violently away or [03 LEV 06 04](#) # Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

violently down a [42 LUK 08 33](#) # Then went the devils out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.

violently down a [41 MAR 05 13](#) # And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, [they were about two thousand;] and were choked in the sea.

violently down a [40 MAT 08 32](#) # And he said unto them, Go. And when they were come out, they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters.

violently take away [18 JOB 24 02](#) # [Some] remove the landmarks; they violently take away flocks, and feed [thereof].

violently taken away [05 DEU 28 31](#) # Thine ox [shall be] slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass [shall be] violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be restored to thee: thy sheep [shall be] given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to rescue [them].

violently taken away [01 GEN 21 25](#) # And Abraham reprov'd Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

violently taken away [18 JOB 20 19](#) # Because he hath oppressed [and] hath forsaken the poor; [because] he hath violently taken away an house which he builded not;

violently taken away [25 LAM 02 06](#) # And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as [if it were of] a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

violently turn and [23 ISA 22 18](#) # He will surely violently turn and toss thee [like] a ball into a large country: there shalt thou die, and there the chariots of thy glory [shall be] the shame of thy lord's house.
