazzam, the children of Uzza, the children of Phaseah,

Uzza wherefore that <u>13_1CH_13_11</u># And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzza: wherefore that place is called Perezuzza to this day.

Uzzah and Ahio <u>10_2SA_06_03</u> # And they set the ark of God upon a new cart, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab that [was] in Gibeah: and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drave the new cart.

Uzzah and God <u>10_2SA_06_07</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for [his] error; and there he died by the ark of God.

Uzzi Izrahiah and <u>13_1CH_07_03</u># And the sons of Uzzi; Izrahiah: and the sons of Izrahiah; Michael, and Obadiah, and Joel, Ishiah, five: all of them chief men.

Uzzi the son <u>13_1CH_09_08</u># And Ibneiah the son of Jeroham, and Elah the son of Uzzi, the son of Michri, and Meshullam the son of Shephatiah, the son of Reuel, the son of Ibnijah;

Uzzi the son 15_EZR_07_04 # The son of Zerahiah, the son of Uzzi, the son of Bukki,

Uzzi the son <u>16_NEH_11_22</u># The overseer also of the Levites at Jerusalem [was] Uzzi the son of Bani, the son of Hashabiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Micha. Of the sons of Asaph, the singers [were] over the business of the house of God.

Uzzi <u>13_1CH_06_05</u> # And Abishua begat Bukki, and Bukki begat Uzzi,

Uzzi <u>16_NEH_12_19</u># And of Joiarib, Mattenai; of Jedaiah, Uzzi;

Uzzia the Ashterathite <u>13_1CH_11_44</u># Uzzia the Ashterathite, Shama and Jehiel the sons of Hothan the Aroerite,

Uzziah and his <u>14_2CH_26_08</u> # And the Ammonites gave gifts to Uzziah: and his name spread abroad [even] to the entering in of Egypt; for he strengthened [himself] exceedingly.

Uzziah built towers <u>14_2CH_26_09</u> # Moreover Uzziah built towers in Jerusalem at the corner gate, and at the valley gate, and at the turning [of the wall], and fortified them.

Uzziah did howbeit <u>14_2CH_27_02</u> # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Uzziah did: howbeit he entered not into the temple of the LORD. And the people did yet corruptly.

Uzziah died I <u>23_ISA_06_01</u># In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.

Uzziah first and <u>14_2CH_26_22</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Uzziah, first and last, did Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, write.

Uzziah had an <u>14_2CH_26_11</u># Moreover Uzziah had an host of fighting men, that went out to war by bands, according to the number of their account by the hand of Jeiel the scribe and Maaseiah the ruler, under the hand of Hananiah, [one] of the king's captains.

Uzziah Jotham Ahaz <u>28_HOS_01_01</u> # The word of the LORD that came unto Hosea, the son of Beeri, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, king of Israel.

Uzziah Jotham Ahaz <u>23_ISA_01_01</u># The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

Uzziah king of <u>12_2KI_15_13</u># Shallum the son of Jabesh began to reign in the nine and thirtieth year of Uzziah king of Judah; and he reigned a full month in Samaria.

Uzziah king of <u>12_2KI_15_32</u># In the second year of Pekah the son of Remaliah king of Israel began Jotham the son of Uzziah king of Judah to reign.

Uzziah king of <u>30_AMO_01_01</u># The words of Amos, who was among the herdmen of Tekoa, which he saw concerning Israel in the days of Uzziah king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel, two years before the earthquake.

Uzziah king of 23_ISA_07_01 # And it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, [that] Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up toward Jerusalem to war against it, but could not prevail against it.

Uzziah king of <u>38_ZEC_14_05</u> # And ye shall flee [to] the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, [and] all the saints with thee.

Uzziah prepared for <u>14_2CH_26_14</u> # And Uzziah prepared for them throughout all the host shields, and spears, and helmets, and habergeons, and bows, and slings [to cast] stones.

Uzziah slept with <u>14_2CH_26_23</u># So Uzziah slept with his fathers, and they buried him with his fathers in the field of the burial which [belonged] to the kings; for they said, He [is] a leper: and Jotham his son reigned in his stead.

Uzziah the king <u>14_2CH_26_18</u> # And they withstood Uzziah the king, and said unto him, [It appertaineth] not unto thee, Uzziah, to burn incense unto the LORD, but to the priests the sons of Aaron, that are consecrated to burn incense: go out of the sanctuary; for thou hast trespassed; neither [shall it be] for thine honour from the LORD God.

Uzziah the king <u>14_2CH_26_21</u> # And Uzziah the king was a leper unto the day of his death, and dwelt in a several house, [being] a leper; for he was cut off from the house of the LORD: and Jotham his son [was] over the king's house, judging the people of the land.

Uzziah the son <u>16_NEH_11_04</u># And at Jerusalem dwelt [certain] of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin. Of the children of Judah; Athaiah the son of Uzziah, the son of Zechariah, the son of Amariah, the son of Shephatiah, the son of Mahalaleel, of the children of Perez;

Uzziah to burn <u>14_2CH_26_18</u># And they withstood Uzziah the king, and said unto him, [It appertaineth] not unto thee, Uzziah, to burn incense unto the LORD, but to the priests the sons of Aaron, that are consecrated to burn incense: go out of the sanctuary; for thou hast trespassed; neither [shall it be] for thine honour from the LORD God.

Uzziah was wroth <u>14_2CH_26_19</u> # Then Uzziah was wroth, and [had] a censer in his hand to burn incense: and while he was wroth with the priests, the leprosy even rose up in his forehead before the priests in the house of the LORD, from beside the incense altar.

Uzziah when he <u>14_2CH_26_03</u># Sixteen years old [was] Uzziah when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and two years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Jecoliah of Jerusalem.

Uzziah who was <u>14_2CH_26_01</u># Then all the people of Judah took Uzziah, who [was] sixteen years old, and made him king in the room of his father Amaziah.

Uzziah <u>13_1CH_27_25</u> # And over the king's treasures [was] Azmaveth the son of Adiel: and over the storehouses in the fields, in the cities, and in the villages, and in the castles, [was] Jehonathan the son of Uzziah:

Uzziah <u>12_2KI_15_30</u># And Hoshea the son of Elah made a conspiracy against Pekah the son of Remaliah, and smote him, and slew him, and reigned in his stead, in the twentieth year of Jotham the son of Uzziah.

Uzziah <u>15_EZR_10_21</u># And of the sons of Harim; Maaseiah, and Elijah, and Shemaiah, and Jehiel, and Uzziah.

Uzziel Amminadab the <u>13_1CH_15_10</u> # Of the sons of Uzziel; Amminadab the chief, and his brethren an hundred and twelve.

Uzziel and Jerimoth <u>13_1CH_07_07</u> # And the sons of Bela; Ezbon, and Uzzi, and Uzziel, and Jerimoth, and Iri, five; heads of the house of [their] fathers, mighty men of valour; and were reckoned by their genealogies twenty and two thousand and thirty and four.

Uzziel and the <u>02_EXO_06_18</u># And the sons of Kohath; Amram, and Izhar, and Hebron, and Uzziel: and the years of the life of Kohath [were] an hundred thirty and three years.

Uzziel four <u>13_1CH_23_12</u> # The sons of Kohath; Amram, Izhar, Hebron, and Uzziel, four.

Uzziel Micah the <u>13_1CH_23_20</u> # Of the sons of Uzziel; Micah the first, and Jesiah the second.

Uzziel Michah of <u>13_1CH_24_24</u> # [Of] the sons of Uzziel; Michah: of the sons of Michah; Shamir.

Uzziel Mishael and <u>02_EXO_06_22</u> # And the sons of Uzziel; Mishael, and Elzaphan, and Zithri.

Uzziel Shebuel and <u>13_1CH_25_04</u># Of Heman: the sons of Heman; Bukkiah, Mattaniah, Uzziel, Shebuel, and Jerimoth, Hananiah, Hanani, Eliathah, Giddalti, and Romamtiezer, Joshbekashah, Mallothi, Hothir, [and] Mahazioth:

Uzziel the son <u>16_NEH_03_08</u># Next unto him repaired Uzziel the son of Harhaiah, of the goldsmiths. Next unto him also repaired Hananiah the son of [one of] the apothecaries, and they fortified Jerusalem unto the broad wall.

Uzziel the sons <u>13_1CH_04_42</u> # And [some] of them, [even] of the sons of Simeon, five hundred men, went to mount Seir, having for their captains Pelatiah, and Neariah, and Rephaiah, and Uzziel, the sons of Ishi.

Uzziel the uncle <u>03_LEV_10_04</u> # And Moses called Mishael and Elzaphan, the sons of Uzziel the uncle of Aaron, and said unto them, Come near, carry your brethren from before the sanctuary out of the camp.

Uzzielites these are <u>04 NUM_03_27</u># And of Kohath [was] the family of the Amramites, and the family of the Izeharites, and the family of the Hebronites, and the family of the Uzzielites: these [are] the families of the Kohathites.

Uzzielites <u>13_1CH_26_23</u> # Of the Amramites, [and] the Izharites, the Hebronites, [and] the Uzzielites:

Zuzims in Ham <u>01_GEN_14_05</u> # And in the fourteenth year came Chedorlaomer, and the kings that [were] with him, and smote the Rephaims in Ashteroth Karnaim, and the Zuzims in Ham, and the Emims in Shaveh Kiriathaim,
