valour a thousand <u>13_1CH_26_30</u># [And] of the Hebronites, Hashabiah and his brethren, men of valour, a thousand and seven hundred, [were] officers among them of Israel on this side Jordan westward in all the business of the LORD, and in the service of the king.

valour an hundred <u>16_NEH_11_14</u># And their brethren, mighty men of valour, an hundred twenty and eight: and their overseer [was] Zabdiel, the son of [one of] the great men.

valour and he <u>07_JUD_11_01</u># Now Jephthah the Gileadite was a mighty man of valour, and he [was] the son of an harlot: and Gilead begat Jephthah.

valour and help <u>06_JOS_01_14</u># Your wives, your little ones, and your cattle, shall remain in the land which Moses gave you on this side Jordan; but ye shall pass before your brethren armed, all the mighty men of valour, and help them;

valour and of <u>13_1CH_12_28</u># And Zadok, a young man mighty of valour, and of his father's house twenty and two captains.

valour and sent <u>06_JOS_08_03</u># So Joshua arose, and all the people of war, to go up against Ai: and Joshua chose out thirty thousand mighty men of valour, and sent them away by night.

valour and Solomon <u>11_1KI_11_28</u># And the man Jeroboam [was] a mighty man of valour: and Solomon seeing the young man that he was industrious, he made him ruler over all the charge of the house of Joseph.

valour and the <u>14_2CH_32_21</u> # And the LORD sent an angel, which cut off all the mighty men of valour, and the leaders and captains in the camp of the king of Assyria. So he returned with shame of face to his own land. And when he was come into the house of his god, they that came forth of his own bowels slew him there with the sword.

valour and there <u>07_JUD_03_29</u> # And they slew of Moab at that time about ten thousand men, all lusty, and all men of valour; and there escaped not a man.

valour and were <u>13_1CH_07_07</u># And the sons of Bela; Ezbon, and Uzzi, and Uzziel, and Jerimoth, and Iri, five; heads of the house of [their] fathers, mighty men of valour; and were reckoned by their genealogies twenty and two thousand and thirty and four.

valour and were <u>13_1CH_12_21</u> # And they helped David against the band [of the rovers]: for they [were] all mighty men of valour, and were captains in the host.

valour and with <u>14_2CH_17_17</u># And of Benjamin; Eliada a mighty man of valour, and with him armed men with bow and shield two hundred thousand.

valour archers and <u>13_1CH_08_40</u># And the sons of Ulam were mighty men of valour, archers, and had many sons, and sons' sons, an hundred and fifty. All these [are] of the sons of Benjamin.

valour at Jazer <u>13_1CH_26_31</u> # Among the Hebronites [was] Jerijah the chief, [even] among the Hebronites, according to the generations of his fathers. In the fortieth year of the reign of David they were sought for, and there were found among them mighty men of valour at Jazer of Gilead.

valour but he <u>12_2KI_05_01</u> # Now Naaman, captain of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honourable, because by him the LORD had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a mighty man in valour, [but he was] a leper.

valour chief of <u>13_1CH_07_40</u> # All these [were] the children of Asher, heads of [their] father's house, choice [and] mighty men of valour, chief of the princes. And the number throughout the genealogy of them that were apt to the war [and] to battle [was] twenty and six thousand men.

valour even ten <u>12_2KI_24_14</u> # And he carried away all Jerusalem, and all the princes, and all the mighty men of valour, [even] ten thousand captives, and all the craftsmen and smiths: none remained, save the poorest sort of the people of the land.

valour famous men <u>13_1CH_05_24</u> # And these [were] the heads of the house of their fathers, even Epher, and Ishi, and Eliel, and Azriel, and Jeremiah, and Hodaviah, and Jahdiel, mighty men of valour, famous men, [and] heads of the house of their fathers.

valour famous throughout <u>13_1CH_12_30</u> # And of the children of Ephraim twenty thousand and eight hundred, mighty men of valour, famous throughout the house of their fathers.

valour for the <u>13_1CH_12_25</u># Of the children of Simeon, mighty men of valour for the war, seven thousand and one hundred.

valour from Zorah <u>07_JUD_18_02</u> # And the children of Dan sent of their family five men from their coasts, men of valour, from Zorah, and from Eshtaol, to spy out the land, and to search it; and they said unto them, Go, search the land: who when they came to mount Ephraim, to the house of Micah, they lodged there.

valour out of <u>14_2CH_25_06</u># He hired also an hundred thousand mighty men of valour out of Israel for an hundred talents of silver.

valour three hundred <u>14_2CH_17_14</u># And these [are] the numbers of them according to the house of their fathers: Of Judah, the captains of thousands; Adnah the chief, and with him mighty men of valour three hundred thousand.

valour was twenty <u>13_1CH_07_09</u># And the number of them, after their genealogy by their generations, heads of the house of their fathers, mighty men of valour, [was] twenty thousand and two hundred.

valour were in <u>14_2CH_17_13</u> # And he had much business in the cities of Judah: and the men of war, mighty men of valour, [were] in Jerusalem.

valour were seventeen <u>13_1CH_07_11</u> # All these the sons of Jediael, by the heads of their fathers, mighty men of valour, [were] seventeen thousand and two hundred [soldiers], fit to go out for war [and] battle.

valour were two <u>13_1CH_26_32</u># And his brethren, men of valour, [were] two thousand and seven hundred chief fathers, whom king David made rulers over the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, for every matter pertaining to God, and affairs of the king.

valour were two <u>14_2CH_26_12</u># The whole number of the chief of the fathers of the mighty men of valour [were] two thousand and six hundred.

valour <u>13_1CH_26_06</u> # Also unto Shemaiah his son were sons born, that ruled throughout the house of their father: for they [were] mighty men of valour.

valour <u>14_2CH_13_03</u># And Abijah set the battle in array with an army of valiant men of war, [even] four hundred thousand chosen men: Jeroboam also set the battle in array against him with eight hundred

thousand chosen men, [being] mighty men of valour.

valour <u>14_2CH_14_08</u> # And Asa had an army [of men] that bare targets and spears, out of Judah three hundred thousand; and out of Benjamin, that bare shields and drew bows, two hundred and fourscore thousand: all these [were] mighty men of valour.

valour <u>14_2CH_17_16</u># And next him [was] Amasiah the son of Zichri, who willingly offered himself unto the LORD; and with him two hundred thousand mighty men of valour.

valour <u>06_JOS_06_02</u># And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, [and] the mighty men of valour.

valour <u>06_JOS_10_07</u># So Joshua ascended from Gilgal, he, and all the people of war with him, and all the mighty men of valour.

valour <u>07_JUD_06_12</u> # And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him, and said unto him, The LORD [is] with thee, thou mighty man of valour.

valour <u>07_JUD_20_44</u> # And there fell of Benjamin eighteen thousand men; all these [were] men of valour.

valour <u>07_JUD_20_46</u># So that all which fell that day of Benjamin were twenty and five thousand men that drew the sword; all these [were] men of valour.
