

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Vashti according to <u>17_EST_01_15</u> # What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law, because she hath not performed the commandment of the king Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?

Vashti And the <u>17_EST_02_04</u> # And let the maiden which pleaseth the king be queen instead of Vashti. And the thing pleased the king; and he did so.

Vashti and what <u>17_EST_02_01</u># After these things, when the wrath of king Ahasuerus was appeased, he remembered Vashti, and what she had done, and what was decreed against her.

Vashti come no <u>17_EST_01_19</u> # If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

Vashti refused to <u>17_EST_01_12</u># But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by [his] chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

Vashti the queen <u>17_EST_01_09</u> # Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women [in] the royal house which [belonged] to king Ahasuerus.

Vashti the queen <u>17_EST_01_11</u># To bring Vashti the queen before the king with the crown royal, to show the people and the princes her beauty: for she [was] fair to look on.

Vashti the queen <u>17_EST_01_16</u> # And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that [are] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

Vashti the queen <u>17_EST_01_17</u># For [this] deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.

Vashti <u>17_EST_02_17</u># And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.
