adventure to set <u>05\_DEU\_28\_56</u># The tender and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

adventured his life <u>07\_JUD\_09\_17</u> # [For my father fought for you, and adventured his life far, and delivered you out of the hand of Midian:

fervently for you <u>51\_COL\_04\_12</u> # Epaphras, who is [one] of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.

fervently <u>60\_1PE\_01\_22</u> # Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, [see that ye] love one another with a pure heart fervently:

invent to themselves <u>30\_AMO\_06\_05</u> # That chant to the sound of the viol, [and] invent to themselves instruments of music, like David;

peradventure he can <u>09\_1SA\_09\_06</u> # And he said unto him, Behold now, [there is] in this city a man of God, and [he is] an honourable man; all that he saith cometh surely to pass: now let us go thither;

prevent me or 18\_JOB\_03\_12 # Why did the knees prevent me? or why the breasts that I should suck?

prevent the night 19\_PSA\_119\_148 # Mine eyes prevent the [night] watches, that I might meditate in thy

word.

prevent thee 19\_PSA\_88\_13\_# But unto thee have I cried, O LORD; and in the morning shall my prayer prevent thee.

prevent them which <u>52\_1TH\_04\_15</u># For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive [and] remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

prevent us for 19\_PSA\_79\_08 # O remember not against us former iniquities: let thy tender mercies speedily prevent us: for we are brought very low.

prevent us <u>30\_AMO\_09\_10</u> # All the sinners of my people shall die by the sword, which say, The evil shall not overtake nor prevent us.

prevented him saying 40\_MAT\_17\_25# He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?

prevented the dawning 19\_PSA\_119\_147 # I prevented the dawning of the morning, and cried: I hoped in thy word.

prevented with their <u>23\_ISA\_21\_14</u> # The inhabitants of the land of Tema brought water to him that was thirsty, they prevented with their bread him that fled.

preventest him with 19\_PSA\_21\_03 # For thou preventest him with the blessings of goodness: thou settest a crown of pure gold on his head.

seventeen men <u>07\_JUD\_08\_14</u># And caught a young man of the men of Succoth, and inquired of him: and he described unto him the princes of Succoth, and the elders thereof, [even] threescore and seventeen men.

seventeenth day of <u>01\_GEN\_07\_11</u># In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

seventeenth day of <u>01\_GEN\_08\_04</u> # And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat.
