washing herself and [10\\_2SA\\_11\\_02](#) # And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: and from the roof he saw a woman washing herself; and the woman [was] very beautiful to look upon.

washing of cups [41\\_MAR\\_07\\_04](#) # And [when they come] from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, [as] the washing of cups, and pots, brazen vessels, and of tables.

washing of it [03\\_LEV\\_13\\_56](#) # And if the priest look, and, behold, the plague [be] somewhat dark after the washing of it; then he shall rend it out of the garment, or out of the skin, or out of the warp, or out of the woof:

washing of pots [41\\_MAR\\_07\\_08](#) # For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, [as] the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.

washing of regeneration [56\\_TIT\\_03\\_05](#) # Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

washing of water [49\\_EPH\\_05\\_26](#) # That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

washing their nets [42\\_LUK\\_05\\_02](#) # And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing [their] nets.

washing whereof every [22\\_SON\\_04\\_02](#) # Thy teeth [are] like a flock [of sheep that are even] shorn, which came up from the washing; whereof every one bear twins, and none [is] barren among them.

washing [16\\_NEH\\_04\\_23](#) # So neither I, nor my brethren, nor my servants, nor the men of the guard which followed me, none of us put off our clothes, [saving that] every one put them off for washing.

washings and carnal [58\\_HEB\\_09\\_10](#) # [Which stood] only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed [on them] until the time of reformation.
