utterly a fault <u>46\_1CO\_06\_07</u> # Now therefore there is utterly a fault among you, because ye go to law one with another. Why do ye not rather take wrong? why do ye not rather [suffer yourselves to] be defrauded?

utterly abhor it <u>05\_DEU\_07\_26</u> # Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: [but] thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it [is] a cursed thing.

utterly abolish <u>23\_ISA\_02\_18</u> # And the idols he shall utterly abolish.

utterly all her <u>24\_JER\_51\_03</u> # Against [him that] bendeth let the archer bend his bow, and against [him that] lifteth himself up in his brigandine: and spare ye not her young men; destroy ye utterly all her host.

utterly and all <u>05\_DEU\_13\_15</u># Thou shalt surely smite the inhabitants of that city with the edge of the sword, destroying it utterly, and all that [is] therein, and the cattle thereof, with the edge of the sword.

utterly and all <u>06\_JOS\_10\_37</u># And they took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof, and all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining, according to all that he had done to Eglon; but destroyed it utterly, and all the souls that [were] therein.

utterly and shalt <u>12\_2KI\_19\_11</u># Behold, thou hast heard what the kings of Assyria have done to all lands, by destroying them utterly: and shalt thou be delivered?

utterly and shalt <u>23\_ISA\_37\_11</u># Behold, thou hast heard what the kings of Assyria have done to all lands by destroying them utterly; and shalt thou be delivered?

utterly and that <u>06\_JOS\_11\_20</u># For it was of the LORD to harden their hearts, that they should come against Israel in battle, that he might destroy them utterly, [and] that they might have no favour, but that he might destroy them, as the LORD commanded Moses.

utterly and to <u>03\_LEV\_26\_44</u># And yet for all that, when they be in the land of their enemies, I will not cast them away, neither will I abhor them, to destroy them utterly, and to break my covenant with them: for I [am] the LORD their God.

utterly bald for <u>26\_EZE\_27\_31</u> # And they shall make themselves utterly bald for thee, and gird them with sackcloth, and they shall weep for thee with bitterness of heart [and] bitter wailing.

utterly be cut <u>04\_NUM\_15\_31</u> # Because he hath despised the word of the LORD, and hath broken his commandment, that soul shall utterly be cut off; his iniquity [shall be] upon him.

utterly be destroyed <u>05\_DEU\_04\_26</u> # I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that ye shall soon utterly perish from off the land whereunto ye go over Jordan to possess it; ye shall not prolong [your] days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed.

utterly broken and <u>24\_JER\_51\_58</u># Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The broad walls of Babylon shall be utterly broken, and her high gates shall be burned with fire; and the people shall labour in vain, and the folk in the fire, and they shall be weary.

utterly broken down <u>23\_ISA\_24\_19</u> # The earth is utterly broken down, the earth is clean dissolved, the earth is moved exceedingly.

utterly burned with <u>10\_28A\_23\_07</u> # But the man [that] shall touch them must be fenced with iron and the staff of a spear; and they shall be utterly burned with fire in the [same] place.

utterly burned with <u>66\_REV\_18\_08</u> # Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong [is] the Lord God who judgeth her.

utterly cast down <u>19\_PSA\_37\_24</u># Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth [him with] his hand.

utterly corrupt yourselves <u>05\_DEU\_31\_29</u> # For I know that after my death ye will utterly corrupt [yourselves], and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because ye will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands.

utterly cut off <u>34\_NAH\_01\_15</u> # Behold upon the mountains the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace! O Judah, keep thy solemn feasts, perform thy vows: for the wicked shall no more pass through thee; he is utterly cut off.

utterly darkened <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_17</u># Woe to the idol shepherd that leaveth the flock! the sword [shall be] upon his arm, and upon his right eye: his arm shall be clean dried up, and his right eye shall be utterly darkened.

utterly desolate <u>23\_ISA\_06\_11</u># Then said I, Lord, how long? And he answered, Until the cities be wasted without inhabitant, and the houses without man, and the land be utterly desolate,

utterly destroy after 24\_JER\_50\_21 # Go up against the land of Merathaim, [even] against it, and against the inhabitants of Pekod: waste and utterly destroy after them, saith the LORD, and do according to all that I have commanded thee.

utterly destroy all <u>09\_18A\_15\_03</u> # Now go and smite Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not; but slay both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass.

utterly destroy all <u>05\_DEU\_12\_02</u># Ye shall utterly destroy all the places, wherein the nations which ye shall possess served their gods, upon the high mountains, and upon the hills, and under every green tree:

utterly destroy every <u>07\_JUD\_21\_11</u># And this [is] the thing that ye shall do, Ye shall utterly destroy every male, and every woman that hath lain by man.

utterly destroy the 09\_1SA\_15\_18 # And the LORD sent thee on a journey, and said, Go and utterly destroy

utterly destroy the <u>23\_ISA\_11\_15</u># And the LORD shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall smite it in the seven streams, and make [men] go over dryshod.

utterly destroy them <u>05\_DEU\_07\_02</u> # And when the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, [and] utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor show mercy unto them:

utterly destroy them <u>05\_DEU\_20\_17</u> # But thou shalt utterly destroy them; [namely], the Hittites, and the Amorites, the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites; as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee:

utterly destroy them <u>24\_JER\_25\_09</u> # Behold, I will send and take all the families of the north, saith the LORD, and Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and will bring them against this land, and against the inhabitants thereof, and against all these nations round about, and will utterly destroy them, and make them an astonishment, and an hissing, and perpetual desolations.

utterly destroyed all <u>09\_1SA\_15\_08</u># And he took Agag the king of the Amalekites alive, and utterly destroyed all the people with the edge of the sword.

utterly destroyed all <u>06\_JOS\_06\_21</u> # And they utterly destroyed all that [was] in the city, both man and woman, young and old, and ox, and sheep, and ass, with the edge of the sword.

utterly destroyed all <u>06\_JOS\_08\_26</u> # For Joshua drew not his hand back, wherewith he stretched out the spear, until he had utterly destroyed all the inhabitants of Ai.

utterly destroyed all <u>06\_JOS\_10\_39</u> # And he took it, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof; and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and utterly destroyed all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining: as he had done to Hebron, so he did to Debir, and to the king thereof; as he had done also to Libnah, and to her king.

utterly destroyed all <u>06\_JOS\_10\_40</u> # So Joshua smote all the country of the hills, and of the south, and of the vale, and of the springs, and all their kings: he left none remaining, but utterly destroyed all that breathed, as the LORD God of Israel commanded.

utterly destroyed that <u>06\_JOS\_10\_35</u> # And they took it on that day, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and all the souls that [were] therein he utterly destroyed that day, according to all that he had done to Lachish.

utterly destroyed the <u>09\_1SA\_15\_20</u># And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites.

utterly destroyed the <u>05\_DEU\_02\_34</u> # And we took all his cities at that time, and utterly destroyed the men, and the women, and the little ones, of every city, we left none to remain:

utterly detest it <u>05\_DEU\_07\_26</u> # Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: [but] thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it [is] a cursed thing.

utterly drive them <u>06\_JOS\_17\_13</u># Yet it came to pass, when the children of Israel were waxen strong, that they put the Canaanites to tribute; but did not utterly drive them out.

utterly fall <u>23\_ISA\_40\_30</u> # Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall:

utterly forget you <u>24\_JER\_23\_39</u> # Therefore, behold, I, even I, will utterly forget you, and I will forsake you, and the city that I gave you and your fathers, [and cast you] out of my presence:

utterly hated her <u>07\_JUD\_15\_02</u> # And her father said, I verily thought that thou hadst utterly hated her; therefore I gave her to thy companion: [is] not her younger sister fairer than she? take her, I pray thee, instead of her.

utterly let nothing <u>24\_JER\_50\_26</u> # Come against her from the utmost border, open her storehouses: cast her up as heaps, and destroy her utterly: let nothing of her be left.

utterly made them <u>04\_NUM\_30\_12</u> # But if her husband hath utterly made them void on the day he heard [them; then] whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the LORD shall forgive her.

utterly melt for <u>10\_2SA\_17\_10</u> # And he also [that is] valiant, whose heart [is] as the heart of a lion, shall utterly melt: for all Israel knoweth that thy father [is] a mighty man, and [they] which [be] with him [are] valiant men.

utterly old and <u>26\_EZE\_09\_06</u> # Slay utterly old [and] young, both maids, and little children, and women: but come not near any man upon whom [is] the mark; and begin at my sanctuary. Then they began at the ancient men which [were] before the house.

utterly out of <u>19\_PSA\_119\_43</u># And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I have hoped in thy judgments.

utterly overthrow them <u>02\_EXO\_23\_24</u> # Thou shalt not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do after their works: but thou shalt utterly overthrow them, and quite break down their images.

utterly perish from <u>05\_DEU\_04\_26</u> # I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that ye shall soon utterly perish from off the land whereunto ye go over Jordan to possess it; ye shall not prolong [your] days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed.

utterly perish in <u>61\_2PE\_02\_12</u> # But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption;

utterly pluck up <u>24\_JER\_12\_17</u># But if they will not obey, I will utterly pluck up and destroy that nation, saith the LORD.

utterly put out <u>02\_EXO\_17\_14</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this [for] a memorial in a book, and rehearse [it] in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly put out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven.

utterly refuse to <u>02\_EXO\_22\_17</u> # If her father utterly refuse to give her unto him, he shall pay money according to the dowry of virgins.

utterly rejected Judah <u>24\_JER\_14\_19</u> # Hast thou utterly rejected Judah? hath thy soul loathed Zion? why hast thou smitten us, and [there is] no healing for us? we looked for peace, and [there is] no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble!

utterly rejected us <u>25\_LAM\_05\_22</u> # But thou hast utterly rejected us; thou art very wroth against us.

utterly separated me 23\_ISA\_56\_03 # Neither let the son of the stranger, that hath joined himself to the LORD, speak, saying, The LORD hath utterly separated me from his people: neither let the eunuch say, Behold, I [am] a dry tree.

utterly spoiled for <u>23\_ISA\_24\_03</u> # The land shall be utterly emptied, and utterly spoiled: for the LORD hath spoken this word.

utterly spoiled he <u>33\_MIC\_02\_04</u> # In that day shall [one] take up a parable against you, and lament with a doleful lamentation, [and] say, We be utterly spoiled: he hath changed the portion of my people: how hath he removed [it] from me! turning away he hath divided our fields.

utterly supplant and <u>24\_JER\_09\_04</u># Take ye heed every one of his neighbour, and trust ye not in any brother: for every brother will utterly supplant, and every neighbour will walk with slanders.

utterly take from <u>19\_PSA\_89\_33</u># Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail.

utterly take them <u>28\_HOS\_01\_06</u> # And she conceived again, and bare a daughter. And [God] said unto him, Call her name Loruhamah: for I will no more have mercy upon the house of Israel; but I will utterly take them away.

utterly to abhor <u>09\_1SA\_27\_12</u> # And Achish believed David, saying, He hath made his people Israel utterly to abhor him; therefore he shall be my servant for ever.

utterly to destroy <u>11\_1KI\_09\_21</u># Their children that were left after them in the land, whom the children of Israel also were not able utterly to destroy, upon those did Solomon levy a tribute of bondservice unto this day.

utterly to make <u>27\_DAN\_11\_44</u># But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many.

utterly unpunished Ye 24\_JER\_25\_29 # For, lo, I begin to bring evil on the city which is called by my name,

and should ye be utterly unpunished? Ye shall not be unpunished: for I will call for a sword upon all the inhabitants of the earth, saith the LORD of hosts.

utterly unto this <u>13\_1CH\_04\_41</u># And these written by name came in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and smote their tents, and the habitations that were found there, and destroyed them utterly unto this day, and dwelt in their rooms: because [there was] pasture there for their flocks.

utterly waste and <u>26\_EZE\_29\_10</u># Behold, therefore I [am] against thee, and against thy rivers, and I will make the land of Egypt utterly waste [and] desolate, from the tower of Syene even unto the border of Ethiopia.

utterly wasted <u>23\_ISA\_60\_12</u> # For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, [those] nations shall be utterly wasted.

utterly with their <u>06\_JOS\_11\_21</u># And at that time came Joshua, and cut off the Anakims from the mountains, from Hebron, from Debir, from Anab, and from all the mountains of Judah, and from all the mountains of Israel: Joshua destroyed them utterly with their cities.
