washing herself and <u>10_2SA_11_02</u># And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: and from the roof he saw a woman washing herself; and the woman [was] very beautiful to look upon.

washing of cups <u>41 MAR 07 04</u> # And [when they come] from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, [as] the washing of cups, and pots, brazen vessels, and of tables.

washing of it <u>03 LEV 13 56 #</u> And if the priest look, and, behold, the plague [be] somewhat dark after the washing of it; then he shall rend it out of the garment, or out of the skin, or out of the warp, or out of the woof:

washing of pots <u>41_MAR_07_08</u># For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, [as] the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.

washing of regeneration <u>56_TIT_03_05</u># Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

washing of water 49_EPH_05_26 # That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

washing their nets <u>42_LUK_05_02</u># And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing [their] nets.

washing whereof every <u>22_SON_04_02</u> # Thy teeth [are] like a flock [of sheep that are even] shorn, which came up from the washing; whereof every one bear twins, and none [is] barren among them.

washing whereof every 22_SON_06_06 # Thy teeth [are] as a flock of sheep which go up from the washing, whereof every one beareth twins, and [there is] not one barren among them.

washing <u>16_NEH_04_23</u> # So neither I, nor my brethren, nor my servants, nor the men of the guard which followed me, none of us put off our clothes, [saving that] every one put them off for washing.

washings and carnal <u>58_HEB_09_10</u> # [Which stood] only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed [on them] until the time of reformation.
