viol and invent <u>30_AMO_06_05</u> # That chant to the sound of the viol, [and] invent to themselves instruments of music, like David;

viol the tabret <u>23_ISA_05_12</u> # And the harp, and the viol, the tabret, and pipe, and wine, are in their feasts: but they regard not the work of the LORD, neither consider the operation of his hands.

violated my law <u>26_EZE_22_26</u> # Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they showed [difference] between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

violence against the <u>29_JOE_03_19</u> # Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence [against] the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.

violence against thy <u>31_OBA_01_10</u># For [thy] violence against thy brother Jacob shame shall cover thee, and thou shalt be cut off for ever.

violence and deceit <u>36_ZEP_01_09</u># In the same day also will I punish all those that leap on the threshold, which fill their masters' houses with violence and deceit.

violence and did <u>26 EZE 18 18</u> # [As for] his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled his brother by violence, and did [that] which [is] not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity.

violence and have <u>26_EZE_08_17</u># Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen [this], O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose.

violence and houses <u>33_MIC_02_02</u> # And they covet fields, and take [them] by violence; and houses, and take [them] away: so they oppress a man and his house, even a man and his heritage.

violence and precious <u>19_PSA_72_14</u># He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight.

violence and robbery <u>30_AMO_03_10</u> # For they know not to do right, saith the LORD, who store up violence and robbery in their palaces.

violence and spoil <u>26_EZE_45_09</u> # Thus saith the Lord GOD; Let it suffice you, O princes of Israel: remove violence and spoil, and execute judgment and justice, take away your exactions from my people, saith the Lord GOD.

violence and spoil <u>24_JER_06_07</u> # As a fountain casteth out her waters, so she casteth out her wickedness: violence and spoil is heard in her; before me continually [is] grief and wounds.

violence and spoil <u>24_JER_20_08</u># For since I spake, I cried out, I cried violence and spoil; because the word of the LORD was made a reproach unto me, and a derision, daily.

violence and strife <u>19_PSA_55_09</u># Destroy, O Lord, [and] divide their tongues: for I have seen violence and strife in the city.

violence and the <u>40_MAT_11_12</u># And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

violence and the <u>33_MIC_06_12</u># For the rich men thereof are full of violence, and the inhabitants thereof have spoken lies, and their tongue [is] deceitful in their mouth.

violence and thou <u>26_EZE_28_16</u># By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

violence and thou <u>35_HAB_01_02</u># O LORD, how long shall I cry, and thou wilt not hear! [even] cry out unto thee [of] violence, and thou wilt not save!

violence are before <u>35_HAB_01_03</u># Why dost thou show me iniquity, and cause [me] to behold grievance? for spoiling and violence [are] before me: and there are [that] raise up strife and contention.

violence but hath <u>26_EZE_18_16</u># Neither hath oppressed any, hath not withholden the pledge, neither hath spoiled by violence, [but] hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment,

violence covereth the <u>20_PRO_10_06</u> # Blessings [are] upon the head of the just: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.

violence covereth the <u>20_PRO_10_11</u># The mouth of a righteous [man is] a well of life: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.

violence covereth them <u>19_PSA_73_06</u># Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; violence covereth them [as] a garment.

violence done to <u>24_JER_51_35</u># The violence done to me and to my flesh [be] upon Babylon, shall the inhabitant of Zion say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say.

violence for they <u>44_ACT_05_26</u> # Then went the captain with the officers, and brought them without violence: for they feared the people, lest they should have been stoned.

violence hath given <u>26_EZE_18_07</u># And hath not oppressed any, [but] hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;

violence hath not <u>26_EZE_18_12</u># Hath oppressed the poor and needy, hath spoiled by violence, hath not restored the pledge, and hath lifted up his eyes to the idols, hath committed abomination,

violence his soul <u>19_PSA_11_05</u># The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence his soul hateth.

violence in the <u>24_JER_51_46</u># And lest your heart faint, and ye fear for the rumour that shall be heard in the land; a rumour shall both come [one] year, and after that in [another] year [shall come] a rumour, and violence in the land, ruler against ruler.

violence is in <u>23_ISA_59_06</u># Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works [are] works of iniquity, and the act of violence [is] in their hands.

Violence is risen <u>26_EZE_07_11</u># Violence is risen up into a rod of wickedness: none of them [shall remain], nor of their multitude, nor of any of theirs: neither [shall there be] wailing for them.

violence neither was 23 ISA 53 09 # And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither [was any] deceit in his mouth.

violence of all <u>26_EZE_12_19</u> # And say unto the people of the land, Thus saith the Lord GOD of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, [and] of the land of Israel; They shall eat their bread with carefulness, and drink their water with astonishment, that her land may be desolate from all that is therein, because of the violence of all them that dwell therein.

violence of fire <u>58_HEB_11_34</u># Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

violence of Lebanon <u>35_HAB_02_17</u> # For the violence of Lebanon shall cover thee, and the spoil of beasts, [which] made them afraid, because of men's blood, and for the violence of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.

violence of the <u>44_ACT_21_35</u> # And when he came upon the stairs, so it was, that he was borne of the soldiers for the violence of the people.

violence of the <u>44_ACT_27_41</u> # And falling into a place where two seas met, they ran the ship aground; and the forepart stuck fast, and remained unmoveable, but the hinder part was broken with the violence of the waves.

violence of the <u>35_HAB_02_08</u># Because thou hast spoiled many nations, all the remnant of the people shall spoil thee; because of men's blood, and [for] the violence of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.

violence of the <u>35_HAB_02_17</u># For the violence of Lebanon shall cover thee, and the spoil of beasts, [which] made them afraid, because of men's blood, and for the violence of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.

violence of your <u>19_PSA_58_02</u> # Yea, in heart ye work wickedness; ye weigh the violence of your hands in the earth.

violence or hath <u>03_LEV_06_02</u># If a soul sin, and commit a trespass against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbour in that which was delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or hath deceived his neighbour;

Violence shall no <u>23_ISA_60_18</u># Violence shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls Salvation, and thy gates Praise.

violence shall that <u>66_REV_18_21</u># And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast [it] into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.

violence that is <u>32_JON_03_08</u># But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily unto God: yea, let them turn every one from his evil way, and from the violence that [is] in their hands.

violence their faces <u>35_HAB_01_09</u># They shall come all for violence: their faces shall sup up [as] the east wind, and they shall gather the captivity as the sand.

violence through them <u>01_GEN_06_13</u> # And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

violence to come 30_AMO_06_03 # Ye that put far away the evil day, and cause the seat of violence to come

violence to do <u>24_JER_22_17</u> # But thine eyes and thine heart [are] not but for thy covetousness, and for to shed innocent blood, and for oppression, and for violence, to do [it].

violence to no <u>42_LUK_03_14</u># And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse [any] falsely; and be content with your wages.

violence to the <u>24_JER_22_03</u># Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.

violence to the <u>20_PRO_28_17</u> # A man that doeth violence to the blood of [any] person shall flee to the pit; let no man stay him.

violence to the <u>36_ZEP_03_04</u># Her prophets [are] light [and] treacherous persons: her priests have polluted the sanctuary, they have done violence to the law.

violence took him <u>44_ACT_24_07</u># But the chief captain Lysias came [upon us], and with great violence took [him] away out of our hands,

violence with his <u>39_MAL_02_16</u># For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for [one] covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously.

violence <u>10_2SA_22_03</u># The God of my rock; in him will I trust: [he is] my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence.

violence 26 EZE 07 23 # Make a chain: for the land is full of bloody crimes, and the city is full of violence.

violence <u>01_GEN_06_11</u># The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

violence <u>20_PRO_04_17</u># For they eat the bread of wickedness, and drink the wine of violence.

violence <u>20_PRO_13_02</u># A man shall eat good by the fruit of [his] mouth: but the soul of the transgressors [shall eat] violence.

violent dealing shall <u>19_PSA_07_16</u># His mischief shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down upon his own pate.

violent man enticeth <u>20_PRO_16_29</u># A violent man enticeth his neighbour, and leadeth him into the way [that is] not good.

violent man to <u>19_PSA_140_11</u># Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth: evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow [him].

violent man who <u>19_PSA_140_04</u> # Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from the violent man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings.

violent man $10_{28A_{22_{49}}}$ # And that bringeth me forth from mine enemies: thou also hast lifted me up on high above them that rose up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man.

violent man <u>19_PSA_140_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;

violent man <u>19_PSA_18_48</u> # He delivereth me from mine enemies: yea, thou liftest me up above those that rise up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man.

violent men have <u>19_PSA_86_14</u> # O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent [men] have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them.

violent perverting of <u>21_ECC_05_08</u># If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for [he that is] higher than the highest regardeth; and [there be] higher than they.

violent take it <u>40_MAT_11_12</u># And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

violently away or <u>03_LEV_06_04</u># Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

violently down a <u>42_LUK_08_33</u># Then went the devils out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.

violently down a <u>41_MAR_05_13</u># And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, [they were about two thousand;] and were choked in the sea.

violently down a <u>40_MAT_08_32</u># And he said unto them, Go. And when they were come out, they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters.

violently take away <u>18_JOB_24_02</u># [Some] remove the landmarks; they violently take away flocks, and feed [thereof].

violently taken away <u>05_DEU_28_31</u> # Thine ox [shall be] slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass [shall be] violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be restored to thee: thy sheep [shall be] given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to rescue [them].

violently taken away <u>01_GEN_21_25</u> # And Abraham reproved Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

violently taken away <u>18_JOB_20_19</u># Because he hath oppressed [and] hath forsaken the poor; [because] he hath violently taken away an house which he builded not;

violently taken away <u>25_LAM_02_06</u> # And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as [if it were of] a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

violently turn and <u>23_ISA_22_18</u># He will surely violently turn and toss thee [like] a ball into a large country: there shalt thou die, and there the chariots of thy glory [shall be] the shame of thy lord's house.

viols the worm <u>23_ISA_14_11</u># Thy pomp is brought down to the grave, [and] the noise of thy viols: the worm is spread under thee, and the worms cover thee.

viols <u>30_AMO_05_23</u> # Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols.
