adventure himself into <u>44\_ACT\_19\_31</u> # And certain of the chief of Asia, which were his friends, sent unto him, desiring [him] that he would not adventure himself into the theatre.

adventure to set <u>05\_DEU\_28\_56</u> # The tender and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

adventured his life <u>07\_JUD\_09\_17</u># [For my father fought for you, and adventured his life far, and delivered you out of the hand of Midian:

peradventure for a <u>45\_ROM\_05\_07</u># For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.

peradventure hate us <u>01\_GEN\_50\_15</u> # And when Joseph's brethren saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did unto him.

peradventure he can <u>09\_1SA\_09\_06</u># And he said unto him, Behold now, [there is] in this city a man of God, and [he is] an honourable man; all that he saith cometh surely to pass: now let us go thither; peradventure he can show us our way that we should go.

peradventure he die <u>01\_GEN\_38\_11</u># Then said Judah to Tamar his daughter in law, Remain a widow at thy father's house, till Shelah my son be grown: for he said, Lest peradventure he die also, as his brethren [did]. And Tamar went and dwelt in her father's house.

peradventure he sleepeth <u>11\_1KI\_18\_27</u># And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he [is] a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, [or] peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked.

peradventure he will <u>11\_1KI\_20\_31</u># And his servants said unto him, Behold now, we have heard that the kings of the house of Israel [are] merciful kings: let us, I pray thee, put sackcloth on our loins, and ropes upon our heads, and go out to the king of Israel: peradventure he will save thy life.

peradventure the LORD <u>04\_NUM\_23\_03</u># And Balaam said unto Balak, Stand by thy burnt offering, and I will go: peradventure the LORD will come to meet me: and whatsoever he showeth me I will tell thee. And he went to an high place.
