

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

unknown and yet <u>47_2CO_06_09</u> # As unknown, and [yet] well known; as dying, and, behold, we live; as chastened, and not killed;

unknown by face <u>48_GAL_01_22</u># And was unknown by face unto the churches of Judaea which were in Christ:

UNKNOWN GOD Whom <u>44_ACT_17_23</u> # For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.

unknown tongue edifieth <u>46_1CO_14_04</u> # He that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church.

unknown tongue let <u>46_1CO_14_27</u> # If any man speak in an [unknown] tongue, [let it be] by two, or at the most [by] three, and [that] by course; and let one interpret.

unknown tongue my <u>46_1CO_14_14</u> # For if I pray in an [unknown] tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.

unknown tongue pray <u>46_1CO_14_13</u># Wherefore let him that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue pray that he may interpret.

unknown tongue speaketh <u>46_1CO_14_02</u># For he that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth [him]; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.

unknown tongue <u>46_1CO_14_19</u> # Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that [by my voice] I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an [unknown] tongue.
