vexed and oppressed 07\_JUD\_10\_08\_# And that year they vexed and oppressed the children of Israel: eighteen years, all the children of Israel that [were] on the other side Jordan in the land of the Amorites, which [is] in Gilead.

vexed but thou 19 PSA 06 03 # My soul is also sore vexed: but thou, O LORD, how long?

vexed for ofttimes 40 MAT 17 15# Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is a lunatic, and sore vexed: for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

vexed his holy 23 ISA 63 10 # But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, [and] he fought against them.

vexed his righteous 61 2PE 02 08 # [For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed [his] righteous soul from day to day with [their] unlawful deeds;]

vexed let them 19 PSA 06 10 # Let all mine enemies be ashamed and sore vexed: let them return [and] be ashamed suddenly,

vexed my soul 18 JOB 27 02 # [As] God liveth, [who] hath taken away my judgment; and the Almighty, [who] hath vexed my soul;

vexed that he 10 2SA 13 02 # And Amnon was so vexed, that he fell sick for his sister Tamar; for she [was] a virgin; and Amnon thought it hard for him to do any thing to her.

vexed the fatherless 26 EZE 22 07 # In thee have they set light by father and mother: in the midst of thee have they dealt by oppression with the stranger: in thee have they vexed the fatherless and the widow.

vexed the poor 26 EZE 22 29 # The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully.

vexed them and 16 NEH 09 27 # Therefore thou deliveredst them into the hand of their enemies, who vexed them: and in the time of their trouble, when they cried unto thee, thou heardest [them] from heaven; and according to thy manifold mercies thou gavest them saviours, who saved them out of the hand of their enemies.

vexed them 09 1SA 14 47 # So Saul took the kingdom over Israel, and fought against all his enemies on every side, against Moab, and against the children of Ammon, and against Edom, and against the kings of Zobah, and against the Philistines: and whithersoever he turned himself, he vexed [them].

vexed them 07\_JUD\_02\_18\_# And when the LORD raised them up judges, then the LORD was with the judge, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them.

vexed unto death 07 JUD 16 16# And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, [so] that his soul was vexed unto death;

vexed us and 04 NUM 20 15# How our fathers went down into Egypt, and we have dwelt in Egypt a long time; and the Egyptians vexed us, and our fathers:

vexed with a 40 MAT 15 22 # And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, [thou] son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.

vexed with the 61 2PE 02 07 # And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked:

vexed with unclean 44 ACT 05 16# There came also a multitude [out] of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

vexed with unclean 42 LUK 06 18 # And they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed.

vexed within her 12 2KI 04 27 # And when she came to the man of God to the hill, she caught him by the feet: but Gehazi came near to thrust her away. And the man of God said, Let her alone; for her soul [is] vexed within her: and the LORD hath hid [it] from me, and hath not told me.
