asswage your grief <u>18_JOB_16_05</u># [But] I would strengthen you with my mouth, and the moving of my lips should asswage [your grief].

asswaged and though <u>18_JOB_16_06</u># Though I speak, my grief is not asswaged: and [though] I forbear, what am I eased?

asswaged <u>01_GEN_08_01</u> # And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that [was] with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters asswaged;

wag his hand <u>36_ZEP_02_15</u># This [is] the rejoicing city that dwelt carelessly, that said in her heart, I [am], and [there is] none beside me: how is she become a desolation, a place for beasts to lie down in! every one that passeth by her shall hiss, [and] wag his hand.

wag his head <u>24_JER_18_16</u># To make their land desolate, [and] a perpetual hissing; every one that passeth thereby shall be astonished, and wag his head.

wag their head <u>25_LAM_02_15</u> # All that pass by clap [their] hands at thee; they hiss and wag their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, [saying, Is] this the city that [men] call The perfection of beauty, The joy of the whole earth?

wages and gathereth <u>43_JOH_04_36</u> # And he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal: that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together.

wages and giveth <u>24_JER_22_13</u> # Woe unto him that buildeth his house by unrighteousness, and his chambers by wrong; [that] useth his neighbour's service without wages, and giveth him not for his work;

wages and I 01_GEN_30_28 # And he said, Appoint me thy wages, and I will give [it].

wages And the <u>02_EXO_02_09</u># And Pharaoh's daughter said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give [thee] thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it.

wages be <u>01_GEN_29_15</u> # And Laban said unto Jacob, Because thou [art] my brother, shouldest thou therefore serve me for nought? tell me, what [shall] thy wages [be]?

wages earneth wages <u>37_HAG_01_06</u> # Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages [to put it] into a bag with holes.

wages for his <u>26_EZE_29_19</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will give the land of Egypt unto Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon; and he shall take her multitude, and take her spoil, and take her prey; and it shall be the wages for his army.

wages nor his <u>26_EZE_29_18</u> # Son of man, Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon caused his army to serve a great service against Tyrus: every head [was] made bald, and every shoulder [was] peeled: yet had he no wages, nor his army, for Tyrus, for the service that he had served against it:

wages of him <u>03_LEV_19_13</u># Thou shalt not defraud thy neighbour, neither rob [him]: the wages of him that is hired shall not abide with thee all night until the morning.

wages of sin <u>45_ROM_06_23</u> # For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

wages of them <u>47_2CO_11_08</u># I robbed other churches, taking wages [of them], to do you service.

wages of unrighteousness <u>61_2PE_02_15</u> # Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam [the son] of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;

wages ten times <u>01_GEN_31_07</u># And your father hath deceived me, and changed my wages ten times; but God suffered him not to hurt me.

wages ten times <u>01_GEN_31_41</u># Thus have I been twenty years in thy house; I served thee fourteen years for thy two daughters, and six years for thy cattle: and thou hast changed my wages ten times.

wages the widow <u>39_MAL_03_05</u> # And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in [his] wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger [from his right], and fear not me, saith the LORD of hosts.

wages then all <u>01_GEN_31_08</u># If he said thus, The speckled shall be thy wages; then all the cattle bare speckled: and if he said thus, The ringstreaked shall be thy hire; then bare all the cattle ringstreaked.

wages to put <u>37_HAG_01_06</u># Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages [to put it] into a bag with holes.

wages <u>42_LUK_03_14</u> # And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse [any] falsely; and be content with your wages.

wagging their heads <u>41_MAR_15_29</u> # And they that passed by railed on him, wagging their heads, and saying, Ah, thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest [it] in three days,

wagging their heads <u>40_MAT_27_39</u># And they that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads,

wagon for two <u>04_NUM_07_03</u> # And they brought their offering before the LORD, six covered wagons, and twelve oxen; a wagon for two of the princes, and for each one an ox: and they brought them before the tabernacle.

wagons according to <u>01_GEN_45_21</u> # And the children of Israel did so: and Joseph gave them wagons, according to the commandment of Pharaoh, and gave them provision for the way.

wagons and eight <u>04_NUM_07_08</u># And four wagons and eight oxen he gave unto the sons of Merari, according unto their service, under the hand of Ithamar the son of Aaron the priest.

wagons and four <u>04_NUM_07_07</u># Two wagons and four oxen he gave unto the sons of Gershon, according to their service:

wagons and twelve <u>04_NUM_07_03</u> # And they brought their offering before the LORD, six covered wagons, and twelve oxen; a wagon for two of the princes, and for each one an ox: and they brought them before the tabernacle.

wagons out of <u>01_GEN_45_19</u># Now thou art commanded, this do ye; take you wagons out of the land of Egypt for your little ones, and for your wives, and bring your father, and come.
