unwashen hands defileth 40\_MAT\_15\_20 # These are [the things] which defile a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man.

unwashen hands they <u>41\_MAR\_07\_02</u># And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault.

unwashen hands <u>41\_MAR\_07\_05</u># Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?

wash all his <u>03\_LEV\_15\_16</u># And if any man's seed of copulation go out from him, then he shall wash all his flesh in water, and be unclean until the even.

wash away thy <u>44\_ACT\_22\_16</u># And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.

wash herself at <u>02\_EXO\_02\_05</u># And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash [herself] at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it.

wash himself in <u>03\_LEV\_14\_08</u># And he that is to be cleansed shall wash his clothes, and shave off all his hair, and wash himself in water, that he may be clean: and after that he shall come into the camp, and shall tarry abroad out of his tent seven days.

wash his clothes <u>03\_LEV\_15\_08</u># And if he that hath the issue spit upon him that is clean; then he shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

wash his clothes <u>03\_LEV\_15\_10</u># And whosoever toucheth any thing that was under him shall be unclean until the even: and he that beareth [any of] those things shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

wash his clothes <u>03\_LEV\_15\_11</u># And whomsoever he toucheth that hath the issue, and hath not rinsed his hands in water, he shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

wash his clothes <u>03\_LEV\_15\_13</u># And when he that hath an issue is cleansed of his issue; then he shall number to himself seven days for his cleansing, and wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in running water, and shall be clean.

wash his clothes <u>03\_LEV\_15\_21</u># And whosoever toucheth her bed shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

wash his clothes <u>03\_LEV\_15\_22</u> # And whosoever toucheth any thing that she sat upon shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

wash his clothes <u>03\_LEV\_15\_27</u># And whosoever toucheth those things shall be unclean, and shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

wash his clothes 03\_LEV\_16\_26 # And he that let go the goat for the scapegoat shall wash his clothes, and

bathe his flesh in water, and afterward come into the camp.

wash his clothes <u>03\_LEV\_16\_28</u># And he that burneth them shall wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in water, and afterward he shall come into the camp.

wash his clothes <u>03 LEV 17\_15</u> # And every soul that eateth that which died [of itself], or that which was torn [with beasts, whether it be] one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even: then shall he be clean.

wash his clothes <u>04\_NUM\_19\_07</u># Then the priest shall wash his clothes, and he shall bathe his flesh in water, and afterward he shall come into the camp, and the priest shall be unclean until the even.

wash his clothes <u>04\_NUM\_19\_08</u># And he that burneth her shall wash his clothes in water, and bathe his flesh in water, and shall be unclean until the even.

wash his clothes <u>04\_NUM\_19\_10</u># And he that gathereth the ashes of the heifer shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even: and it shall be unto the children of Israel, and unto the stranger that sojourneth among them, for a statute for ever.

wash his clothes <u>04\_NUM\_19\_19</u># And the clean [person] shall sprinkle upon the unclean on the third day, and on the seventh day: and on the seventh day he shall purify himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be clean at even.

wash his clothes <u>04\_NUM\_19\_21</u> # And it shall be a perpetual statute unto them, that he that sprinkleth the water of separation shall wash his clothes; and he that toucheth the water of separation shall be unclean until even.

wash his feet <u>01\_GEN\_24\_32</u> # And the man came into the house: and he ungirded his camels, and gave straw and provender for the camels, and water to wash his feet, and the men's feet that [were] with him.

wash his feet <u>43\_JOH\_13\_10</u> # Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash [his] feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.

wash his feet <u>42\_LUK\_07\_38</u># And stood at his feet behind [him] weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe [them] with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed [them] with the ointment.

wash his feet <u>19\_PSA\_58\_10</u> # The righteous shall rejoice when he seeth the vengeance: he shall wash his feet in the blood of the wicked.

wash his flesh <u>03\_LEV\_14\_09</u> # But it shall be on the seventh day, that he shall shave all his hair off his head and his beard and his eyebrows, even all his hair he shall shave off: and he shall wash his clothes, also he shall wash his flesh in water, and he shall be clean.

wash his flesh <u>03\_LEV\_16\_04</u># He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches upon his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen mitre shall he be attired: these [are] holy garments; therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and [so] put them on.

wash if the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_58</u># And the garment, either warp, or woof, or whatsoever thing of skin [it be], which thou shalt wash, if the plague be departed from them, then it shall be washed the second time, and shall be clean.

wash in Jordan 12\_2KI\_05\_10 # And Elisha sent a messenger unto him, saying, Go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to thee, and thou shalt be clean.

wash in the <u>43\_JOH\_09\_07</u># And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, [which is by interpretation, Sent.] He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

wash in them 14\_2CH\_04\_06 # He made also ten lavers, and put five on the right hand, and five on the left, to wash in them: such things as they offered for the burnt offering they washed in them; but the sea [was] for the priests to wash in.

wash in them 12 2KI 05 12 # [Are] not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? may I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in a rage.

wash in water <u>03\_LEV\_01\_09</u># But his inwards and his legs shall he wash in water: and the priest shall burn all on the altar, [to be] a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

wash in <u>14\_2CH\_04\_06</u># He made also ten lavers, and put five on the right hand, and five on the left, to wash in them: such things as they offered for the burnt offering they washed in them; but the sea [was] for the priests to wash in.

wash me and 19\_PSA\_51\_07\_# Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

Wash me thoroughly 19\_PSA\_51\_02 # Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

wash mine hands <u>19\_PSA\_26\_06</u> # I will wash mine hands in innocency: so will I compass thine altar, O LORD:

wash my feet <u>43\_JOH\_13\_06</u># Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?

wash my feet <u>43\_JOH\_13\_08</u> # Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me.

wash myself with 18\_JOB\_09\_30 # If I wash myself with snow water, and make my hands never so clean;

wash not their <u>40\_MAT\_15\_02</u># Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread.

wash one another's <u>43\_JOH\_13\_14</u># If I then, [your] Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

wash that whereon <u>03\_LEV\_06\_27</u> # Whatsoever shall touch the flesh thereof shall be holy: and when there is sprinkled of the blood thereof upon any garment, thou shalt wash that whereon it was sprinkled in the holy place.

wash the disciples' 43\_JOH\_13\_05 # After that he poureth water into a basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe [them] with the towel wherewith he was girded.

wash the feet 09\_1SA\_25\_41 # And she arose, and bowed herself on [her] face to the earth, and said,

Behold, [let] thine handmaid [be] a servant to wash the feet of the servants of my lord.

wash the inwards <u>02\_EXO\_29\_17</u># And thou shalt cut the ram in pieces, and wash the inwards of him, and his legs, and put [them] unto his pieces, and unto his head.

wash the inwards <u>03\_LEV\_01\_13</u># But he shall wash the inwards and the legs with water: and the priest shall bring [it] all, and burn [it] upon the altar: it [is] a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

wash the inwards <u>03\_LEV\_09\_14</u> # And he did wash the inwards and the legs, and burnt [them] upon the burnt offering on the altar.

wash the thing <u>03\_LEV\_13\_54</u># Then the priest shall command that they wash [the thing] wherein the plague [is], and he shall shut it up seven days more:

wash thee not <u>43\_JOH\_13\_08</u> # Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me.

wash thee with 24\_JER\_02\_22 # For though thou wash thee with nitre, and take thee much soap, [yet] thine iniquity is marked before me, saith the Lord GOD.

wash their clothes <u>02\_EXO\_19\_10</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes,

wash their clothes <u>04\_NUM\_08\_07</u># And thus shalt thou do unto them, to cleanse them: Sprinkle water of purifying upon them, and let them shave all their flesh, and let them wash their clothes, and [so] make themselves clean.

wash their hands <u>05\_DEU\_21\_06</u># And all the elders of that city, [that are] next unto the slain [man], shall wash their hands over the heifer that is beheaded in the valley:

wash their hands 02\_EXO\_30\_19 # For Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet thereat:

wash their hands <u>02\_EXO\_30\_21</u> # So they shall wash their hands and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, [even] to him and to his seed throughout their generations.

wash their hands <u>41\_MAR\_07\_03</u> # For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash [their] hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders.

wash them not <u>03\_LEV\_17\_16</u> # But if he wash [them] not, nor bathe his flesh; then he shall bear his iniquity.

wash them with <u>02\_EXO\_29\_04</u> # And Aaron and his sons thou shalt bring unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and shalt wash them with water.

wash them with <u>02\_EXO\_40\_12</u># And thou shalt bring Aaron and his sons unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and wash them with water.

wash they eat <u>41\_MAR\_07\_04</u> # And [when they come] from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, [as] the washing of cups, and pots, brazen vessels, and of tables.

wash thine heart <u>24\_JER\_04\_14</u> # O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, that thou mayest be saved. How long shall thy vain thoughts lodge within thee?

wash thy face 40\_MAT\_06\_17 # But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face;

wash thy feet 10\_2SA\_11\_08# And David said to Uriah, Go down to thy house, and wash thy feet. And Uriah departed out of the king's house, and there followed him a mess [of meat] from the king.

Wash thy self <u>08\_RUT\_03\_03</u># Wash thy self therefore, and anoint thee, and put thy raiment upon thee, and get thee down to the floor: [but] make not thyself known unto the man, until he shall have done eating and drinking.

wash thyself paintedst <u>26\_EZE\_23\_40</u> # And furthermore, that ye have sent for men to come from far, unto whom a messenger [was] sent; and, lo, they came: for whom thou didst wash thyself, paintedst thy eyes, and deckedst thyself with ornaments,

wash with water <u>02\_EXO\_30\_20</u># When they go into the tabernacle of the congregation, they shall wash with water, that they die not; or when they come near to the altar to minister, to burn offering made by fire unto the LORD:

wash withal and <u>02\_EXO\_30\_18</u> # Thou shalt also make a laver [of] brass, and his foot [also of] brass, to wash [withal]: and thou shalt put it between the tabernacle of the congregation and the altar, and thou shalt put water therein.

wash withal <u>02\_EXO\_40\_30</u> # And he set the laver between the tent of the congregation and the altar, and put water there, to wash [withal].

Wash you make <u>23\_ISA\_01\_16</u> # Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil;

wash your clothes <u>04\_NUM\_31\_24</u> # And ye shall wash your clothes on the seventh day, and ye shall be clean, and afterward ye shall come into the camp.

wash your feet <u>01\_GEN\_18\_04</u> # Let a little water, I pray you, be fetched, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree:

wash your feet <u>01\_GEN\_19\_02</u> # And he said, Behold now, my lords, turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and tarry all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall rise up early, and go on your ways. And they said, Nay; but we will abide in the street all night.

washed and anointed <u>10\_2SA\_12\_20</u> # Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

washed and behold <u>03\_LEV\_13\_55</u># And the priest shall look on the plague, after that it is washed: and, behold, [if] the plague have not changed his colour, and the plague be not spread; it [is] unclean; thou shalt burn it in the fire; it [is] fret inward, [whether] it [be] bare within or without.

washed and came <u>43\_JOH\_09\_07</u> # And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, [which is by interpretation, Sent.] He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

washed and do <u>43\_JOH\_09\_15</u># Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. He said unto them, He put clay upon mine eyes, and I washed, and do see.

washed and I <u>43\_JOH\_09\_11</u># He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.

washed as the <u>02\_EXO\_40\_32</u># When they went into the tent of the congregation, and when they came near unto the altar, they washed; as the LORD commanded Moses.

washed away the 23 ISA 04 04 # When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.

washed away thy <u>26\_EZE\_16\_09</u># Then washed I thee with water; yea, I thoroughly washed away thy blood from thee, and I anointed thee with oil.

washed before dinner <u>42\_LUK\_11\_38</u># And when the Pharisee saw [it], he marvelled that he had not first washed before dinner.

washed but ye <u>46\_1CO\_06\_11</u># And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

washed from their <u>20\_PRO\_30\_12</u> # [There is] a generation [that are] pure in their own eyes, and [yet] is not washed from their filthiness.

washed his armour 11\_1KI\_22\_38 # And [one] washed the chariot in the pool of Samaria; and the dogs licked up his blood; and they washed his armour; according unto the word of the LORD which he spake.

washed his clothes <u>10\_2SA\_19\_24</u># And Mephibosheth the son of Saul came down to meet the king, and had neither dressed his feet, nor trimmed his beard, nor washed his clothes, from the day the king departed until the day he came [again] in peace.

washed his face <u>01\_GEN\_43\_31</u># And he washed his face, and went out, and refrained himself, and said, Set on bread.

washed his garments <u>01\_GEN\_49\_11</u># Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

washed his hands <u>40\_MAT\_27\_24</u># When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but [that] rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed [his] hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye [to it].

washed I thee <u>26\_EZE\_16\_09</u> # Then washed I thee with water; yea, I thoroughly washed away thy blood from thee, and I anointed thee with oil.

washed in them <u>14\_2CH\_04\_06</u> # He made also ten lavers, and put five on the right hand, and five on the left, to wash in them: such things as they offered for the burnt offering they washed in them; but the sea [was] for the priests to wash in.

washed in water <u>26\_EZE\_16\_04</u> # And [as for] thy nativity, in the day thou wast born thy navel was not cut, neither wast thou washed in water to supple [thee]; thou wast not salted at all, nor swaddled at all.

washed my feet <u>42\_LUK\_07\_44</u># And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped [them] with the hairs of her head.

washed my feet <u>22\_SON\_05\_03</u> # I have put off my coat; how shall I put it on? I have washed my feet; how shall I defile them?

washed my hands <u>19\_PSA\_73\_13</u># Verily I have cleansed my heart [in] vain, and washed my hands in innocency.

washed my steps <u>18\_JOB\_29\_06</u> # When I washed my steps with butter, and the rock poured me out rivers of oil;

washed needeth not <u>43\_JOH\_13\_10</u> # Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash [his] feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.

washed the burnt <u>26\_EZE\_40\_38</u># And the chambers and the entries thereof [were] by the posts of the gates, where they washed the burnt offering.

washed the chariot 11 1KI 22 38 # And [one] washed the chariot in the pool of Samaria; and the dogs licked up his blood; and they washed his armour; according unto the word of the LORD which he spake.

washed the inwards <u>03\_LEV\_08\_21</u> # And he washed the inwards and the legs in water; and Moses burnt the whole ram upon the altar: it [was] a burnt sacrifice for a sweet savour, [and] an offering made by fire unto the LORD; as the LORD commanded Moses.

washed the saints' <u>54\_1TI\_05\_10</u> # Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work.

washed the second <u>03\_LEV\_13\_58</u># And the garment, either warp, or woof, or whatsoever thing of skin [it be], which thou shalt wash, if the plague be departed from them, then it shall be washed the second time, and shall be clean.

washed their clothes <u>02\_EXO\_19\_14</u> # And Moses went down from the mount unto the people, and sanctified the people; and they washed their clothes.

washed their clothes <u>04\_NUM\_08\_21</u># And the Levites were purified, and they washed their clothes; and Aaron offered them [as] an offering before the LORD; and Aaron made an atonement for them to cleanse them.

washed their feet <u>01\_GEN\_43\_24</u># And the man brought the men into Joseph's house, and gave [them] water, and they washed their feet; and he gave their asses provender.

washed their feet <u>43\_JOH\_13\_12</u> # So after he had washed their feet, and had taken his garments, and was set down again, he said unto them, Know ye what I have done to you?

washed their feet <u>07\_JUD\_19\_21</u> # So he brought him into his house, and gave provender unto the asses: and they washed their feet, and did eat and drink.

washed their hands <u>02\_EXO\_40\_31</u> # And Moses and Aaron and his sons washed their hands and their feet thereat:

washed their robes <u>66\_REV\_07\_14</u># And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

washed their stripes 44\_ACT\_16\_33 # And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed [their] stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.

washed them with 03\_LEV\_08\_06 # And Moses brought Aaron and his sons, and washed them with water.

washed they laid <u>44\_ACT\_09\_37</u># And it came to pass in those days, that she was sick, and died: whom when they had washed, they laid [her] in an upper chamber.

washed to her <u>61\_2PE\_02\_22</u># But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog [is] turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

washed us from 66\_REV\_01\_05 # And from Jesus Christ, [who is] the faithful witness, [and] the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

washed with milk <u>22\_SON\_05\_12</u> # His eyes [are] as [the eyes] of doves by the rivers of waters, washed with milk, [and] fitly set.

washed with pure <u>58\_HEB\_10\_22</u> # Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

washed with water <u>03\_LEV\_15\_17</u> # And every garment, and every skin, whereon is the seed of copulation, shall be washed with water, and be unclean until the even.

washed your feet <u>43\_JOH\_13\_14</u> # If I then, [your] Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

washest away the <u>18\_JOB\_14\_19</u> # The waters wear the stones: thou washest away the things which grow [out] of the dust of the earth; and thou destroyest the hope of man.

washing herself and <u>10\_2SA\_11\_02</u># And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: and from the roof he saw a woman washing herself; and the woman [was] very beautiful to look upon.

washing of cups <u>41\_MAR\_07\_04</u># And [when they come] from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, [as] the washing of cups, and pots, brazen vessels, and of tables.

washing of it <u>03\_LEV\_13\_56</u># And if the priest look, and, behold, the plague [be] somewhat dark after the washing of it; then he shall rend it out of the garment, or out of the skin, or out of the warp, or out of the woof:

washing of pots <u>41\_MAR\_07\_08</u># For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, [as] the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.

washing of water 49\_EPH\_05\_26 # That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

washing their nets <u>42\_LUK\_05\_02</u># And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing [their] nets.

washing whereof every 22\_SON\_04\_02 # Thy teeth [are] like a flock [of sheep that are even] shorn, which came up from the washing; whereof every one bear twins, and none [is] barren among them.

washing whereof every 22\_SON\_06\_06 # Thy teeth [are] as a flock of sheep which go up from the washing, whereof every one beareth twins, and [there is] not one barren among them.

washing <u>16\_NEH\_04\_23</u># So neither I, nor my brethren, nor my servants, nor the men of the guard which followed me, none of us put off our clothes, [saving that] every one put them off for washing.

washings and carnal <u>58\_HEB\_09\_10</u> # [Which stood] only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed [on them] until the time of reformation.

washpot over Edom <u>19\_PSA\_108\_09</u># Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe; over Philistia will I triumph.

washpot over Edom  $\underline{19}$  PSA  $\underline{60}$  08 # Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe: Philistia, triumph thou because of me.
