vanity and a <u>21\_ECC\_02\_21</u># For there is a man whose labour [is] in wisdom, and in knowledge, and in equity; yet to a man that hath not laboured therein shall he leave it [for] his portion. This also [is] vanity and a great evil.

vanity and are <u>24\_JER\_02\_05</u> # Thus saith the LORD, What iniquity have your fathers found in me, that they are gone far from me, and have walked after vanity, and are become vain?

vanity and became <u>12\_2KI\_17\_15</u> # And they rejected his statutes, and his covenant that he made with their fathers, and his testimonies which he testified against them; and they followed vanity, and became vain, and went after the heathen that [were] round about them, [concerning] whom the LORD had charged them, that they should not do like them.

vanity and departeth <u>21\_ECC\_06\_04</u> # For he cometh in with vanity, and departeth in darkness, and his name shall be covered with darkness.

vanity and divining <u>26\_EZE\_22\_28</u> # And her prophets have daubed them with untempered [mortar], seeing vanity, and divining lies unto them, saying, Thus saith the Lord GOD, when the LORD hath not spoken.

vanity and it 21\_ECC\_06\_02 # A man to whom God hath given riches, wealth, and honour, so that he wanteth nothing for his soul of all that he desireth, yet God giveth him not power to eat thereof, but a stranger eateth it: this [is] vanity, and it [is] an evil disease.

vanity and lies <u>20\_PRO\_30\_08</u> # Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me:

vanity and lying <u>26\_EZE\_13\_06</u> # They have seen vanity and lying divination, saying, The LORD saith: and the LORD hath not sent them: and they have made [others] to hope that they would confirm the word.

vanity and men <u>19\_PSA\_62\_09</u> # Surely men of low degree [are] vanity, [and] men of high degree [are] a lie: to be laid in the balance, they [are] altogether [lighter] than vanity.

vanity and quicken <u>19\_PSA\_119\_37</u># Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; [and] quicken thou me in thy way.

vanity and seek <u>19\_PSA\_04\_02</u># O ye sons of men, how long [will ye turn] my glory into shame? [how long] will ye love vanity, [and] seek after leasing? Selah.

vanity and seen <u>26\_EZE\_13\_08</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye have spoken vanity, and seen lies, therefore, behold, I [am] against you, saith the Lord GOD.

vanity and sin <u>23\_ISA\_05\_18</u># Woe unto them that draw iniquity with cords of vanity, and sin as it were with a cart rope:

vanity and speak <u>23\_ISA\_59\_04</u># None calleth for justice, nor [any] pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity.

vanity and that <u>26\_EZE\_13\_09</u># And mine hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity, and that divine

lies: they shall not be in the assembly of my people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I [am] the Lord GOD.

vanity and the <u>24\_JER\_10\_15</u># They [are] vanity, [and] the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish.

vanity and the <u>20\_PRO\_22\_08</u># He that soweth iniquity shall reap vanity: and the rod of his anger shall fail.

vanity and the <u>38\_ZEC\_10\_02</u># For the idols have spoken vanity, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because [there was] no shepherd.

vanity and their <u>23\_ISA\_44\_09</u> # They that make a graven image [are] all of them vanity; and their delectable things shall not profit; and they [are] their own witnesses; they see not, nor know; that they may be ashamed.

vanity and their <u>18\_JOB\_15\_35</u> # They conceive mischief, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepareth deceit.

vanity and their <u>19\_PSA\_144\_08</u># Whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand [is] a right hand of falsehood.

vanity and their <u>19\_PSA\_144\_11</u> # Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand [is] a right hand of falsehood:

vanity and their <u>19\_PSA\_78\_33</u> # Therefore their days did he consume in vanity, and their years in trouble.

vanity and things <u>24\_JER\_16\_19</u> # O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto thee from the ends of the earth, and shall say, Surely our fathers have inherited lies, vanity, and [things] wherein [there is] no profit.

vanity and vexation <u>21\_ECC\_01\_14</u> # I have seen all the works that are done under the sun; and, behold, all [is] vanity and vexation of spirit.

vanity and vexation <u>21\_ECC\_02\_11</u># Then I looked on all the works that my hands had wrought, and on the labour that I had laboured to do: and, behold, all [was] vanity and vexation of spirit, and [there was] no profit under the sun.

vanity nor sworn <u>19\_PSA\_24\_04</u> # He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

vanity not willingly <u>45\_ROM\_08\_20</u># For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected [the same] in hope,

vanity of their <u>49\_EPH\_04\_17</u> # This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,

vanity of vanities <u>21\_ECC\_01\_02</u> # Vanity of vanities, saith the Preacher, vanity of vanities; all [is] vanity.

vanity Selah <u>19\_PSA\_39\_05</u># Behold, thou hast made my days [as] an handbreadth; and mine age [is] as nothing before thee: verily every man at his best state [is] altogether vanity. Selah.

vanity Selah <u>19\_PSA\_39\_11</u> # When thou with rebukes dost correct man for iniquity, thou makest his beauty to consume away like a moth: surely every man [is] vanity. Selah.

vanity shall be <u>18\_JOB\_15\_31</u> # Let not him that is deceived trust in vanity: for vanity shall be his

recompense.

vanity shall be <u>20\_PRO\_13\_11</u># Wealth [gotten] by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase.

vanity shall take <u>23\_ISA\_57\_13</u> # When thou criest, let thy companies deliver thee; but the wind shall carry them all away; vanity shall take [them]: but he that putteth his trust in me shall possess the land, and shall inherit my holy mountain;

vanity the work <u>24\_JER\_51\_18</u> # They [are] vanity, the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish.

vanity their works <u>23\_ISA\_41\_29</u># Behold, they [are] all vanity; their works [are] nothing: their molten images [are] wind and confusion.

vanity there is <u>21\_ECC\_07\_15</u># All [things] have I seen in the days of my vanity: there is a just [man] that perisheth in his righteousness, and there is a wicked [man] that prolongeth [his life] in his wickedness.

vanity they allure <u>61\_2PE\_02\_18</u># For when they speak great swelling [words] of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, [through much] wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error.

vanity they sacrifice <u>28\_HOS\_12\_11</u># [Is there] iniquity [in] Gilead? surely they are vanity: they sacrifice bullocks in Gilgal; yea, their altars [are] as heaps in the furrows of the fields.

vanity tossed to <u>20\_PRO\_21\_06</u># The getting of treasures by a lying tongue [is] a vanity tossed to and fro of them that seek death.

vanity under the <u>21\_ECC\_04\_07</u># Then I returned, and I saw vanity under the sun.

vanity unto thee <u>26\_EZE\_21\_29</u># Whiles they see vanity unto thee, whiles they divine a lie unto thee, to bring thee upon the necks of [them that are] slain, of the wicked, whose day is come, when their iniquity [shall have] an end.

vanity what is <u>21\_ECC\_06\_11</u># Seeing there be many things that increase vanity, what [is] man the better?

vanity yea it 21\_ECC\_04\_08 # There is one [alone], and [there is] not a second; yea, he hath neither child nor brother: yet [is there] no end of all his labour; neither is his eye satisfied with riches; neither [saith he], For whom do I labour, and bereave my soul of good? This [is] also vanity, yea, it [is] a sore travail.

vanity <u>21\_ECC\_01\_02</u> # Vanity of vanities, saith the Preacher, vanity of vanities; all [is] vanity.
