abused her all [07 JUD 19 25](#) # But the men would not hearken to him: so the man took his concubine, and brought her forth unto them; and they knew her, and abused her all the night until the morning: and when the day began to spring, they let her go.

accused Daniel and [27 DAN 06 24](#) # And the king commanded, and they brought those men which had accused Daniel, and they cast [them] into the den of lions, them, their children, and their wives; and the lions had the mastery of them, and brake all their bones in pieces or ever they came at the bottom of the den.

accused have the [44 ACT 25 16](#) # To whom I answered, It is not the manner of the Romans to deliver any man to die, before that he which is accused have the accusers face to face, and have licence to answer for himself concerning the crime laid against him.

accused him I [44 ACT 23 28](#) # And when I would have known the cause wherefore they accused him, I brought him forth into their council:

accused him of [41 MAR 15 03](#) # And the chief priests accused him of many things: but he answered nothing.

accused him [42 LUK 23 10](#) # And the chief priests and scribes stood and vehemently accused him.

accused of questions [44 ACT 23 29](#) # Whom I perceived to be accused of questions of their law, but to have nothing laid to his charge worthy of death or of bonds.

accused of riot [56 TIT 01 06](#) # If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly.

accused of the [44 ACT 22 30](#) # On the morrow, because he would have known the certainty wherefore he was accused of the Jews, he loosed him from [his] bands, and commanded the chief priests and all their council to appear, and brought Paul down, and set him before them.

accused of the [44 ACT 26 02](#) # I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before thee touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews:

accused of the [44 ACT 26 07](#) # Unto which [promise] our twelve tribes, instantly serving [God] day and night, hope to come. For which hope's sake, king Agrippa, I am accused of the Jews.

accused of the [40 MAT 27 12](#) # And when he was accused of the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing.

accused the Jews [27 DAN 03 08](#) # Wherefore at that time certain Chaldeans came near, and accused the Jews.

accused them before [66 REV 12 10](#) # And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

accused unto him [42 LUK 16 01](#) # And he said also unto his disciples, There was a certain rich man,

which had a steward; and the same was accused unto him that he had wasted his goods.

caused a blemish [03 LEV 24 20](#) # Breach for breach, eye for eye, tooth for tooth: as he hath caused a blemish in a man, so shall it be done to him [again].

caused a cry [24 JER 48 04](#) # Moab is destroyed; her little ones have caused a cry to be heard.

caused a deep [01 GEN 02 21](#) # And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

caused a mourning [26 EZE 31 15](#) # Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when he went down to the grave I caused a mourning: I covered the deep for him, and I restrained the floods thereof, and the great waters were stayed: and I caused Lebanon to mourn for him, and all the trees of the field fainted for him.

caused a seat [11 1KI 02 19](#) # Bathsheba therefore went unto king Solomon, to speak unto him for Adonijah. And the king rose up to meet her, and bowed himself unto her, and sat down on his throne, and caused a seat to be set for the king's mother; and she sat on his right hand.

caused all that [14 2CH 34 32](#) # And he caused all that were present in Jerusalem and Benjamin to stand [to it]. And the inhabitants of Jerusalem did according to the covenant of God, the God of their fathers.

caused all the [09 ISA 10 20](#) # And when Samuel had caused all the tribes of Israel to come near, the tribe of Benjamin was taken.

caused all this [24 JER 32 23](#) # And they came in, and possessed it; but they obeyed not thy voice, neither walked in thy law; they have done nothing of all that thou commandedst them to do: therefore thou hast caused all this evil to come upon them:

caused an ambushment [14 2CH 13 13](#) # But Jeroboam caused an ambushment to come about behind them: so they were before Judah, and the ambushment [was] behind them.

caused an east [19 PSA 78 26](#) # He caused an east wind to blow in the heaven: and by his power he brought in the south wind.

caused David to [09 ISA 20 17](#) # And Jonathan caused David to swear again, because he loved him: for he loved him as he loved his own soul.

caused Egypt to [23 ISA 19 14](#) # The LORD hath mingled a perverse spirit in the midst thereof: and they have caused Egypt to err in every work thereof, as a drunken [man] staggereth in his vomit.

caused every man [24 JER 34 16](#) # But ye turned and polluted my name, and caused every man his servant, and every man his handmaid, whom he had set at liberty at their pleasure, to return, and brought them into subjection, to be unto you for servants and for handmaids.

caused great joy [44 ACT 15 03](#) # And being brought on their way by the church, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great joy unto all the brethren.

caused grief he [47 2CO 02 05](#) # But if any have caused grief, he hath not grieved me, but in part: that I may not overcharge you all.

caused him to [11 1KI 01 44](#) # And the king hath sent with him Zadok the priest, and Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, and they have caused him to ride upon the king's mule:

caused him to [11 1KI 20 33](#) # Now the men did diligently observe whether [any thing would come] from him, and did hastily catch [it]: and they said, Thy brother Benhadad. Then he said, Go ye, bring him. Then Benhadad came forth to him; and he caused him to come up into the chariot.

caused him to [23 ISA 63 14](#) # As a beast goeth down into the valley, the Spirit of the LORD caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name.

caused him to [24 JER 15 08](#) # Their widows are increased to me above the sand of the seas: I have brought upon them against the mother of the young men a spoiler at noonday: I have caused [him] to fall upon it suddenly, and terrors upon the city.

caused him to [07 JUD 16 19](#) # And she made him sleep upon her knees; and she called for a man, and she caused him to shave off the seven locks of his head; and she began to afflict him, and his strength went from him.

caused him to [20 PRO 07 21](#) # With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him.

caused his army [26 EZE 29 18](#) # Son of man, Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon caused his army to serve a great service against Tyrus: every head [was] made bald, and every shoulder [was] peeled: yet had he no wages, nor his army, for Tyrus, for the service that he had served against it:

caused his children [14 2CH 33 06](#) # And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

caused his name [15 EZR 06 12](#) # And the God that hath caused his name to dwell there destroy all kings and people, that shall put to their hand to alter [and] to destroy this house of God which [is] at Jerusalem. I Darius have made a decree; let it be done with speed.

caused in the [26 EZE 32 25](#) # They have set her a bed in the midst of the slain with all her multitude: her graves [are] round about him: all of them uncircumcised, slain by the sword: though their terror was caused in the land of the living, yet have they borne their shame with them that go down to the pit: he is put in the midst of [them that be] slain.

caused it not [30 AMO 04 07](#) # And also I have withholden the rain from you, when [there were] yet three months to the harvest: and I caused it to rain upon one city, and caused it not to rain upon another city: one piece was rained upon, and the piece whereupon it rained not withered.

caused it to [32 JON 03 07](#) # And he caused [it] to be proclaimed and published through Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying, Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste any thing: let them not feed, nor drink water:

caused Lebanon to [26 EZE 31 15](#) # Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when he went down to the grave I caused a mourning: I covered the deep for him, and I restrained the floods thereof, and the great waters were stayed: and I caused Lebanon to mourn for him, and all the trees of the field fainted for him.

caused many to [39 MAL 02 08](#) # But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have corrupted the covenant of Levi, saith the LORD of hosts.

caused me to [26 EZE 03 02](#) # So I opened my mouth, and he caused me to eat that roll.

caused me to [26 EZE 37 02](#) # And caused me to pass by them round about: and, behold, [there were] very many in the open valley; and, lo, [they were] very dry.

caused me to [26 EZE 46 21](#) # Then he brought me forth into the utter court, and caused me to pass by the four corners of the court; and, behold, in every corner of the court [there was] a court.

caused me to [26 EZE 47 06](#) # And he said unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen [this]? Then he brought me, and caused me to return to the brink of the river.

caused me to [01 GEN 20 13](#) # And it came to pass, when God caused me to wander from my father's house, that I said unto her, This [is] thy kindness which thou shalt show unto me; at every place whither we shall come, say of me, He [is] my brother.

caused me to [01 GEN 41 52](#) # And the name of the second called he Ephraim: For God hath caused me to be fruitful in the land of my affliction.

caused me to [19 PSA 119 49](#) # ZAIN. Remember the word unto thy servant, upon which thou hast caused me to hope.

caused men to [19 PSA 66 12](#) # Thou hast caused men to ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water: but thou broughtest us out into a wealthy [place].

caused my fury [26 EZE 24 13](#) # In thy filthiness [is] lewdness: because I have purged thee, and thou wast not purged, thou shalt not be purged from thy filthiness any more, till I have caused my fury to rest upon thee.

caused my people [24 JER 12 14](#) # Thus saith the LORD against all mine evil neighbours, that touch the inheritance which I have caused my people Israel to inherit; Behold, I will pluck them out of their land, and pluck out the house of Judah from among them.

caused my people [24 JER 23 13](#) # And I have seen folly in the prophets of Samaria; they prophesied in Baal, and caused my people Israel to err.

caused my people [24 JER 23 22](#) # But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

caused my terror [26 EZE 32 32](#) # For I have caused my terror in the land of the living: and he shall be laid in the midst of the uncircumcised with [them that are] slain with the sword, [even] Pharaoh and all his multitude, saith the Lord GOD.

caused Solomon to [11 1KI 01 38](#) # So Zadok the priest, and Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, went down, and caused Solomon to ride upon king David's mule, and brought him to Gihon.

caused terror in [26 EZE 32 23](#) # Whose graves are set in the sides of the pit, and her company is round about her grave: all of them slain, fallen by the sword, which caused terror in the land of the living.

caused that even [43 JOH 11 37](#) # And some of them said, Could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died?

caused the arrows [25 LAM 03 13](#) # He hath caused the arrows of his quiver to enter into my reins.

caused the children [14 2CH 08 02](#) # That the cities which Hiram had restored to Solomon, Solomon built them, and caused the children of Israel to dwell there.

caused the children [04 NUM 31 16](#) # Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against the LORD in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD.

caused the dayspring [18 JOB 38 12](#) # Hast thou commanded the morning since thy days; [and] caused the dayspring to know his place;

caused the eyes [18 JOB 31 16](#) # If I have withheld the poor from [their] desire, or have caused the eyes of the widow to fail;

caused the gallows [17 EST 05 14](#) # Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made.

caused the house [26 EZE 44 12](#) # Because they ministered unto them before their idols, and caused the house of Israel to fall into iniquity; therefore have I lifted up mine hand against them, saith the Lord GOD, and they shall bear their iniquity.

caused the inhabitants [14 2CH 21 11](#) # Moreover he made high places in the mountains of Judah, and caused the inhabitants of Jerusalem to commit fornication, and compelled Judah [thereto].

caused the light [18 JOB 37 15](#) # Dost thou know when God disposed them, and caused the light of his cloud to shine?

caused the owners [18 JOB 31 39](#) # If I have eaten the fruits thereof without money, or have caused the owners thereof to lose their life:

caused the people [16 NEH 08 07](#) # Also Jeshua, and Bani, and Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodijah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, Pelaiah, and the Levites, caused the people to understand the law: and the people [stood] in their place.

caused the sea [02 EXO 14 21](#) # And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go [back] by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry [land], and the waters were divided.

caused the servants [24 JER 34 11](#) # But afterward they turned, and caused the servants and the handmaids, whom they had let go free, to return, and brought them into subjection for servants and for handmaids.

caused the slain [24 JER 51 49](#) # As Babylon [hath caused] the slain of Israel to fall, so at Babylon shall fall the slain of all the earth.

caused the solemn [25 LAM 02 06](#) # And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as [if it were of] a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

caused the tribe [09 ISA 10 21](#) # When he had caused the tribe of Benjamin to come near by their families, the family of Matri was taken, and Saul the son of Kish was taken: and when they sought him, he could not be found.

caused the waters [23 ISA 48 21](#) # And they thirsted not [when] he led them through the deserts: he caused the waters to flow out of the rock for them: he clave the rock also, and the waters gushed out.

caused the widow's [18 JOB 29 13](#) # The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy.

caused thee to [10 2SA 07 11](#) # And as since the time that I commanded judges [to be] over my people Israel, and have caused thee to rest from all thine enemies. Also the LORD telleth thee that he will make thee an house.

caused thee to [05 DEU 34 04](#) # And the LORD said unto him, This [is] the land which I sware unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, saying, I will give it unto thy seed: I have caused thee to see [it] with thine eyes, but thou shalt not go over thither.

caused thee to [26 EZE 16 07](#) # I have caused thee to multiply as the bud of the field, and thou hast increased and waxen great, and thou art come to excellent ornaments: [thy] breasts are fashioned, and thine hair is grown, whereas thou [wast] naked and bare.

caused thee to [23 ISA 43 23](#) # Thou hast not brought me the small cattle of thy burnt offerings; neither hast thou honoured me with thy sacrifices. I have not caused thee to serve with an offering, nor wearied thee with incense.

caused their sons [12 2KI 17 17](#) # And they caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

caused their sons [26 EZE 23 37](#) # That they have committed adultery, and blood [is] in their hands, and with their idols have they committed adultery, and have also caused their sons, whom they bare unto me, to pass for them through [the fire], to devour [them].

caused their terror [26 EZE 32 24](#) # There [is] Elam and all her multitude round about her grave, all of them slain, fallen by the sword, which are gone down uncircumcised into the nether parts of the earth, which caused their terror in the land of the living; yet have they borne their shame with them that go down to the pit.

caused their terror [26 EZE 32 26](#) # There [is] Meshech, Tubal, and all her multitude: her graves [are] round about him: all of them uncircumcised, slain by the sword, though they caused their terror in the land of the living.

caused them to [30 AMO 02 04](#) # Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Judah, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they have despised the law of the LORD, and have not kept his commandments, and their lies caused them to err, after the which their fathers have walked:

caused them to [26 EZE 20 10](#) # Wherefore I caused them to go forth out of the land of Egypt, and brought them into the wilderness.

caused them to [26 EZE 39 28](#) # Then shall they know that I [am] the LORD their God, which caused them to be led into captivity among the heathen: but I have gathered them unto their own land, and have left none of them any more there.

caused them to [28 HOS 04 12](#) # My people ask counsel at their stocks, and their staff declareth unto them: for the spirit of whoredoms hath caused [them] to err, and they have gone a whoring from under their God.

caused them to [24 JER 18 15](#) # Because my people hath forgotten me, they have burned incense to vanity, and they have caused them to stumble in their ways [from] the ancient paths, to walk in paths, [in] a way not cast up;

caused them to [24 JER 50 06](#) # My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away [on] the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.

caused them to [16 NEH 08 08](#) # So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused [them] to understand the reading.

caused them to [19 PSA 78 13](#) # He divided the sea, and caused them to pass through; and he made the waters to stand as an heap.

caused thine enemy [25 LAM 02 17](#) # The LORD hath done [that] which he had devised; he hath fulfilled his word that he had commanded in the days of old: he hath thrown down, and hath not pitied: and he hath caused [thine] enemy to rejoice over thee, he hath set up the horn of thine adversaries.

caused thine iniquity [38 ZEC 03 04](#) # And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.

caused thy days [26 EZE 22 04](#) # Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast defiled thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come [even] unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries.

caused to be [24 JER 29 04](#) # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, unto all that are carried away captives, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem unto Babylon;

caused to cleave [24 JER 13 11](#) # For as the girdle cleaveth to the loins of a man, so have I caused to cleave unto me the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah, saith the LORD; that they might be unto me for a people, and for a name, and for a praise, and for a glory: but they would not hear.

caused to fly [27 DAN 09 21](#) # Yea, whiles I [was] speaking in prayer, even the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, touched me about the time of the evening oblation.

caused to pass [26 EZE 20 26](#) # And I polluted them in their own gifts, in that they caused to pass through [the fire] all that openeth the womb, that I might make them desolate, to the end that they might know that I [am] the LORD.

caused waters to [19 PSA 78 16](#) # He brought streams also out of the rock, and caused waters to run down like rivers.

caused wine to [24 JER 48 33](#) # And joy and gladness is taken from the plentiful field, and from the land of Moab; and I have caused wine to fail from the winepresses: none shall tread with shouting; [their] shouting [shall be] no shouting.

caused you to [24 JER 29 07](#) # And seek the peace of the city whither I have caused you to be carried away captives, and pray unto the LORD for it: for in the peace thereof shall ye have peace.

caused you to [24 JER 29 14](#) # And I will be found of you, saith the LORD: and I will turn away your captivity, and I will gather you from all the nations, and from all the places whither I have driven you, saith the LORD; and I will bring you again into the place whence I caused you to be carried away captive.

caused you to [24 JER 29 31](#) # Send to all them of the captivity, saying, Thus saith the LORD concerning Shemaiah the Nehelamite; Because that Shemaiah hath prophesied unto you, and I sent him not, and he caused you to trust in a lie:

confused and the [44 ACT 19 32](#) # Some therefore cried one thing, and some another: for the assembly was confused; and the more part knew not wherefore they were come together.

confused noise and [23 ISA 09 05](#) # For every battle of the warrior [is] with confused noise, and garments rolled in blood; but [this] shall be with burning [and] fuel of fire.

espoused to a [42 LUK 01 27](#) # To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name [was] Mary.

espoused to Joseph [40 MAT 01 18](#) # Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

espoused to me [10 2SA 03 14](#) # And David sent messengers to Ishbosheth Saul's son, saying, Deliver [me] my wife Michal, which I espoused to me for an hundred foreskins of the Philistines.

espoused wife being [42 LUK 02 05](#) # To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

espoused you to [47 2CO 11 02](#) # For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present [you as] a chaste virgin to Christ.

excused [42 LUK 14 18](#) # And they all with one [consent] began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.

excused [42 LUK 14 19](#) # And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.

misused his prophets [14 2CH 36 16](#) # But they mocked the messengers of God, and despised his words, and misused his prophets, until the wrath of the LORD arose against his people, till [there was] no remedy.

mused in their [42 LUK 03 15](#) # And as the people were in expectation, and all men mused in their hearts of John, whether he were the Christ, or not;

refused and said [09 ISA 28 23](#) # But he refused, and said, I will not eat. But his servants, together with the woman, compelled him; and he hearkened unto their voice. So he arose from the earth, and sat upon the bed.

refused and said [01 GEN 39 08](#) # But he refused, and said unto his master's wife, Behold, my master wotteth not what [is] with me in the house, and he hath committed all that he hath to my hand;

refused and said [01 GEN 48 19](#) # And his father refused, and said, I know [it], my son, I know [it]: he also shall become a people, and he also shall be great: but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his seed shall become a multitude of nations.

refused him for [09 ISA 16 07](#) # But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for [the LORD seeth] not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.

refused him that [58 HEB 12 25](#) # See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more [shall not] we [escape], if we turn away from him that [speaketh] from heaven:

refused I have [20 PRO 01 24](#) # Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded;

refused if it [54 1TI 04 04](#) # For every creature of God [is] good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:

refused is become [19 PSA 118 22](#) # The stone [which] the builders refused is become the head [stone] of the corner.

refused my judgments [26 EZE 05 06](#) # And she hath changed my judgments into wickedness more than the nations, and my statutes more than the countries that [are] round about her: for they have refused my judgments and my statutes, they have not walked in them.

refused saith thy [23 ISA 54 06](#) # For the LORD hath called thee as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when thou wast refused, saith thy God.

refused saying Who [44 ACT 07 35](#) # This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge? the same did God send [to be] a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush.

refused the tabernacle [19 PSA 78 67](#) # Moreover he refused the tabernacle of Joseph, and chose not the tribe of Ephraim:

refused to be [01 GEN 37 35](#) # And all his sons and all his daughters rose up to comfort him; but he refused to be comforted; and he said, For I will go down into the grave unto my son mourning. Thus his father wept for him.

refused to be [58 HEB 11 24](#) # By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

refused to be [24 JER 31 15](#) # Thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, [and] bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they [were] not.

refused to be [19 PSA 77 02](#) # In the day of my trouble I sought the Lord: my sore ran in the night, and ceased not: my soul refused to be comforted.

refused to come [17 EST 01 12](#) # But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by [his] chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

refused to eat [10 2SA 13 09](#) # And she took a pan, and poured [them] out before him; but he refused to eat. And Amnon said, Have out all men from me. And they went out every man from him.

refused to give [11 1KI 21 15](#) # And it came to pass, when Jezebel heard that Naboth was stoned, and was dead, that Jezebel said to Ahab, Arise, take possession of the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, which he refused to give thee for money: for Naboth is not alive, but dead.

refused to give [04 NUM 20 21](#) # Thus Edom refused to give Israel passage through his border: wherefore Israel turned away from him.

refused to hear [24 JER 11 10](#) # They are turned back to the iniquities of their forefathers, which refused

to hear my words; and they went after other gods to serve them: the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my covenant which I made with their fathers.

refused to hearken [38 ZEC 07 11](#) # But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear.

refused to let [24 JER 50 33](#) # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah [were] oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

refused to obey [09 ISA 08 19](#) # Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us;

refused to obey [16 NEH 09 17](#) # And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou [art] a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

refused to receive [24 JER 05 03](#) # O LORD, [are] not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, [but] they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.

refused to return [28 HOS 11 05](#) # He shall not return into the land of Egypt, but the Assyrian shall be his king, because they refused to return.

refused to walk [19 PSA 78 10](#) # They kept not the covenant of God, and refused to walk in his law;

refused [12 2KI 05 16](#) # But he said, [As] the LORD liveth, before whom I stand, I will receive none. And he urged him to take [it]; but he refused.

refusedst to be [24 JER 03 03](#) # Therefore the showers have been withholden, and there hath been no latter rain; and thou hadst a whore's forehead, thou refusedst to be ashamed.

used as his [07 JUD 14 20](#) # But Samson's wife was [given] to his companion, whom he had used as his friend.

used curious arts [44 ACT 19 19](#) # Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books together, and burned them before all [men]: and they counted the price of them, and found [it] fifty thousand [pieces] of silver.

used deceit the [45 ROM 03 13](#) # Their throat [is] an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used

deceit; the poison of asps [is] under their lips:

used divination and [12 2KI 17 17](#) # And they caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

used enchantments and [14 2CH 33 06](#) # And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

used enchantments and [12 2KI 21 06](#) # And he made his son pass through the fire, and observed times, and used enchantments, and dealt with familiar spirits and wizards: he wrought much wickedness in the sight of the LORD, to provoke [him] to anger.

used helps undergirding [44 ACT 27 17](#) # Which when they had taken up, they used helps, undergirding the ship; and, fearing lest they should fall into the quicksands, struck sail, and so were driven.

used in any [03 LEV 07 24](#) # And the fat of the beast that dieth of itself, and the fat of that which is torn with beasts, may be used in any other use: but ye shall in no wise eat of it.

used none of [46 1CO 09 15](#) # But I have used none of these things: neither have I written these things, that it should be so done unto me: for [it were] better for me to die, than that any man should make my glorying void.

used oppression and [26 EZE 22 29](#) # The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully.

used out of [26 EZE 35 11](#) # Therefore, [as] I live, saith the Lord GOD, I will even do according to thine anger, and according to thine envy which thou hast used out of thy hatred against them; and I will make myself known among them, when I have judged thee.

used similitudes by [28 HOS 12 10](#) # I have also spoken by the prophets, and I have multiplied visions, and used similitudes, by the ministry of the prophets.

used sorcery and [44 ACT 08 09](#) # But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:

used the office [54 1TI 03 13](#) # For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.

used the young [07 JUD 14 10](#) # So his father went down unto the woman: and Samson made there a feast; for so used the young men to do.

used this power [46 1CO 09 12](#) # If others be partakers of [this] power over you, [are] not we rather? Nevertheless we have not used this power; but suffer all things, lest we should hinder the gospel of Christ.

used to fast [41 MAR 02 18](#) # And the disciples of John and of the Pharisees used to fast: and they come and say unto him, Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but thy disciples fast not?

used to push [02 EXO 21 36](#) # Or if it be known that the ox hath used to push in time past, and his owner hath not kept him in; he shall surely pay ox for ox; and the dead shall be his own.

used to the [24 JER 02 24](#) # A wild ass used to the wilderness, [that] snuffeth up the wind at her pleasure; in her occasion who can turn her away? all they that seek her will not weary themselves; in her month they shall find her.

used we flattering [52 1TH 02 05](#) # For neither at any time used we flattering words, as ye know, nor a cloak of covetousness; God [is] witness:

used witchcraft and [14 2CH 33 06](#) # And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

used [58 HEB 10 33](#) # Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used.
